## ESKENDEREYA BUOYS ZAYAT STABLES

Ahmed Zayat's Zayat Stables is going through Chapter 11 bankruptcy reorganization, but the operation enjoyed a banner day last Saturday when **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) bounded away with the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park ([video](#)) and vaulted himself to the top of many people's Kentucky Derby watch list. Zayat admitted yesterday that the regally bred colt's 8 1/2-length victory in the nine-furlong event was extra special.

"To be quite honest with you, I was totally frozen," Zayat admitted. "That's unlike me. I'm a very emotional person, but I was frozen. We've been going through a lot lately, as you know, and I was just looking at the sky holding back the tears.


My wife Joanne and our kids were surrounding me and looking at me and I wasn't even moving. And they were saying, 'Are you ok?' and 'Why is daddy not reacting?' Usually I am rooting and we are all high-fiving. But Saturday I was just holding back tears and wondering where this performance came from. I read a quote that said, 'There is nothing like a fast Derby horse to get you out of Chapter 11 reorganization.'"

Zayat Stables purchased Eskendereya, the Arabic name for the Egyptian city of Alexandria, for \$250,000 as a 2008 Keeneland September yearling. Second over the Saratoga lawn in his debut last September, the chestnut graduated by 7 1/4 lengths in the off-the-turf Pilgrim S. at Belmont in October, and he concluded his juvenile campaign with a ninth-place effort in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He is now two-for-two as a sophomore after beginning the season with a Gulfstream allowance victory Jan. 7.

Zayat said Eskendereya has matured considerably, and he was expecting a big effort in

the Fountain of Youth.

"It is very significant how they change from their two-year-old to three-year-old years," Zayat explained. "You want them to start filling up, growing, acting mature and focused. We were very encouraged because he was doing exactly all the right things that you wanted to see from a colt who had been promising as a two-year-old turning three. In terms of appearance, demeanor, the way that he had been training, everything was right and [trainer] Todd [Pletcher] was high on [him]."

Despite his optimism, Zayat said he was still surprised by how easily Eskendereya won.

"Everything was on all-systems go," he said. "He looked ready, but you still don't expect somebody, in a field that is probably the deepest prep from the five that day, to win that way and, with the sheer movement of how he galloped out and the time he ran, everything was breathtaking for me. I expected he could run first, second or third, and I was looking for a good, forward performance, but I didn't expect him to do what he did. For me, it was incredible."

Eskendereya's authoritative victory may leave his rivals hoping the colt is peaking too soon for the first Saturday in May, but Zayat thinks the Fountain of Youth didn't take too much out of his colorbearer.

"When Eskendereya galloped out, he galloped very, very strongly," Zayat said. "When John Velazquez got back to the winner's circle, he said to Todd, 'This sucker would not stop.' And I was looking at him; there was almost no sweat on him and he was breathing normal. It was like the race was nothing for him. It looks like it didn't take a lot out of him and I think he has a lot left in the tank. So I don't think this race was particularly taxing on him."

“It’s scary for me, to be honest with you,” he said. “From now to Derby Day will be an eternity for me. I try to be grounded. I realize that this horse is royally bred and he’ll cherish even more distance-- he’ll love 1 1/4 miles, even 1 1/2 miles, and he doesn’t get tired. So ev-

erything is going right for him, but it’s still a little surreal to me.”

A big win in a major Kentucky Derby prep race automatically generates interest in a horse, and Zayat said he has been inundated with offers to buy Eskendereya.

“I have had numerous offers, as you can imagine,” the Egyptian businessman said. “Our phone has not stopped ringing. Everybody has Derby fever and everybody thinks that he is something special. By definition, he’s the fastest three-year-old in the country, based on Beyer, Ragozin or Thoro-Graph. The way he won, the time, and his pedigree--these are all the characteristics that people desire.”

And Zayat is listening.

“Of course, I am entertaining offers,” he said. “This is a business for me. It’s not a hobby. I love horses, I love developing horses, but it’s also a business. Sometimes you have to look into how you can make value of your horses.”

This is not the first time Zayat has been on the Kentucky Derby path. Zayat homebred **Pioneerof the Nile** (Empire Maker) won last year’s GI Santa Anita Derby and was second behind Mine That Bird (Birdstone) in the Kentucky Derby.

“We were very spoiled by Pioneerof the Nile,” Zayat said. “He was our first homebred who became a Grade I winner. So there is always a special feeling with a homebred. It meant a lot. With Eskendereya, we liked him when we bought him as a yearling. The fun part of that is, you have to take a punt on these horses. You hope you made the right bet and you saw something that others didn’t. And now he’s lived up to what we thought he could do. I have had the pleasure of experiencing success with three different ways of picking a horse: first breeding one that ran second in the Derby; then picking Eskendereya as a yearling; and I also bought [multiple Grade I winner] **Zensational** (Unbridled’s Song) as a two-year-old at Fasig-Tipton Calder. I hope I’m not touting myself here, but I’ve experienced three different stars from three different places of equine development. Each one has their own special excitement and pleasure and satisfaction that you get from their success.”

Still, bankruptcy news is never far from the fore. Fifth Third Bank, which filed suit against Zayat Stables, claiming the organization defaulted on loan payments, had been seeking a trustee to oversee the stables, but the bank withdrew that request last week. Zayat said yesterday the bank’s actions were puzzling to him. “I’ve never understood how they’ve been working and what motivates them,” he said. “I have no understanding why they would have done that in the first place, and certainly I have no understanding of why they are doing this now. But I can tell you one thing, they had no shot of winning.”

## RACHEL BREEZES SIX FURLONGS

Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) breezed six furlongs at Fair Grounds in 1:14 yesterday. It was her fifth workout since annexing the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga last September. With regular exercise rider Dominic Terry aboard, the bay rattled off fractions of :13, :25 1/5, :37 3/5, :49 4/5 and 1:02. She galloped out seven furlongs in 1:27. "Dom split off 'the right way' with her, galloped her around the pole and let her work," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "Dom did it to a 'T' and if I wanted something different, I should have asked him." The GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Preakness S. heroine continues to remain on target for the Mar. 13 New Orleans Ladies S.

## MAXIMUS RULER SIDELINED

**Maximus Ruler** (Roman Ruler), second-best in the GIII LeComte S. Jan. 23, will be sidelined until late spring or early summer, according to *Daily Racing Form*. He was withdrawn from last Saturday's GII Risen Star S. with a bruised hoof. "A couple things lit up on the bone scan," trainer Clark Hanna told *DRF*. "There's nothing fractured, nothing chipped off. They just said that if you press on, you could make things worse. Hopefully, he'll be ready for a good summer campaign." The dark bay graduated versus allowance company in his two-year-old finale at Churchill Nov. 28.

## WHIRLWAY REMATCH IN GOTHAM

**Peppi Knows** (Stephen Got Even) and **Afleet Again** (Afleet Alex), first and second in the Whirlaway S. at Aqueduct Feb. 6, will do battle again in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 6. "He's proven he likes the inner track," trainer Robert Reid of the Whirlaway runner-up.

"We'd like a longer race--the further, the better for him--but a shorter field in the Gotham would be to our advantage. He's a big, bulky horse, and once he gets rolling, you don't want to

have him check, or go wide, or anything like that." Also expected for the Gotham are **Awesome Act** (Awesome Again), **Nacho Friend** (Friends Lake), **Tiz Chrome** (Tiznow) and **Wow Wow Wow** (Broken Vow). Nacho Friend, off since finishing a close fourth in the GII Sanford S. July 30, has been working bullets at Palm Meadows for his return. "I think he's a talented colt, but I don't know his total ability," trainer Kelly Breen said of the George and Lori Hall colorbearer. "Each race from now on will be an acid test of his ability. He's my best, but I don't know how he stacks up against the others. I do know we have a fresh, energetic horse that's ready to run."

Tiz Chrome suffered his first career defeat when fourth as the even-money favorite in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita Feb. 13. "He looks good, and he'll go back to the track this week," said trainer Bob Baffert said. "He ran well in the Bob Lewis, but I don't think he likes synthetic. He's better on dirt. He's a speed horse, and we're looking at the Gotham because the inner track helps speed horses." Awesome Act was last seen finishing a close fourth in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Nov. 7; Wow Wow Wow enters off a \$40,000 optional-claiming victory at Oaklawn Feb. 13.



UAE 1000 Guineas winner **Siyaadah** looks to make it two in a row. The bay bested most of her rivals here in that 1600-meter event Feb. 11, and the added ground this time should be within her scope. "We were very pleased with her win, which was a good performance," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "We knew she had improved over the winter and, hopefully, there is more to come from her." Siyaadah broke her maiden at first asking at Redcar last August, but was off the board in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood later that month and in a conditions race at Newmarket in October. Perfect in four starts in her native Chile, **Mensajera de la Luz** was purchased by Prince Sultan Mohammed Saud al Kabeer after taking the G1 Tanteo de Potrancas last June. In her only start for her new connections, she was a lack-luster 12th in the UAE 1000 Guineas.

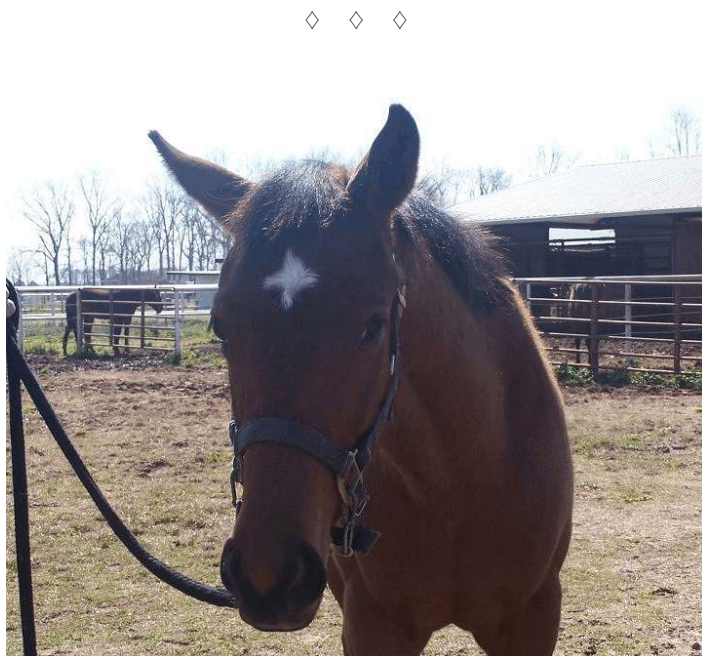

**NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL**



**NEXT FARM BILL MAY BE PASSED EARLY**

The 2008 farm bill is scheduled to remain in place through fiscal year 2012. But House Agriculture Chairman [Collin Peterson](#) (D-MN) recently has floated the idea that the 2012 farm bill might be passed a year early. Typically running 1,000 pages, the farm bill is one of the most important vehicles for legislation affecting agricultural interests - including breeding farms.

Peterson has suggested that the next farm bill be passed as part of reconciliation, a legislative process that limits debate and amendment and is intended to reduce the chance that a contentious budget bill will face a filibuster. Peterson believes that Congress may soon be forced to make many quick and difficult decisions related to the budget deficit and could turn to reconciliation as a way to control spending.

Peterson says he wants to begin holding hearings on the farm bill this year.

The 2008 farm bill included an [accelerated depreciation schedule](#) for young racehorses, lobbied for by NTRA and other industry organizations. The new schedule puts all horses on a three-year depreciation schedule that better reflects the length of a horse's racing career than the previous seven-year schedule.

**CLANGALANG COLT TOPS MM TASMANIAN SALE**

A son of G1 Australian Derby hero Clangalang (Aus) out of SW Genuine Blonde (Aus) (Sandpit {Brz}) brought a final bid of A\$80,000 from Paul Geard to top the Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale Tuesday. Catalogued as [hip 153](#), the colt is a half to SW Radha Rani (Aus) (Delago Brom {Aus}), and was consigned by Armidale Stud, agent. Geard recently captured the G3 Tasmanian Derby with another son of Clangalang, Geegees Blackflash (Aus). His trainer, John Luttrell, will handle Tuesday's sales topper as well. "We've had some good success in recent weeks with progeny by the sire, and this colt was a really nice youngster," Geard said. "He's very athletic and looks as though he will grow into a really nice racehorse. We are hoping he could win a Derby in a couple of years, or even win the Magic Millions [2YO Classic] next year." A dairy farmer based in Hobart, Geard and his wife are the leading owners in Tasmania, with about 24 horses in training. Figures at the Tasmanian sale were up sharply, with the gross of A\$1,490,250 rising 66 percent from last year. The average of A\$14,193 was up 44 percent, and the clearance rate was a solid 70 percent. Magic Millions Managing Director David Chester remarked, "Things were tough early, but the bidding got stronger as the sale went, and the nice horses in the sale certainly had plenty of admirers." Chester added, "For the figures to be up significantly across the board is very pleasing."
