THE NEED FOR SPEED

There are five black-type events during today's Gulfstream Sprint Showcase program, and the GIII Mr. Prospector H., which features a clash between **Custom for Carlos** (More Than Ready) and **Munnings**

(Speightstown), just might be the headliner. Custom for Carlos, a maiden winner and third-place finisher in the GII Swale S. over this strip last winter, wired the field in the GIII Jersey Shore BC S. in July. He bounced back from three tough beats to defeat solid older rivals in the Bet On Sunshine H. at Churchill Nov. 21, and has a pair of bullet works at Palm Meadows in preparation for

his four-year-old opener. "He's a quality horse and worked well for the race," said trainer Eddie Kenneally.

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Munnings himself was a sharp winner versus his elders in the GII Tom Fool H. at Belmont July 5, but caught sloppy tracks in each of his next three tries and wound up third each time. After rounding out the trifecta in the GI Haskell Invitational

Aug. 2, the flashy chestnut filled that spot in the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga Aug. 29, and once more to the venerable pair of Kodiak Kowboy (Posse) and Fabulous Strike (Smart Strike) in the GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont Oct. 3 in what would be his final 2009 appearance. "We skipped the Breeders' Cup because it was run at Santa Anita over a synthetic surface, and the only bad race he's run in his career came at Santa Anita over a synthetic surface," trainer Todd

Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. The colt's lone unplaced effort in 10 starts was a 10th-place finish in the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "The plan was to run him in the Cigar [at Aqueduct Nov. 28], but he bruised a foot prior to the race," Pletcher added. "He's trained well since he's come down here. Seven furlongs is probably his optimum distance, but he's run against the best of the best and, hopefully, this race will set him up for the next one on Feb. 13 [GII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship]." But a 70-percent chance of rain may result in the colt staying in his barn. "If the track comes up sloppy on Saturday, it's possible I might scratch him," Pletcher told *DRF*. **Field, p4**

LAND-HO IN THE SAN PASQUAL

Furthest Land (Smart Strike), perfect in three previous starts on synthetic surfaces, puts that record on the line in today's GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita. After capturing the GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Sept. 26, the dark bay posted a 21-1 upset in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile over this Pro-Ride Nov. 7, and his connections have earmarked the \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 27 as his current target. "He's been super," trainer Mike Maker said to *Daily Racing Form*. "He got over that track well in the Breeders' Cup, and we don't have any concern." **Nownownow** (Whywhywhy), hero of the GII San Fernando S. over this track and trip last January, was beaten just 1 3/4 lengths when seventh in the GII Strub S. Feb. 7, but hasn't faced the starter since finishing third by a head in the GII Mervin Muniz Jr. Memorial H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 14. "I worked him his last few times and he's definitely fit," said jockey Joe Talamo. "He seems to love the track. He's run some nice races over it, and if he has some pace to run at, it will help." **Cont. p3**

Grade III Old Hat Stakes

NEW FACES IN OLD HAT Today's GIII Old Hat S. will feature 11 three-year-old fillies--seven of which are unbeaten--looking for their first victory at the graded level. **Cuff Me** (Officer) overwhelmed New York-breds in her first two starts before adding a win in the Silent Turn S. on Aqueduct's inner track Dec. 4. Trained by Tony Dutrow, the bay filly defeated **Touching Beauty** (Tapit) by two lengths at the Big A, and shipped to Palm Meadows shortly after that effort. "She was touted as a nice filly before she even came to me and they were right," Dutrow told *Daily Racing Form*. "All three of her efforts at two were impressive and she couldn't be doing better since coming down here, so why not give her an opportunity to swing for a graded stakes?" Among Cuff Me's rivals also sporting perfect records are the Calder-based duo of **Carphonic** (Lion Heart) and **Dances With Ashley** (Wildcat Heir).

"He's been very special," said trainer and co-owner Bill Morey Jr. "We've picked our spots well for this horse and he's rewarded us like another millionaire we had, Dixie Dot Com." The dark bay has bankrolled \$1,122,411 for Morey and additional owners Dwaine Hall and Ernest Langbein. "We bred him, we raised him, we watched him grow from a baby, and we watched him add those zeroes on, and they got to the point where, wow, we hit a million," Morey reflected. **Cont. p4**

"[Bold Chieftain] has done everything we've asked him," Morey continued. "We don't want to push the horse if he's not happy, but there's no market as a stallion right now. Our best offer was \$20,000, so if the horse is happy and healthy, why not try to keep going a little bit further? If the horse wasn't healthy, we would not keep racing him. But gee whiz, \$20,000? I could run him in a \$100,000 claiming race, for crying out loud. Anyway, there's no market in being bought as a stallion, and he's healthy and in good form. He's lost a step, but he sure loves those Cal-bred races."

WATERHOUSE LEADS WAY AGAIN For the second consecutive day, trainer Gai Waterhouse walked

away with the session topper at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, which held its third session Friday. Bidding on behalf of a group of owners that raced the 2008 G1 Golden Slipper S. winner Sebring (Aus) (More Than Ready), Waterhouse went to

A\$620,000 (US\$572,791) Friday to obtain [hip 540](#), a bay son of Encosta de Lago (Aus).

“He’s one of the most attractive horses in the sale,” said Waterhouse, who has spent just over A\$2.7 million at the sale to lead all buyers. “I thought he was just lovely. I actually wrote in my catalogue ‘sexy!’ The main group [that bought the yearling], the Henderson boys, had said to me, ‘Identify a few colts at the sale that we should be investing in.’”

Thursday’s topper is out of River Song (Aus) (Fusaichi Pegasus), who hails from the immediate family of leading sire Redoute’s Choice (Aus).

While the average price compared well to last year’s mark, the sale continued to lack a seven-figure horse, and the weakness at the top was noted by Waterhouse.

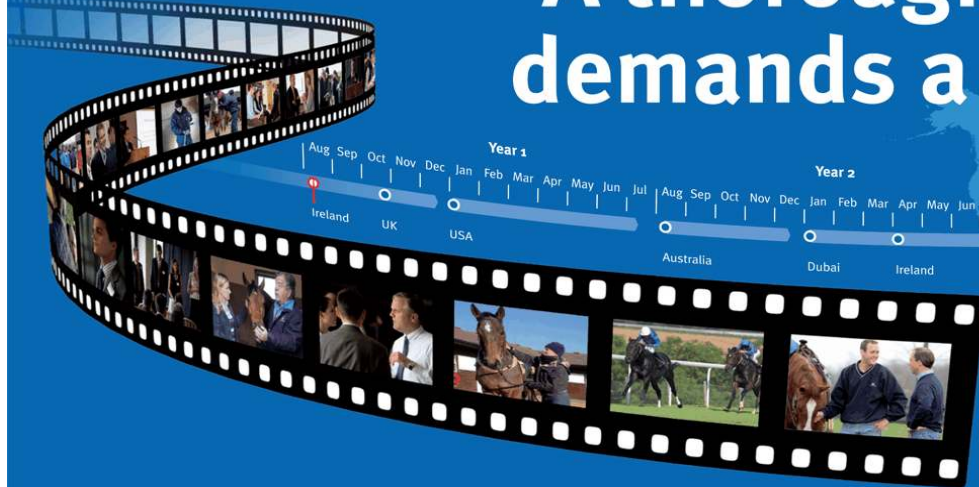
“He looks a great value,” she said of the session topper. “There is no doubt a few years ago he would have made a lot more. It’s a great time to be buying horses, especially as the prizemoney keeps going up.”

The top filly of day was [hip 473](#), a daughter of Redoute’s Choice (Aus) who sold for A\$520,000. Damon Gabbedy of Belmont Bloodstock Agency outbid James Bester to acquire the yearling, who is out of MGSW Piper Star (Aus) (Kaaipstad {NZ}). According to *Racing and Sports*, all four of the dark bay’s siblings had sold as yearlings through Magic Millions, with her 3/4-brother Demi’s Star (Aus) (Danahill Dancer {Ire}) fetching A\$720,000 in 2006.

[Hip 427](#), a Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) half-brother to last year’s Golden Slipper and Magic Millions Classic winner Phelan Ready (Aus) (More Than Ready), went unsold when bidding stopped A\$40,000 short of his reserve at A\$460,000.

After a somewhat slow start, the clearance rate improved for the second straight session, which pleased Magic Millions Managing Director David Chester. **Cont. p6**

LAPENTA TO SPONSOR DERBY TRIAL Owner Robert LaPenta will sponsor the \$200,000 GIII The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial, which will be contested at Churchill Downs Apr. 24, it was announced Friday. The one-mile affair honors LaPenta's 2004 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. hero The Cliff's Edge (Gulch). Restored to Grade III status last year, the traditional opening day feature was contested as a \$100,000 race at 7 1/2 furlongs in 2009. "Our sponsorship of

In addition to The Cliff's Edge, LaPenta has campaigned Eclipse Award winner War Pass (Cherokee Run) and 2008 GI Belmont S. hero Da' Tara (Tiznow).

ECLIPSE AWARD FOR DRAPE Joe Drape has won the 2009 Media Eclipse Award for Writing in the Feature/Enterprise category for "Despite Outcry, Derby Owners Fall Silent on Drugs for Horses," the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, *Daily Racing Form* and National Turf Writers Association announced yesterday. The piece appeared in the Apr. 30 edition of the *New York Times*. Drape, a resident

of New York, previously won an Eclipse Award in the same category in 2002. "We had been wondering what kinds of medications and drugs were being used on racing's biggest stages," said Drape. "So we tried a different approach by trying to obtain veterinary records of the starters in the Kentucky Derby. Rick Porter and Larry Jones [owner and trainer of Derby starter Friesan Fire] complied with the request, so I decided to ask the other connections. I am grateful to those owners, horsemen and veterinarians and horse rescue groups who do push to make the game humane and contested on a level playing field. It's not always a popular issue, but they keep it in the public eye. In researching this article, I found that we were further away from 'hay, oats and water' than I thought. Still, most everyone now acknowledges that this is a problem, and in recent months we have seen states and major races take a stronger stance to outlaw steroids and illegal drugs." The judges for this Eclipse Award category were Rob Longley of the *Toronto Star*, Fred Klein, former columnist for *The Wall Street Journal* and Neil Milbert, former horse racing writer for the *Chicago Tribune*.

Amelia Bearhart Dies:

Richard Maynard's **Amelia Bearhart** (Bold Hour--Myrtlewood Lass, by *Ribot) was buried Jan. 7 at Maynard Farm near Lexington, Kentucky, it was announced yesterday. She was 27. A stakes-placed performer on the racetrack, the chestnut produced Explosive Red (Exploident) as her fourth foal. He numbered the 1993 GI Hollywood Derby among his six career victories, and earned \$864,931. In 1992, the mare foaled Ruby Ransom (Red Ransom), a black-type winner who went on to produce GSWs Sacred Song (Diesis {GB}) and Strut the Stage (Theatrical {Ire}). Campaigned by Sam-Son Farm, the big chestnut also won the 1997 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Hollywood Park, and received an Eclipse Award for his efforts. Amelia Bearhart also produced the stakes-placed Memorized (Ziggy's Act) and Sundown Serenade (Deputy Minister), and her 2001 Storm Cat filly, Platinum Heights, realized \$2.8 million at Keeneland July. Her final foal was the 2006 War Chant filly Here Comes Amelia.
