When entries were taken for the GIII Southwest S., **"TDN Rising Star" *** **Conveyance** (Indian Charlie) drew the two hole, the perfect stall given his preferred front-running style. Connections would have been significantly more dismayed when the grey drew out in the nine after bad weather forced the rescheduling of the one-mile event to yesterday. In the end, it didn't matter. The GIII San Rafael S. hero, favored by the Hot Springs faithful at 9-5, jumped best of all and led throughout, holding off a sustained run from GISW **Dublin** (Afleet Alex) for the victory. **Cont. p4**

A half-brother to the good Group 1-winning turf sprinter Balmont (Stravinsky), Eskendereya kicked off his career on the green stuff, finishing second at Saratoga Sept. 7. Given a crack at the off-the-turf Pilgrim S. Oct. 4 despite his maiden status, he rated just off the pace and stormed home by 7 1/4 lengths over a sticky racetrack. Sent to Santa Anita for the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the chestnut colt took some play at 12-1, but was taken up on the clubhouse turn and lost all chance, finishing ninth. He made all of the running in a Jan. 7 allowance going this track's one-turn mile, scoring by 1 1/4 lengths, and trained well for the return to graded competition. While Eskendereya was enjoying a clean run stalking the pace of longshot **Lost Aptitude** (Aptitude) from second, race favorite **Buddy's Saint** (Saint Liam) was enduring a nightmarish opening quarter mile several lengths behind. The GIII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. winner was a bit slow into stride, then angled to the fence and attempted to squeeze through inside of Aikenite (Yes It's True) entering the first turn. The two exchanged bumps three times, relegating Buddy's Saint to the latter half of the field and effectively ending his afternoon. Meanwhile, back on the front end, Eskendereya wrested command from the weakening Lost Aptitude and was soon joined by Jackson Bend, who drew to within a length at the quarter pole. But, while that one was all out beneath Jeremy Rose, the eventual winner was pulling clear with every stride and was in a race of his own at the wire. "You've got to be excited when they perform like that in these kind of races at this time of year," commented winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "I was particularly pleased with the way he finished. I don't think we've ever gotten to the bottom of him." Pletcher added that the winner would make his next start in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 20.

Discreetly Mine dusted fellow Triple Crown aspirant Super Saver (Maria's Mon) by 6 1/4 lengths to graduate at Saratoga Aug. 22, then was runner-up in his next two, behind D'Funnybone (D'Wildcat) in the GII Futurity S. Sept. 19 and to that one's stablemate Homeboykris (Roman Ruler) in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 10. Given the rest of the year off, the blue-blood resurfaced in Gulfstream's Spectacular Bid S. Jan. 9 and split the field in fourth as the 9-5 favorite. Trying a two-turn route for the first time in his career, Discreetly Mine showed the way early on--ears pricked--from New York maiden winner Tempted to Tapit, and the two raced through an easy half-mile in :48.75 over a track that played kind to speed all day long. Favored Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) raced slightly better than centerfield, while Gill Lecomte S. hero Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) had his work cut out as the deepest closer in the field. Discreetly Mine cut the corner into the stretch, opened a bit of daylight and was always holding Tempted to Tapit to the line. Northern Giant was third at every call and outfinished Drosselmeyer to round out the triple. Ron the Greek's sixth-place effort can be upgraded, given the prevailing track bias.

A 7 1/4-length maiden winner May 23, D' Funnybone finished runner-up to Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil) in the July 11 Frank Gomez Memorial S. before being purchased by these connections. He overpowered the field in the GII Saratoga Special S. by 10 1/2 lengths Aug. 20 and tacked on a 4 3/4-length success in the Sept. 19 GII Futurity S. before the wheels came off on Championship Day. Content to race in the three path as Wildcat Frankie (Wildcat Heir) and Hear Ye Hear Ye (Hear No Evil) scrimmaged up front, D' Funnybone launched a menacing bid on the turn, led into the stretch and was not fully extended to score. Bob Black Jack set a world record in winning the 2008 Sunshine Millions Dash, stopping the clock in 1:06 2/5. Stretched out in an effort to embark the Triple Crown train, the dark bay was third in the GII San Felipe S. and second in the GI Santa Anita Derby before finishing 16th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Off for 7 1/2 months, the Cal-bred resurfaced with a fifth-place effort in that year's GIII V. O. Underwood S., but closed the season with a 2 1/4-length success in the GI Malibu S. He was subsequently found to have a lesion in a tendon and underwent various treatments, sidelining him for eight months. He trained like a champion in recent weeks and was well-backed to pick up where he left off. Fastest in this compact field, Bob Black Jack got his opening quarter mile in :23, a walk for a horse used to going several lengths faster. Confronted by Ventana at the quarter pole, the five-year-old kicked clear and was tiring noticeably late, but found the wire first. "I was quietly confident, but when you haven't run for a year and two months, you've got a built-in excuse right there," said winning trainer Jim Kasparoff. "You can't let him go in :23 and :45 (and :58). She continues to get little respect at the mutuel windows, but for Jody Slew--and her backers--that ignorance has been financially rewarding. A two-time winner last season at sprint distances, the bay filly was a well-beaten third in the Sept. 5 Bassinet S. at River Downs, then checked in 10th of 12 in the Gill Pocahontas S. going Churchill Downs's one-turn mile Nov. 1. Thinking she may just be a turf filly, Jody Slew tried a two-turn route for the first time in her career, and gave a good account of herself, finishing third at odds of 76-1 in the Nov. 28 Caressing H. after a wide trip. The \$10,000 Keeneland September yearling was dismissed as a 23-1 outsider for this track's Tiffany Lass S. Jan. 23, and lingered towards the rear before coming late for a half-length victory from Bella Medaglia (Medaglia d'Oro). Quiet Temper, a disappointing fifth in the Tiffany Lass, took command shortly after the break, while Jody Slew galloped along in her customary trailing position. Favored Devil May Care (Malibu Moon) came to put some pressure on the pace-setter at the quarter pole, but retreated soon thereafter. Quick Temper opened it up a bit inside the final furlong, but Jody Slew kept plugging away in the middle of the track and was up in the final jump despite racing erratically late. And the final nominee is Ashford's Van Nistelrooy, a son of Storm Cat who kicked off with four two-year-old GSW and was fourth on the 2007 Freshman Sire List from his first crop. Though he's only 14th on the 2009 third-crop sire list, his stud fee has been cut in half for 2010, and there was no fluke about that good first-crop two-year-old form. He's also the sire of the very good mare Boundless from his first crop in New Zealand.

Courageous Cat made it three straight wins in Saratoga's GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S., then completed the trifecta as the 4-5 chalk in Belmont's GI Jamaica H. Oct. 10. Overlooked at 22-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, he found only the brilliant filly Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) too tough and settled for second. Sitting a stalking second behind Jet Propulsion through fractions of :23.22 and :45.98, Courageous Cat turned up the heat entering the stretch. Beneath Garrett Gomez, he hit the front after a couple of right-handers in the stretch, and dug down gamely to hold the rallying Cherokee Artist. "We were really excited with him coming back as well as he's been training for the last month, although you are always a little concerned about their first race back," trainer Bill Mott revealed. "The race developed about the way we expected, although I thought there might be another horse to go with the pacesetter. He did get a little tired toward the end, which was to be expected after the layoff, but he was able to go on and win." As for what's next Mott continued, "He's been invited to the mile-and-an-eighth race in Dubai, the [\$5 million, G1] Duty Free [Mar. 27], and we've been looking at going in that direction for some time. If all goes well, that's where he'll go." Gomez added, "He's a three-year-old just turning four, and last year he really started to come into his own; for a comeback race I thought it was impressive."

JOHN'S CALL DIES The popular Grade I winner John's Call (Lord At War {Arg}--Calling Guest {Ire}, by Be My Guest) was euthanized Thursday after sustaining a fractured right foreleg in a paddock accident, according to *Steeplechase Times*. He was 19. The chestnut was at trainer Tom Voss' farm in Monkton, Maryland. Bred in Kentucky by Wimborne Farm, John's Call broke his maiden at Aqueduct in his three-year-old finale, and enjoyed some success over fences at four. Out of action for 23 months with some tendon problems, he worked his way through high-priced claimers and allowance events to earn his first black-type success as an eight-year-old in Delaware

Park's Sussex H., then added the Bald Eagle Breeders' Cup H. and Gill Laurel Turf Cup in succession. He aired by 9 1/4 lengths in the 2000 GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga and, two starts later, annexed the GI Turf Classic Invitational S. at Belmont. Subsequently a close third to Kalanisi (Ire) in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, John's Call returned at 10 to take the Cape Henlopen H., but faded to finish ninth in his Sword Dancer title defense, and was retired after two additional unplaced efforts. His record stood at 40-16-11-3 with earnings of \$1,572,080. Voss kept the gelding as a stable pony, and John's Call led the post parade in a race named in his honor at Saratoga.

It's a tough assignment for a first-time starter to break from the rail going seven furlongs, but Streaker proved up to the task. The Phipps homebred hails from a family steeped in high-class distaffers, and she just might be adding to the trophy case later this year. The winning debut

didn't come as much of a surprise to Hall of Fame trainer Shug McGaughey.

"She had trained well," McGaughey said. "She's quicker than the rest of the family."

He should know. McGaughey has guided the careers of many sharp runners carrying the black and cherry red colors of the Phippses.

Streaker's dam, Matlacha Pass (Seeking the Gold), aired by 8 1/4 lengths in her lone start at two in 1999.

After returning to add an allowance score in June of her three-year-old season, the bay ran second in another allowance, but never faced the starter again. However, she has proven herself as a broodmare. Her first foal, the Storm Cat filly Chili Cat, was stakes-placed at Belmont, and her second was Pine Island (Arch). Second in the GI Mother Goose S. and GI Coaching Club American Oaks, that rangy filly captured the GI Alabama S. and GI Gazelle S. prior to sustaining a fatal injury in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Matlacha Pass is out of Our Country Place (Pleasant Colony), a daughter of MGISW Maplejinsky (Nijinsky II) foaled in 1992. The late Ogden Phipps acquired Our Country Place privately from her breeders, the Sugar Maple Farm of Howard and Susan Kaskel and Deborah Norton, during the time that her half-sister Sky Beauty (Blushing Groom {Fr}) was running roughshod over all of the important races for fillies in New York.

Our Country Place never faced the starter, but has established a burgeoning dynasty. Her first foal was Country Hideaway (Seeking the Gold), a multiple graded stakes winner of \$762,568 who is already the dam of graded winners Boca Grande (A.P. Indy) and Vacation (Dynaformer). Her second foal was Matlacha Pass, and she later produced another Seeking the Gold filly in Pleasant Home, who trumped a solid field by 9 1/4 lengths in the 2005 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Pine Island kicked off her career with a win at Gulfstream, and Streaker will be patiently handled by McGaughey.

"She is faster than the mother and Pine Island," he said. "She's a big, nice-looking filly. She acted good over there, handled the one post and was professional, so I'm pleased."

McGaughey will look for a first-level allowance next.

"I think she'll stretch out," he offered. "I'm not going to do it right now. But, hopefully, when we get to the summer, I hope this is the kind of filly that we'll be running in some of the longer races in New York."

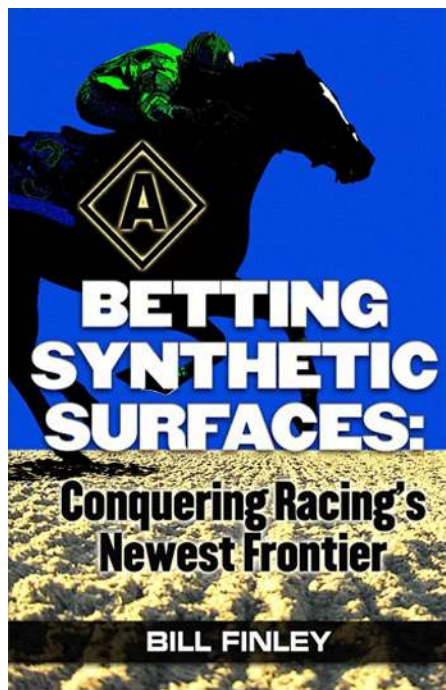

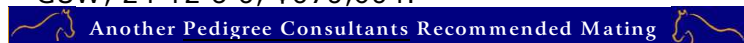

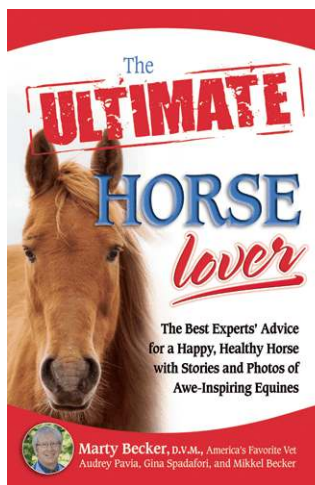
