MORE DISTAFFER DOMINATION IN BIG 'CAP'?

Four members of the fairer sex teamed up to win six Grade I races against males in North America last year, and **St Trinians (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}) will try to keep the trend alive in 2010 in today's GI Santa Anita H., weather permitting. Unbeaten and untested in four

starts since relocating from Great Britain, the bay will try to emulate Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire})'s victory over the Big 'Cap's course and distance in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic four months ago. Formerly an all-weather handicap specialist in her native land, the expatriate romped by four lengths in a Santa

Anita optional claimer in her North American debut last March, then came off the bench to post a seven-length success in a Hollywood Park allowance Dec. 3. She earned her first black-type victory with a 3 3/4-length triumph in the Paseana H. at Santa Anita Jan. 9, and easily accounted for GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic winner Life Is Sweet (Storm Cat) by 1 3/4-lengths in the Gil Santa Maria H. under the San Gabriel Mountains Feb. 13 in her most recent effort. By competing today, St Trinians will avoid a match up with the undefeated two-time champion older female Zenyatta, who has the Mar. 13 GI Santa Margarita H. penciled in for her first start since the Breeders' Cup. Thirteen opponents will try to prevent St Trinians from becoming the first filly or mare to win the Big Cap since the race was inaugurated in 1935, but a full field isn't the only thing that may deny the five-year-old a chance to make history. Santa Anita has lost five race cards this meet after its Pro-Ride main track failed to drain sufficiently, and weather.com gives a 70 percent chance of precipitation in Arcadia tomorrow, with rainfall up to a half-inch. **Cont. p3**

FORMAT CHANGE FOR KEESEP SALE

Keeneland officials announced Friday morning that there will be a new format for the September Sale in 2010. Book 1, which had 418 catalogued over two day sessions in 2009, will now offer a combined 200 hips during evening sessions on Sunday, Sept. 12 and Monday, Sept. 13. An expanded Book 2 will take place over four sessions, Tuesday through Friday, followed by a dark day Saturday. The four Book 2 sessions will also offer fewer horses than in 2009, with about 325 catalogued daily, as opposed to about 400 in 2009. "The new format reflects the changing Thoroughbred industry," Keeneland President and CEO Nick Nicholson said. "We've been working in collaboration with our customers, particularly our consignors, over the last few years to develop a format that fits the current dynamics and needs of our buyers and sellers." Added Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell, "The new format allows us to offer 1,500 yearlings prior to the sale's dark day, which benefits both consignors and buyers. At the same time, we are doing it within a format that allows us to sell fewer yearlings each day." Consignors voiced their support of the plan. "The new format will give the sale some pizzazz the first couple of nights," said Eaton Sales' Reiley McDonald. "It will take some pressure off buyers the first week when there is more selection done in the barn area, and it will level the playing field in book two for both sellers and buyers." **Cont. p2**

Win-Win at Keeneland September...

The format changes for Keeneland September, which had been in the works for three years, were nearly put into place for 2009. "We almost instituted something close to this last year, but felt that because of the realities of 2009, that would not be a good year to introduce a new format," Nick Nicholson said. "The economy was previewing the fact that it was likely to be a rough year anyway, so we didn't want to burden the 2009 crop [of yearlings] with anything additional to that. It also gave us another year to think about it and to ask people and to tweak it even more than we have, and I think it's an improved product."

Nicholson outlined the goals the new format was designed to meet.

"We see a number of benefits to this new format, both to the buyers and the consignors," he explained. "The one that I'm most excited about, probably, is that it will allow us to have more quality product in front of the larger professional buyers before we have our dark day. We also asked, "Can we accomplish having more of the quality yearlings in front of this group of buyers, but do it in a less hurried, less havoc kind of atmosphere?" These are such important decisions, and we want to give people the appropriate time to see every yearling and to think about their decisions."

Keeneland is also trying to generate a social setting early in the sale reminiscent of the more festive atmosphere that surrounded Keeneland July in years past. "We believe that nighttime sessions will add an extra level of excitement," Geoffrey Russell remarked. "A worry of many of our constituents was that maybe September had become way too businesslike, and we were just churning people through here. When people come to Central Kentucky they buy horses, but they do other things, too, and it is very important that our auction here at Keeneland is a part of that Central Kentucky economy, and we want to be a part of that, too. We want to make sure people can come here, enjoy the social aspects of Central Kentucky, and also do their business."

Nicholson added, "I think you'll see more social events from the consignors, and we are going to try and make a real effort to use these wonderful facilities here in a way that provides the kind of social atmosphere--the kind of welcoming atmosphere--that will make this an enjoyable experience. We think that overlays well with selling fewer horses each day. I can promise you this--everyone will be well fed and nobody will leave here thirsty unless it's of their own choosing."

Despite the fact that Keeneland officials are trying to recreate the best of the July Sale in September, Nicholson said, it was "doubtful" there would be a return to that venue in the near future.

"The consignors say that the extra months are so important. These yearlings change more each week during that period of time than any other period of time in their lives," he said. "I think the best attributes of the July Sale can be accomplished with this format."

In addition to the benefits to buyers and consignors, the changes to Keeneland September should also be a boon the sale itself.

"I think the new format allows the sale to be as good as it possibly can be. The marketplace and the economy will determine how good that can be, but the format will present it in the best possible light right now," said Nicholson.

Bill Farish of Lane's End Farm echoed that statement.

"Lane's End could not be more supportive of Keeneland's proposed changes to the September Yearling Sale," Farish said. "Keeneland has worked closely with many consignors in the past few months to alter and improve the format of the sale. The quality and value that are hallmarks of the September Sale will be strengthened even further with the implementation of this exciting new approach."



Big 'Cap cont.

Lightly raced **Neko Bay**, now a seven-year-old, earned his first graded victory when he made an outside rally to win the Jan. 9 GII San Pasqual H. by 1 3/4 lengths the last time he went postward. Also entering the Big 'Cap off a victory in a 1 1/8-mile race at Santa Anita is **Jeranimo**, who split horses to win the Feb. 13 GII Strub S. for four-year-olds by 1 1/4 lengths. **Loup Breton**, second in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp last April, makes his first start on any surface besides turf. The import has won two of three starts in North America, including the GII San Marcos S. Jan. 24 despite receiving a rough trip.

Misremembered, hero of the GII Swaps S. and GII Indiana Derby as a sophomore, has finished second in his last three starts. Runner-up to Jeranimo in the Strub, the ridgling fired a 1:12 1/5 six-furlong bullet over this surface Mar. 1. "I'm trying something different [with Misremembered today]," trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'll put him on the lead." Such tactics would work against front-runner **Mast Track**, who was a close sixth the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 7 after setting the pace. The bay won the 2008 GI Hollywood Gold Cup over today's distance after getting loose on the lead, but would not enjoy such favorable conditions here should he be challenged by Misremembered.

In the 1937 Santa Anita H., jockey Red Pollard's blindness his right eye may have prevented him from seeing Rosement, who rallied on the outside to deny Seabiscuit by a nose in third running of the "Hundred Grandeur." Today, **Blind Luck**, whose sire Pollard's Visions suffers from the same affliction, is heavily favored to win the GI Santa Anita Oaks, one of two Grade I races on the GI Big 'Cap undercard. The chestnut will aim for her third consecutive Grade I win and her fourth victory at the highest level in her career. A runaway winner of the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 20, Blind Luck took the overland route to get up by a nose in the last stride in the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita Feb. 13 last time out. She'll have the benefit of an extra sixteenth of a mile in today's 1 1/16-mile affair.

It was his lone victory over the weeds, but the West Point Thoroughbreds colorbearer was second in the GI Eddie Read H. on the Del Mar spinach July 25. "I think his best races are on the turf," said jockey David Flores. "But he runs good on anything. He always tries. He is an honest horse." **Battle of Hastings**, hero of the GII Colonial Turf Cup in June and GII Virginia Derby in July, looks to regain the winning thread after finishing second in three of his last four starts, including the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 29 most recently. **Fluke** and 2008 Kilroe winner **Ever a Friend**--first and second, respectively, in the GI Citation H. Nov. 27--renew their rivalry here.

Nextdoorneighbor earned **"TDN Rising Star"** status after graduating by four lengths at Santa Anita Jan. 24 in his first start over a route of ground, and jumps into graded competition here in his first start against winners. The homebred was assigned post 10 when this race was originally scheduled to be contested a week ago, and finds himself toward the outside once again. Perhaps no horse benefitted more from the postponement of this race than **Kettle River**, who was able to squeeze in one more workout Mar. 1. The Darley Stable representative missed a workout in February after getting sick, but was able to play catch up with a five-furlong drill Monday. He enters this spot on a two-race winning streak after breaking his maiden by 1 1/2-lengths at Hollywood Park Nov. 15 and posting a 3/4-length allowance score Jan. 6, with **The Program**, who returned to win a similar race by a nose Feb. 3, not far back in third. ASPCA ANNOUNCES MILLION DOLLAR RESCUING RACEHORSES INITIATIVE

The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals has announced the Million Dollar Rescuing Racers Initiative--made possible by a generous donor--that will aid in the rescue of retired racehorses from neglect, abuse and slaughter. Six equine rescues and sanctuaries across the country were selected to take up the challenge of redoubling their efforts to save Thoroughbreds. The six grant recipients are: California Equine Retirement Foundation in Winchester, CA; Old Friends in Georgetown, KY; MidAtlantic Horse Rescue in Chesapeake City, MD; Kentucky Equine Humane Center in Lexington, KY; Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation (headquartered in Saratoga Springs, NY, with contracted housing in 14 states); and Communication Alliance to Network Thoroughbred Ex-Racehorses (CANTER) in East Lansing, MI (with chapters in eight states). Said ASPCA President and CEO Ed Sayres, "Too often, [Thoroughbreds] end up at auctions, or worse, are sent to slaughterhouses where their lives come to a brutal end. These grants will enable organizations devoted to equine rescue the ability to save more horses and further advance their mission." The selected recipients cover a wide range of Thoroughbred rescues, and the grant funding--ranging from \$100,000 to \$350,000--will be distributed over the next two-to-three years to help each of the groups increase capacity and rescue more horses. The oldest and largest of the rescue groups, the TRF, was awarded the largest grant--\$175,000 in 2010, with another \$175,000 earmarked for 2011. "We are grateful that someone outside of the racing industry has put a focus on the needs of ex-racehorses with such a substantial gift," said TRF Executive Director Diana Pikulski. "We would like to now call upon those inside the sport to match this grant to ensure the donor's wish that more Thoroughbred racehorses are able to live out their lives in comfort, peace and dignity."

CHRB ENDS ZAYAT INVESTIGATION The California Horse Racing Board has decided not to continue its investigation into Thoroughbred owner Ahmed Zayat's relationship with Michael and Jeffrey Jelinsky, a pair of brothers who last May pleaded guilty to charges of conducting an illegal bookmaking operation. Zayat loaned \$155,000 to Michael (Jelinsky) and \$450,000 to Jeffrey (Jelinsky), according to the *New York Times*. The CHRB, like racing commissions in other states, has a rule that prohibits licensees from associating with convicted felons or known bookmakers, but found during a preliminary inquiry that the loans did not violate its rule. "Our chief of investigations has gone over all the court documents and, based on what we can find, Mr. Zayat made the loans, according to the *New York Times* article, long before these two individuals were convicted of a crime," CHRB Executive Director Kirk Breed said in an e-mailed statement. "Therefore, we can't see any reason to pull the license of Mr. Zayat. As more information becomes available, we will certainly look into it."
