## BUSINESS AS USUAL

A field of 11 will line up for today's \$500,000 Sunshine Millions Classic at Santa Anita. **The Usual Q. T.** (Unusual Heat) needed six starts to break his maiden, but has been unbeatable since. The gelding has won

five starts, including the GII Oak Tree Derby Nov. 7, the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 29 and the GIII Sir Beaufort S. Dec. 26. Connections hope he can translate his red-hot form to the all-weather, as they opted for the Classic over the Sunshine Millions Turf at Gulfstream. "The money enters into it, but the big thing is the travel," trainer Jim Cassidy

said. "I've never really traveled with him except to Hollywood Park, and he's gotten a little aggressive about that. Eventually, we were going to try him on [synthetics], and I think this is a good opportunity." Also riding a winning streak is **Compari** (Redattore {Brz}), who has won four straight. He has already proven himself at today's distance, courtesy his gate-to-wire success in the Snow Chief S. for Cal-bred sophomores at Hollywood Park last April. He returned from a layoff to capture an allowance over the Hollywood turf course Dec. 17, and enters today's race off a second black-type score over state-breds in the Sensational Star H. down the hill on New Year's Day. Invader **Palladio** (Lycius) brings graded credentials to the Classic. The five-time graded stakes winner hasn't raced since capturing the GII Autumn S. at Woodbine Nov. 14, but has been firing bullets at Payson Park in Florida in preparation for his California debut.

## CASINO OPERATOR CHOSEN FOR AQUEDUCT

New York Governor David Paterson has selected Aqueduct Entertainment Group to operate the VLT casino at Aqueduct Racetrack in Ozone Park, New York. "After an extensive review of the five remaining bids to operate the video lottery terminals at Aqueduct racetrack, I have chosen, and the Leaders have agreed, the organization that best fulfills our selection criteria," the governor said in a release. "AEG has both the financial viability and ability to pay the required up front licensing fee. All of the groups have valid proposals, but AEG presented a comprehensive bid that enjoys community support and also offers strong marketing appeal." According to its website, Aqueduct Entertainment Group consists of a wide-ranging partnership, including The Navegante Group, which is led by Larry J. Woolf, the former chairman, CEO and president of MGM Grand Hotels in Las Vegas. It also consists of construction companies GreenStar Services Corporation, Turner Construction Company and Levine Builders; construction consulting companies the Darman Group and PS&S Design; Siemens, an electrical engineering company; and Clairvest Group, a Canadian merchant bank. First approved in 2001, the construction of the Aqueduct casino was long delayed by the political process. It has been authorized for 4,500 slot machines with NYRA receiving seven percent of gross gambling venues and horsemen getting 6.5 percent. 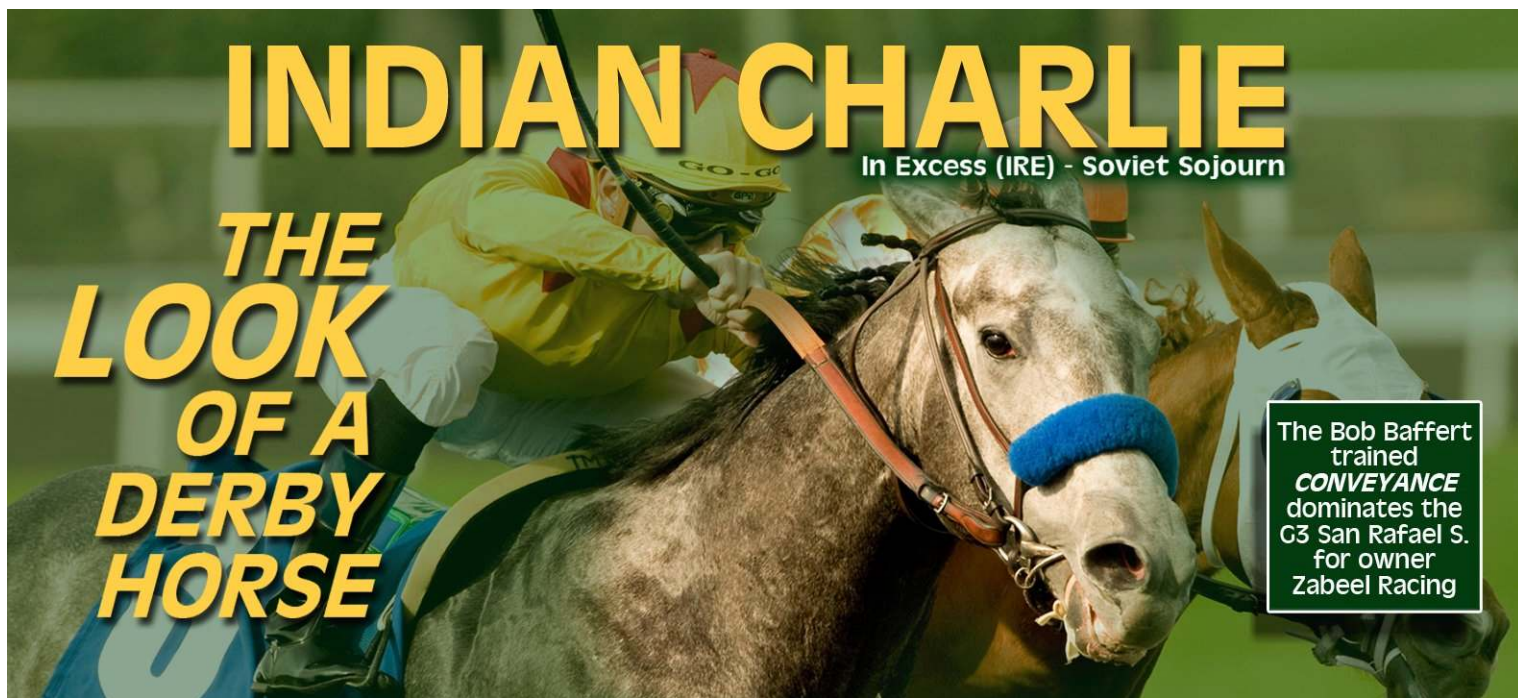

**Soldier's Dancer** seeks his second straight Sunshine Millions Turf title. A close fourth in the GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial H. in March and runner-up in a Calder allowance in August, the gray regained the winning thread with a sharp score in the PTHA President's Cup S. at Philly Park Sept. 19. He got up late to defeat Florida-breds by a half-length in the Bonnie Heath Turf Cup H. at Calder Nov. 14 most recently. **Bad Action**, winner of the Nov. 6 GIII Pegasus S. and second in the Nov. 21 GIII Discovery H. in his last two starts while racing for Gary Contessa, was cross-entered in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Santa Anita, but will compete in the Turf. Now owned by Derrick Smith and trained by Todd Pletcher, the gelding will make his first start on turf since taking a Belmont optional claimer by a nose back in October. They'll all have to gun down **Jet Propulsion**, who was haltered for \$50,000 out of a 2 1/2-length gate-to-wire victory in a Calder optional claimer Dec. 12 last time out.

**Sweet Repent**, winner of four straight at Calder, will try to keep the streak intact across town at Gulfstream. Three of those victories came by a nose, including a narrow decision over **Amazing** in the GIII Stage Door Betty H. Dec. 26 most recently. Sweet Repent stalked the pace and edged the pacesetter in the final stride to earn her first graded success in that effort, and could get a similar set up today. Amazing, who improved vastly in her return to conventional dirt, could receive pressure on the front end from **Jessica is Back**, who led every step when reporting home a 5 3/4-length winner of a Calder allowance Dec. 6 the last time she went postward.

The 2009 Cal Cup Distaff H. winner **Century Park** earned a graded placing when second in the GIII Harold C. Ramser S. Oct. 24, but failed to fire when last of seven in the GII San Gorgonio H. Jan. 2. It was her lone off-the-board effort in five starts over this course. Closer **Saucey Evening**, who enters this spot off a victory in the restricted Starine S. at Hollywood Park Dec. 3, could be the beneficiary if Century Park and Cal Cup Distaff H. heroine **Bootleg Annie** hook up in a speed duel.

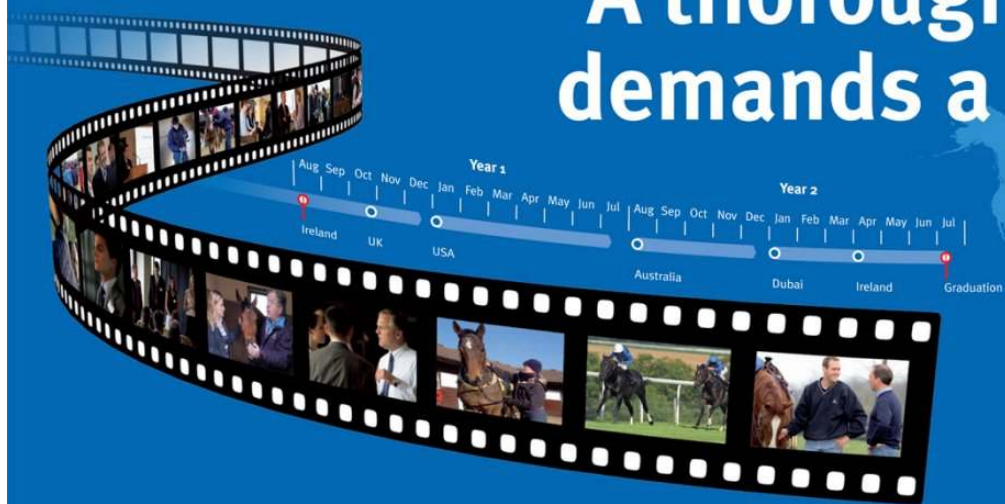

As a sophomore, the gelding scored by 2 1/4 lengths in the now-defunct Sunshine Millions Dash, and was awarded the victory via disqualification in the Gil Swale S. two starts later. He received rough trips from post one in his next two efforts, finishing second in the GIII Withers S. in April and reporting home fifth in the Gil Woody Stephens S. in June. Freshened over the summer, the four-year-old enters this spot off a 3 1/4-length victory in a Laurel optional claimer Nov. 28. **Pashito the Che** had a three-race winning streak snapped by the narrowest margins in the Gravesend H. over the inner track Dec. 26. Prior to that effort, the bay had triumphed in three consecutive black-type events: the Commemorate S. at Belmont Sept. 27, the Gallant Bob H. at Philadelphia Park Oct. 10 and the Jack Dudley Sprint H. against Florida-breds at Calder Nov. 14. **Machismo**, runner-up in this event last year at Santa Anita, looks to go one better in his third start off a layoff. Sixth in the GIII Vernon Underwood S. Dec. 6 after steadying at the start, he got back on track with a nose victory in a Dec. 31 optional claimer at Santa Anita in his most recent outing.

It's been just over a year since The Pamplemousse burst onto the scene at Santa Anita. After graduating in his juvenile finale in December 2008, the big grey rolled to victory in the GIII San Rafael S. in January, then added another wire-to-window success in the GIII San Rafael S. Feb. 28. He was the morning-line favorite for the GI Santa Anita Derby, but heat was detected in his left fore, and a tendon injury put the promising sophomore on the sidelines.

"He went to the farm for most of his recovery time, and he just returned to the racetrack," co-owner Alex Solis II said via e-mail. "He will be walking twice a day for the next two months. Then he will start tack walking for a bit, and then he will return to the track."

Though The Pamplemousse won't see afternoon action for quite some time, his connections will continue to be patient with him.

"We are just hoping he has recovered from his injury," Solis added. "We are very excited and hopeful for his return."

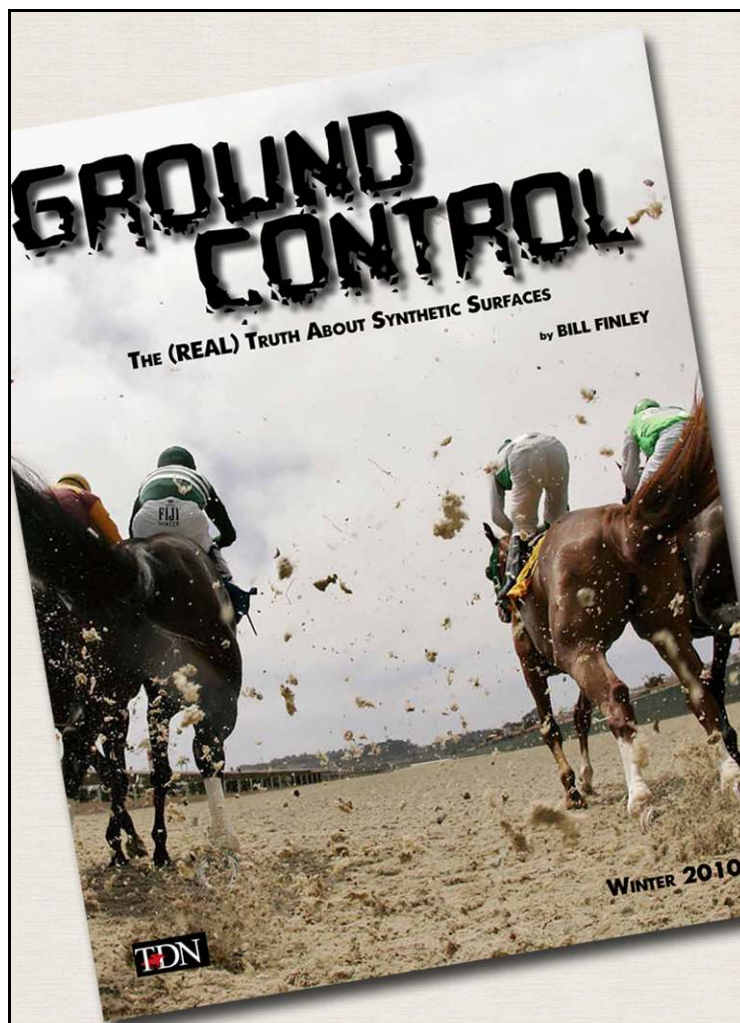
