## A RINGING ENDORSEMENT

The pre-race focus was on unbeaten **Conveyance** (Indian Charlie), but it was WinStar Farm's **Endorsement** (Distorted Humor) who turned back that pacesetting favorite at midstretch and pulled clear to a confident three-length win in yesterday's GIII Sunland Derby at Sunland Park. Jumping up to stakes company off an Oaklawn maiden win, Endorsement tracked Convey-

ance as the gray loped along on the front end through fractions of :23.71, :48.04 and 1:11.91. The chestnut took closer order on the turn and put a head in front in upper stretch. Conveyance offered brief resistance, but Endorsement kicked clear in the final

sixteenth to earn a berth to the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby in the race that produced last year's winner Mine That Bird (Birdstone). "He's given us all the indications that he had this race in him," said winning owner Bill Casner. "And those Distorted Humors--they have grit." **Tempted to Tapit** (Tapit), who chased the top two around the course, was another three lengths back in third. **Cont. p2**

## STACK STREAK CONTINUES

Continuing the hot streak of form of the Tommy Stack yard in this fledgling stage of the 2010 Flat season, **Noll Wallop (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) brushed aside some big names to book his Classic ticket with a 3 1/2-length victory in the Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. Sunday. Free early while restrained by Wayne Lordan with only two behind, he moved smoothly to the fore on the final turn. Taking control passing the quarter pole, the sophomore surged clear of the staying-on and non-threatening **Viscount Nelson** (Giant's Causeway), who fared best of the Ballydoyle contenders. "He has always worked well and we knew he'd stay and handle the ground, but we weren't sure how good he was," Lordan commented. "He carried me into the race and I thought I had got there too soon, but when I let him down, he picked up and went to the line well. He's an improving horse and deserves a shot at the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 22]." In the filly's equivalent, **Lady Springbank (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) was a 1 1/2-length winner of the G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial S. **Cont. p4-5**

**Endorsement Takes Sunland Derby (cont. from p1)**

Yesterday's victory was a homecoming for Bill Casner, who began galloping horses at Sunland Park in the 1960s. "I came to the racetrack in 1963, when I was 15," Casner recalled. "Back then, \$1,000 was a big purse, with \$600 to the winner. To come back and win this race is amazing. I never dreamed it, but hope springs eternal in this game." Casner added that this win puts Endorsement up with WinStar's other Derby hopefuls. "I think this moved him right up there with [GI Florida Derby third] **Rule** (Roman Ruler) and [GIII Tampa Bay Derby third] **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon)," he said. Endorsement, who began his career with a seventh-place effort at Churchill Downs last November for trainer Richard Budge, was transferred to the barn of former Elliott Walden assistant Shannon Ritter and opened his sophomore campaign with a runner-up effort at Fair Grounds Jan. 10. He broke his maiden with a front-running tally at Oaklawn Park Feb. 20. "He's really been improving since the win at Oaklawn," Ritter said. "And his work last week was just amazing." Also prepping for the Santa Anita Derby, **Caracortado** (Cat Dreams) went six furlongs under regular rider Paul Atkinson in 1:13.40. "Everything is perfect," trainer Mike Machowsky reported. Winner of the Feb. 13 GII Robert B. Lewis S., Caracortado suffered the first loss of his career when third in the Mar. 13 GII San Felipe S. last time out. **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) worked seven furlongs Sunday at Santa Anita in 1:26.20. "He went well," trainer John Sadler said of the GII San Vicente S. and GII San Felipe S. winner. "I moved the work up one day. I wanted six days into the Derby. Everything is perfect so far." **Skipshot** (Skip Away), a winner of three straight at Golden Gate this winter, went five furlongs in a bullet :58.40. "He galloped out real nice," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "At least we think he likes the race track after being here for about a week." GIII Generous S. winner **Who's Up** (Graeme Hall) worked five furlongs in :58.80 and GII San Rafael S. runner-up **Cardiff Giant** (Yankee Gentleman) covered six furlongs in 1:15. **Posse Power** (Posse), third in the GIII El Camino Real Derby, went a mile in 1:40.20 for trainer Frank Lucarelli.





**SANTA ANITA DERBY HOPEFULS WORK**

Champion juvenile **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) tuned up for a likely start in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby with a six-furlong move in 1:12 at Santa Anita yesterday. "I was waiting to see how he came out of the work, but right now, I'd say he's 90 percent sure to run here [at Santa Anita]," trainer Bob Baffert, who had also been considering the Apr. 10 GI Arkansas Derby for Lookin at Lucky, said yesterday. "He looked good. I liked what I saw." Lookin at Lucky won the Mar. 13 GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn in his sophomore bow.

**KENTUCKY NEXT FOR FAIR GROUNDS OAKS**

**RUNNERS** The first four runners from Friday's GII Fair Grounds Oaks are now being aimed for the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks. Trainer Dale Romans reported that Oaks winner **Quiet Temper** (Quiet American) came out of her half-length victory in fine shape. "She looks good," Romans said. "She came out of the race fine and she will leave for Kentucky [this] morning. She's a really good filly. I've only been fortunate enough to saddle one other filly in the Kentucky Oaks. Her name was Sweeping Story and she finished third behind Silverbulletday in 1999. I'm looking forward to going back there with this one." Also aiming for the Kentucky Classic are Fair Grounds Oaks runner-up **Champagne d'Oro** (Medaglia d'Oro), third-place finisher **Sheer Beauty** (Mizzen Mast) and fourth-place **Seeking the Title** (Seeking the Gold). **Jody Slew** (Slew City Slew), seventh in the Oaks after missing some training days before the race, may also head to Louisville.

Tanda, whose only previous main-track appearance was a fifth-place debut effort at Hollywood Park last December, broke her maiden down the hill at Santa Anita Jan. 3. She returned to that course and distance to finish second behind Rose Catherine (Speightstown) in the Jan. 24 Sweet Life S. and again to win a Mar. 5 optional claimer. The bay filly settled into a stalking position after a slow start, while Crisis of Spirit (Vindication) zipped through fractions of :21.92 and :44.34. As the pacesetter began to falter at midstretch, La Nez was rallying in the middle of the track, but Tanda snuck through an opening along the rail and scampered clear to an authoritative victory. "The way she won today, against this type of competition is amazing," said winning rider Alex Solis. "I know there were only five horses, but they were very good horses. She won very easy and she came back like she didn't even run. I know she's been running on the grass, but in my opinion, she would be able to adapt to the surface. She's a very classy filly." Trainer Dan Hendricks admitted he had some concerns about the surface switch. "I just wasn't sure, because I always watched her work before she ever ran on turf, so I was just a little worried about switching to another surface," Hendricks said. "But now all those worries are gone, and I'm just thankful that David Ingordo bought her at the sale. He did a super job finding her out of a thousand horses. I owe it all to him and the owner, Bob [Hutton]. He was very patient. He told me from the beginning, 'You don't have to rush her.' Trained by Karl Burke at two, Lady Springbank was sixth on her last start for that subsequently suspended trainer in Sandown's Listed Star S. in July. Her record for Paul Deegan is now two-for-two in group company after she added this prize to her success in the G3 CL Weld Park S. at The Curragh in September. Racing wide towards the forefront early, the grey took control passing the quarter pole as the favorite Famous (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) faltered and had inflicted the damage by the time Duchess of Foxland emerged from the pack. "She loves that ground and that's the key to her," jockey Jim Crowley said of the winner, who is bound for the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 23. "She is a gassy filly and we've tried to drop her in at home, but she's one who is worse the more you pull against her. She stays well enough and we are confident that another furlong won't be a problem."

Speak Easy Gal, purchased privately in January, is now three-for-three since switching to the barn of Marty Wolfson. The chestnut filly went wire-to-wire to take a Jan. 30 Gulfstream allowance by 2 1/4 lengths and held off the late rush of graded stakes winner Salve Germania (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) to take a Mar. 4 allowance by a head. Stretching out to this marathon distance, Speak Easy Gal went right to the lead and set measured fractions of :24.39, :50.47, 1:16.35 and 1:40.61. She opened up a clear advantage in upper stretch and was all out to hold off the late rush of Lady Shakespeare. "There wasn't much speed in the race and I knew I was going to go right to the lead," explained winning rider Elvis Trujillo. "Every time she runs, she breaks sharp, and I was able to slow things down on the lead and get away from them a little up front. She was always going along very comfortable, and it was a slow pace; very easy going for her." Wolfson added, "I ran her in this race, because I thought she would be the only speed, although they pressed her more than I thought. ### TAVISTOCK SECURED BY CAMBRIDGE STUD

New Zealand Thoroughbred breeder Sir Patrick Hogan announced yesterday that Cambridge Stud has secured a 50-percent interest in dual Group 1-winning **Tavistock** (Montjeu {Ire}--Upstage {GB}, by Quest For Fame {GB}) and will stand the four-year-old upon the conclusion of his racing career. A stud fee for the young stallion will be announced at that time. "The buying strength at Karaka this year told us that it's the classic middle distance horse which is the most in-demand," Sir Patrick told *New Zealand Thoroughbred Marketing*. "He's a lovely looking horse-- has a good strong male-type head on him...nice length, an excellent set of legs with nice bone, very good set of knees and joints and stands 16.00 [hands, measured]." Phil Cataldo, an independent bloodstock agent in New Zealand, negotiated Tavistock's purchase. Earlier this season, Tavistock outgunned Horse of the Year Mufhasa (NZ) (Pentire {GB}) in the G1 Hawke's Bay Mudgway Partsworld S. at Hastings and, more recently, Tavistock took the Waikato Draught Sprint in February. Renamed Lord Tavistock in Australia, the colt scored for trainer Mick Price in Flemington's G2 VRC Blamey S. and the VRC Henry Bucks Best Dressed Plate. The four-year-old, now with Andrew Campbell, is expected to contest Saturday's G1 George Ryder S. on Golden Slipper Day at Rosehill Gardens before making his final career start in the G1 All-Aged S. on Sydney Cup Day at Royal Randwick Apr. 10.
