SYNTHETICS OVER TRAVEL FOR Q.T.

G1 Hollywood Derby winner **The Usual Q.T.** (Unusual Heat) has won six straight races over the turf, but the four-year-old will return to the all-weather track for Saturday's Sunshine Millions Classic at Santa Anita rather than trek across the country for the Sunshine Millions Turf at Gulfstream Park. "I've never really traveled with him except to Hollywood Park, and he's gotten a little

Benoit aggressive about that," explained trainer Jim Cassidy.

"Eventually, we were going to try him on the dirt [synthetic], and I think this is a good opportunity." The Usual Q.T. worked five furlongs over Santa Anita's Pro-Ride Sunday in :59.80 with regular rider Victor Espinoza in the irons. The bay gelding is coming off wins in the Nov. 7 GII Oak Tree Derby, Nov. 29 Hollywood Derby and Dec. 26 GIII Sir Beaufort S. Asked if he was concerned by jockey Garrett Gomez's trip, trainer Julio Canani quipped, "I told him next time I was bringing in Sandy Hawley. It looked like I was in Deadwood."

Loup Breton, second behind Vision d'Etat (Fr) (Chichicastenango {Fr}) in last year's G1 Prix Ganay for trainer Elie Lellouche, opened his U.S. campaign with a win in a Nov. 19 allowance at Hollywood Park. The bay closed to miss by just a neck behind Proudinsky (Ger) (Silvano {Ger}) in the nine-furlong GII San Gabriel H. over this course Dec. 27.

Sent off the heavy 3-5 favorite yesterday, Loup Breton was content to settle near the back of the pack as **Porfido (Chi)** (Mash One {Chi}) set the early fractions. The paceset-

ters began to tire in upper stretch, leaving the rallying Loup Breton nowhere to go, but Garrett Gomez swung the favorite to the outside and the Irish-bred six-year-old closed powerfully to overtake High Court Drama in the final strides.

"He's getting better adapted to our American style of racing with each start," said Gomez. "He was very handy with me today and he did his job. Around the [far] turn, there was nowhere to go. I was just in a little pocket and it seemed like nothing would develop. On the turf, somebody's going to stop and somebody's going to kick on and you wait for that moment when they separate themselves and take advantage of it. He was loaded for bear, but I just had to wait."

The San Marcos had originally been scheduled as part of last Monday's rain-cancelled holiday card at Santa Anita.

Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision), a Eclipse finalist for champion juvenile filly, worked seven furlongs yesterday at Santa Anita in 1:25.60. The chestnut filly, an impressive seven-length winner of the Dec. 20 GI Hollywood Starlet S., is expected to make her sophomore debut in the Feb. 6 GI Las Virgenes S. "It was a really nice workout," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "She finished up real good, with the last eighth in 11 and three. We're very pleased with the progress she's making." In addition to the Starlet, Blind Luck also won last year's GI Oak Leaf S.

Quality Road Works Towards Donn



Quality Road (Elusive Quality) turned in a five-furlong work in 1:00 1/5 Sunday at Palm Meadows in preparation for the Feb. 6 GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park. It was the second fastest of 19 works at the distance. Winner of last year's GI Florida Derby, the four-year-old bay had to be scratched at the gate before the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in November, but rebounded to take the Jan. 3 GIII Hal's Hope S. in his most recent trip to the post. Other Todd Pletcher trainees working at Palm Meadows yesterday include promising sophomores **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) (four furlongs in :51 1/5); GIII Delta Jackpot winner **Rule** (Roman Ruler (five furlongs in 1:01 2/5; and GI Champagne S. runner-up **Discreetly Mine** (Mineshaft)

(four furlongs in :51 2/5). Eskendereya, a Gulfstream allowance winner Jan. 7, is considered possible for the Feb. 20 GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S.

But I always thought he'd be better going around two turns, and today he just put everything together. We'll see how he comes out of it, and may look at the Gill Sham S. [at Santa Anita Feb. 27]." 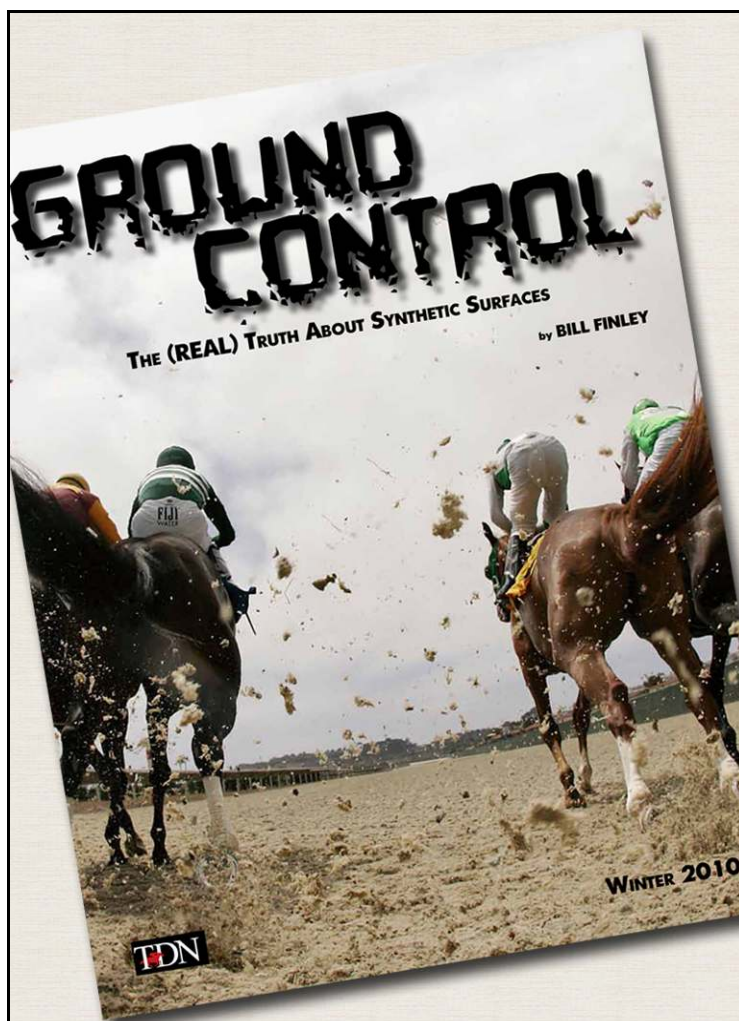
