OAKLAWN OFFERS \$5-MIL 'BLOSSOM' LURE

Officials at Oaklawn Park have announced that the purse of the GI Apple Blossom H. would be raised to \$5 million should Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) and two-time Eclipse Award winner

Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) clash for the first time in their careers. Both horses have raced and won at the Hot Springs oval. Rachel Alexandra won the Martha Washington S. and the GII Fantasy S. there last season, while Zenyatta made her lone dirt appearance a winning one in the 2008 Apple Blossom. If just one of the two goes postward, the purse

would revert to its original \$500,000.

"We have always pursued a goal of bringing the world's best racing to Arkansas," track President Charles Cella said. "That is what led us to create the Racing Festival of the South more than 30 years ago. We have been even more fortunate in recent years. That gives us the opportunity to fulfill the promises we continually make to our fans, our horsemen and all of our supporters--should this race come off as expected, it will most certainly fulfill every promise made."

Jess Jackson, whose Stonestreet Stables owns Rachel Alexandra with Harold McCormick, says he'll let the filly do the talking. "As you have heard me say many times before, a number of factors must be considered when deciding where to race a horse--the number one factor being the condition of the horse," he said in a release. "Rachel will tell us when she is ready to start her 2010 campaign and we humans must agree she is in top form. My family and I would love to see her run at Oaklawn Park. If she is in top form and it fits in our schedule, we will be there. Rachel, as you know, likes the track having won twice there last year."

NTRA CEO Alex Waldrop commended Oaklawn for trying to facilitate the race. "This is the match-up that every fan wants to see," he said. "Assuming that each horse remains healthy and fit, a showdown between these two great champions on Apr. 3 in the Apple Blossom truly could live up to its billing as a race for the ages."

The connections of Zenyatta also left the door open for a possible match-up in the Apple Blossom.

"We're all very excited about the opportunity," said Dottie Ingordo-Shirreffs, racing manager for Zenyatta owners Jerry and Ann Moss and wife of trainer John Shirreffs. "It would be fabulous for the fans and the racing industry. It's a race we've won before, so she likes that track. We'll do our best to make the race, but obviously, it all depends on Zenyatta and how she's doing."

Officials at Oaklawn have also decided to lengthen the race from its traditional mile and a sixteenth to a mile and an eighth and will rename the race the Apple Blossom Invitational.

Alexandros, hero of the 2007 G3 Prix de Cabourg at Deauville, placed third in last term's G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad Al Sheba in March. Second, beaten a nose, in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. May 16, notched an allowance race at Nottingham Nov. 4 before concluding his four-year-old campaign with a close seventh in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 13. Tracking the early leaders here, Alexandros kicked clear with an explosive turn of foot in the stretch to report home a much-the-best winner. Winning jockey Frankie Dettori said, "It is a great track [the turf course] and I was really impressed with the condition it is in and especially the sweeping bends. MULLINS SETTLES WITH IEAH IEAH Stables and Jeff Mullins have resolved a dispute over money the trainer said he was owed following **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even)'s win in the GI Wood Memorial S. last April. "It's all settled," Mullins told *Daily Racing Form* after receiving last Monday a \$31,336 payment from IEAH, which co-owns I Want Revenge with David Lanzman. Mullins had filed a complaint with Santa Anita stewards last month, which could have led to sanctions from the stewards against IEAH. A hearing scheduled for yesterday was cancelled.

STING TO PLAY MEYDAN Acclaimed recording artist Sting will help kick off the inaugural season of Meydan Race Course in Dubai when he plays the Dubai Racing Carnival during the 'Super Thursday' card on Mar. 4. Super Thursday is widely seen as precursor to the Dubai World Cup. A composer, singer, actor and activist, Sting has evolved into one of the world's most distinctive and highly respected performers, collecting as a solo performer 11 Grammys, 2 Brits, a Golden Globe, an Emmy, three Oscar nominations, *Billboard Magazine's* Century Award, and MusiCares 2004 Person of the Year. The concert is expected to commence after the last race at 11 p.m. Gates to Meydan will open from 6 p.m. for ticket holders who are interested to also view the races. Ticket prices start from UAE\$150 (\$27) for free standing admissions, and UAE\$735 (\$200) for premium seats. Sting formerly headed the influential rock band The Police, whose third album, *Zenyatta Mondatta*, gave dual champion *Zenyatta* (Street Cry {Ire}) her name.

INTERACTIF RETURNS IN SUNDAY'S HALLENDALE BEACH Promising MGSW **Interactif** (Broken Vow), unraced since finishing a close-up third in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 7, returns in Sunday's \$125,000 Hallandale Beach S. at Gulfstream. The Wertheimer & Frere homebred has drawn the outside post eight in the 1 1/16-mile turf event. Regular rider Kent Desormeaux gets the call from trainer Todd Pletcher. **Interactif** was a convincing winner of the GIII With Anticipation S. in his grass debut at Saratoga in September and added the GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland a month later. He was beaten just 3/4 lengths by **Pounced** (Rahy) in the Breeder's Cup. While the colt begins his sophomore campaign on the spin-ach, Pletcher has said that he hasn't ruled out returning the bay to the dirt. **Interactif** broke his maiden going five furlongs over Monmouth's main track July 5 before running eighth in the GII Sanford S. at Saratoga July 30.

In 2009, Donna Jones--whose father Kenneth Jones, Jr. founded Domino Stud in Lexington--was set the unenviable task of dispersing the family's bloodstock holdings, including the farm. It wasn't the easiest process in the world, especially where it came to letting go the farm's employees, some of whom refused to leave the premises when asked.

"I told someone that, 'I need to get a gun and I'm gonna shoot someone,'" Jones recollected about her tongue-in-cheek discussion. "So, we're sitting at the [Keeneland] April meeting and laughing about it, and one of my girlfriends said, 'Donna, get your gun; that's a great name for a horse.' I took a look at my girlfriend and said, 'The two-year-old sales are on. Let's go get a racehorse.'"

Employing the services of bloodstock agent David Ingordo, Jones went to \$170,000 for a May foal by Stormy Atlantic, who breezed a strong eighth of a mile in :10.1 ([video](#)) for the Keeneland April Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. Jones named her purchase Donna Getyourgun.

"I really wanted to shop the two-year-old market because I wanted a horse that I could race immediately," Jones, 33, explained. "I have an amazing trainer in Ian Wilkes, and to pick up a two-year-old that was recommended by David seemed a quick and efficient way to get in. The two-year-old sales fit me best. It was something I very much wanted to do for a long time, and when the opportunity presented itself, I took advantage of it."

A debut runner-up over the Arlington Poly Sept. 12, the chestnut filly broke through with a half-length graduation at Keeneland Oct. 25 ([video](#)). She was a disappointing fourth as the favorite in her conventional dirt debut at Churchill Nov. 28, but proved that effort was a fluke with a good-looking entry-level allowance success at Gulfstream this past Sunday ([video](#)). Jones was fully expecting that kind of performance, but wants to take things one step at a time.

"She looked amazing [going into Sunday's race]," she explained. "She had grown more and she had put on so much muscle. I couldn't believe how she changed in that short time." She continued, "I was so thrilled. I am so happy with Ian Wilkes, because he keeps me very involved and he puts up with thousands of questions I have for him on a regular basis. The next day I want to know how she is and is she eating well and after that we can talk about what's next."

The Jones family, which sold MGSW Miss Isella (Silver Charm) for \$1.085 million this year at KEEJAN, will also be represented by her half-brother Guam Typhoon (Distorted Humor) in Saturday's Super S. at Tampa. Both horses are out of La Cucina (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}), also the dam of 2003 GII Arkansas Derby hero Sir Cherokee (Cherokee Run). A.C.

There were no major fireworks at Tattersalls' one-day February Sale in Newmarket yesterday with a top price of just 55,000gns. That came for four-year-old **Rhythm Queen (GB)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}--Flawly {GB}, by Old Vic {GB}), a maiden half-sister to G1 Prix du Jockey-Club runner-up Best Name. [Hip 69](#) had cost owner Pat Fahey 700,000gns, but did not trouble the judge when trained by David Wachman, and is now the property of Andrew Tinkler, CEO of the Eddie Stobart haulage firm. Agent Dwayne Woods, who keeps Tinkler's mares at his locally based Brook Stud, fought off Cormac McCormack to get the filly.

"Andrew's getting together a few decent broodmares," said Woods. "I can see why she cost what she did as a yearling, her conformation is as good as it can get and, although she wasn't much of a racehorse and looks poor at the moment, in a couple of months she'll look great."

"She's out of an Old Vic mare and the obvious stallion would be Monsun, but that might be a bit rich for her just at the moment, and also it's probably best not to travel her in her condition now."

Veteran County Waterford agent John O'Byrne paid 50,000gns for **Chrisalice (Gr)** (Lujain--Diary {Ire}, by Green Desert), a six-year-old who had scored twice in Greece. [Hip 61](#) is a half-sister to both G1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner Total Gallery (Ire) (Namid {Ire}) and Group 1-placed Lady Darshaan (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}). That duo's joint owner-breeder Seamus Kennedy was underbidder.

"She's for myself and, with her pedigree, she could go to any of the stallions at Coolmore," said O'Byrne. "She's well-related and I have five or six mares at home, but am never married to them. If I can sell them on, I do as you have to try and keep your head above water in this business."
