Triple Threats

“NEIGHBOR” BREEZES FOR SHAM

Amerman Racing homebred **Nextdoorneighbor** (Lido Palace {Chi}), tabbed a **“TDN Rising Star”** after an impressive maiden victory at Santa Anita Jan. 24, breezed four panels at Santa Anita yesterday in :47 3/5. It was the fourth fastest of 33 works at the distance. Nextdoorneighbor is readying for Saturday’s GIII Sham S. “He looked awesome working today--he just keeps getting stronger,” said bloodstock agent Bob Feld, an advisor to John and Jerry Amerman who was on hand to watch the work. Feld bought the colt’s dam, GSW Fencelineneighbor (Wild Rush) privately for the Amermans. Second and then fourth in sprints in his first two starts, Nextdoorneighbor won by four lengths when stretched to two turns in his latest. He has posted three works in the interim, including a sharp six-furlong drill in 1:10 3/5 Feb. 15. “He has the look of a Derby horse,” Feld added. “You see him and you say, ‘Man, he’s a good-lookin’ son of a gun.’ But Saturday will be the test. I think he’s got the ability; I think he has the talent, the stride and the look, but you have to have a lot of class at that level. He’ll answer a lot of questions Saturday.” Nextdoorneighbor is trained by Mike Machowsky, who saddled Caracortado (Cat Dreams) to victory in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Feb. 13. -L.M.

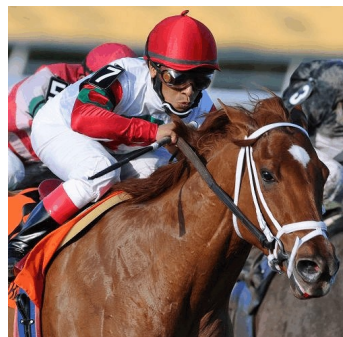

FLORIDA SOPHOMORES LOOK AHEAD

Eskendereya (Giant’s Causeway), runaway winner of the nine-furlong GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Saturday, will likely make another start over that course and distance in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 20, *Daily Racing Form* reports. “He is two-for-two [at Gulfstream],” trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. “The luxury we have is that if we need more time, there are other races a week or two later, like the [GI] Wood Memorial at Aqueduct on Apr. 3.” Eskendereya could meet stablemate **Rule** (Roman Ruler), victor of the GIII Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay Downs Feb. 13, in the Florida Derby. Saturday’s GII Hutcheson S. winner **D’ Funnybone** (D’wildcat) will stretch out in the Florida Derby, while Fountain of Youth runner-up **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil) will return in Wood Memorial, according to *DRF*. “[Jackson Bend is] too small and ran too hard to come back off two races like that in four weeks,” trainer Nick Zito told *DRF*. “He needs another two weeks, so that makes the Wood the logical spot.” **Buddy’s Saint** (Saint Liam), a troubled ninth in the Fountain of Youth, will return in either the Florida Derby or the Wood Memorial, the publication reported.

Discreetly Mine (Mineshaft) and **Tempted To Tapit** (Tapit), who ran one-two all the way around the course in Saturday's GII Risen Star S. at the Fair Grounds,

could face each other again in the GII Louisiana Derby back at that venue Mar. 27. "It's five weeks to the Louisiana Derby and then five weeks to the [GI Kentucky] Derby, and he showed he likes that track," trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing*

Form of his plans for Risen Star winner Discreetly Mine. Tempted to Tapit could also return to the Big Easy for the Louisiana Derby, but owner Gainesway Farm will also look at other options, according to the Fair Grounds stable notes. "We're going to give him about a month or so, and then see what might be the best spot for him," said Gainesway Vice President Charlie Aker, who added, "We're shipping him back to Gulfstream Park [Monday], and we'll see what shapes up as the best race for him to make his next start. I do know it will be at least four weeks before he makes his next start." Trained by Steve Klesaris, the gray entered the Risen Star off an 11 1/2-length maiden victory at Aqueduct Jan. 18 in his fourth start.



RACING Round-Up

'CAP MAY FIT FOR LOUP BRETON European import **Loup Breton (Ire)** (Anabaa) may give Santa Anita's Pro-Ride main track a try in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 6, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The Wildenstein Stable colorbearer has won two of three starts in North America, including the GII San Marcos S. over the Santa Anita turf course Jan. 24 last time. "He worked unbelievably [Sunday morning]," trainer Juilo Canani told *DRF* after the bay covered five furlongs on the main track in :59 4/5. Before coming to the United States, Loup Breton won a pair of graded stakes in France and was second in the 2009 G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp.

Dancing in Silks Unlikely for Golden Shaneen...

Dancing in Silks (Black Minnaloushe), upset winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, is unlikely for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 27 after finishing fifth in Saturday's GII San Carlos H., according to *Daily Racing Form*. "I don't think we'll go, but I need to talk to the owner [Ken Kinakin]," trainer Carla Gaines told the trade daily. "He was very quiet before the race. Usually, his typical behavior in the paddock is bouncing and showing off. He was sound, ate up and his temperature is good. Maybe the Breeders' Cup took a lot out of him? I don't know."

The word "stakes" refers to non-black-type stakes, which do not appear
 in the catalogue page. They are:

*Races in which the prize money offered is made up at least in part of
 money put up by the owners of the horses entered, but which offers a
 purse of less than \$50,000; or excludes horses from black-type money
 levels due to eligibility requirements.

Graded/Group Stakes

There are 16 countries in the world where the racing is of a quality
 such that that country is allowed to determine its own Graded or Group
 stakes races, and they are accepted automatically as such in the
 catalogue. Know that if it has a Grade on it in the *TDN*, it's a real Grade.

No doubt bearing in mind the maxim "like father, like son," breeders naturally tend to assume that what worked well for a famous stallion will, hopefully, work equally well for his stallion sons.

Unfortunately, this assumption ignores the fact that the stallion sons have inherited 50-percent extra bloodlines from their dams, so we most definitely are not comparing like to like.

I touched on this topic four years ago in a British magazine. One example I cited involved Sadler's Wells and daughters of Riverman. To update the figures, the matings between Sadler's Wells and Riverman mares produced an impressive 16-percent stakes winners, including the Arc-winning Carnegie. However, it has been a very different story regarding sons of Sadler's Wells with daughters of Riverman. There are 95 such foals of racing age, by a total of 32 sons, but only one has so far attained stakes-winner status (that stakes success being a dead-heat in a listed race).

I also mentioned Sadler's Wells's tremendous record with daughters of Alleged, with three Group 1 winners among his eight stakes winners from the 40 foals bred to this cross. At the time of my original article, sons of Sadler's Wells had sired only one stakes winner from daughters of Alleged. Although that has now improved a little, their percentage falls a long way short of Sadler's Wells's 20 percent.

I said at the time that some would simply interpret this to mean that Sadler's Wells is a far better sire than many of his stallion sons, but Galileo, Montjeu, El Prado, Baratheia and In the Wings all have at least one foal out of daughters of Riverman and Alleged.

After issuing this warning, I quickly added that breeders mustn't be too hasty in their interpretation of the statistics. **Caulfield cont. p5**

“Nashwan had more than 30 foals of racing age out of Nureyev mares at the end of 2002, but only two of them (an ordinary six percent) had become stakes winners,” I wrote. “As neither had won at Group 1 level, it seemed fair to assume that this nick wasn’t fulfilling breeders’ very high expectations of this blue-blooded match-up. Then, a year later, Bago recorded the first of his five Group 1 victories to justify the extensive experimentation with this cross.”

All of which brings us neatly to the topic of Storm Cat and Seattle Slew. Sending daughters of the 1977 Triple Crown winner to Storm Cat proved a very reliable route to producing very talented performers. Thanks to the likes of Raging Fever, Statue of Liberty, Stormin Fever, China Storm and Stormy Atlantic, this cross achieved a stakes-winner figure of 20 percent, from 35 foals.

Success on this scale was guaranteed to persuade breeders that sons of the Overbrook superstar were an obvious choice for their Seattle Slew mares. I believe there are 143 foals of racing age by 32 different sons of Storm Cat, yet only one of them--the Grade III winner Atlantic Ocean--had managed to win at graded or group level prior to Saturday's Fountain of Youth S. (and she might have been an exception to the rule because of her 3x2 inbreeding to Seattle Slew).

But--just like Bago--Eskendereya showed with his wide-margin Grade II victory at Gulfstream that he could quickly make amends for the shortcomings of so many of the Seattle Slew mares' previous runners by Storm Cat's sons.

Giant's Causeway is responsible for 25 of the foals out of Seattle Slew mares and they also include Flying Spur, a good second to Rachel Alexandra in the GII Fair Ground Oaks; and Joffe's Run, a minor stakes winner, plus talented recent performers in General Consensus, Becausewecan and Tinaar. The Ashford champion also has several good winners with second dams by Seattle Slew, including the Grade I winner Frost Giant, the Grade I-placed Jade Queen and the Japanese Group 2 winner Suzuka Causeway.

Forty-three yearlings by Giant's Causeway made it into Book 1 of Keeneland's 2008 September Sale, but Eskendereya wasn't one of them, even though his dam Aldebaran Light had already been represented by Balmont, one of the leading British two-year-olds of 2003. His price of \$250,000 fell \$50,000 short of Giant's Causeway's fee, which had peaked at \$300,000 in the year of his conception. That high was prompted by Giant's Causeway's exceptional success with his first two crops, with Shamardal, Footstepsinthesand, Maids Causeway, Aragorn and My Typhoon heading the first crop and First Samurai and Diamond Omi the second.

Needless to say, expectations are very high for Giant's Causeway's 2007 crop. So far it has produced several good winners outside the U.S., including Eightfold Path, a royally bred colt who won the G3 Prix Eclipse at two; Eishin Apollon, who was rated the second-best two-year-old in Japan; Saying, a listed winner in France; and Viscount Nelson, a good second at Group 2 level in England. In addition to Eskendereya, the American contingent features Connemara, who improved his record to three wins from four starts when he took the GIII El Camino Real Derby, Northern Giant, a creditable third in the GII Risen Star S., and Christine Daae, a **TDN Rising Star**. Given the tendency for Giant's Causeway's progeny to improve with age, there's good reason to expect that this crop will continue to thrive.

Of course, Giant's Causeway's fee for 2010 stands no higher than \$100,000, even though he ended 2009 as North America's leading sire. Thanks to Shamardal and Footstepsinthesand, he is already shaping up as a promising sire of sires, so watch out for First Samurai's first runners later this year. Also keep an eye on his broodmare daughters, as Jewel of the Night, a lightly raced filly from his first crop, has already produced the Grade I performer Evening Jewel.

Eskendereya's Fountain of Youth performance confirmed that a mile and a quarter will hold no fears for him, and his first two dams are by those Triple Crown stalwarts Seattle Slew and Alydar. His third dam Stellar Odyssey had Kentucky Derby winners as her sire and half-brother, as she was by the 1964 winner Northern Dancer out of Queen Sucree, dam of the 1974 winner Cannonade. Stellar Odyssey was also a half-sister to Kennelot, dam of the 1985 Kentucky Derby runner-up Stephan's Odyssey, so there can be no questioning the classic quality of Eskendereya's bloodlines.

Steckroth in Feb. 17 letter that it no longer plans to proceed with those efforts. In the letter, Fifth Third said it still might oppose Zayat's use of cash collateral to keep the stable running. The bank has until Mar. 1 to file an objection, according to the *Herald-Leader*.
