**BOURBON BAY POURS IT ON IN OBISPO**

Racing under dark clouds which were hovering menacingly over the San Gabriel mountains, **Bourbon Bay** (Sligo Bay {Ire}) came from just off the pace to garner his first career black-type victory in Sunday's GII San

Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita. **Sudden War (Arg)** (Arg) (Sunray Spirit) jumped out to take an early advantage and led the field through opening splits of :49.89, 1:15.14 and 1:41.12, while Bourbon Bay, sent off at

7-2, was content to track the pace in third. With the 5-2 leader in his sights turning for home, the lightly-raced four-year-old strode past his rival around the final bend and drove clear late to score by 4 1/4-widening lengths. **Unusual Suspect** (Unusual Heat), sent off at generous 12-1 odds, closed late to grab the runner-up spot, while Sudden War held on to be third. "I was in a great position going into the first turn," explained winning rider Rafael Bejarano. "When we broke from the gate, they took hold of [Porfido] and sent [Sudden War], so I was able to cover my horse up, and stay nice and relaxed until the half-mile pole. And then I asked him. With the fractions we had, you have to have a lot of horse [to catch the pacesetter], but when you're on the best horse, it makes it easy. My horse has a really good turn of foot in the stretch." At two, Bourbon Bay was in the money in four of five starts, including a runner-up finish in the Miller Lite Cradle S. at River Downs and a third in Hollywood's mile GIII Generous S. at Hollywood. Lightly raced last season, the bay was fourth behind The Pamplemousse (Kafwain) in the GIII Sham S. before being shipped to Canada. Third in a Woodbine allowance in September, the gelding, who according to trainer Neil Drysdale 'had a lot of mucous and allergy problems as a three-year-old,' failed to handle a yielding turf course and had to settle for 10th going nine panels at that oval in October. Sent back to his California base for his next start, the \$1,700 KEESep yearling was an improved fourth while trying 10 panels at Hollywood in December. Most recently, Bourbon Bay responded to the added yardage when winning over course and trip Jan. 6. "When we purchased him [fall, 2008], we purchased him with the idea that he'd be a mile and a half horse, so he's lived up to it to date," said winning trainer Neil Drysdale. "He won well the other day, so it's good. It looks like he's improving."

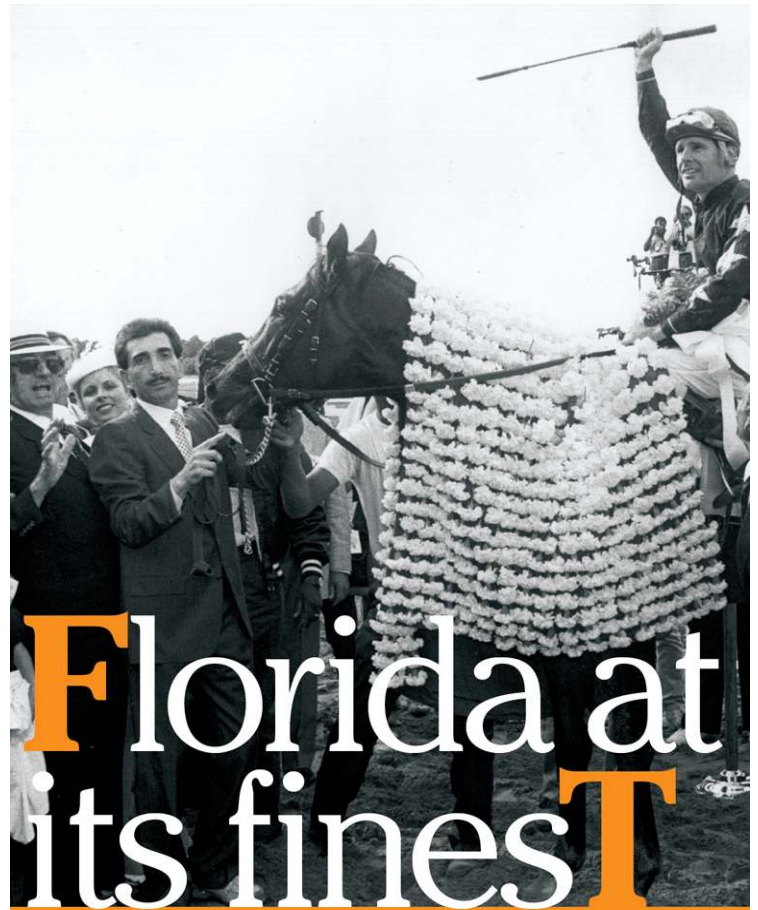

G1 Japan Cup Dirt winner Kane Hekili (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) in Funabashi's Kashiwa Kinen May 5, and routed his opponents with a four-length score in the Championship Nambu Hai at Morioka Oct. 12. He capped his 2009 cam-

paign with a 3 1/2-length triumph in the G1 Japan Cup Dirt at Hanshin Dec. 6, and was subsequently awarded champion dirt horse honors for 2009. Looking to open his five-year-old campaign by gaining his fifth-consecutive triumph here, the chestnut intently tracked the pacesetter in second early before he claimed the lead with 400 meters left. Kept under wraps, he kicked clear of his rivals to post a facile success, while Testa Matta gave game chase to get up for second. The G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Mar. 27 is a possible target for Espoir City, according to trainer Tetsuzo Sato.

"We'll give him a few days and then take him back to the track and see how he is from there." Sent off the 9-5 choice in the Gulfstream feature, the winner of last season's GII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. ran into traffic in the opening quarter mile of the nine-furlong event and was never able

to overcome the setback. "He [jockey Jose] Lezcano said we got shut off going into the first turn, so we really had a rough trip and had trouble making up the ground," said Levine. "It's a tough track to make up ground on, so we'll just have to throw the race out and start again." As for where the colt might start next, Levine added, "I won't make up my mind for a week or two to see how he's doing before deciding where he goes next."

Starfish Bay, a debut winner over this course last Valentine's Day, set the five-furlong course mark of :54 3/5 at Monmouth Park while taking a July 8 allowance and won the From New York to Old York S. at Saratoga last August. The Gainesway homebred had been sidelined since a third-place effort in a Keeneland allowance last October. The speedy filly stepped right out to the early lead and blazed through fractions of

:21.05 and :42.59 and held sway late to complete the five furlongs in a course record :53.75. "She was the fastest horse in the race, so she was supposed to be on the lead, and she did everything so easy," explained jockey Chris DeCarlo. "She's just naturally fast, and she likes to hear her feet rattle over a firm turf course. And this turf is really firm right now; they've been running very fast times over this course." Trainer Todd Pletcher added, "She's always been a very fast filly. She came out of her last race with a lung infection that took a while to clear up, but she's come back and trained well. It took us a while finding her specialty, which is sprinting on grass. That's what she'll be doing in the future."

Trappe Shot, who sold for a sales record \$850,000 at last year's FTTMAY auction, stumbled at the start and checked in fifth in his July 29 bow at Saratoga, but had not been out since. Favored at 3-5 in his return, the chestnut colt was three wide while attending the pace through fractions of :22.44, :45.42 and :57.42. He took command in upper stretch and strode clear without being asked to win by 10 1/4 lengths. Smoking the Field (Freefourinternet) was second and Monte (D'Wildcat) was third. 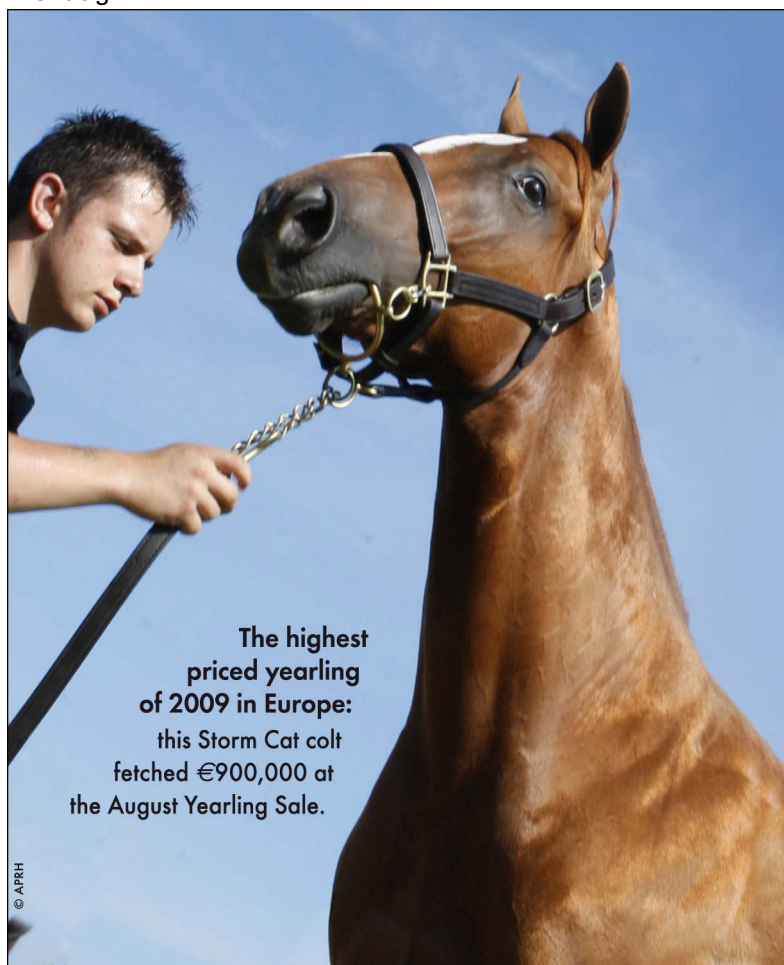

the twin Secretariat conquerors Prove Out and Onion. The strapping chestnut colt sold out of the Hobeau dispersal at Fasig-Tipton May last year just two months after Dreyfus passed away, and showed yesterday he has the potential to live up to his lineage. He is a half-brother

to Miss Shop (Deputy Minister), a homebred who carried the Hobeau Farm colors to victory in the GI Personal Ensign S. in August of 2007 and won two other graded races while banking over \$1.1 million for trainer Allen Jerkens. Trappe Shot is also a half to SW & GSP Bought in Dixie (Dixieland Band), SW Shop Again (Wild Again) and GSP Bulling (Holy Bull). **Cont. p3**

Trappe Shot was offered by Cary Frommer at the Fasig-Tipton sale after breezing and eighth in a co-bullet :10 1/5. The final hammer price of \$850,000 was the highest price ever paid for a Midlantic juvenile, surpassing Zounds (Johannesburg), who made \$625,000 in 2006. Bloodstock agent Steve W. Young signed the ticket for the youngster, who then went straight to trainer Kiaran McLaughlin's barn.

"We got him right out of the sale," confirmed McLaughlin, who added the colt didn't really get a chance to get off on the right foot. "He was unfortunate in his first run. He stumbled out of there and had a rough trip, and so we decided to give him a little break, and the owners were kind enough to give him a little time at Vinery at Ocala. [Vinery manager] Ian Brennan did a great job with him getting him ready, and we got him back on the first of January, or thereabouts."

McLaughlin was impressed with his charge's effort yesterday.

"He's been training very well, and he did everything right today," he said. "It was a great spot to get him started back. I thought that he was maybe going to need a race, but he overcame being a work or two short. He's a really nice horse, and we're happy that he came back and showed us what we thought he's been all along."

By looks and by pedigree, it appears that Trappe Shot will appreciate two turns, though McLaughlin noted that you never really know until you run them over a distance of ground.

"It's hard to say that he's a two-turn horse that is just that talented [to win going six furlongs], but he is very talented and should get two turns, being by Tapit," said McLaughlin. "We'll probably look to go a little farther with him next time, we're just not sure where or when."

Asked if the colt would try stakes company next time or instead go into an allowance, McLaughlin replied, "That's a good question. It's a little bit early to tell, but he's definitely a stakes horse, and we'll probably look for a little stakes somewhere."

Last year, McLaughlin found himself running out of time to get Charitable Man (Lemon Drop Kid) to the Triple Crown races--the Grade II-winning juvenile missed the first two legs before finishing fourth in the GI Belmont S.--and could be in a similar position with Trappe Shot this term. McLaughlin said it was just too early to tell if the colt would make any of the Triple Crown races.
