GABBY GOLDEN IN SANTA MONICA

Let go at 11-1 odds despite her Grade I credentials, **Gabby's Golden Gal** (Medaglia d'Oro) proved her victory in last summer's GI Acorn S. was no fluke as she came from just off the pace to take Sunday's GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita. Content to track the front-running duo of **Czechers** (Indian Charlie) and **Free Flying Soul** (Quiet American) through solid opening splits of :23.58, :46.31 and 1:09.76, the dark bay

drove to the front in midstretch and had enough left to hold off the late-closing 2-1 choice **Proviso** (GB) (Dansil {GB}). "[Trainer] Bob [Baffert] said the main thing was to make her relax and then to make my move," said rider Martin Garcia. "I had an opportunity to keep her outside of those two speed horses [Free Flying Soul and Czechers] and she relaxed very well. When I asked her, she just took off." BICKERSONS DOMINATES IN FORWARD GAL

Plenty of pre-race attention was afforded to the GI Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Park Sunday afternoon and for good reason. Poised to make her seasonal debut in the seven-furlong test was GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine and divisional champion **She Be Wild** (Offlee Wild), who was sent off the 7-5 choice. However, it was **Bickersons** (Silver Deputy) who belied her generous 9-1 odds when annihilating her competition with an embarrassingly easy seven-length victory. Closing for second was 51-1 longshot

Joanie's Catch (First Tour), while **Liam's Dream** (Saint Liam) rounded out the trifecta. "That was really an eye-opener," said winning jockey Joe Bravo. "Let's put it like this; you've got the Breeders' Cup winner and a full field, and our filly destroys a field like that. It makes us feel so good going forward with her." She Be Wild, who was settled in midpack in the early going, appeared to be in contention turning for home, but faded late to be fifth. "She took to the dirt well and I got a good trip, but the distance was too short for her," said jockey Julien Leparoux, who was aboard the beaten favorite. RACHEL ALEXANDRA BACK ON WORK TAB

Recently crowned Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) turned in her first official work of the year, breezing four furlongs in :52 at Fair Grounds Sunday. "I even asked for a touch slower, but for her that's just physically impossible," said Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen. "It was a perfect work. We're not out to impress anybody at this point. I'm happy with how manageable she is, how happy she is being out there. Looking at her body motion, she's

happy with what she's doing." Reaffirming the point, track clocker Billy Pettingill added, "I can tell you that she was a very happy horse coming off the track. She enjoyed being out there and never turned a hair. I would say she was going about 60 percent." Rachel Alexandra has not raced since concluding her championship campaign with a gritty win in the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga last September. In addition to the Woodward, she also captured the GI Preakness S., GI Haskell Invitational and GI Kentucky Oaks. Blasi admitted it was good to have the star filly back working again. "Anytime you can wake up like I do and walk in the barn and see Rachel Alexandra, it is a good morning," he said.

A well-beaten sixth behind subsequent Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Kentucky Oaks in May, the dark bay was shipped to New York for the GI Acorn S. and took it in wire-to-wire fashion. Ninth after stumbling at the start in the GI Prioress S. July 4, Gabby's Golden Gal closed out the season with a seventh in the GI La Brea S. Dec. 26. "She just needed the race [in the La Brea]," said trainer Bob Baffert. "I thought she was training well enough to win it, but she just laid an egg that day. This filly has always shown me signs of greatness, like Indian Blessing. 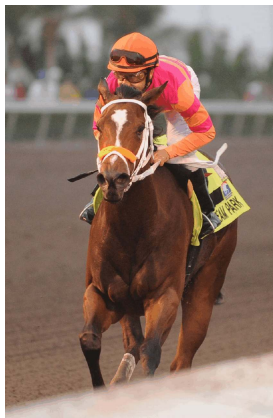

Bickersons, who graduated at second asking at Monmouth last July, finished third in the Spa's GI Spinaway S. and Santa Anita's GI Oak Leaf S., but failed to reproduce that form when 10th the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Nov. 7. "We took her all over last year and ran in the big races," said winning trainer Kelly Breen. "I think we found out that she could do well around two turns in the right company, but not necessarily against the best." A 2 1/2-length winner in the seven-furlong Moccasin S. at Hollywood Nov. 22, the dark bay was a well-beaten fifth in her most recent start in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 20. "Seven-eighths is probably her best game, and

maybe she can go a one-turn mile," added Breen. "When she blew out that :33 and 4/5 [Jan. 24], I was concerned that she might have left her race at Palm Meadows, but obviously she didn't."

CRISP READIES FOR SHOWDOWN

In preparation for a confrontation with Eclipse Award juvenile filly finalist **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) in Saturday's GI Las Virgenes S., ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Crisp** (El Corredor) worked six furlongs in 1:13.80 at Hollywood Park. Winner of her last two starts, including the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Jan. 10, the filly recorded the third fastest of 12 moves at the distance Sunday. "[Joel] Rosario worked her and everything is thumbs up," said trainer John Sadler. "Racing against Blind Luck is challenging in the sense that she's the second best three-year-old on the West Coast. The first one is Lookin at Lucky [Smart Strike, champion juvenile colt]. We're up against it, but you've got to get them started." Also likely for the Las Virgenes are **La Nez** (Storm Creek) and **Summer Games** (Limehouse).

Pulsion Misses '10 Debut Due to Cough

Pulsion (Include), slated to make his 2010 debut in the sixth race at Gulfstream yesterday afternoon, was scratched Sunday morning after developing a cough. "I went to the barn early [Sunday] morning, and he coughed 20 times," explained trainer Patrick Biancone. "We scoped him and found mucus. It's just a little cold.

He's eating well. We should be all right." Runner-up behind eventual juvenile champion Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike) in last October's GI Norfolk S., the \$250,000 OBSMAR juvenile finished 11th in his most recent start in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 7. "It's destiny, you know," said Biancone, who trains the colt for Flying Zee and Kona Stables. "I prefer finding out before we race than after we race." As for what lies ahead, Biancone added, "Our target is the [GII] Fountain of Youth S. [Feb. 20]. We'd prefer to give him a race before that. If we can't, we'll train him up to the Fountain of Youth. It just makes it more difficult."

RECORD ENTRIES FOR DUBAI WORLD CUP A record 1,951 entries were taken for the 2010 Dubai World Cup card, slated for Mar. 27 at Meydan Racecourse. The closure of the free entry stage Jan. 13 saw entries from 23 countries for the revamped eight-race program, highlighted by the \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup. The World Cup, run for the first time on an all-weather surface, attracted the highest number of nominations in its history, with dual Eclipse Award winner **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) and Japanese champion **Vodka (Jpn)** (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}) prominent among the 288 entries received. Godolphin's trainer Saeed bin Suuroor had the most entries in the 2000-meter feature with 34.

WinStar's three-year-old contingent just got deeper. The operation owns runaway GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. winner Super Saver (Maria's Mon), GIII Hollywood Prevue S. hero American Lion (Tiznow) and GIII Delta Jackpot S. victor Rule (Roman Ruler), and now has another on the GI Kentucky Derby trail following Drosselmeyer's victory at Gulfstream yesterday.

"We've felt all along that we had four really good prospects, and that [Drosselmeyer would] be one of the four," said Elliott Walden, vice president and racing manager for WinStar. "It's hard to rank them. He's the only one that has won at three. The others had better form at two, but we always felt this horse had as much ability as Rule, Super Saver and American Lion."

WinStar pushed the limits of its budget when it acquired Drosselmeyer for \$600,000 at the 2008 Keeneland September yearling sale.

"We thought he was one of the top two or three Distorted Humors of that year," Walden said. "That was about the limit we could muster on him. We have bought horses that were that expensive, but typically we try to buy them for less."

Walden offered a simple explanation for why Drosselmeyer, a son of the 2001 GI Las Virgenes S. and GI Santa Anita Oaks winner Golden Ballet (Moscow Ballet), began his career on turf.

"The races were longer on the turf--that was the main reason [he began his career on grass]," Walden said. "We wanted to run him longer, instead of the short sprints at Saratoga. We were always going to try him on the dirt."

Following yesterday's victory, the chestnut remains undefeated over conventional dirt, cementing his status as a Classic contender. Connections have yet to determine where he will make his next start, but it's safe to say it will be on the main track.

"I talked to [trainer] Billy [Mott] just a few minutes ago, and we're going to make a decision towards the end of the week," Walden said. "We're in no real hurry. We'll probably get two more starts in before the Derby, and, hopefully, we'll get enough earnings to get in." -J.F.
