Today's GIII Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay Downs features a number of three-year-olds testing their credentials for the Classics. Fantasy Lane Stable's unbeaten **Uptowncharlybrown** (Limehouse), a colt whose

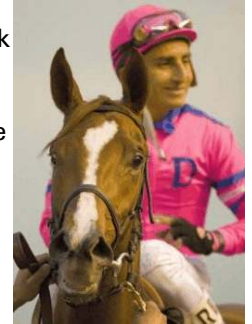
fan page on Facebook grows daily, will be stretching out to a route for the first time. A nine-length winner of his career bow over the tricky Tampa surface Dec. 26, the chestnut dashed away from his rivals in the seven-furlong Pasco S. Jan. 16, and trainer Alan Seewald is looking to see some more from his charge this afternoon. "This race really means a lot to us," Seewald told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's a perfect stepping stone for him going into the [GIII] Tampa Bay Derby [Mar. 13], and it's most impor-

tant that he runs well and gets a lot out of the race. If he happens to win, all the better." Seewald added, "I really wish I had a two-turn race under his belt, but I didn't have time. He's taking a lot on making the third start of his life in seven weeks. It's a big jump he's trying to accomplish. But he's very rateable, and has all the makings of a horse who will run all day. One thing he does have in his favor is two races over this track, although even that's no replacement for the experience some of the others have." *For more on Uptowncharlybrown, see Take Two, p11*

Eric Fein has owned or co-owned a pair of colts that hit the board in the last two runnings of the Sam F. Davis, Big Truck (Hook and Ladder) and Musket Man (Yonaguska), before capturing the Tampa Bay Derby. This year's model is **Schoolyard Dreams** (Stephen Got Even), who will add blinkers after capturing a local allowance going a mile and 40 yards Jan. 9. Fein is partners with Anthony Mitola in the bay colt. **Cont. p2**

**SATURDAY AT SANTA ANITA, TAKE TWO**

Last Saturday's card at Santa Anita was washed out when the Arcadia area received over three inches of rain in a 24-hour period, and three graded stakes have been brought back today. Multiple Grade I winner **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) is still the headliner in the GI Las Virgenes, while the GII Robert B. Lewis continues to feature a clash between two sons of Tiznow, **American Lion** and **Tiz Chrome**. American Lion, a stylish maiden winner at Keeneland Oct. 18, looked a bit green when he added a score in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 21. The rescheduled Lewis will mark his first attempt at two turns. Trainer Eoin Harty termed the delay "a minor inconvenience." Harty added, "You've got to go two turns for the first time at some point, so this is it for him. But you never know if they can be successful until they do it."

Dec. 4, thereby giving his connections the luxury of plotting out the perfect timetable to the first Saturday in May. "Obviously, by already having enough graded

earnings, we don't have to push as much and we've got a margin for error should something happen where he doesn't run well in one of these preps," trainer Todd Pletcher told DRF. "It certainly takes the pressure off having to win. What we're looking for here is a good comeback without him overdoing it while gradually building him up for a peak performance, hopefully, on Derby Day."

**Blind Luck**, winner of the GI Oak Leaf S. Oct. 4, couldn't quite finish off her race in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and dropped a 3/4-length decision to champion She Be Wild (Offlee Wild). The one-time claimer overturned that effort with an exclamation point, posting a stunning seven-length triumph in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 20, and breaks from the rail in this redrawn affair. **Crisp** earned "TDN Rising Star" status off her adventurous maiden score at Hollywood Dec. 10, then validated that performance with a one-length victory from **Evening Jewel** in the Jan. 10 GIII Santa Ysabel S. Trainer John Sadler knows he faces a daunting task this afternoon. "Racing against Blind Luck is challenging in the sense that she's the second-best three-year-old on the West Coast," he explained. "The first one is Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike). We're up against it, but you've got to get them started."

**Life Is Sweet**, last seen posting an eye-catching win over **Mushka** in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 6, begins her five-year-old campaign. The Wygod homebred also annexed last term's GII El Encino S., GII La Canada S., and GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. in succession at the Great Race Place. "A lot of people overlook that she won at Santa Anita in January and was still able to run in the Breeders' Cup and several races in between," trainer John Shirreffs told *Daily Racing Form*. "She ran all year long." **Mushka** also makes her first start since the Breeders' Cup. The dark bay previously was placed first through disqualification in Keeneland's GI Juddmonte Spinster S. in October. **St Trinians** has been perfect in three attempts since shipping to the U.S., including the Paseana H. last time Jan. 9.

Winner of the GII Swaps S. in wire-to-wire fashion July 18, he beat Giant Oak (Giant's Causeway) in the GII Indiana Derby Oct. 3. Second by a neck to the progressive Blame (Arch) in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Nov. 27, he cut back to a sprint and gave an excellent account of himself placing second in the GI Malibu S. Dec. 26.

**Massone** rates a longshot look for the exotics. Third in last year's GI Toyota Blue Grass S., he was fourth in the Swaps and earned a career-best figure when third to Regal Ransom (Distorted Humor) in the GII Super Derby in September. Most recently third in the grassy GIII Sir Beaufort S. Dec. 26, he has trained sensationally for this return to Pro-Ride.

KEEAPR purchase debuted impressively over six furlongs of the Del Mar Polytrack Aug. 29, drawing off for a 3 1/4-length victory. Sent off at odds of 4-1 against Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike) while making his first start going two turns in the GI Norfolk S. Oct. 4, the dark bay was last or second last much of the way and made a late run into sixth, beaten just over two lengths. **Tiz Chrome** broke his maiden at 15-1 at Churchill Downs Nov. 1 and was purchased privately.

In his first appearance for his new connections, the flashy bay laid close to a quick pace and accelerated away for a four-length victory in the Dec. 19 Stuka S. ([video](#)), a non black-type event in Inglewood. "I didn't think he would run like that at Hollywood Park," trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He blew them away that day. He's a laid-back kind of horse. He shows you a lot more in the afternoon than in the morning." Baffert added, "This is the first prep where you can really get a line on horses. It's a pretty strong bunch."

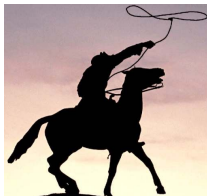

Despite the fact that Fantasy Lane Stable made only three purchases at last year's juvenile sales, the partnership definitely made the most of its limited portfolio with the acquisition of SW Uptowncharlybrown, who will lineup in today's Gill Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay Downs, and try to punch his ticket to the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby.

Consigned by Casse Sales at last year's OBS April Two-Year-Old in Training Sale, Uptowncharlybrown was secured for \$57,000 by Fantasy Lane Stable, a racing partnership headed by New York native Robert Lane Hutt. Currently a resident of Forked River, New Jersey, Hutt credits his father, David, with introducing him to racing and nurturing his love of the sport. After years of frequenting racetracks along the East Coast, Hutt, who lost his father in a tragic car accident in 1998, created Fantasy Lane Stable the following year in the memory of his beloved parent. With about 12 partners on board in its first year, the partnership quickly took flight, and now boasts membership--at varying levels of investment--of over 300. According to Hutt, listed among the occupations of the partners involved in Fantasy Lane are a pilot, corrections officer, teacher, contractor and guidance counselor.

In 1999, Fantasy Lane enjoyed its initial winner when its first starter, Lisa's Step (Star de Naskra), won in her debut in June. After acquiring horses privately and through the claiming ranks in the early years, Fantasy Lane decided to shift its focus to the two-year-old sales, and was quickly rewarded for its patronage.

"About five years ago, we decided we are just going to buy two-year-olds in training," said Hutt. "We thought we'd just buy a couple a year and not spend a lot of money. That's tough to do, but we feel we have a formula that has worked for us so far."

With the help of advisors Gate Artis and trainer Alan Seewald, Hutt secured a pair of juveniles that, although failing to meet their reserves, subsequently made their mark at the black-type level. Awalkinthepark (Ecton Park), who RNAd at OBSMAR in 2005, was subsequently purchased for \$125,000 and earned black-type during his career. R Betty Graybull (Holy Bull), who also RNAd at the OBSMAR sale, but was subsequently purchased for \$60,000, went on to score in the NATC Futurity S. at Monmouth Park in 2008. Also racing under the Fantasy Lane Stable banner was Cobra Strike (Ecton Park), who brought \$100,000 at the OBSFEB sale in 2007 before finishing runner up in the NATC Futurity S. at the Meadowlands.

"We've had four stakes horses in the last four years, and that's by only buying a couple a year," said Hutt. "You can't complain about that."

Plucked out of the same sale as Uptowncharlybrown by the partnership was Joyce's Angel (Afleet Alex), named after a little girl from Holland who was battling cancer. Although Joyce passed away last Thanksgiving, the partners eagerly anticipate the debut of the four-legged Joyce, who is expected to make her debut at Tampa in the next couple of weeks. Rounding out the trio of juvenile purchases last season is Writethatdown (Read the Footnotes), who brought \$60,000 at Fasig-Tipton in Timonium last May and is expected to make his debut sometime this spring. However, despite the high hopes for the other members of the team, there is little doubt who is the star of Fantasy Lane Stable these days.



While Uptowncharlybrown may not have overwhelmed some of the observers at the April Sale in Ocala last spring, he certainly caught the eye of the Fantasy Lane team, who were interested in finding a two-year-old that could offer something more than just a fast time.

"We liked the way he worked and we thought he'd probably make a nice three-year-old," recalled Hutt. "We loved his stride. He just has one of the most fluid, humongous strides I've ever seen. We don't buy the fastest horses in the sale, we are more concerned with their action and their stride. The reason why we buy two-year-olds as opposed to yearlings is that, although you pay a premium, you can see them move. And that's very very important to us."

After sending the colt for a brief stint to Monmouth Park, Uptowncharlybrown was given some time to develop at Joe Jennings' Walnford Stud in Allentown. However, it wasn't long after returning to

join Seewald's string at the Oceanport oval that the team knew they might have something special on their hands.

"We hadn't even breezed Charly yet, and one day last September, Alan says to me, 'I think this may be the best horse we've ever had,'" recalled Hutt. "And this is after having had some pretty nice horses before."

Settled off the early pace in his career bow at Tampa Dec. 26, the

chestnut took over with ease heading into the stretch and was in splendid isolation at the wire, winning by nine lengths. Favored while jumping up in class for the Jan. 16 Pasco S., Uptowncharlybrown once again made a mockery of his rivals as he galloped home a six-length winner.

"That was just his natural talent that you saw in the Pasco," said Hutt. "But now he is ready to step up."

Hutt indicated that while the colt doesn't have to win Saturday, a good effort would take him to the Gill Tampa Bay Derby.

"We're still trying to find out how much time he needs in between races to fire his best effort," said Hutt. "I can assure you, he's not a sprinter, he never has been and never will be. In his races, he just galloped out past the finish line 20 lengths ahead of the others horses. He will get better as he goes longer."

Despite having enjoyed success in the past, the Fantasy Lane team dare to hope that the current team can take them to new heights in '10.

"It's unbelievable what has happened," he added. "We put up a few thousand dollars and we have a horse that can maybe win the Kentucky Derby--or at least make it to the starting gate. It's like a dream. I just wish my father was here to see it."--CB

**PINKARELLA (f, 4, Malibu Moon--Stormy Monday, by Storm Cat)** finished third to the ill-fated Carlsbad (Rocky Bar) in the GIII Santa Paula S. at Santa Anita last March before hitting the shelf. She returned to thrash older fillies and mares by five-lengths in a Hollypark allowance Nov. 27, but could not overcome a high draw and some trouble when eighth in the GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26. Trying a conventional dirt surface for the first time as the 8-5 favorite, the bay settled just off the early speed, engaged the front runners turning for home and drew clear to defeat Wyatt's Women (Eltish) by 4 1/4 lengths. 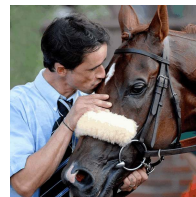
