★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Crisp** (El Corredor), prominent from the start with blinkers added, battled her way to victory in the GI Santa Anita Oaks as 1-2 **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) couldn't quite overcome the slow early pace, finishing third. "I hope to go to the Kentucky Oaks with her," said winning trainer John Sadler. "She's got good stamina and can run a big distance." **Cont. p3**

'ACT' AWESOME IN GOTHAM

Making his first start on dirt, **Awesome Act** (Awesome Again) swooped up turning for home in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct and crossed the line safely in front as the 5-2 favorite. The chestnut will remain in the U.S. to prepare for the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 3. "I believed in this horse today," said winning trainer Jeremy Nosedo. Misremembered paired up wins at Hollywood last spring before finishing second to Grazen (Benchmark) in the Gill Affirmed H. June 20. He turned the tables on that rival with a front-running score in the Gill Swaps S. July 18, but wasn't quite ready for the big boys next out in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Sept. 6, fading to 10th after being a pace factor early. Breeder and trainer Bob Baffert shipped to the chestnut to Hoosier Downs and he responded with a track-record-setting performance in the Gill Indiana Derby Oct. 3. Second by a neck to Blame (Arch) in the Gill Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 27, he came home to settle for the runner-up spot in the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26, and was upended once more at 3-5 in the Gill Strub S. over this surface Feb. 13. Victor Espinoza had been in the irons since Misremembered's maiden win, but Baffert gave the call this time to Martin Garcia.

"Last time, I was so disappointed," Baffert reflected. "I've got a great staff. When I was gone to the Olympics, they worked him here, and Martin has been part of the camp. He's had a lot to do with it. He worked him for me the other day. I've been winning with this kid...Our numbers are really huge [14 for 51, 27.4 percent]. He just got him out there, and I think we just needed to let him run."

After an alert start, the four-year-old conceded the lead to Mast Track (Mizzen Mast), cruising along in second as that veteran led through fractions of :47.06 and 1:10.81, with favorites St Trinians and Loup Breton (Ire) (Anabaa) bumping one another while well behind in the early stages.

Misremembered reeled the pacesetter in on the far turn and entered the stretch in front. Neko Bay came flying up the rail to make it interesting, but Misremembered dug in with the wire fast approaching to give Baffert his second Big 'Cap win, following General Challenge's score in 2000. Baffert's wife Jill

co-owns Misremembered with George and Lynn Jacobs.

St Trinians wound up sixth while trying to become the first distaffer to take this historic contest. "She had a tough time, but I give her credit," said rider Joel Rosario. "The other horses were coming in on her. She was never comfortable in there. She was between horses much of the time and we got too far back. She moved a little bit after that, but it was just too much to make up."

Second-choice Loup Breton wound up 11th. "[St Trinians] kept bumping me around the first turn," reported jockey Garrett Gomez. "We made a little run going into the far turn and I was done. He was wanting to get out. I could feel that he wasn't traveling the way he normally travels. By the time we started to make a run, he was like Jell-O under me."

"She was more focused today and she was into the bridle." The odds-on chalk, last after a half in :49.78, couldn't get through on the inside and came flying when a seam opened up, but the wire came too soon. Rider Rafael Bejarano said, "I was in a good position, but when we came into the stretch, my hole closed." Juddmonte's Ventura (Chester House) was nailed at the wire by Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in last year's Kilroe, but Proviso was the one snatching victory from the jaws of defeat this time to earn her first Grade I trophy. A Group 3 winner for Andre Fabre in France, the bay switched to synthetic and crossed the line first in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 11, but was disqualified and placed second. She ran fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 6, and most recently finished second in the seven-furlong GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 31, her first start for trainer Bill Mott. Back on grass here, the homebred bided her time in eighth as one-time stablemate Fluke did the honors up front. The Brazilian looked to have it won at the stretch call, but Proviso cut into his advantage with every stride and got the bob. "I thought I won it and I pumped my fist just to sell it [to the placing judges]," said winning rider Mike Smith. Alpie's Bet made up ground to finish fourth in each of his first two appearances, both sprints, on Hollywood's Cushion Track Nov. 18 and Dec. 5. Trainer Alexis Barba opted to stretch him out in the California Breeders' Champion S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26, and the robust colt came on late to get second to Caracortado, who would go on to take the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Alpie's Bet had blinkers added for a turf maiden here Jan. 15 and, after getting roughed up at the start, finally had his picture taken ([video](#)). With two bullet drills in the interim, he returned to the main track for this contest. Jockey Alex Solis had his mount well-placed in sixth as Nextdoorneighbor (Lido Palace {Chi}) cut out splits of :47.61 and 1:12.22, and the pair edged closer on the second turn. The Cal-bred entered the lane four wide under a full head of steam and kicked away smartly in the final sixteenth to deny favored Setsuko. "He's so big, he's so heavy, when he comes out of the gate, it takes him a while to get into stride," Solis explained. "The way he ran today didn't surprise me at all. The first time I rode him [Dec. 26], I came back and told Alexis I think he can run all day. Alexis used to work for [the late] Eddie Gregson, and they had a horse back then named Candi's Gold. I told her this horse reminds me a lot of him; he's big, strong and he'll run any distance. To be honest, I try not to think too far ahead. I just pray to God he stays healthy." Runner-up to ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ Al Zir (Medaglia d'Oro) in his Aug. 7 career bow at Newmarket, Awesome Act missed by a head over the same course a fortnight later, then ran third in an all-weather maiden at Kempton Sept. 5. After graduating at Goodwood Oct. 1, he could only manage ninth in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 17, but was nevertheless sent to Santa Anita for the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Nov. 7. The chestnut had a wide trip en route to finishing a bang-up fourth at 31-1, and his connections began to plot out a course to get them to the first Saturday in May. The curtain was late going up on Act 1 when New York's weather woes delayed the colt's arrival in the Gotham, but he nevertheless hit his lines perfectly. Jockey Julien Leparoux, in town for the ride, allowed the favorite to settle into stride near the back of the pack, while third-choice Wow Wow Wow (Broken Vow) showed the way from Peppi Knows (Stephen Got Even) through a :46.60 opening half. Awesome Act weaved his way through traffic on the far turn before shifting out to enter the stretch four

wide. Given his cue by Leparoux, the British invader kicked away smartly in midstretch to come home a popular winner. Winning trainer Jeremy Noseda conditioned another son of Awesome Again, Wilko, to surprise the field in the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and was confident his charge could handle this assignment.

"You would think a horse by Awesome Again would handle the dirt," Noseda offered. "For the first time, it's all we could ask for. He's a horse that is reminding me all the time of Wilko." The conditioner added, "We had the discussion about him possibly being a Derby horse after the Breeders' Cup. I stood up and said, 'I believe I can do it from Europe.' Now he's been in America, and we can move forward. I will be going back to Newmarket; maybe I'll come in for a day and watch him train. He'll stay at Belmont Park, in Steve Asmussen's barn with my team, and get ready for the Wood." Awesome Act's dam, an allowance winner for the Niarchos family, sold for \$900,000 at KEENOV in 2007 and produced a Johannesburg colt the following April. 

The four-year-old, a A\$1.2-million Inglis Easter yearling purchase, captured the G2 VRC Sires' Produce S. and was runner-up in the G1 Golden Slipper S. His stud fee has not yet been set.

Nakatani Gets Rebel Ride on Dublin...

Grade I winner **Dublin** (Afleet Alex), a late-charging second under Terry Thompson last out at Oaklawn in the GIII Southwest S. Feb. 20, will be ridden by Corey Nakatani in the GII Rebel S. Mar. 13, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "[Owners] Bill Mack and Robert Baker are very, very knowledgeable, very, very involved, and, as owners, they just felt that we maybe should have more experience in the big arena," trainer D. Wayne Lukas told *DRF*. "No reflection on Terry at all, because Terry did a beautiful job working with this horse this spring. But they just thought we might need somebody that has been in more than one Breeders' Cup or [Kentucky] Derby, and had a little more experience going for them. Nakatani's riding very well right now. He's available. He wanted to ride the horse. And he's here at Oaklawn, so he was a logical choice." Previously based in California, Nakatani currently heads the jockey standings at the Hot Springs oval.

Game On Dude to Florida Derby...

Game On Dude (Awesome Again), with just a Feb. 27 Gulfstream maiden victory ([video](#)) to his credit, will make his next appearance in the Mar. 20 GI Florida Derby. Second going seven panels Jan. 23, the dark bay will be making his two-turn bow off that one-mile graduation. "He ran an excellent race the first time and was probably 80 percent that day," said trainer Michael Mareina. "Now he's been schooled. He's sat behind horses. He's eaten dirt and waited. What Bull Hancock Really Thought:



One morning in 1969 in a conversation with my father, I asked him why he didn't take a few more mares to Bold Ruler, whose stud fee was \$100,000 and who was getting about 38 mares, and he said:

“Because, son, over-breeding a stallion compromises the quality of the offspring. It has been tried with stallions who got a couple of stakes winners in their first crops and were never heard from again.”

He would not double a stallion two days in a row because he believed it diminished semen vitality and was not conducive to producing the soundest and most robust offspring.

He said that a stallion should make around 100 covers a year. In the early 70's before the days of palpation and ultrasound, that was about 40 mares at 2.5 covers per mare. Today that would be about 75 mares at 1.3 covers per mare.
