BACK ON THE ROAD

Quality Road (Elusive Quality), so impressive in winning the GI Florida Derby and GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream last winter, kicks off his four-year-old

campaign in today's GIII Hal's Hope H. at the Hallandale oval. The handsome bay will be making his first start since being infamously scratched at the gate of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 7; prior to that, he was third in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 3.

Trainer Todd Pletcher has prescribed plenty of schooling for his charge. "He couldn't be doing any better in the morning, including his sessions at the starting gate," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's stood at the gate several times a week with both the regular gate crew and Bob Duncan, and has been perfect. He seems to be handling everything very well, and a one-turn mile is something he's done before. Hopefully, he'll run well on Sunday, but not run the race of the year, because it's a race we're looking to build on for the [GI] Donn [H. at Gulfstream Feb. 6]." Among the competition in the Hal's Hope is stablemate **Harlem Rocker** (Macho Uno), who was sidelined following his disqualification from first in the 2008 GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile. The Stronach homebred has made just one start since, finishing second by a head in a seven-furlong optional claimer at Churchill Nov. 14.

Saturday's GII San Gorgonio H. lost some of its luster when it was revealed that Life Is Sweet (Storm Cat) tied up in the morning and was scratched (*see p3*), but

Cat by the Tale (Tale of the Cat) came home a good-looking winner. "[Trainer] Neil [Drysdale] said that I could probably lay second or third early," said winning rider Joel Rosario. "I didn't want anybody to get an easy lead, and I wanted to make sure I put some pressure on. She got to the three-eighths pole really easy. I wanted to make the lead at the quarter pole, and she did the rest. She was impressive." There was a four-way photo for second, with multiple Grade I

winner--and 2-1 favorite--**Diamondrella (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) coming up short in fifth. Sent off as the third choice to Diamondrella, Cat by the Tale enjoyed a perfect trip in the catbird seat off pacesetter Century Park (General Meeting). She pounced to the lead turning for home and finished up smartly for her first graded trophy. **Cont. p2**

Cat by the Tale hit the board once in two juvenile starts at Arlington for trainer David Hanley. Acquired on Raymond Keogh's behalf as a three-year-old at KEEJAN, she won twice in Ireland in 2008 for trainer David Wachman before being transferred to Neil Drysdale last spring. After capturing her U.S. bow, the chestnut ran second and third in a pair of Hollywood allowance heats in May, then idled for five months. She came back to annex a hillside sprint at Oak Tree Oct. 23, followed that with a solid third to Tuscan Evening (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the GII Las Palmas H. Nov. 6, and came into this test off another good show effort in the GII Bayakoa H. on the Hollywood main track Dec. 5.

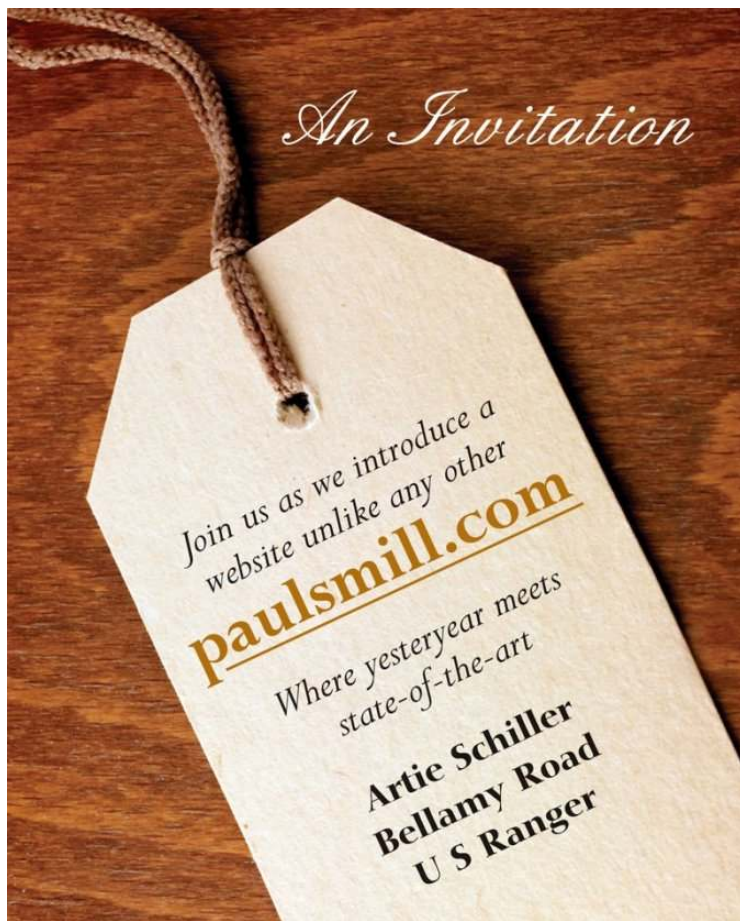

Life Is Sweet Ties Up, Scratched...

GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine **Life Is Sweet** (Storm Cat) was scratched on the morning of her intended 2010 opener, yesterday's GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita. "She tied up after galloping early [Saturday] morning," owner Marty Wygod told *Daily Racing Form*. "We thought we were over that problem--it's what plagued us from last year. We got over it after we came back from Del Mar. Unfortunately, it came back. Obviously, we couldn't medicate her and we couldn't run her." Now five, the **TDN Rising Star** will undergo a thorough examination to determine whether she races again, or instead heads to the breeding shed. "I really want to run her," Wygod continued. "Everybody started to see her brilliance in the Breeders' Cup. We'll try to figure out what makes the most sense. It's disappointing because she would have loved the grass. It's very puzzling." The Wygod homebred, a full-sister to champion and fellow Breeders' Cup winner Sweet Catomine, captured the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H., GII El Encino S. and GII La Canada S. in 2009, and also ran third to the boys in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup. She has bankrolled \$1,770,810 to date.

Trainer Bob Baffert, inducted into the Hall of Fame last summer, has been on quite a roll in recent weeks with his youngsters, including a GI CashCall Futurity victory by likely champion Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike). He also made headlines with Kaleem Shah's **Take Control** (A.P. Indy), the first foal from champion Azeri (Jade Hunter) who was tabbed as a **TDN Rising Star** following a last-to-first success in his Dec. 30 career opener at Santa Anita ([video](#)). "He needed a race,"

Baffert reflected about the \$1.9-million KEEAPR grad.

"He ran green, but we were hoping he would run like we thought he could. He'd been working well with nice horses, but I didn't want to run him short, because he would have got nothing out of it." The chestnut's education will continue in an allowance race. "We'll run him in non-winners [of one]," Baffert added. "It's sort of tough moving up too fast, but at least I snuck in a two-year-old race for him."

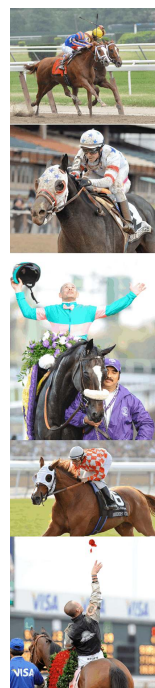

Speed was king going two turns over the inner track Saturday afternoon, and Laus Deo took full advantage. Third, but disqualified to fifth behind subsequent SW & GSP Citrus Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) in his Sept. 26 debut going two turns at Delaware Park, the attractive bay colt remained at a route of ground for an Oct. 31 maiden at Philly Park, settling for second after setting the pace. Cut back to a sprint distance last time out Dec. 11, he came from just off of it to score by a good-looking 1 3/4 lengths. Favored Ibboyyee (Medallist) won the break, but Laus Deo was sent through at the fence by David Cohen to lead entering the first bend. Laus Deo clicked off a half-mile in :49.48 and six panels in a pedestrian 1:15.12, but had the odds-on selection to deal with, as Ibboyyee ranged up at the quarter pole. But Laus Deo repelled that bid and found the line just ahead of the fast-finishing Worth a Buck. Ibboyyee checked in a no-excuses fourth. Brake Lights was purchased as a weanling for a lofty \$220,000 at KEENOV on behalf of these owners, who campaigned the late Saint Liam to Horse of the Year and GI Breeders' Cup Classic titles in 2005. Saddled by assistant trainer Artie Magnuson for his Dec. 5 debut over a sloppy inner track, the bay colt raced just off the speed and tried to make a race of it late, but weakened a bit to finish fifth by 3 1/2 lengths. Trying two turns for the first time, Brake Lights broke alertly and was in front soon thereafter. Well rated on a moderate pace of :48.53 for the half and 1:14.24 for six panels, he had plenty left for the drive and was ridden out to a 9 1/2-length success. The final time was :1 2/5 quicker than stakes horses clocked in the Count Fleet S. later in the program. Lifetime Record: 2-1-0-0, \$25,890. Greenspring, who only made it to the races this past June, sustained his first career defeat when second to Who's the Cowboy in an optional claimer at 'Club Med' Oct. 2. After rebounding in a similar affair at Laurel Oct. 30, the bay finished a solid second in his black-type bow, Aqueduct's GIII Fall Highweight H. on Thanksgiving. He was favored here while stretching out beyond six furlongs for the first time. Allowed to settle into stride as GSW Researcher (Two Smart) set the pace, Greenspring ranged up on the turn and galloped away in the lane to record a popular victory. "That's racehorse time," winning trainer Chris Grove offered. "I wanted to stretch out to seven-eighths for the [GII] General George [H. at Laurel Feb. 15], so I figured this would be a good prep for him.
