BEND IN THE ROAD

Gulfstream's series for Triple Crown hopefuls kicks off today with the GIII Holy Bull S., a one-turn mile that offers an intriguing cast of nine. Favored on the morning-line is **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil), the former

Calder denizen who compiled solid speed figures while sweeping the Florida Stallion Stakes series for breeder Jacks or Better Farm and trainer Stanley Gold. The chestnut recovered from a poor start to take his winning streak to five in the In Reality S. at Calder Oct. 17 ([video](#)), an effort that caught the attention of Robert LaPenta. LaPenta acquired a majority

interest in the youngster and transferred him to Nick Zito, and Jackson Bend has turned in four solid drills at Palm Meadows since mid-December. "Naturally, I'm hoping this horse will live up to the expectations of both his owners and the potential these people think he has," Zito told *Daily Racing Form*. "These are obviously different horses he'll be trying, and we haven't played

any games with him in his last three works. When you get in this league, it's a different story." Jeremy Rose will be in the irons for the first time, and they will break from the outside. "I'm really grateful for the post position," Zito added. "That was one

of my main concerns. He stumbled last time leaving the gate, and I think there's a lot less chance he'll have a similar issue breaking from the outside." Recent winners of the Holy Bull to make an impact on the first Saturday in May include Closing Argument (Successful Appeal), the runner-up in the 2005 GI Kentucky Derby; and Barbaro (Dynaformer), who captured the GI Florida Derby and GI Kentucky Derby in 2006 **Cont. p2**

ELEVEN LINE UP IN LECOMTE

A competitive field of 11 three-year-olds will go postward in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds this afternoon. Breaking from the rail is **Maximus Ruler** (Roman Ruler), who tries two turns for the first time following two sharp efforts at Churchill Downs. The dark bay came up a head short when third in his Nov. 14 career opener ([video](#)), then graduated in a one-mile allowance two weeks later ([video](#)). "I think he'll break good and it'll be up to [jockey] Cisco [Torres] from there," said trainer Clark Hanna. "I don't think he'll be on the lead. I hope he'll show some tactical speed and rate like he has in his two previous races. He's so big, he's not going to be a go-getter coming out; I just hope he'll relax and have something to finish with." Hanna added, "I don't feel that we have to win [in order to continue on to the Feb. 20 GIII Risen Star]. We're looking at it one hurdle at a time. Let's see how he runs this race, and then we'll take it from there." Immediately to the right of Maximus Ruler in the gate is **Turf Melody** (Maria's Mon), who got up in the last jump to land the \$200,000 Springboard Mile at Remington Park Dec. 13. Priscilla Graham's colorbearer is a half-brother to GSW Stanley Park (Swain {Ire}). **Field, p4**

A 3 1/4-length winner over **Thank You Phillippe** (Proud Accolade) in his second start at the Miami oval July 11 ([video](#)), the bay defeated a solid cast in Belmont's GI Champagne S. Oct. 10 ([video](#)) when saddled by Rick Dutrow Jr. for the first time. However, he flattened out to fifth in his

juvenile finale, the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct Nov. 28. "There's got to be some reason why he ran so poorly in the Remsen, but I can't explain it," Dutrow told *DRF*. "He just didn't show up that day, which makes it all the more important for him to show up on Saturday. He ran big in a one-turn mile winning the Champagne, and we're giving him the same opportunity to run big doing the same thing here. This race is extremely important for him if he's going to run in bigger races down the road." Thank You Phillippe, second in Jackson Bend's In Reality, was a distant runner-up to Buddy's Saint (Saint Liam) in the GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct Nov. 7, and adds blinkers following another bridesmaid finish to Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) in a local allowance Jan. 7. **William's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) has done most of his running on turf or synthetic surfaces, but his best efforts have come in two dirt tries.

Dancing in Silks earned a 106 Beyer Speed Figure when defeating M One Rifle by a nose in the Cal Cup Sprint Oct. 3 over this track and trip, but that earned him no love the following month in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Dismissed at 25-1, the bay gelding came out on the money end of a four-horse photo, and was an Eclipse Award finalist. But just as the recent deluge will keep M One Rifle in the barn, there's a chance that Dancing in Silks will await the Sunshine Millions next Saturday. "I don't know what will happen with the track," trainer Carla Gaines told *Daily Racing Form*. With a reported 7 1/2 inches of rain in the Arcadia area since last weekend, Santa Anita has cancelled three live cards this week. Gaines added, "I'm not crazy about the one hole. I'm not crazy about spotting some of them 10 pounds."

RACING Round-Up

THE MAILET EUTHANIZED The Mailet (Rock Hard Ten--Emerging Glory, by Smarten), who shipped from her New York base to cause an upset in the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood Park in November, broke down a quarter-mile into a five-furlong workout yesterday at Gulfstream Park and was subsequently euthanized, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Bred in Kentucky by Wind Hill Farm, the \$75,000 KESEEP yearling purchase was beaten a combined 63 1/4 lengths in two main-track appearances to start her career, but turned it around to break her maiden at 43-1 on the Belmont turf Oct. 22. That effort prompted trainer Bruce Levine to send the filly to the left coast, where she came from off the pace for a half-length success in the Miesque, returning 11-1 to her backers. She was prepping for a start in the Coconut Grove S. Feb. 14 when she was stricken. "It's hard to believe she did so much damage as easy as she pulled up," Levine told *DRF*. "Just having her as a broodmare would have been fine if we could have saved her, but she shattered her sesamoid and cracked her cannon bone. It's really heartbreaking. This was a really nice filly, but when you have to make that phone call to the owners it doesn't make a difference even if it was a ten thousand claimer. It's the hardest thing in the world to do." Owned by J. W. Singer LLC, The Mailet compiled a record of 4-2-0-0 and earnings of \$86,976.

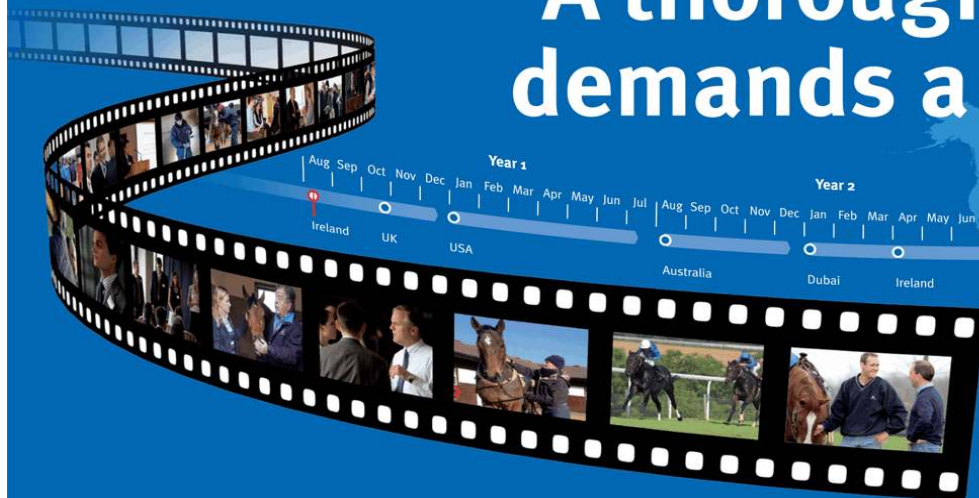

Intense Focus Retires to Ballylinch...

Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway--Daneleta (Ire), by Danehill), who registered a career high when winning the 2008 G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, has been retired and will stand at Ballylinch Stud in County Kilkenny, Ireland. Racing in the colors of Jackie Bolger, he also hit the board in the G2 Coventry S., the G2 Railway S. and the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere during a busy juvenile campaign. Intense Focus made just two starts last term, finishing second in the G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial and fifth in the G1 St James's Palace S. He concluded his racing career with a lifetime record of 11-2-2-3, and earnings of £353,135. He retires to stud the property of a partnership of breeders which include his trainer Jim Bolger and his fee has yet to be announced. Commenting on the new arrival, Ballylinch Managing Director John O'Connor said, "Intense Focus goes to stud as a Group 1-winning two-year-old by Giant's Causeway at a time when his sire's first two sons at stud, Shamardal and Footstepsinthesand, have made excellent starts to their stallion careers. He is a beautifully conformed and very correct horse whose looks will really appeal to breeders. As befits a very fast two-year-old, he should have a strong influence for speed and precocity."

PAPA CLEM RETIRED Bo Hirsch's **Papa Clem** (Smart Strike--Miss Houdini, by Belong to Me) emerged from his victory in the Feb. 16 GII San Fernando S. with a left front ankle injury and has been retired from racing, trainer Gary Stute confirmed. "It was deterioration of the ankle," Stute said. "He was never sore. My vet X-rayed it, and I asked him if I could turn him out and bring him back, but he said 'No.' I trust my vet Kurt Hoffman completely, and when he says they can't come back, I believe him." He will enter stud for the current breeding season, though no decision on a farm has been made. Bred by Hirsch from his Grade I-winning Miss Houdini, Papa Clem emerged as a top three-year-old of 2009, finishing second in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. and in the GII Louisiana Derby before taking the GII Arkansas Derby. Beaten a head for third in the GI Kentucky Derby and sixth in the GI Preakness S., he spent several weeks over the summer at Monmouth, where he took third in the Long Branch S. and fourth in the GI Haskell Invitational S. Rested off a seventh in the GII Del Mar Derby on the turf Sept. 6, he returned to action with a promising third-place effort in the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. Dec. 26 prior to his San Fernando success. He retires with a record of 13-3-2-2 and earnings of \$1,121,190. "I thought he'd win the Strub, and I thought he'd have a chance in the Santa Anita H. or even in Dubai," Stute added. "I didn't foresee this coming at all."

Denis of Cork Retired...

GSW **Denis of Cork** (Harlan's Holiday--Unbridled Girl, by Unbridled), second in the GI Belmont S. and third in the GI Kentucky Derby in 2008, has been retired. Now five, the Florida-bred bay was sidelined by a hairline fracture in his left hind ankle after his runner-up finish behind Da' Tara (Tiznow) in the third leg of the Triple

Crown. He suffered another setback while on the farm in Ocala, injuring his right front suspensory in late winter of 2009, but, after an extended rehab, returned to the work tab last November. He appeared to be nearing a return when he reinjured the suspen-

sory earlier this month, and the decision was made to retire him.

"Denis of Cork is currently out of training, and plans are being made for the next stage of his career," said trainer David Carroll. "He suffered a soft tissue injury to his right front foreleg, and it has not responded to treatment." A \$250,000 Barretts March purchase for Mr. and Mrs. William K. Warren, Denis of Cork won his first three starts, including the GIII Southwest S. at Oaklawn. Fifth in the GII Illinois Derby, he was low on graded earnings and just squeaked into the field for the Kentucky Derby, but proved he belonged when completing the triple behind Big Brown (Boundary) and Eight Belles (Unbridled's Song). He compiled a record of 6-3-1-1 and earned \$613,252. Stud plans have not been determined.

As poet Carl Sandburg might have said, this Ned Evans homebred will enter her 2010 season on little cat feet. Cat Moves opened her career with three consecutive victories, including a 3/4-length score in the GI Prioress S. at Belmont on Independence Day. Third in the GI Test S. Aug. 8, the bay has been unseen since finishing fifth in the Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. in her first start beyond seven furlongs. "I think she proved that she is not a two-turn horse, so she will be brought back for her four-year-old campaign as a sprinter," trainer Tony Dutrow said. Like her stablemate Seattle Smooth, Cat Moves needed time off because of "wear and tear in her ankles." The homebred is currently being turned out at Evans' Spring Hill Farm in Casanova, Virginia. "She won't start back in training until the end of February," Dutrow said. "Dr. Bramlage at Rood and Riddle thought the prognosis for her having a good four-year-old season was excellent."

earned a career high when she rallied to capture the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 13, and connections are looking to pick up additional Grade I tallies in 2010. Unraced since that effort, the \$340,000 FTKJUL yearling is back in light training at Palm Meadows, according to trainer Tony Dutrow. "She had some wear and tear in her ankles, and we were advised to give her some time [off after the Phipps]," Dutrow said. Seattle Smooth returned to the track Jan. 1 and is expected to be back on the worktab in March. "If everything goes perfectly, she might be able to run at the end of April," Dutrow said. "The goal would be to win another Grade I with her, but we're just getting back in training." Seattle Smooth began her career competing over synthetic surfaces in California, winning once in five starts over the all-weather. Unbeaten in five attempts since being shipped East to race over conventional dirt, the five-year-old could be a contender in this year's Breeders' Cup, which will return to a traditional surface at Churchill Downs after being contested over at Pro-Ride at Santa Anita the past two years. "It would be a great to if she had a chance at [the Breeders' Cup] this fall," Dutrow said. "You'd want to keep that long campaign in mind and hope she stays in great shape."

"She was always scheduled to have a break after her last race at Ascot," confirmed Godolphin's Simon Crisford. As for what lies ahead for the U.S.-bred sophomore, filly Crisford added, "Long Lashes is in light training in Dubai, and she will be prepared for a European campaign. She will be ready to run in early May, but we do not have any specific plans for her."

PLETCHER SUSPENDED FOR '08 MEDICATION VIOLATION


The California Horse Racing Board announced Friday that trainer Todd Pletcher has been fined \$25,000 and suspended a minimum of 10 days for a procaine violation incurred when Wait a While (Maria's Mon) finished third in the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Procaine, a local anesthetic, is found in the commonly used antibiotic Procaine Penicillin G. It is a Class 3 medication. Pletcher received a 60-day suspension, but 50 days will be stayed, provided that the conditioner has no other Class 1, 2 or 3 violations during a one-year probationary period. The CHRБ met Jan. 15 and adopted the decision of hearing officer Steffan Imhoff. "The offense is somewhat mitigated because we find that Pletcher was treating Wait a While with Procaine Penicillin G on the recommendation of his veterinarian and that the treatment was terminated 18 days before the race," Imhoff's decision read. "If, as we believe, another Procaine injection was given shortly before the race, there is no evidence to suggest that this was done by Pletcher, or on his behalf. Therefore, we hold that Pletcher should be placed on one-year probation, and that all but 10 days of his 60-day suspension should be stayed." CHRБ Executive Director Kirk Breed has ordered that Pletcher pay his fine and begin his suspension by Feb. 20. The CHRБ does not expect Pletcher to appeal.

TEXAS SHOWDOWN FOR THE LADIES? Sam Houston Race Park and Jim McIngvale's Gallery Furniture have stepped up efforts to lure Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) and two-time champion **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) to the Texas track. The proposed \$1.5-million event would be contested at nine furlongs Mar. 27 as part of the Maxxam Gold Cup card. "This would be the greatest horse race of the 21st century and it would be a privilege for Gallery Furniture to promote this as taking place in Houston," said Jim "Mattress Mack" McIngvale. "You go, girls!" Sam Houston's President and Chief Operating Officer Andrea Young added, "We are continuing to work on all fronts to get Zenyatta and Rachel Alexandra, as well as other top horses from around the world, to come to Sam Houston Race Park and participate in what would be one the most exciting races in horse racing history. Adding a race of this caliber to our Maxxam Gold Cup event is a great way to showcase our nationally recognized racing surface, it's a great time of year weather-wise, and we think it's an ideal way to close out our Thoroughbred meet."
