A GEM OF A GORGONIO

Grade I winners **Diamondrella (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) and **Life Is Sweet** (Storm Cat) face off in today's GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita. **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** Life Is Sweet, first or second in four of her five grass starts, makes her first appearance since a

decisive 2 1/2-length success in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic on the Santa Anita Pro-Ride. "She was supposed to be a grass filly," said regular rider Garrett Gomez. "That's where she did some of her better running early on in her career back East. When she came to California, she adapted to the synthetic really well." Gomez added, "She should be fine back on grass. That's kind of what she's meant to do." But it is turf specialist Diamondrella who rates the nod. The six-year-

old mare capped a six-race winning streak on the sod with a 1 3/4-length score over 2008 Eclipse champion Forever Together (Belong to Me) in the June 6 GI Just a Game S. at Belmont. Sixth when switched to the all-weather for the Sept. 12 Presque Isle Downs

Masters S., she rebounded to take the Oct. 10 GI First Lady S. on the Keeneland spinach. Diamondrella was 11th after a less-than-perfect trip in the Nov. 7 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint before closing to be third behind Ventura (Chester House) in the Nov. 28 GI Matriarch S. going a mile at Hollywood, and she should relish the extra furlong this afternoon. **Rosa Grace (GB)** (Lomitas {GB}) adds blinkers after a solid fifth-place effort in the Oct. 10 GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Oak Tree. Beaten just 2 3/4 lengths by Magical Fantasy (Diesis {GB}) that afternoon, the five-year-old grey has been working well, but trainer Ben Cecil believes she needs more ground to be at her best. "This is not an easy spot, and she really wants to go a mile and a quarter, plus," Cecil admitted. **Field, p3**

Lost Aptitude (Aptitude) in the final strides to post the upset by a head. "The favorite on the lead wasn't stopping, so it was a matter of my horse finishing strong for me--and he did,"

jockey Eduardo Nunez said. Fly By Phil had finished first or second in all four of his previous appearances, but was trying turf for the first time. "Although he had never run on turf, [owner Gilbert Campbell] and I decided the timing was right and we'd give him a chance," trainer Kathleen O'Connell said. "I actually would have had much more confidence in his chances if the race had come off the turf, although this horse does have turf pedigree." But he will be back on the dirt next time out. "We'll look ahead now to the Sam Davis [GIII, 1 1/16, Feb. 13] at Tampa Bay, which has been in the plans for awhile," O'Connell said. **Cont. p2**

Second in his first two tries, Fly By Phil was scheduled to make his turf bow in a maiden test at Calder Sept. 20, but romped home a 10 3/4-length winner when that race was taken off the grass. The Campbell homebred was given a break after that score, returning to post an allowance score Dec. 11, but was an outsider trying a yielding Calder course in his black-type debut. Bumping with favored Lost Aptitude after breaking a bit toward the inside, he shook off the contact and tugged Eduardo Nunez up to sit off the crowd's choice early. Nunez was still sitting chilly as they raced around the bend, but he put Fly By Phil to a drive when they straightened for home. 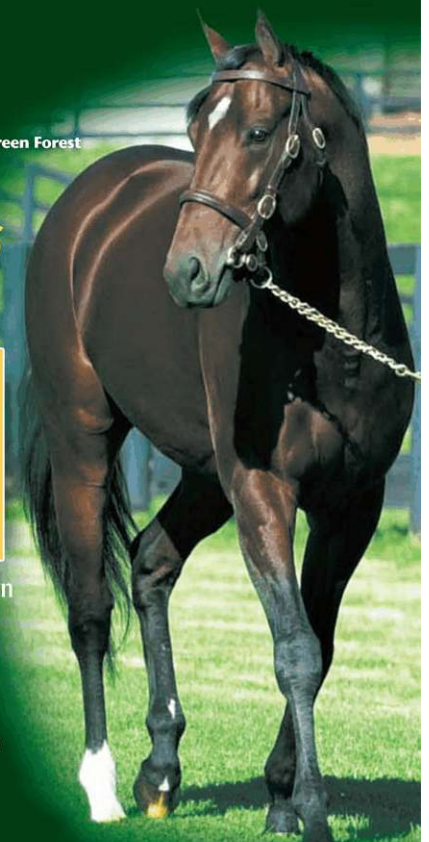

ASMUSSEN SETS RECORD; GOMEZ TAKES FOURTH MONEY TITLE

Steve Asmussen, the leading trainer in North America by races won in 2003 and 2008, set a single-season record in 2009, winning 650 races from 2,944 starts. Todd Pletcher was a distant runner-up, with 238 victories from 1,108 starts. Asmussen was also the leading conditioner by earnings, with \$21,876,405 in purses last year. Michael Gill was the leading owner in 2009, winning 370 races from 2,247 starts. Gill's earnings totalled \$6,669,950. Second was Juddmonte Farms, with \$6,525,818 in earnings. Juddmonte, however, sent out just 116 runners, with 27 wins. For the first time, two distaffers finished one-two in the standings for the year's top earners. GI Breeders' Cup Classic heroine Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) was the first filly or mare since Dance Smartly in 1991 to lead the list, taking home purses of \$3,330,000. Three-year-old filly Rachel Alexandra was second, with \$2,746,914 in earnings. Stats were compiled by Equibase.

Gomez Ekes Out Another Title...

It went down to the wire in the North American jockeys' race, but Garrett Gomez led the standings by earnings for a fourth straight season, compiling \$18,571,171 in purses. Julien Leparoux just missed in second, with earnings of \$18,560,565. It initially looked as if Leparoux was going to take the title; Gomez had just two mounts at Santa Anita on New Year's Eve, and even after winning aboard his second of the two, Fund Raiser (Harlan's Holiday), in the fourth race, he was still \$194 behind. But Martin Pedroza took off Cenizo (Value Plus), the morning-line favorite in the eighth race finale, and Gomez picked up the mount. Cenizo scored as the 9-10 chalk, and Gomez had himself another title. "To have to go down to actually my last mount of the year is unreal," Gomez said. "I was lucky enough to pick up the winner. I was hanging around the [jockeys'] room, hoping to pick up something, and Martin didn't feel well."

Mar. 21 prior to a third in the GII Bed o' Roses H. on the outer track Apr. 18. Away seven months thereafter, the bay returned to action with a fourth in the In Her Glory S. "Awesome Ashley broke sharp - she was really sharp coming into the race - and was a little closer than I thought she was going to be, but I don't think that really put her at any disadvantage.
