RACHEL TO BYPASS APPLE BLOSSOM

One day after finishing second in her seasonal return in the New Orleans Ladies S. at the Fair Grounds, **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) was officially confirmed out of the GI Apple Blossom H., which will be contested Apr. 9. Owner Jess Jackson confirmed yesterday that, although the defending Horse of the Year exited the race healthy, the four-year-old would not be shipped to Oaklawn Park for a match-up with champion Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}). "[Saturday's] race, while a disappointment, helped us define Rachel Alexandra's racing condition," explained Jackson. "While she is healthy, just as I had anticipated, she is not in top form. Therefore, I decided [Sunday] she will not be going to the Apple Blossom on Apr. 9. [Trainer] Steve [Asmussen] and I discussed this fully and we now regret we tried to accelerate her training in order to meet the Apple Blossom schedule. We have a whole season before us to help define her greatness. She will tell us when her next race will be." Responding to Rachel Alexandra's defection, Zenyatta's owner, Jerry Moss, said, "We're disappointed that we're not going to be able to face each other in the Apple Blossom. Hopefully, we can meet down the line. We respect both Steve and Mr. Jackson as horsemen, and they're going to do what's right for their horse. That's all anybody could ask for. We'll go on to the Apple Blossom as planned."

Feb. 20 GII Fountain of Youth S., the chestnut recorded the 21st fastest of 43 works at the distance yesterday. Also slated for this weekend's GI Kentucky Derby prep is **Pleasant Prince** (Indy King), who earned the bullet for five furlongs at Gulfstream Park yesterday. Owned by Ken and Sarah Ramsey and trained by Wesley Ward, the colt covered the distance in :59 1/5. Pleasant Prince was fourth in the Fountain of Youth. "I was really excited going into the [Fountain of Youth]," said Ward. "The horse was training great. I've always felt since we bought the horse that he was going to be something special, and I think he's starting to emerge into what his potential is. Hopefully, he is one that is a late developer and will come around quickly to get us the big one [Florida Derby]." Posting a bullet work for the same distance at Palm Meadows Sunday was **Soaring Empire** (Empire Maker), who completed the task in 1:00 2/5. Jockey Eddie Castro, who was aboard for the breeze, will ride the colt in the nine-furlong test. Also working five panels at the Hallandale oval were **Tempted to Tapit** (Tapit), who was caught in :59 4/5 and **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even), who stopped the timer in 1:02.

BUDDY'S SAINT OUT OF DERBY CONTENTION WITH ANKLE CHIP

Buddy's Saint (Saint Liam) is no longer under consideration for the GI Kentucky Derby after connections discovered a chip in his right front ankle Sunday morning, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The injury was discovered after the winner of the GII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. breezed five furlongs in 1:01.30 at Gulfstream Park yesterday. "He didn't really work that good; he didn't gallop out real well," trainer Bruce Levine told *DRF*. "He cooled out sore, we took some pictures and discovered a chip in his right front ankle." Ninth in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth at Gulfstream Feb. 20 in his lone start as a sophomore, Buddy's Saint had been targeting the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 3 at Aqueduct. "I'm going to talk to Dr. John Madison at Ocala Equine about the possibility of doing surgery to remove the chip," Levine added. "I think he'll need 60 to 90 days off, and then we can probably have him back by the fall."

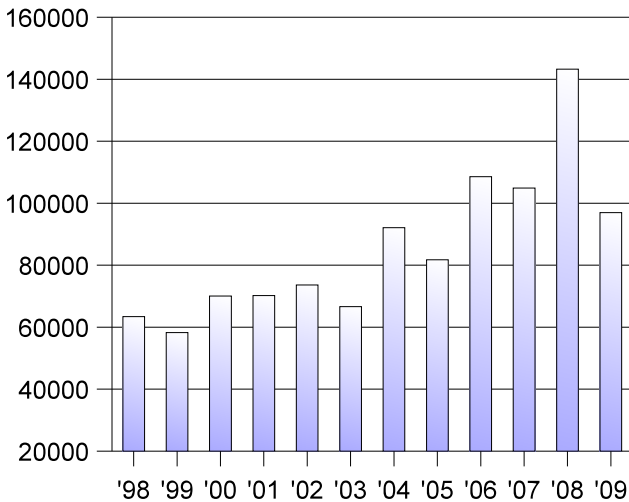
TWO IN :10 FLAT AT SECOND BREEZE SHOW

The Ocala Breeders' Sales company held the second of two breeze shows yesterday in advance of the March Selected Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training, to be held Tuesday and Wednesday in Ocala, Florida.

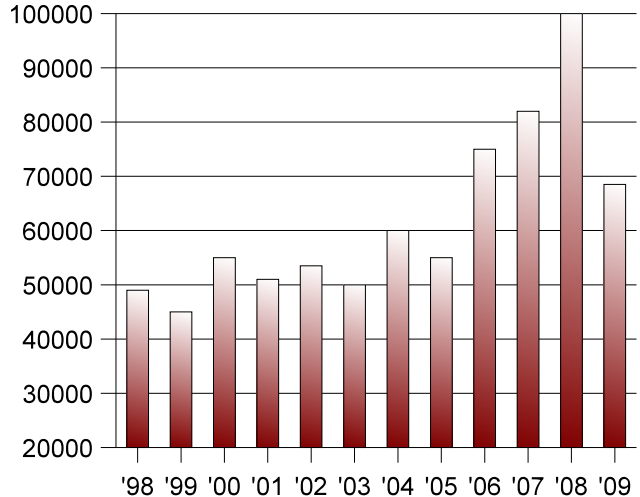
Two youngsters shared the bullet for an eighth-of-a-mile breeze. Hip [282](#), a bay filly from the first crop of Grade II stakes winner Badge of Silver (Silver Deputy), zipped the distance in :10 flat. Consigned by Leprechaun Racing, the filly is out of Silver Bride (Runaway Groom) and is a half-sister to stakes winner Hallway (Graeme Hall). That time was equaled by hip [306](#), a colt by another first-crop sire, Henny Hughes (Hennessy). The colt is a son of Tacticmove (Deputy Minister), a half to graded winners Cat Fighter (Storm Cat) and Ishiguru (Danzig). James Layden consigns.

After rain and wind forced the postponement of the breeze shows, attending buyers enjoyed good weather over the weekend at OBS. Bloodstock agent David Ingordo, on hand Saturday to watch a horse he purchased for Padua, Odysseus (Malibu Moon), win the GIII Tampa Bay Derby, set up shop on the second floor of the OBS grandstand yesterday morning, along with WinStar's Doug Cauthen and Elliott Walden, West Point Thoroughbreds' Terry Finley and Buzz Chace, trainer Linda Rice, and agent Steve Young. Sitting down below on the stands outside were the Spendthrift team, including Seth Semkin and trainer Richard Mandella, as well as Stonestreet Stable rep John Moynihan, Bionic Bloodstock's Bob Feld and Barry Berkelhammer, New York conditioners John Kimmel and Gary Contessa, and a Hidden Brook team comprised of Jack Brothers, Mark Roberts and Dan Hall.

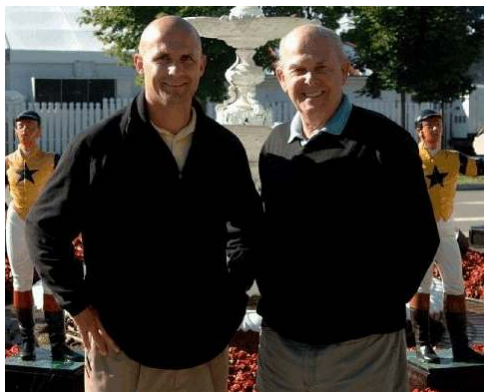

More to the Point...

While the names of some prominent buyers of juveniles have been conspicuously absent from the sales sheets in 2010, one operation that has remained plenty busy is West Point Thoroughbreds. The racing syndicate, headed up by Terry Finley, has acquired no fewer than seven two-year-olds thus far this season, including three at the OBS February (gross: \$340,000) and four and Fasig-Tipton Calder (gross: \$1.04 million), for a total expenditure of \$1.38 million.

One thing that could have curbed West Point's participation in this year's market is a lack of investors. Many owners, after all, have scaled back considerably in their discretionary spending. But that hasn't been the case, reports Finley.

"Not surprisingly but thankfully, we've had a good bit of interest in West Point," he said last week. "Our pipeline has been fairly strong with people looking to either stay in the game, or trying to get involved for the first time."

That has been good news for consignors, as West Point buying team has been shopping the sales aggressively this year. West Point's primary bloodstock advisor Buzz Chace and his associate Mike Shannon spent much of last week going through the offerings at OBS March.

"They've been here all week and we'll be active here, then all three of us will fly right out to Barretts the day after the sale," said Finley. "There are a lot of great buying teams out there, and I'm real confident in ours. We've been together for a long time, and we're real comfortable with each other. It's something that works for us."

In 2009, West Point was more active at February than at Calder--it was February's leading buyer, with six purchased for \$1.26 million, vs. one purchased at Calder for \$100,000--and while the opposite was true this year. According to Finley, that wasn't by design.

"It just worked out like that," he said. "When you get yourself into trouble is when you go in with a real hard and fast plan. We vetted a decent amount of horses at the first sale, and some we didn't like the vet on, and others we got outbid on. But we're really happy with the three we ended up with."

Finley said the 2010 class of West Point two-year-olds will number roughly 30 horses when all is said and done, including 14 who were purchased as yearlings last year. That's a bigger West Point crop than usual, said Finley, but market conditions warranted increased participation.

"The last think I want to do is try to figure out the market, but we thought the market was swinging back into the end-user's favor more than it had been," Finley said. "As a result, we were stronger than we usually are at the yearling sales, and wound up with 14 yearlings. In the past, I think we bought maybe five or six a year. We thought with the turbulence in the market, it was a good time to take advantage." **Cont. p4**

Finley added that some members of that 30-strong roster will be based at tracks new to West Point.

"We've got a couple Canadian-breds, and we'll go up to Woodbine and race for the first time," said Finley. "Mark Casse will train for us. We also have a string going to Chicago, and Wayne Catalano will train for us there. In all those places, we've had a real good response. We're due to go up to Canada at an event in two or three weeks, and we've also been to Chicago twice. It works out well--it gets people in tune with what we're doing."

Asked if the new faces in West Point's partnerships are mostly friends and colleagues of existing members or outside investors, Finley replied, "It's a little bit of both. Referrals are by far the biggest part of our new business, but sometimes we're dealing with brand-new guys who like the business. It's a good cross-section. And as the years have gone by, we haven't had a huge influx, but a solid amount of established owners who want to have a shot to get the 'big' horse. They claim or they go the sales and buy \$50-\$60,000 horses, and they just realize they have a better shot if they take a piece of a \$400,000 horse."



Finley also provided an update for several prominent West Point runners, including OBS Championship S. winner **Quiet All American** (Forest Camp)--a \$225,000 purchase from Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stable last year at February--goes next in the Mar. 20 GII Lane's End S. at Turfway; fellow three-year-old colt **Boulder Creek** (Tapit)--a \$300,000 OBSFEB purchase from Niall Brennan last year and recently fifth in the GIII Sham S. at Santa Anita--will head to the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3; Awesome Gem will try the GII New Orleans H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 27; and Macho Again will return in the lucrative, \$1-million Charles Town Classic Apr. 17.

TDN Q&A

Tom Ventura, general manager and director of sales at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company, recently sat down for a Q&A session with the *TDN's* Steve Sherack to discuss the upcoming OBSMAR sale and more. The two-day auction kicks off at 2 p.m. Tuesday.



There are 183 fewer lots catalogued for this year's OBSMAR sale than in 2009. Was the cutback by design or more of a result of pinhookers scaling back at the 2009 yearling sales?

We didn't change our criteria. We wanted to stick with what has worked for us and concentrate on the quality. If it resulted in fewer horses, like it did, that was fine with us. We didn't want to lower the standards just to have more horses.

Can you discuss the quality of the catalogue?

The catalogue is solid. I think there's a good mix of horses. There's solid pedigrees and physically, I think, people will be happy when they come here.

Coming off the heels of the Fasig-Tipton Calder sale-- which realized healthy gains in average and median-- what are your expectations for the March sale? Do you think the momentum will carry over?

You would hope so, and I think this will be a broader test of the market. It's hard to really use the first two sales as a gauge, because the number of horses [catalogued]--there were only 160 in our sale [OBSFEB] and a little more than 200 at the Fasig-Tipton [Calder] sale. It's really hard to make any solid projections or conclusions to where the market is, but I think this will be a fair test. I think we've got the horses, and in earlier sales you did see plenty of interest in the barn area; it didn't always translate into a sale, but there seems to be genuine interest in the horses.

Ventura Q&A cont.

The Safetrack synthetic surface is going on its third season at OBS now. Are you happy with it/has it met expectations?

We're very happy with it. We made an effort after last year to tone it down a bit. It's a learning process on how to maintain these tracks. It's a naturally quick surface, but we've got a maintenance program set up to where we're very happy with it. It was noticeably slower in the February sale this year compared to last year. I think it's a very fair racetrack and it handles the weather well. We haven't had any problems with the surface. The consignors are happy with it. There haven't been any issues with the horses coming off the track. As far as our surface goes, we couldn't be happier--especially on a rainy day. That racetrack stays the same from beginning to end. We've got the horses performing on a level field, or at least a field where the buyers can gauge them accurately...Unfortunately, a lot of the synthetics are getting lumped in with what's happening at one racetrack [Santa Anita]. Every synthetic track isn't the same, just like every dirt track isn't the same.

I don't think it's the surface at Santa Anita; I think it's pretty common knowledge that the drainage seems to be the problem. **Cont. p7**

Was the weather--specifically the threat of rain during the breeze shows--the reason why OBS chose to install a synthetic surface?

That was a part of the reason. The most important part is the welfare of the horses. We felt strongly that Safetrack was a surface that was kind on the horses. [Being able to handle the rain] was certainly a bonus in our situation where these horses are to run on a specific day. We have a little bit of wiggle room in terms of moving the works one day back if we don't have good weather, but it's not like you can scratch and run the horse two weeks later. I think it's fair for the consignors, and it's nice to be able to give the buyer's some confidence that the horse that worked at 10 a.m. was over the same track as 3 p.m.

The OBS February sale saw a new buyer in Chuck Sandford come in and land the topper at \$475,000. Amy Tarrant, predominantly a yearling shopper, was also very active at the top of the market. Has OBS done anything differently to recruit new buyers?

We try and spread the word as best we can through the traditional ways. Since last year, we have also had representation on the racetrack. We try and reach out and cultivate customers and follow up on the existing customers that have had some success and let them know what we have for this go around...We do have some interest from overseas for the March sale. We've got credit in for some Japanese-based buyers, so hopefully they will participate.

With the majority of prospective buyers coming from out of town, are there any restaurants or attractions you recommend for them to see while in Ocala?

Well, my wife's a good cook, but I don't want them to come over my house [laughs]. One of things that seems to be popular is that several of the local hotels have the breeze videos right on one of the television channels. So you can be sitting in the Hilton, or the Residence Inn, and you flip to channel 16, and you can watch the videos until you fall asleep. As far as dining options, I know Mark's Prime Steaks is a popular destination.

"Halo's Image was a lynch pen of our operation and a farm favorite," said George G. Isaacs, general manager at Bridlewood. "He embodied everything we strive to accomplish here at Bridlewood: excellence on the racetrack, excellence at stud and excellence in the relationships we established through him. My personal memories of the joy this horse brought the Appleton family and Happy Alter throughout the years makes this a touch overwhelming and especially bitter-sweet at the moment. I feel like I just lost a dear old friend."



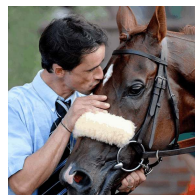
