IEAH Stables and Whizway Farms's **Amen Hallelujah** (Montbrook), last seen annexing the GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita Jan. 16, proved she can handle dirt just as well, posting a dominating performance in yesterday's GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream. Assigned the dreaded one hole in the eight-furlong affair, she shadowed 6-5 favorite **Bickersons** (Silver Deputy) from the inside through a half-mile in :47.54, put that foe away in the stretch and opened daylight to win her dirt debut for fun. "I brought her back from California just to run in this race," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. offered. "I've always thought she'd be better on dirt--she trains better on dirt than the synthetic. I really haven't thought about what might be next." Cont. p2

SANTA ANITA CANCELS SATURDAY CARD

Officials at Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, California, were forced to cancel the live racing program Saturday --which included the GIII Sham S. for three-year-olds--in the aftermath of another heavy rainstorm. The field for the Sham will be redrawn and run Saturday, Mar. 6. As has been the case several times this winter, the Pro-Ride surface failed to drain sufficiently to conduct live racing following rains that began Friday evening and continued into Saturday. The cancellation marked the fifth weather-related closure of the current winter/spring meeting. "This is terribly disappointing to everyone involved," said Santa Anita President Ron Charles. "Our main problem continues to be with the way the main track is draining. We've had a very problematic area near the finish line and we were successful in keeping the surface area there dry with the use of tarps, but we have standing water in other areas and it therefore would not be suitable to run on, especially with the prospect of more heavy rain through the afternoon. As we've said many times, in this very difficult situation, safety has to be our number-one priority. As disappointing as it is to our horsemen, fans and employees, we simply cannot jeopardize the well-being of our athletes, be they human or equine." Live racing is expected to resume Sunday.

Amen Hallelujah was campaigned by Whizway Farms and trainer Steve Asmussen last term, but IEAH Stables obtained a controlling interest in the dark bay following a run-away optional claiming score at Arlington Sept. 18. Transferred to Dutrow thereafter, she turned in a strong third-place finish to Negligee (Northern Afleet) and She Be Wild (Offlee Wild) in her two-turn bow in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 9, then resurfaced to place a distant third behind Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 20. She is perfect in two starts since. "It was a good race for her," said jockey Julien Leparoux, the eighth different rider to pilot

Aurora Lights, heroine of last term's GIII Selene S. over the Woodbine Polytrack, reported home a well-beaten 10th in the grassy GIII Pin Oak Valley View S. at Keeneland Oct. 23 and closed out her sophomore campaign with a troubled third-place finish on dirt in the GIII Stage Door Betty H. at Calder Dec. 26. Kicking off the year in this spot, she sat close to the leaders while last of six through a half mile in :48.21. With Cornelio Velasquez aboard, she rallied three wide off the turn for home and reeled in the pacesetter in deep stretch to win going away. From exercise rider for one of the most respected stables in the country to being a respected member of the juvenile pinhooking community, Cary Frommer has

achieved much in the Thoroughbred industry. That was on display when Not for Silver (Not For Love), an \$85,000 FTMMAY Frommer grad from 2008, won the GII Carry Back S. at Calder last Summer. And it was on display when last week when **Trappe Shot** (Tapit)

put up a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ performance in his second outing at Gulfstream. Frommer sold the chestnut on behalf of breeder Hobeau Farm for a sale-record \$850,000 at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Sale, and on Feb. 21, he returned from a lengthy layoff to dust a field of Florida-breds at Gulfstream by 10 1/4 lengths ([video](#)).

"As a two-year-old, he was a real no-brainer," Frommer remembered. "He was part of the Hobeau Farm dispersal, and he's part of their legacy. He was real smart, real attractive and just did everything he had to do the right way."

Frommer said getting the colt to auction was a team effort.

"I only got the horse as it got closer to the sale," said Frommer. "Hobeau's longtime farm manager Craig Wheeler had broken him and the other horses, and then Barry Berkelhammer had handled him before I got him. So he was shuffled around a little bit, but by the time he got to the sale, he was ready for everything."

Speedy veteran **Presious Passion** is looking for his second win in this event. The seven-year-old gelding won last year's GI United Nations S. and GI Clement Hirsch in catch-me-if-you can fashion, and he nearly stole the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, coming up just a half-length short of Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}). Presious Passion, prepping for the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, has been off since tiring to fifth in the Dec. 26 GII W L McKnight H. at Calder. **Winchester**, winner of the 2008 GI Secretariat S., made only four starts last year. He was second in the GII Bowling Green H. and GIII Sycamore S. before ending his abbreviated campaign with a third-place effort in the McKnight. **Expansion** is making his first start since winning the Nov. 7 GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct in his debut for trainer Chad Brown.

Frommer consigns under her own name.

"I think I'm just loaded for bear; I think I have some really nice horses here," Frommer said of her Calder consignment. "I have a Harlan's Holiday colt [hip 44] who looks very special, and I have some really nice fillies.

Obviously I'm a Tapit fan, and I

have two real special Tapit fillies. They're a little different. The one filly out of Purloined [hip 163] is very speedy, quick and has a great temperament. She's a beautiful mover and is just very fast. The filly out of Wild Lucy Black [hip 234] is a big, scopey filly who looks like she wants to go longer. She won't work like a house on fire, but she'll gallop out real good and show people she's a big mover. Both of them have great minds, just like Trappe Shot did. That must be a trait that Tapit puts on his horses, because they're all real smart, intelligent horses."

Intelligent is an adjective that could also be used to describe Frommer herself. She is a straight-talking sort who learned from some of the best in the business, including Hall of Fame trainer Mack Miller.

"I got into racing when I was 20, and was able to work for some real big outfits at the time," Frommer said. "I worked as an exercise rider for Buckland Farm, then moved on and rode for Mack Miller."

Miller trained for Paul Mellon's famed Rokeby Stables. Some of the more famous horses Frommer got on in the mornings were Java Gold, winner of the GI Travers S. and GI Whitney H. in 1987, and MGISW You'd Be Surprised.

"Java Gold was like a pony," Frommer recalled. "He was very quiet, very easy to deal with and low key. He never got frazzled about things. He was a real class horse."

Frommer said the quality around her at Rokeby left an indelible impression.

"At one point, I remember looking down Mr. Miller's shedrow," she said. "There were 30 horses in the barn, and there were three champions that I could see. He always had just such wonderful horses for Mr. Mellon. It was a fun place to work."

For a time, Frommer and her husband Tim, who broke and trained horses for operations like Claiborne Farm, William Haggin Perry and J. Mack Robinson, trained at Fair Hill in Maryland in the summer and wintered in Aiken. But after awhile the transient life began to look less appealing, and they decided to call Aiken home year-round.

"Once we were living in Aiken full-time and there wasn't anyway to race, really, I needed something to keep my mind occupied," explained Frommer. "I'm too goal-oriented to just train horses--I have to have a reason and a finish, so that's where the pinhooking came in."

Frommer will offer roughly a dozen of her own pinhooking prospects this season, and has another 25 or so for clients. She also sells a quintet for Cary Frommer Ventures, a partnership group she launched last year comprising friends and associates.



"I always owned my own horses, but had an occasional friend who was a partner," Frommer said. "With the way things were financially last year, it seemed like a good idea to spread things out a little bit. So we brought in a few people, friends that were involved in horses anyway. Luckily, they are turning out to be some nice horses."

Frommer is quick to share credit with Barry Berkelhammer, the Ocala-based horseman who helps her select and purchase yearling prospects.

"I do a lot of business with Barry, and get the benefit of his shrewd eye when I'm out buying horses," said Frommer.

As for the future, Frommer says she's content keeping things small, consigning for herself and a handful of clients.

"I don't like a lot of different owners," she said. "I'm not very good, I must say, with dealing with owners. I'm much happier dealing with the horses." -LM

He could have gone to the lead, but I told Edgar [Prado] to let the other horse go and be a measuring stick. It certainly showed he likes the dirt." 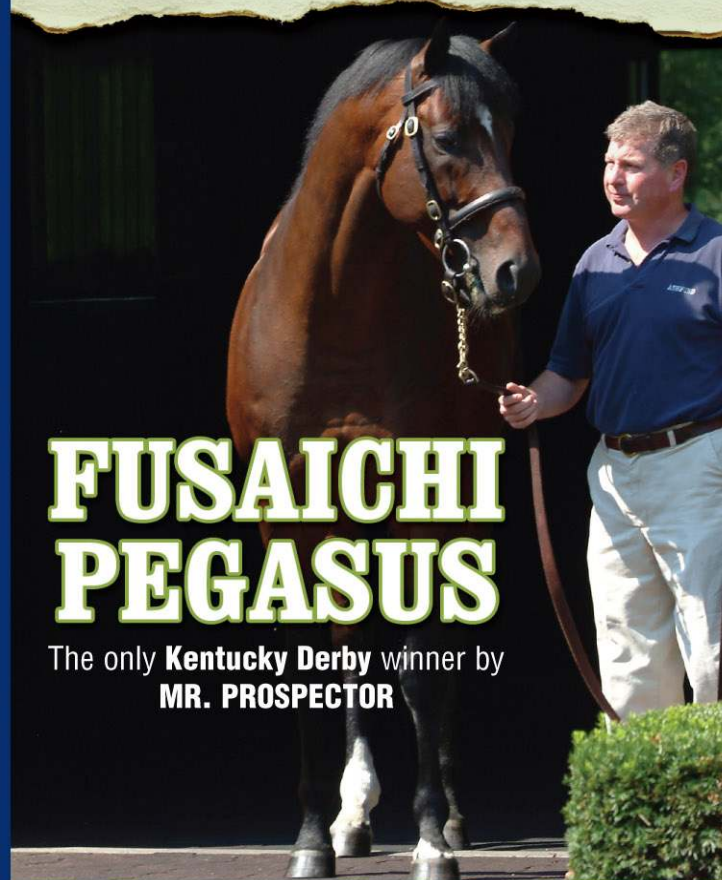
