The grey colt shook off his first-start loss at Delaware Park July 28 with three-length tally in an off-the-turf maiden test at Saratoga Aug. 22. Making his third appearance in a one-mile allowance at Philly Park Nov. 20, he romped by 12 1/2 lengths, and was deemed

ready for black-type company in his sophomore bow. "[Owner Rick] Porter and I decided we might be in business with a good horse after we watched him work at Delaware Park in late June, and he hasn't disappointed us yet," trainer Tony Dutrow said. **Cont. p2**

HAMMER TIME

Jack T. Hammer homebred **Ron The Greek** (Full Mandate) was nowhere to be found when they turned into the stretch, but he came flying in the final sixteenth of a mile to take the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds by a widening 1 1/2 lengths. The well-travelled bay broke his maiden at Hoosier Park Oct. 11 and came back to post a narrow allowance

score at Delta Downs Nov. 13. Trailing the field early in the Dec. 13 Springboard Mile S. at Remington Park, he made up six lengths in the final furlong, but had to settle for fourth. An extra 40 yards made all the difference here. Last of 10 after a half in :46.80, the May foal had just one behind him when they hit the top of the lane, and still had seven to pass at midstretch. But **Ron The Greek** was rolling, making up seven lengths in the final furlong to post the mild upset at 7-1. He will likely point for the Feb. 20 GIII Risen Star S. **Chart, p2**

Bumped at the break in the Holy Bull, Winslow Homer rated off the pace as Thank U Philippe (Proud Accolade) and Homeboykris (Roman Ruler) moved up to duke it out through a rapid half in :45.76 and six panels in 1:09.66. The leaders started to look for the gas pump when they straightened for home and Winslow Homer, tucked in at the rail on the turn, found a seam between the leaders at the top of the lane. He grabbed the advantage at the eighth pole and outfinished 8-5 favorite Jackson Bend. "I came here today without any particular expectations, just hoping he would keep his place in line [on the Derby trail]," Tony Dutrow added. "Naturally, I have to be very pleased with the way he ran. We'll look ahead now to the [Feb. 20 GII Fountain of Youth if all goes well. He's actually bred for two turns. The goal is the Kentucky Derby." Jockey Ramon Dominguez remarked, "When he made the lead, he started to come back to me, so I had to encourage him a little to keep going. Eight-year-old broodmare Summer Raven (Summer Squall) was sold for \$1.7 million carrying a full sibling to Winslow Homer as part of the Overbrook dispersal at Keeneland November 2009. Reynolds Bell signed the ticket for an undisclosed client. "He's a fairly new person in the business and he is looking to put together a nice broodmare band to breed to race and sell," Bell said after the hammer fell. "He's a bargain shopper and he understands there is some value in the market right now. This mare might have cost \$2.5 million last year."

Sidelined for nearly 10 months and switched to the barn of trainer Carl O'Callaghan after that start, he is now perfect in three outings under new management. The gelding went gate to wire at 61-1 in an optional claimer at Oak Tree Oct. 30. Off at 7-1 in the Dec. 6 GIII Vernon O. Underwood S., he set the pace and held on gamely to win by a neck. Kinsale King pressed the pace from second here, drove to the front as they neared the lane and held on late. He will try to step it up a notch in his next appearance. "I told [owner Dr. Patrick Sheehy] back in June we'd be going to Dubai [for the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen], and I think that's where we're going," O'Callaghan said with a grin. Dynamic Range steps up to stakes company for the first time. The four-year-old gelding, on the board in seven of his 10 turf starts, bids for his third straight after taking an optional claimer going 1 1/2 miles at Oak Tree Nov. 8 and a 1 1/4-mile optional test at Hollywood Dec. 19. **High Court Drama** made his U.S. bow at Hollywood Nov. 15, winning an optional claimer going nine panels on the lawn. The five-year-old switched to synthetic for the Dec. 12 GIII Native Diver H. and rallied for second, with subsequent GII San Pasqual hero Neko Bay (Giant's Causeway) back in third. He should relish the added distance here. Morning-line chalk **Loup Breton**, a two-time group winner in France, shipped to the U.S. after a pair of off-the-board efforts in the May 17 G1 Prix d'Ispahan and Aug. 15 G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron. The Wildenstein homebred opened his stateside account with a win in a Hollywood allowance test Nov. 19, and missed by just a neck when rallying for second in the Dec. 27 GII San Gabriel H. at 1 1/8 miles. He is another well-suited to the 10 panels of the San Marcos.

TRADITIONAL DRAW FOR KENTUCKY DERBY

Churchill Downs announced Friday that, starting this year, it will no longer give the connections of GI Kentucky Derby runners the opportunity to choose their posts based on the draw, but will instead return to a traditional post position draw. The draw, which had been televised on ESPN since the two-tiered system was instituted in 1998, last year lost its network coverage, and was carried only on HRTV. "We don't have that national media window anymore," Churchill Vice President of Communications John Asher told *Daily Racing Form*, explaining the decision. The two-tiered draw, which had been used to determine the post positions for the GI Preakness S. starting in 1999, was dropped last year. "We have gotten quite a few suggestions that we go back to the blind draw," Asher added. "It seemed to be the right time to go back."

Why the TDN?



"The immediacy of information in TDN makes it indispensable for me. In a tough market you look for every edge. Maybe a sire is quietly making a move which will tighten the supply of seasons. You need to be ready to strike quickly when you have a horse to buy or to sell. TDN is a big help."

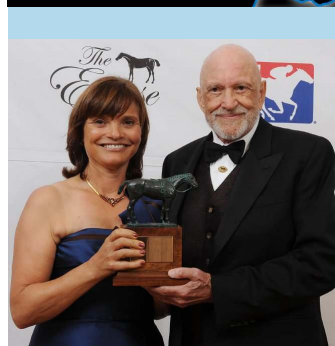

Jess Jackson

Accomplishment: Jess Jackson is the principal owner of Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro), who was named Horse of the Year and champion three-year-old filly at the Eclipse Awards Monday night.

Birthdate: Feb. 18, 1930.

Birthplace: Los Angeles

Principal Business: Half my time is spent on our equine business, Stonestreet Farms located in

Lexington, Kentucky, and the rest of the time I am focused on Jackson Family Wines in Sonoma County, California.

What first drew you to racing? I come from a long line of farmers. Horses were a part of life. I came to appreciate their power, speed and loyalty.

What is the most exciting race you've seen that didn't involve one of your own horses? My favorite racing memory was seeing Seabiscuit at Bay Meadows in 1938. It was the Depression and the world needed a hero. Seabiscuit had real heart.

What has been your most satisfying accomplishment in racing? I am constantly working to bring a higher level of integrity and transparency to the business, such as the elimination of dual agency and the establishment of a single, authoritative organization to oversee the sport. I'd like to think I have contributed to the betterment of the racehorses and to the better enjoyment of the sport by the fans.

Which of Rachel's races was most impressive? That's hard to pick, since she had such an amazing year--the 19+ length wins, the track records--but if I had to pick one, I'd say the GI Woodward S. She was the first filly or mare to ever win that race against older colts. She went out too fast, due to a fast early pace set by rabbits, then she had to fend off a succession of challenges. She won despite running, in effect, several separate races.

Curlin and Rachel Alexandra are two of the finest horses to race this century. What fine wines would you compare them to, and why? Actually, Rachel has her own wine now: a Kendall-Jackson Pinot Noir from our Arroyo Seco vineyards. Like her, it is smooth and otherworldly in its depth. Curlin would be more like our Jackson Hills Cabernet: strong, powerful, enduring.

What is your favorite vacation spot? Hanalei Bay, Kauai, Hawaii.

What was your childhood ambition? Not to have to worry about food. There were days when I went to bed hungry, and days when I ate rice three times a day.

What was your first job? I started farming when I was eight. I spent my summers working on relatives' farms, and my family had our own garden in the backyard of our San Francisco home during the Depression. I raised chickens and sold the eggs, and worked at dozens of odd jobs through college.

What is your favorite dessert? Chocolate. Good chocolate is irresistible. My weakness is an exotic chocolate bar, 70% to 80% cocoa, slightly bitter, lemon or orange flavored.

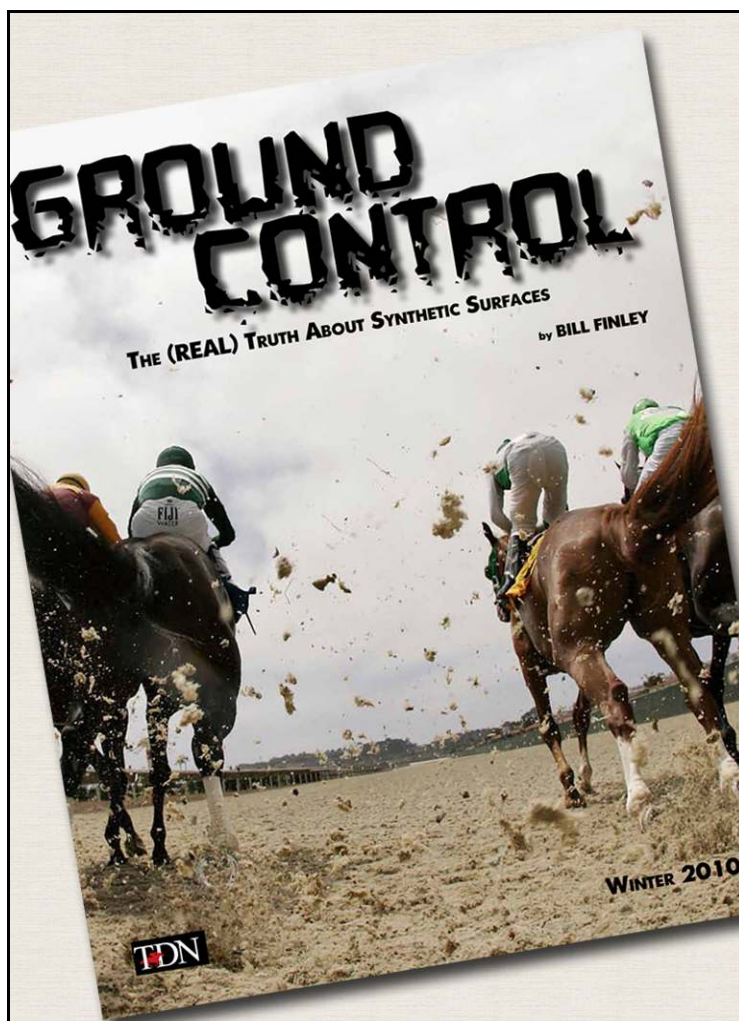

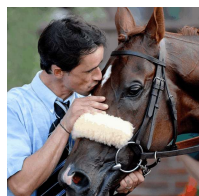

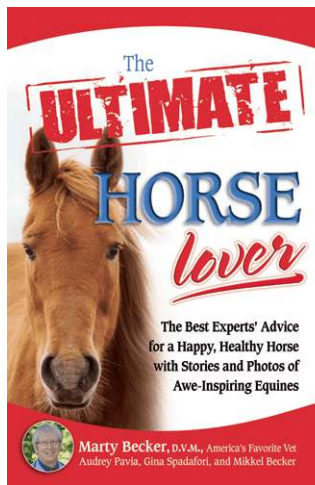
