### RACHEL READY FOLLOWING FINAL WORK

Reigning Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) breezed four furlongs in :49 at the Fair Grounds yesterday in her final workout ahead of her comeback effort in Saturday's New Orleans Ladies S. Unraced since winning the Sept. 5 GI Woodward S. over older males, the five-time Grade I-winning filly has

been based at the Fair Grounds since December, and has posted seven published workouts dating back to Jan. 31. Clockers timing the four-year-old's breeze yesterday caught fractional times of :25 1/5 and :37 1/5, with a five-furlong gallop-out time of 1:01 4/5. "It was just an easy half," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "It's hard to compare her to anybody else, so we just gave her an easy half and let [exercise rider Dominic Terry] get along with her, and it looked like she went beautiful.

She's a beautiful mover. That's how she runs, and that's what makes her special. She went over the race-track very well--it was in great shape this morning. That's all we could hope for." Rachel Alexandra will bring a nine-race winning streak into Saturday's event, which could serve as a prep for a possible match-up with **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Apple Blossom S. at Oaklawn Apr. 9. Zenyatta is scheduled to make her seasonal debut in Saturday's GI Santa Margarita H. at Santa Anita.

### GOLDIKOVA RETURNS IN PRIX D'ISPAHAN

Dual GI Breeders' Cup Mile heroine **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) will make her comeback in G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 23, a race in which she finished a disappointing seventh last year. "She has been back with me for a few weeks and is in great form," conditioner Freddy Head told the *Racing Post*. "I think I will have to start her in the Prix d'Ispahan, as she must have a run before the [G1] Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot, but all will depend on the ground." A champion in France at three and the Eclipse Award winner as top grass distaffer at four, Goldikova boasts a record of 15-10-2-2 and has bankrolled \$4,087,789. She followed last season's lackluster effort in the Prix d'Ispahan with victories in the G1 Falmouth S., G1 Prix Rothschild and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois. Third in the G1 Prix de la Foret in October, she capped off the campaign with a successful title defense in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile.

### EAGLE MOUNTAIN RETIRED

Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum's globe-trotting **Eagle Mountain (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}--Masskana {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}), winner of the 2008 G1 Hong Kong Cup, has been retired after sustaining a tendon injury in training, trainer Mike de Kock revealed yesterday. The six-year-old bay finished runner-up in the 2007 G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Champion S. when trained by Aidan O'Brien, and preceded his career highlight with a runner-up finish in the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Turf in his second start for de Kock. "This is his third career-threatening injury, and enough is enough," the trainer said. "He's been a great servant to Sheikh Mohammed and the stable, and did us proud. Eagle Mountain's future as a stallion is being discussed, and we will entertain offers for him. He has an amazing race record and was one of the best horses I have ever worked with." Eagle Mountain, who finished second in a Feb. 19 conditions event at Meydan in his final start, retires with a career record of 19-5-7-1 and earnings of £1,790,492.

After considering staying home for the GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita, Bob Baffert has decided to send champion two-year-old **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) to Oaklawn for Saturday's GII Southwest S., *Daily Racing Form* reports. "The only reason why I wouldn't have gone to Arkansas is it was freezing weather," Baffert told the publication. "It looks like it's going to be decent weather, in the 50s. If it was going to be in the 30s, I wouldn't go." **Tiz Chrome** (Tiznow) will miss the San Felipe after missing several days of training last week, Baffert said.

**She Be Wild to Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay...**

Champion two-year-old filly **She Be Wild** (Offlee Wild) will likely make an intra-state trip to compete in Saturday's GIII Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs, *Daily Racing Form* reports. According to trainer Wayne Catalano, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine didn't handle the surface when fifth in the GII Forward Gal S. over the main track at Gulfstream Jan. 31 in her sophomore and conventional dirt debut. "We really have only two options with her, which would be to get her a prep and then bring her back in three weeks for the [GI] Ashland S. [at Keeneland Apr. 3], or to just train her up to the Ashland," Catalano told *DRF*. "She's doing well at the moment, and it looks like the race at Tampa is going to come up a fairly soft spot, so I think that's the way we'll go."

**Go East, Young Fillies...**

The top three finishers in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Oaks are likely to make their next starts outside California, *Daily Racing Form* has revealed. 🐾 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🐾 **Crisp** (El Corredor), upset winner of Saturday's event, could resurface in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3, or could wait until the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30. **All Due Respect** (Value Plus) and **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision)--second and third, respectively, in the Santa Anita Oaks--could meet again in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park Apr. 2.

## AMERICAN OAKS REDUCED BY \$450,000 AS HOLLYWOOD PARK SLASHES STAKES PURSES

Hollywood Park will offer \$5.8 million in stakes money during the 2010 spring/summer meet, down \$2.2 million from the previous year. The GI American Oaks, which offered a \$700,000 purse in 2009, will now be worth \$250,000, the minimum for a Grade I race. The GI Hollywood Gold Cup will carry a \$500,000 purse this year, \$200,000 less compared to the previous term. The GII Jim Murray Memorial H. and GIII Will Rogers H. have returned to the schedule after not being contested last year while the GIII Ack Ack H., GIII Cinema H., GIII Round Table H., Flawlessly S. and Khaled S. have been placed on hiatus for 2010. "We've made these changes in an effort to keep overnight purses as high as possible as we cope with the struggling economy," said Martin Panza, Hollywood Park's vice president of racing. "We've got to put as much money into overnight purses as possible to aid horsemen in these tough economic times."

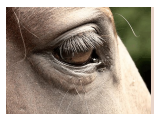

## FAIR GROUNDS REDUCES STAKES PURSES

Fair Grounds officials announced yesterday that they will reduce the purses of the GII Fair Grounds Oaks, GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial H. and GII New Orleans H. by \$100,000 apiece. The three back-type events will now be worth \$300,000 each. "This move, painful as it is, ensures that we will not have to cut overnight purses for our final month of racing," said Fair Grounds Vice President and General Manager Eric Halstrom in a press release. "Looking at this from a long-term perspective, we have to get closer to a balanced purse account if we are to offer the highest possible purses for our horsemen next season." Halstrom added, "We're hoping that the world-class racing we have lined up for our big days during the final three weeks of the meet will allow us to end on a high note, and then head into next year ready to go with an attractive purse structure and stakes program."

The feat of siring at least one Grade I winner in each of his first four crops, all conceived at fees no higher than \$10,000, helped propel Mr. Greeley into the big time, to the extent that his fee eventually rose as high as \$125,000. Now, history has gone close to repeating itself with El Corredor, the Grade I winner from Mr. Greeley's first crop. A handsome winner of the Cigar Mile, El Corredor has now sired a Grade I winner in four of his first five crops, thanks to Crisp's victory Saturday.

Crisp follows Adieu, who helped the Hill 'n' Dale resident get off to a fine start with her success in the 2005 Frizette S.; Dominican, who shocked the future Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense in the 2007 Blue Grass S.; and Backstreet Rhythm, who got the better of Pure Clan and Ariege to take the 2008 Garden City S. Interestingly, these Grade I successes have come on dirt, turf and two types of synthetic, which suggests that El Corredor is pleasingly versatile as a stallion.

Unfortunately for his owners, El Corredor's success has yet to translate into the same sort of steady climb in his fee that Mr. Greeley enjoyed. No doubt, the economic climate is at least partly responsible for this. However, his 2010 fee of \$15,000 also reflects the fact that El Corredor's book fell to 79 mares at a fee of \$25,000 in 2009, having never previously fallen below 115 mares. He covered as many as 195 mares at an increased fee of \$30,000 in 2006, after Adieu had helped him finish runner-up to Tiznow among the freshman sires of 2005. That first crop also contained Itty Bitty Pretty, winner of the GIII Santa Ysabel S. at the start of 2006, and Wanna Runner, who enjoyed profitable time in the spring of 2006, thanks to victories in the WinStar Derby and the GIII Walmac Lone Star Derby.

This could well be a case of success breeding further success four or five years down the line, and I will be surprised if Crisp remains the only graded winner from the 2007 crop, which also includes the Colin S. winner Fearless Cowboy.

Another reason why El Corredor's fee has to be competitive this year is that he is once more bound to face strong competition at Hill 'n' Dale from his half-brother Roman Ruler. This son of Fusaichi Pegasus matched El Corredor's achievement of finishing second on the freshman sires' list. Indeed, he went very close to topping the table, thanks to the efforts of such as Homeboykris and Rule.

To digress a little, I mentioned when I reviewed Rule's pedigree in December that Roman Ruler's book had fallen from 197 mares in his first year to only 37 mares in his fourth season in 2009, his figures for the intervening years being 112 and 62. He was by no means alone in this among the stallions that started out in 2006. Offlee Wild's figures for his first and fourth seasons stood at 97 and 56, while Pollard's Vision's went from 133 to 36, Proud Accolade's from 91 to 41, Limehouse's from 141 to 68, Closing Argument's from 158 to 63, Grand Reward's from 187 to 41 and Consolidator's from 137 to 70.

Of course, there is nothing new about a young stallion finding it increasingly hard to attract mares until he has proven himself, and the situation is no doubt being exacerbated by the current rapid fall in the broodmare population. Even so, this trend is likely to make it harder than ever to assess exactly how well a young stallion is faring, and breeders will need to bear in mind the opportunities--or lack of them--which many young stallions receive after their newness has worn off.

El Corredor was fortunate that his early career wasn't subject to such pronounced fluctuations. Breeders therefore have plenty of evidence on which to base their verdict on the 13-year-old stallion. A good proportion of his success has come with mares from the Storm Cat line. His durable son El Caballo, a Grade III winner at six this year, is out of a Storm Cat mare, while the Grade III winner El Gato Malo is out of a Mountain Cat mare, Fearless Cowboy is out of a daughter of Forest Wildcat; and Crisp is out of a Sir Cat mare. Sir Cat, a graded winner at three, four and five, is now permanently resident in Chile, having originally shuttled there from Gainesway.

Crisp is the first foal of Cat's Fair, who never raced after being sold for \$14,500 as a yearling. However, she has kept good company as a broodmare, visiting El Corredor, Mr. Greeley, Street Sense and then Mr. Greeley again, and her price rose to \$175,000 when she was offered at Keeneland last November.

One of the reasons why Mr. Greeley became a likeable option for Cat's Fair is that she is a half-sister to Thorough Fair, who produced the GI Futurity S. winner Whywhywhy to the son of Gone West.

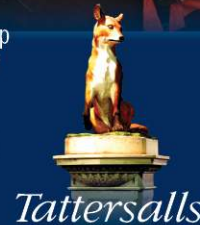

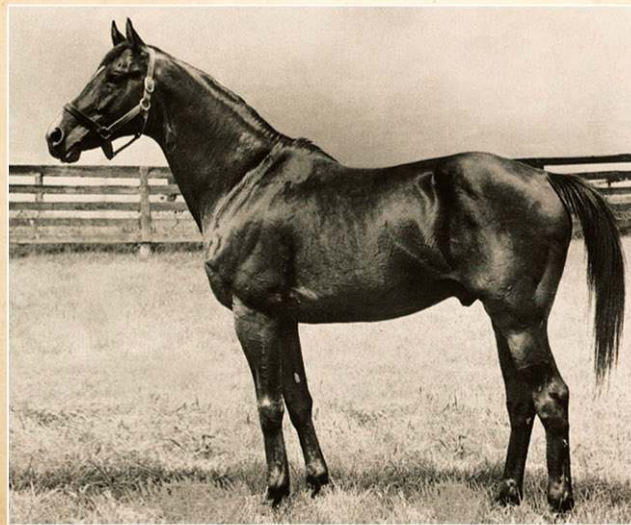
