BIG HOOFTSTEPS TO FOLLOW FOR LENTENOR

His full-sibling Barbaro announced himself the horse to beat on the first Saturday in May with a game victory in the GI Florida Derby four years ago. Can **Lentenor** (Dynaformer) follow up on his big brother's accomplishments in the 59th edition of the nine-furlong

test at Gulfstream Park this afternoon? It will be tough. While Barbaro already had two graded wins over the Gulfstream main tracks to his credit when he went to the gate for the 2006 Florida Derby, Lentenor has never competed on conventional dirt. The bay was third on the Keeneland Poly in his career opener

back in October, then switched to the turf to run second at the Big A Nov. 28. The Lael homebred graduated by 3 1/2 lengths on the Gulfstream green Jan. 20 before finishing second in an entry-level allowance Feb. 17. Connections acknowledge that it is a big step for the colt, but if he is going to have an opportunity to make it into the entries for the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby, they had to give him a shot. "We decided to give the horse a chance in either the Florida Derby or the [GI Apr. 3] Wood [Memorial]," trainer Michael Matz explained. "The biggest thing right now with him is that he is still developing quite a lot. Whether he has enough experience to be ready for this is another story--we don't know. We know he has to be first or second if he is going to be qualified for the Derby, and the Jacksons wanted to give him the chance. If he's not first or second, we will make another plan." **Field, p5**

CHRISTINE DAAE READY FOR THE SPOTLIGHT

Christine Daae (Giant's Causeway), an easy winner of two straight, receives a class test in today's GI Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream Park. The chestnut was tabbed a **"TDN Rising Star"** after drawing off to an 8 3/4-length maiden score at Gulfstream Jan. 15 in her second start, and enters this affair off a handy allowance victory Feb. 28 over the Bonnie Miss track and trip. Also entering this spot on a two-race winning streak is **Amen Hallelujah** (Montbrook). Winner of the GI Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita Jan. 16, the IEAH colorbearer kicked clear to a 6 1/4-length success in the GI Davona Dale S. over a one-turn mile at Gulfstream Feb. 27 in her first start over conventional dirt. The dark bay was third in two prior two-turns attempts, the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland and the GI Hollywood Starlet S. last year. "It's a lot of fun being around her," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said. "She's laid back. She doesn't care about anything. She's got a chance of being a good one, man." Also making her first start off the all-weather is **Switch** (Quiet American), who was third in the Santa Ynez and in the GI Las Virgenes S. in Arcadia Feb. 13. **Field, p2**

Of the quartet, **Miner's Reserve** boasts the best Beyer, earning a 94 with his 5 1/2-length maiden victory going a mile at Gulfstream Feb. 27. **Game On Dude** was also a maiden winner going a mile on this track that afternoon, but went four ticks slower while scoring by three. **First Dude** strutted his stuff over the Florida Derby track and trip in an allowance test Feb. 21. On the pace from the start, he grabbed a clear lead at the eighth pole, but was caught on the line, finishing second by a head. The bay has been first or second in all four career starts. **Best Actor** exits a third-place finish in a nine-panel allowance Jan. 31.

CHICK LANG PASSES AWAY Charles John "Chick" Lang, who served as director of racing, vice president and general manager during a 27-year stint at Pimlico Race Course, died Thursday. Lang had been in the hospital since the day after Christmas. He was 83. To honor the man known as "Mr. Preakness," the Maryland Jockey Club announced Friday that they will rename

the Gill Hirsch Jacobs S. on the Preakness undercard. Lang was the grandson of trainer John Mayberry, who won the 1903 Kentucky Derby with Judge Himes; his father, Chick Lang Sr., rode Reigh Count to victory in the 1928 "Run for the Roses." His late son Chickie Lang was a race-track executive as well, and his grandson, Bart Lang, is the director of racing at Lone Star Park.

After his retirement from Pimlico, Lang worked as the racing analyst at WBAL radio in Baltimore, earning two media Eclipse Awards. He also received the Certificate of Distinguished Citizenship of Maryland three times, the Special Award of Merit from the Maryland Jockey Club, the Humphrey S. Finney Award from the Maryland Racing Media Association and the Jockeys Agent Benevolent Association Man of the Year Award. Lang is survived by his wife of six decades, Nancy; daughter Debi; six grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. The funeral service will be private, but a ceremony, in which his ashes will be spread in the Pimlico winner's circle, is being planned. In lieu of flowers, the family requested that donations be sent to The WBAL Kids Campaign, 3800 Hooper Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland; or the Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund, PO Box 803, Elmhurst, Illinois, 60126.

GOMEZ TO RIDE IN KY IN SPRING, NY OR NJ IN SUMMER Jockey Garrett Gomez will ride in Kentucky in the spring and spend the summer in either New York or New Jersey, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The two-time Eclipse winner for outstanding rider will compete at Keeneland in April and at Churchill Downs for at least part of its spring meet before continuing his eastward journey. He will then be off to Saratoga in New York or to Monmouth Park in New Jersey to take advantage of the track's daily overnight purse distribution of approximately \$1 million per day. "We're going to explore staying at Churchill Downs and have the option of Monmouth or Saratoga," Gomez's agent Ron Anderson told *DRF*, adding, "We'll see how things are going. This is a different time for our industry in terms of where horses will be running."

MIDSHIPMAN OUT OF GODOLPHIN MILE Eclipse champion **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song), winner of a Meydan conditions race Feb. 25, has been declared out of the Mar. 27 G2 Godolphin Mile, it was announced on the Godolphin website yesterday. The four-year-old had a recurrence of the soft tissue injury that sidelined him at three. "It is a great shame he has had this setback as we had been so pleased with his last run," said Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford. DOMINGUEZ GETS WIN 4,000 Jockey Ramon Dominguez yesterday became the 58th jockey in history to win 4,000 races, piloting **Fortyninegeorgest** (Ecton Park) to a half-length score in the second at Aqueduct. Born in Venezuela, the 33-year-old reinsman started out riding show jumpers before switching to the track. He came to the U.S. in 1995, and rode his first winner in March of 1996 at Hialeah Park. The leading rider in North America in 2001 and 2003, Dominguez began riding full time in New York last year, and led the standings at every meet. He is currently the top jockey in the nation in wins, with 90 through Thursday. "It feels great, but it's almost surreal," said Dominguez. "It's the kind of thing that happens slowly over the years, but you're not prepared for it when it gets here. I'm so excited. You remember the big races, but every win counts just as much. 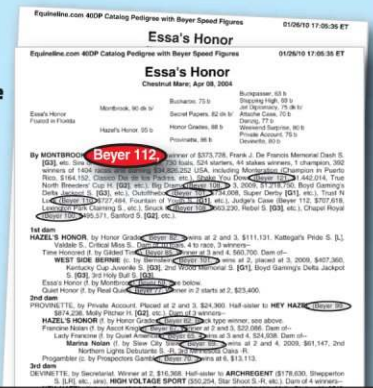

HENSHIN HERO (Dance Master)

When Henshin Hero, a \$3,700 purchase out of the 2008 Keeneland September sale, faced the starter for the first time last Aug. 31 going 5 1/2 furlongs at Remington Park ([video](#)), he was 51-1 and little was expected of him. Some 64 seconds and some change later, he'd lit up the tote to the tune of \$105.40 and had caught the eye of many an observer, including advisors to Cheyenne Stables' Everett Dobson.

"I got a call from an agent who told me about the horse," Dobson said by phone from St. Louis, where he was watching his daughter compete in a volleyball tournament. "We didn't buy him until a few weeks after he had won his maiden, but what we particularly liked about him is that the horse that he beat [Banner Cat] came back and won, so that sort of flattered him. We

thought the horse would make a nice fit for Oaklawn, he was priced right and so we went for it. We figured he could compete in shorter races, and he might even be able to go long, since he is out of a mare by Saint Ballado."

Things didn't go as planned in Henshin Hero's first start in Dobson's green and gold silks in a Jan. 23 allowance over a sloppy Oaklawn strip. The gelding unseated Israel Ocampo soon after the start, and it was back to the drawing board. His next opportunity to run came in a first-level allowance against straight three-year-olds at the Hot Springs oval Feb. 20. Quickly away, Henshin Hero clicked off a half-mile in :44 4/5 and was never menaced, streaking home by 7 1/4 lengths ([video](#)). Yesterday's margin of victory was not quite as impressive, numerically speaking, but it was a pleasing result to Dobson and company all the same.

"[Trainer] Bret [Calhoun] told me that the horse was doing great," Dobson related. "He did it last time and he was able to do it again this time, though this was against older horses."

Among the vanquished were favored Hamazing Destiny (Salt Lake) and Backwater Blues (Dixieland Band), most recently runner-up in the Mountain Valley S. Feb. 27. Dobson is going to wait until the paint dries on yesterday's win, but sees the future as bright for Henshin Hero.

"He's definitely stakes-quality, that's for sure," he commented.

It was the second win in as many days for Dobson, whose French Dip (Speightstown) snapped a 13-month skid in an Aqueduct allowance this past Wednesday.

Focused as he is on his racing stable, Dobson is also plenty busy as part-owner of the National Basketball Association's Oklahoma City Thunder.

In just its second year since being moved from Seattle, the team is currently tied for fifth in the Western Conference, some 16 games over the .500 threshold (41-26) and looking squarely at a post-season bid.

"It's gone exceptionally well," said Dobson, a former telecommunications executive. "We have a playoff-contending team, anchored by Kevin Durant, and it's just very exciting. History will show that we were very fortuitous to draft Kevin. Like in horse racing, you try to surround yourself with good people and hope for the best."--*Alan Carasso*

Kauto Star's jockey Ruby Walsh said of the fallen champion, "You cannot afford to make mistakes like that in Grade 1 company and that's the way it goes in racing. It was a bad fall, but he got up and cantered back down fresh as a daisy."
