SHIRREFFS GRABS SOME ZZZZZZZS

First he watched his charge Zardana (Brz) (Crimson Tide {Ire}) upset the New Orleans Ladies S. at Fair Grounds, then John Shirreffs headed to the paddock at Santa Anita and saddled unbeaten **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) to what would be her 15th career victory in the GI Santa Margarita H. It was a bit more eventful than perhaps it had been scripted: Zenyatta was still last as they headed into the stretch, and jockey Mike Smith opted to take the shorter route to the wire. He had to steady

briefly and, for a moment, it seemed the GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner was in a spot of trouble. But she angled inside to pass one rival, eased up on the outside of pacesetter **Dance to My Tune** (Stravinsky), and was on her way to yet another ears-pricked victory. "Everybody really loves her," owner Jerry Moss said. "Everybody's so pleased to have her back and to root for her, and when she wins, she makes everybody happy. She's perfect. She's the idol of perfection we all strive for. That's about as profound as I get." **Cont. p2**

ZARDANA UPSETS RACHEL AT FAIR GROUNDS

Her name begins with Z and ends with A, and John Shirreffs trains her, but it wasn't Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) that handed Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) her first defeat in 10 starts. Instead, it

was Shirreffs's second-stringer **Zardana (Brz)** (Crimson Tide {Ire}) that shocked the crowd in the New Orleans Ladies S. at Fair Grounds yesterday. In hand as Rachel shadowed outsider **Fighter Wing** (Empire Maker) through the opening exchanges, 9-1 Zardana crept closer as they neared the turn. Jockey

Calvin Borel, aboard the 1-20 chalk, was already looking over his shoulder on the backstretch, but he didn't seem to see Zardana coming. The bay mare, under David Flores, shot up on the outside and had a head in front when they turned for home. Borel finally went to the whip, encouraging Rachel left- and right-handed, but she never could get back on top, and Zardana drove home a 3/4-length winner. Trainer Steve Asmussen took all the blame for the loss. "It was a lack in fitness," Asmussen said. "It's our job to have her there, and I didn't do it." **Cont. p3**

Ann Moss revealed yesterday that, in the Moss household, there is a trophy case devoted solely to the hardware won by Zenyatta. The Santa Margarita was the last of the Southern California Grade I events missing from display, which already housed the trophies from the GI Vanity H. (2), GI Lady's Secret BC S. (2), GI Clement L. Hirsch S. and GI Apple Blossom H., not to mention the GI BC Ladies Classic and GI BC Classic. Oh er latest tally, jockey Mike Smith said, "This was her first race back and I wanted to make it as easy as possible. I could've wheeled wide when we turned for home, but... I cut some corners and gambled a bit. I was confident at all times that if she needed to make room, she could. She's a bit of a bully." Trainer John Shirreffs added that the defeat of Rachel Alexandra, and what her plans might be, would have no effect on the schedule for Zenyatta. Zardana was a stakes winner in three starts while racing on conventional dirt in Brazil, but finished off the board in six of her first seven outings in the U.S. Her only success over that stretch was a win in the 2008 Osunitas H. on the turf at Del Mar. She improved last year, going three-for-seven with a victory in the Dec. 5 GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park, but could do no better than fourth in her first outing this year, the Feb. 13 GII Santa Maria H. She was trying the dirt for the first time since shipping state-side here. Content to track **Fighter Wing** (Empire Maker) and **Rachel Alexandra** from third, she was still three lengths off the leaders as they raced into the far turn.

But jockey David Flores got his mount motoring as they came around the bend, and they rocketed past **Rachel** at the top of the lane. "We had a picture-perfect trip," Flores said. "The strategy was simply to get her to relax and [John Shirreffs] said she would get the job done. I got after her pretty hard coming home, but she is a real warrior." The reigning Horse of the Year dug in and tried to make a race of it, but the 6 1/2-month layoff took its toll. "My little filly tried hard," Calvin Borel said. "She needed the race, that's all. I wanted to let her run her race early...I'd have got by [Fighter Wing] her anytime, and my filly could have gone on, but they wanted me to wait and not get into her until the sixteenth pole." Borel added, "You know how I know she's a real racehorse? She was beat when that other horse went by her, but she didn't quit. She dug in and fought right back and stayed with the winner the rest of the way. That's the kind of racehorse she is. My little filly tried her heart out. She just needed the race." Steve Asmussen remarked, "She was strong early and got tired. [It's] very disappointing that she lost. You hate to be in that position, but now that it's over, you know it's not something we got away with. She's not where I thought she was." Looking ahead, he continued, "You take her back, you evaluate her, you see how her mood is, her diet, how she goes back to the race-track, how she breezes. No crystal ball could see that far ahead. But if I thought she'd get beat, I wouldn't have run her today, so I'm definitely going to be cautious." [Click for the **brisnet.com** chart](#) or the [brisnet.com PPs](#). A \$475,000 graduate of last year's Keeneland April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, Lookin At Lucky debuted just shy of three months later, becoming a **☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆** with a professional 3/4-length victory at Hollywood Park July 11. Stepped up into stakes company off that effort, the attractive bay colt swept Del Mar's series for juveniles, taking the GII Best Pal S. by 3/4 of a length Aug. 9 prior to a one-length success in the GI Del Mar Futurity Sept. 7.

Saturday's live racing program at Aqueduct was canceled. The featured GIII Cicada S. now will be run Saturday, Mar. 20.

He ran his record to a perfect four from four, taking his first two-turn voyage in the GI Norfolk S. by 1 3/4 lengths, but could not carry his luck over to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile.

Forced into a wide trip from a high draw that Saturday afternoon, he nonetheless was gaining on Noble's Promise as the wire loomed, but was outfinished by upstart Vale of York (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and settled for second. Given a final chance to cement his status at the top of his generation, Lookin At Lucky was more prominent than is his custom in the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 19 and was more workmanlike than spectacular in defeating his arch-rival by three-quarters of a length. The two would meet again in their respective first sophomore starts and first over a conventional dirt surface. Longshot Royal Express (Royal Academy), coming off a near-miss to Backtalk (Smarty Jones) in the Sportsman's Paradise S. Feb. 26, set the pace, as Lookin At Lucky settled worse than midfield beneath Garrett Gomez. He was advancing down the backstretch when Noble's Promise shifted his ground a bit at the half-mile pole and appeared to momentarily lose his action. But he was right back into the bridle, attacked approaching the stretch and closed with determined strides to run his head-to-head record with Noble's Promise to three for three. Second by a head on debut at Del Mar July 25, Sidney's Candy was designated a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"**

☆ after scoring by four lengths and setting a track record of 1:02.71 for 5 1/2 furlongs over Polytrack at the seaside oval Aug. 22. He went to the sidelines following that effort, and beat one home in his comeback race, a Dec. 30 Santa Anita allowance. Underterred, connections entered the homebred in the GII San Vicente S. in Arcadia Feb. 15, and he rewarded them with a gate-to-wire 4 1/4-length victory. Trying two turns for the first time here, the chestnut quickly cleared up front and received mild pressure through a half of :48.55. It looked like it was game over at the top of the stretch, but Rajiv Maragh kept riding and Odysseus responded, coming on again from between horses to get his nose down on the wire. "I thought we got beat, to be honest," owner Satish Sanan admitted. The chestnut broke his maiden in his

second start, scoring in a seven-furlong maiden test at Gulfstream Jan. 14, and was tabbed a **"TDN Rising Star"** after taking an optional claimer by 15 lengths over this track and trip Feb. 17. The second choice in his stakes bow, Odysseus was tugging on Maragh as he tracked favored Super Saver (Maria's Mon) from the outside early. He shortened stride and dropped back when they fanned into the lane, and it appeared that the rallying Schoolyard Dreams would give owner Eric Fein a third consecutive win in this event. But it turned out that Odysseus had a little something left, and he dug down and drove up inside Schoolyard Dreams to get the bob. Looking ahead, Sanan said the Apr. 3 GI Wood Memorial S. would likely be next, adding, "Obviously, we want to go to the [May 1 GI Kentucky] Derby and see what happens." She lugged in a bit before finally switching to her right lead in deep stretch and, levelling off late, was going away at the wire. Despite the five-race winning streak, trainer and co-owner Dave Vivian seemed unlikely to send the winner to the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks. "I don't think so, but never say never," Vivian said. Form reports. Trainer John Shirreffs told the publication the five-year-old suffered muscle cramps following a workout this morning at Hollywood Park, prompting owner Marty Wygod to retire the mare. "She came back to the barn from the workout and tied up a little bit," Shirreffs told the *DRF*. "We don't want to compromise

her at all." The bay had suffered muscle cramps before, which forced the full-sister to the 2004 champion two-year-old filly Sweet Catomine to be scratched out of the GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita Jan. 2.

Owned by her breeders Pam and Marty Wygod, *Life Is Sweet* was tabbed a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ after breaking her maiden by nine lengths on turf at Belmont Park in October 2007. She earned her first Grade I victory in the GI Santa Margarita H. last March, and was third against males in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. in July. The mare had been aiming for a tilt at the \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 27, but retires with a record of 16-6-4-1 and earnings of \$1,820,810, and will now be bred to Smart Strike.

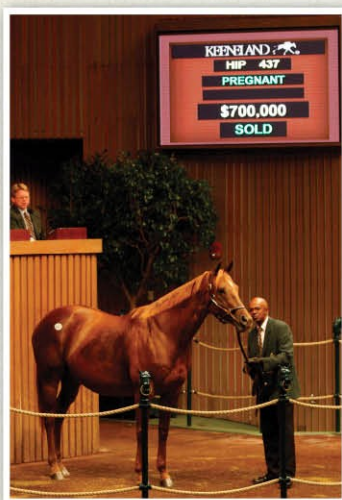

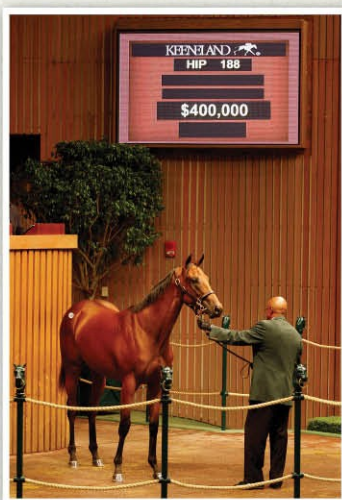

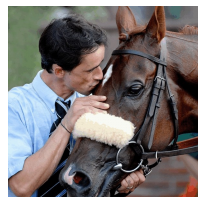
