BOLD LATE RUN LANDS CLASSIC

In a sign of the times, connections have been unable, as yet, to secure a stud deal for millionaire Cal-bred **Bold Chieftain** (Chief Seattle) in the Golden State or elsewhere. The seven-year-old's game victory over hard-charging Canadian invader **Palladio** (Lycius) in Saturday's Sunshine Millions Classic doesn't necessarily make that a slam dunk, but trainer Bill Morey is no less proud of the effort turned in by his charge. "He's unbelievable," the conditioner--barely able to talk--told HRTV's Millie Ball on his way from the grandstand boxes to the winner's circle. "He's taken us so many places. He's just great." A four-time black-type winner against his fellow California-breds and victorious in 11 black-type events overall, the stocky dark bay went on a three-race winning streak at the end of 2009, commencing the skein with a 3-5 success in the Sept. 7 Governor's H. at Sacramento before making the trip downstate to annex the Oct. 3 California Cup Classic over this course and distance. Given a few weeks off thereafter, he made it three straight with a three-length victory in the Nov. 27 San Quentin S. at Golden Gate Fields, but was last seen finishing a competitive fourth to Neko Bay (Giant's Causeway) in this track's GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 9. Taken a bit further off the pace this time as Lava Man's half-brother **Enriched** (High Brite) led, Bold Chieftain commenced his rally on the turn and was within shouting distance as they cornered. Forced to steady briefly behind **Acclamation** (Unusual Heat) approaching the eighth pole, he leveled out and charged between that foe and **Unusual Smoke** (Unusual Heat) before holding off the flying Palladio. "This ranks right up there with any race I've ever won, anywhere," commented Russell Baze. "We were in some pretty tight straights there turning for home. I didn't know if I was going to get through or not." Favored **The Usual Q. T.** (Unusual Heat), trying Pro-Ride following six straight turf wins, pressed the pace and was rank early, then drifted back in the field to finish last. "The race set up badly for us. There was too much pressure too early," said his trainer Jim Cassidy. **SM Classic chart p2**

'CHAMPS' TOPS IN CANADA

Juddmonte's **Champs Elysees** (GB) (Danehill) was honored with Sovereign Awards as Canada's Horse of the Year and champion turf horse at the 35th annual awards ceremony held Friday night in Toronto, Ontario. The bay capped his career with a rallying score in the GI Pattison Canadian International at Woodbine Oct. 17, and enters stud this year at Banstead Manor. He was trained by the late Bobby Frankel. Juddmonte's Garrett O'Rourke dedicated the award to Frankel. "Obviously this is a huge, huge honor for Juddmonte," O'Rourke told *Daily Racing Form*. "To come away with the big one is exceptionally special for us."

For the first time in the awards' 35-year history, honors were shared by a pair of recipients. **Biofuel** (Stormin Fever) and **Negligee** (Northern Afleet) each received 135 points in the voting for top juvenile filly, and the connections of both fillies took home Sovereign Awards. Biofuel captured the GIII Mazarine S. before finishing a troubled fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Negligee shipped to Keeneland to annex the GI Darley Alcibiades S. before finishing sixth in the Breeders' Cup. Unbeaten **Hollinger** (Black Minnaloushe), hero of the Cup and Saucer S. and Coronation Futurity, was the top two-year-old male.

Milwaukee Appeal (Milwaukee Brew) was honored with the three-year-old filly award following a win in the Woodbine Oaks and a third-place finish in the Queen's Plate. **Tribal Belle** (Tribunal) captured the inaugural female sprinter award, while **Field Commission** (Service Stripe) landed male sprinter honors. Eugene Melnyk scored four trophies at the awards, coming away with owner and breeder honors, and his outstanding broodmare **Pico Teneriffe** (Red Ransom) produced champion older runner Marchfield. "Any time you win an award, in any category, you have to be thrilled," Melnyk remarked to *DRF*. "There are hundreds and hundreds of owners and breeders who would love just to be nominated. To come in here and win four awards...I'm absolutely speechless."

Five straight starts, five perfect trips and five consecutive visits to the winner's circle for Sweet Repent. The dark bay, sixth in a Aug. 8 turf allowance at Calder, returned to the main track for a nose success in allowance company Aug. 28 and in the off-turf Judy's Red Shoes S. Sept. 26. She made it three on the bounce with a 3 1/4-length victory from Jessica Is Back in the restricted Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. Nov. 14 at Calder and was up in the final jump to hand Amazing (Greatness) a nose defeat in the GIII Stage Door Betty H. Dec. 26. Allowed to sit the garden trip as Jessica Is Back and Amazing kept each other company through a half in a solid :46.83, Sweet Repent looked in a bit of trouble as she came under a Manoel Cruz ride approaching the quarter pole. But, switched out in upper stretch, she found her best stride and rolled home a convincing winner.

"I was concerned when [jockey] Manoel Cruz was asking her in the far turn and really not getting to the leaders, but she got going and wore them down," said winning trainer David Braddy. "She gets a vacation now, probably about 60 days off."

The Sunshine Millions Turf looked on paper to be a relatively paceless affair, and so it unfolded. Jet Propulsion, fresh off the Marty Wolfson claim, took full advantage, stealing away on a very comfortable pace before easily holding off a late bid from stable companion Pickapocket for the victory. Offered for as little as \$10,000 when campaigned exclusively on the dirt early in his career, the veteran matured into a useful grass horse, including a 25-1 upset of the 2007 GIII Miami Mile BC H. at crosstown Calder. An allowance winner

over this course last winter, the gelding made his summer home in the Midlantic, finishing seventh in the July 11 Battlefield S. at Monmouth, third in the WV Speaker's Cup Aug. 1 at Mountaineer and eighth in the GIII Red Bank H. at the Jersey Shore Sept. 6. He returned to South Florida for an Oct. 10 allowance score, but was most recently haltered for \$50,000 out of a Dec. 12 score at Calder. Masterfully handled up front by Eclipse Award winner Julien Leparoux, Jet Propulsion was soon in front here and never looked back.

Trainer Tom Proctor made a victorious return to Southern California, sending out Florida-bred Tight Precision to a popular victory in the Filly and Mare Turf. Off the board just once since making the switch to the infield midway through her sophomore campaign in 2008, the dark bay was runner-up in the Hatoof S. at Arlington and fourth to barnmate Closeout (Repriced) in that track's Gill Pucker Up S. before closing the season with a close second to Acoma (Empire Maker) in Keeneland's Gill Valley View S. in October 2008. She lost nearly a year to injury, returning with a fifth in Keeneland allowance company Oct. 9 prior to a four-length tally beneath Churchill's Twin Spires Nov. 11. She took a third-level allowance at Gulfstream by 1 1/2 lengths last time Jan. 6 and was sent cross-country in search of her first black-type success. This Ones for Phil posted a lofty 115 Beyer in taking last year's Sunshine Millions Dash for three-year-olds, but failed to see out the 8 1/2 furlongs of the Feb. 28 GII Fountain of Youth S., finishing fifth to Quality Road (Elusive Quality). He crossed the line second, but was promoted to the win in the seven-furlong GII Swale S. Mar. 28, was a troubled runner-up in the GIII Withers S. going Aqueduct's one-turn mile Apr. 25. However, he was a disappointing fifth in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 6 and was spelled. The chestnut took advantage of a soft return spot, drilling Laurel allowance foes by 3 1/4 lengths Nov. 28 and was slightly preferred here to the gritty Pashito the Che. Together after a quarter-mile in :21.46, they raced as a team--Pashito the Che inside and This Ones for Phil outside--into the lane. Well clear of their rivals following a half in a testing :43.23, they slugged it out stride for stride down to the wire with the race favorite prevailing narrowly in the finish. The lone Cal-bred in the field, Quisisana found the wire first in a three-way photo to earn honors for the Golden State in the Sunshine Millions. After winning three of her first four starts, the dark bay was sidelined following a fourth in Oak Tree's Cascapadia H. in October 2008. She returned to fill the same spot in an optional claiming dash on the Del Mar sod Sept. 2, then finished third in the Cal Cup Distaff down the hill at Santa Anita Oct. 3. Improving to get second in an optional claimer on the Hollywood lawn Nov. 19, Quisisana switched to the synthetic to secure a cross-town optional claimer Dec. 13. The lightly raced mare raced in the second flight down the backstretch. here. Moving up to challenge four wide on the turn, she hit the front in midstretch and stretched her neck to defy Dubai Majesty on the outside to secure a nifty pay-check.

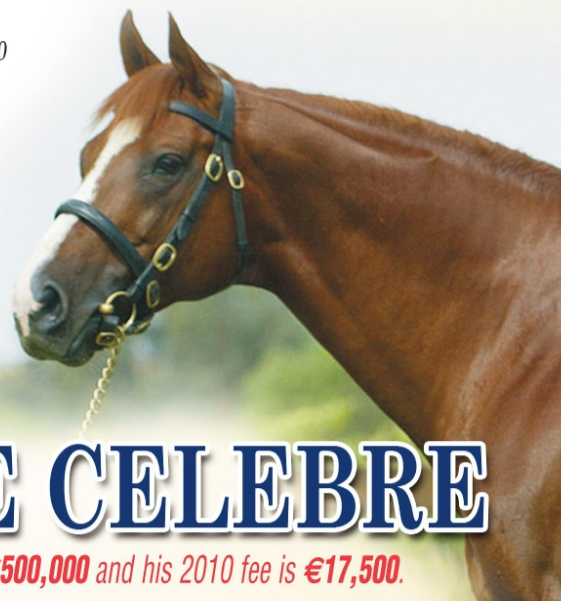

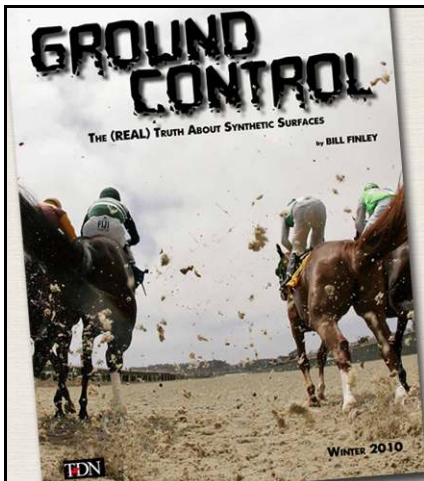
Imperio yesterday, as his family's homebred **General Maximus** (Freud) returned to the races in style to remain unbeaten. Sidelined by a pair of ankle chips following an impressive bow at Belmont last July ([TDN In Sharper Focus](#)), the flashy chestnut compiled an impressive worktab at Gold Mark Farm for his sophomore debut.

"Todd Quast at Gold Mark told me that General Maximus was about 75- to 80-percent fit, but that he was going to run his eyeballs out," said Imperio, who watched the race in New York. "I couldn't believe it--when that horse headed him in the stretch, I figured he'd get tired, but he looked at the other horse twice and wouldn't let him pass."

General Maximus is likely to tackle more distance in his next start.

"I didn't look at the condition book yet, but we'll probably look to stretch him out to a mile," Imperio said. "A mile stakes for three-year-olds would be ideal, but we have to see how everything plays out. We're just so excited right now. We bred the horse, so it's like he's our baby."

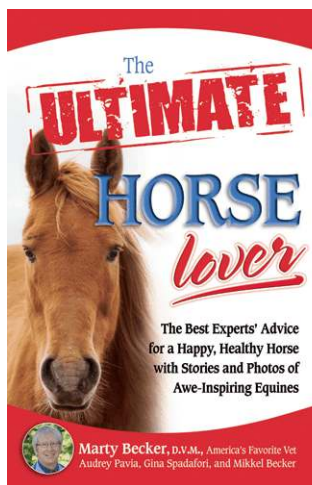
