He's certainly the master of this domain. **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality), bet down to 2-5 in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream yesterday, had only the clock as his rival in the stretch and crossed the wire in 1:47.49 for the nine furlongs. The homebred bettered his own mark of 1:47.72, which he set during his GI Florida Derby win last March. There was only one way jockey John Velazquez could describe the victory.

RAIN FORCES SANTA ANITA TO CANCEL

For the fourth time this winter, Santa Anita was forced to cancel live racing due to heavy rains; the track had been scheduled to host three graded events Saturday. "This is obviously very disappointing," said Santa Anita General Manager George Haines. "The main track is draining better than it was a month ago, but we got very substantial rain overnight and this morning and, as a result, we had standing water in several areas." Haines added, "As we've said all along, safety is going to be our number one priority in determining whether or not we're able to run, and the situation this morning was not good. That said, this weather system is supposed to be completely cleared out by late

this afternoon, and we are optimistic about being able to run [Sunday]." Santa Anita will bring back the cancelled trio of the GI Las Virgenes S., GI Robert B. Lewis S. and GI Strub S. for next Saturday, Feb. 13. All three races will be open to original nominees and will be redrawn. The overnight stakes carded for Saturday--the Leroidesanimaux S. and Wishing Well H.--will be contested Thursday and Friday, respectively.

Quality Road stormed to victory last winter for trainer Jimmy Jerkens in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. and GI Florida Derby before being sidelined by a quarter crack. After setting a track record in his first try for trainer Todd Pletcher in the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga, the handsome colt caught sloppy tracks in his next two starts, a third in the GI Shadwell Travers S. at the Spa Aug. 29 and a second in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 3. However, he suffered a well-publicized meltdown in the starting gate of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita, and found himself being vanned back to New York. The Virginia-bred was repeatedly schooled at the gate, and came back to post a professional tally in the GIII Hal's Hope H. over a flat mile at Gulfstream Jan. 3.

Content to sit in second as **Past the Point** (Indian Charlie) clipped off splits of :23.21 and :46.02, the odds-on chalk drew even after six furlongs in 1:09.87. No challenges were forthcoming from the other runners, and Quality Road opened up at will for a popular score.

"Obviously, he ran the kind of race we know he's capable of, and the race set up just as we thought," said Pletcher. "He's got a very high cruising speed and can go :46 and 1:09 and still keep going. Not many horses can do that, and he was spotting weight to all those horses, six pounds or more."



Take the Points, a multiple Grade I winner against his peers in 2009, crossed the line first here, but was taken down after clipping heels in the final 50 yards with Yate's Black Cat (Black Minnaloushe), who stumbled badly and nearly went down. Court Vision, in the clear on the outside, wound up getting his picture taken. Narrowly beaten when third in this event last year for trainer Bill Mott, Court Vision was turned over to Rick Dutrow Jr. following a sixth-place finish in the GI United Nations S. July 4. The dark bay returned to earn a narrow decision in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 10, and closed out 2009 with an honorable fourth to champion Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita Nov. 7. Allowed to settle into stride by Robby Albarado, Court Vision raced in fifth as Le Grand Cru showed the way through splits of :46.59 and 1:10.03. The favored five-year-old advanced on the outside through the far turn, but couldn't quicken past Take the Points, and crossed the line 1 1/2 lengths behind that grey rival. "I had a great trip," Albarado reported. "I think my horse ran a great race and it was a good comeback for him. I was in striking distance with a chance to win and wasn't bothered in the stretch." The horses have all cooled out, but the race may not really be over. "[Owner] Mr. [Jack] Wolf and I have already talked about it and we'll consider an appeal," Take the Points' trainer Todd Pletcher commented. "The head-on [camera] shot on turf is not really a true one. We thought the one [Le Grand Cru] came out a little [into Yate's Black Cat]. The thing that bothers me most is that there was no way the horse he was supposed to have bothered was ever going to beat him. I've always thought that if it isn't clear, you just leave it alone."

Tottie kicked off her sophomore season with a non-threatening third to Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial S. last May, but could only manage eighth in the G1 Epsom Oaks the following month for trainer Amanda Perrett. The bay made four more starts in her native Britain and missed the frame in each of them, and was sent across the Atlantic following a sixth in a handicap at Sandown Aug. 9. Given some time to get accustomed, the homebred rallied from ninth to claim a first-level local allowance Jan. 7 and was favored in this class hike. The distinctively marked filly enjoyed a perfect trip in second whilst tracking In My Glory, then made her move in front of the stands. A host of rivals came running in the final sixteenth, but Tottie had first run and earned her first black-type trophy. "She came to me in September on a recommendation from [bloodstock agent] James Delahooke," said winning trainer Chad Brown. "The owner, Mr. [Julian] Richmond-Watson from England, said to take whatever time you think she needs. She had a bad first month here before she began to acclimate, and the extra time has paid off." Rider Jose Lezcano added, "The plan was to come from behind, but when she broke, she broke right on top and I didn't want to take her back. If today's card isn't canceled, highweight **Richard's Kid** will have the services of Garrett Gomez for the first time. Now owned by Zabeel Racing, he was ridden by Mike Smith when he defeated Einstein (Brz) (Spend a Buck) by a neck at 24-1 in Del Mar's GI Pacific Classic Sept. 6, and had the services of Alex Solis when third in the Oct. 10 GI Goodwood S. and sixth in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at this venue. "He's been working really well," Gomez said of Richard's Kid. "He needs the pace in front of him." That pace will likely come from **Mast Track**, who wired the GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 12 last out.

He was saddled that day by former Frankel assistant Humberto Ascanio, and will now compete for conditioner John Shirreffs. **Marsh Side** finds himself in an easier spot after beating one home when 17th in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 29. The 2008 GI Canadian International S. winner has raced exclusively on turf since reporting home fourth in that year's Cougar II H. at Del Mar. **Furthest Land**, winner of the 2009 GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, will look to make amends after finishing last of seven in the Jan. 9 GII San Pasqual H. as the 3-5 favorite. Santa Anita will have an early first post of 11 a.m. due to the Super Bowl.

Typhoon Tracy, the lone female in a field of nine, sat a stalking trip off a moderate tempo, pounced at the 400-meter marker and stayed on for a workmanlike victory in this weight-for-age event. "It's nice to get that open age win out of the way," trainer Peter Moody told *AAP*. "We weren't expecting it to be easy and she's got nice improvement on the back of that. It was a nice soft kick-off to hopefully a fruitful campaign. The plan is to run in the Futurity in two weeks time then there's a hell of a lot of options beyond that." The G1 Futurity S. over 1600 meters takes place Feb. 27 at Caulfield. A dual Group 1 winner against her own sex, Typhoon Tracy was last seen taking the G1 Myer Classic at Flemington Oct. 31. 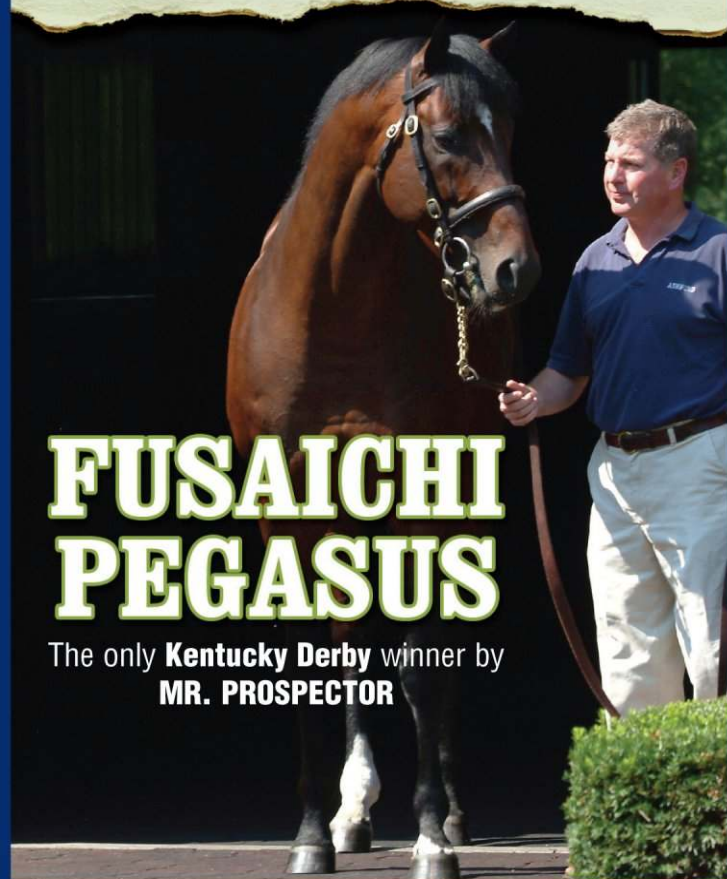

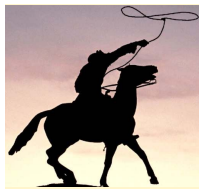

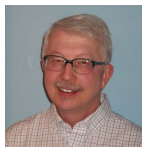
