ESKENDEREYA THE MAIN ACT

Some 11 winners of the GI Wood Memorial--New York's main prep for the GI Kentucky Derby--have gone on to wear the blanket of roses, including Fusaichi Pegasus, the most recent horse to complete the double in 2000. There have been a handful of horses who have

"failed" in the Wood, only to go on to Derby glory, including the likes of Monarchos (Maria's Mon) in 2001 and Funny Cide (Distorted Humor) in 2003. The connections of **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) face something of a dilemma with their odds-on favorite in today's nine-furlong event. His victory in the GII Fountain of Youth S. has all but ensured the chestnut a spot in the

gate in four weeks' time and his lofty 106 Beyer from that score is heads and shoulders above every other Classic hopeful, bar GIII Sunland Derby hero Endorsement (Distorted Humor). Therefore, do you ask for a top effort or do you ask for just enough to get him to the next one? "He has so much potential, he just seems like he continually gets better, not only his races but watching him train," trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "Physically, he's got all the tools, so I can see continued improvement in him."

DERBY DREAMIN IN L.A. AND CHI-TOWN

Major Derby preps are on tap this afternoon on the West Coast and in the country's heartland. At Santa Anita, champion **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) faces nine other sophomores in the GI Santa Anita Derby, including upstart **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride

{Arg}), who will attempt to stretch his ample speed to today's nine-furlong distance. Just outside the city limits of Chicago, a field of eight will face the starter in the GIII Illinois Derby at Hawthorne Race Course. In a group that lacks an obvious standout, Gold Mark Farm LLC's **Backtalk** (Smarty Jones) will try to prove to his connections that he can take his game to the next level and is worthy of the opportunity to emulate his Kentucky Derby-winning sire. **Fields p3, 6**

An Act to Follow...

Susan Roy and Vinery Stables' **Awesome Act** (Awesome Again) will look to become the second consecutive horse to pair up victories in the GIII Gotham S. and the Wood following I Want Revenge (Stephen Got Even) in 2009. A maiden winner in his fourth career start at Goodwood Oct. 1, the attractive chestnut was

only ninth in the G1 Dewhurst S. Oct. 17, then made his first voyage to the States, running on to finish fourth in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Nov. 7. He made the trans-Atlantic journey again for his sophomore debut in the Gotham Mar. 6 and handled every challenge most professionally, coming from off the pace for a 1 1/4-length success from GII Illinois Derby hopeful Yawanna Twist (Yonaguska). "The performance in the Gotham confirmed what we believed, that he would handle the dirt and hopefully be a better horse on the dirt," said trainer Jeremy Nosedo, who saddled another son of Awesome Again, Wilko, to an upset victory in the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "It's put him in the firing line, but we need a good performance on Saturday to keep moving forward and to believe that we are realistic about our dream of being in Kentucky."

Schoolyard Dreams (Stephen Got Even) was originally ticketed for Hawthorne, but was rerouted to this much more difficult and much less logical spot. Runner-up to Rule (Roman Ruler) when beaten three lengths in the GIII Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 13, he looked to be on his way to providing owner Eric Fein with a third straight win in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 13, only to have victory snatched away from him on the wire by Odysseus (Malibu Moon). He gets the services of jockey Ramon Dominguez this afternoon.

Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil) lost his debut last season before commencing a five-race winning streak, capped by a triple-digit figure success in the Oct. 17 In Reality S. Following that effort, owner Robert LaPenta purchased a controlling interest in the colt, and he has since been second in both of his appearances. Beaten 3/4 of a length to the sidelined Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song) in the GIII Holy Bull S. Jan. 23, he was no match for Eskendereya in the Fountain of Youth, checking in 8 1/2 lengths adrift of the Zayat runner. Trainer Nick Zito reaches out for Calvin Borel for the Wood.

LOOKIN LUCKY FOR BAFFERT?

Trainer Bob Baffert has had his fair share of success on the first Saturday in May, with victories from Real Quiet (1997), Silver Charm (1998) and War Emblem in 2002. The silver-haired conditioner is no stranger to the Santa Anita Derby winner's circle, having won the race no fewer than five times. Of those horses, none has managed to double up in the 'big' Derby, though Cavonnier (Batonnier) came this close back in 1996. Champion **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) flies the flag for the stable today in a race that is strictly a steppingstone on the road to Louisville. Rock-solid in landing five of his six starts as a juvenile, the bay was sent to Oaklawn Park to test a dirt track for the GII Rebel S. Mar. 13 and passed with flying colors, overcoming trouble on the backstretch to defeat the gritty Noble's Promise (Cuvee) by a head. While he may be the horse to beat this afternoon, he is something other than the best bet on the program. That distinction could fall to **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}), who looks to dole out his speed over nine panels today. Accorded ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status off a record-setting maiden score at Del Mar last August, the chestnut returned from a break to finish a disappointing fourth in a Dec. 30, but has been lights out since. He bounced back with a front-running 4 1/4-length tally in the GII San Vicente S. over seven furlongs Feb. 15 and controlled the pace yet again in the GII San Felipe S. going 8 1/2 furlongs Mar. 13, holding off Interactif (Broken Vow) by a half-length, with the previously unbeaten **Caracortado** (Cat Dreams) another 1 1/2 lengths back in third.

Negligee had the measure of champion **She Be Wild** when the two met in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland last October, getting up to beat the subsequent Eclipse winner by a half-length at equal weights in what was her two-turn debut. The bay made a right-hand turn at the eighth pole in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and still hit the line just 1 3/4 lengths behind She Be Wild in sixth. She makes her sophomore bow here, but has been training steadily since mid-January. She Be Wild kicked off 2010 in the Jan. 31 GII Forward Gal S. on the Gulfstream main track. Bet down to 7-5, she had no late kick and finished fifth, but trainer Wayne Catalano is expecting vast improvement in her second outing of the year. "She didn't handle that surface at all," Catalano told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm not going to totally rule out the dirt for her, but I noticed when I breezed her myself down there in Florida, she was just kind of scrambling around the turn. Polytrack is definitely her best surface." First or second in six of seven appearances, **Evening Jewel** ships in from California. The bay was beaten a nose by Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) when runner-up in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 13. **Apple Charlotte** was an allowance winner on the turf at Gulfstream in her seasonal debut Feb. 20 and came back to be second by a half-length after a rough trip in the Mar. 6 GIII Herecomesthebride S. She tries synthetic for the first time.

Warrior's Reward, who defeated **Munnings** in a very highly rated Churchill allowance last May, placed in the GIII Northern Dancer S., the GII Dwyer S. and the GII Jim Dandy S., but was fifth in the GI Shadwell Travers S. before cutting back to one turn. Fifth in the GIII Perryville S. at Keeneland Oct. 17, he was a strong runner-up in Churchill allowance company Nov. 21 and got 2010 off on a good note, defeating a strong bunch in a Feb. 21 Gulfstream allowance. **Munnings** was unlucky to catch sloppy strips when third in the GI NetJets King's Bishop S. and GI Vosburgh S. last term, but took advantage of his preferred underfoot conditions when striking from close range in the GII Gulfstream Park Spring Championship Feb. 13. He'll be tough from on or near the pace this afternoon.

Musket Man is undefeated in four sprint tries and enters this off a half-length comeback victory in the Feb. 6 Super S. at Tampa.

Win Willy has won four of six Oaklawn starts, including the 2009 GII Rebel S. and the GIII Razorback H. last out Mar. 6. "We're all set for the big race," said trainer Mac Robertson. "I like our chances." The veteran **Jonesboro**, who has earned over \$1.4 million, has been off the board in his last four tries, including a fifth in the Razorback. "I think when horses get older like this, it might take them a little longer to really get racing fit," trainer Randy Morse told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's older and smarter. He's going to kind of do things at his own pace now." At the other end of the career spectrum is **Follow the Leader**. Second in his lone appearance at three, the chestnut has rattled off three straight outings at Oaklawn this winter, and steps up in class following an optional-claiming success Mar. 13.

Backtalk opened his career with three straight victories, taking the July 3 GIII Bashford Manor S. in his second start and the July 30 GII Sanford S. in his third. Fourth in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. Sept. 7, he showed little when eighth in the Oct. 10 GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland and was put away for the year. The chestnut made his return as the 1-2 chalk in the Feb. 26 Sportsman's Paradise S. at Delta Downs and came with a determined late run to win by a half-length (video). Backtalk blazed six furlongs in 1:09 3/5 in a work at the Fair Grounds Mar. 25, much faster than trainer Tom Amoss had intended. Amoss is also concerned about the colt's capabilities at a route of ground. "It'll be the longest distance Backtalk has ever raced, and he's yet to prove he can go a true distance of ground," Amoss told *TDN* after the breeze. "He'll need to show that he is indeed a horse that routes well on the dirt, and from there we'll make some decisions."

Yawanna Twist bested New York-bred company handily in two starts at Aqueduct this winter, then stepped up for the Mar. 6 GIII Gotham S. and was a solid second. He stretches to two turns for the first time. **Game Ball** lost his rider when he clipped heels in a \$50,000 maiden-claimer on the turf at Tampa Dec. 30, but shook off that experience to graduate by 9 3/4 lengths in a similar test that was taken off the lawn Feb. 12. The chestnut followed up with an allowance tally at that track Mar. 5, and tries black-type competition for the first time.


The streaking **Compari** has a tough task in his graded-stakes debut. Since graduating in a Cal-bred contest over this course and distance last March, the bay has been unstoppable in five straight starts, and most recently led every step in Santa Anita's Crystal Water H. for state-breds over this familiar trip. Nordic Truce was the recipient of a textbook ground-saving ride from jockey Julien Leparoux, came out in upper stretch and got to Royal Ascot stakes winner Strike the Tiger in the waning strides to land the first stakes of the spring stand in Lexington. Sent to South Florida in late October, Nordic Truce debuted in a one-mile event over the Calder turf, overcoming a tardy dispatch to take a Nov. 15 maiden by a widening 4 1/2 lengths. The bay was off two months, returning as the 2-1 favorite in the Jan. 16 Dania Beach S. at Gulfstream Park. As many as 15 lengths behind after a suicidal half-mile, he still had nine rivals in front of him with a final furlong to race, but sprinted past them all for a neck success. Drawn cozily inside in post two, Nordic Truce skimmed the rail underneath a pair of rivals at Strike the Tiger and California raider Macias (Purge) engaged in fractions which usually spell doom over the testing Keeneland turf course. Leparoux allowed Nordic Truce to advance right on to the heels of the pacesetters approaching the far turn as Guys Reward made eyecatching progress from the latter half of the field. The even-money chalk found the room he needed three off the fence in upper stretch, and, while Macias hoisted the white flag soon thereafter, Strike the Tiger dug in determinedly and was tagged in the final two strides.

Bred to Win Partners LLC's Codoy (Bernstein) breezed five-eighths of a mile in 1:01.80 with John Velazquez in advance of a start in next Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. Working inside of a stablemate, the bay was caught by Keeneland clockers in :13.20, :25.80, :37.80 and :49.20 before galloping out six panels in 1:14.40. "The colt went very good," said Velazquez, who rode Bandini (Fusaichi Pegasus) to the win in the 2005 Blue Grass. "I had a target in front of him, just kinda sat there and made him work from the quarter pole home. He worked really, really well." Codoy has crossed the line first in each of his two starts on Polytrack, graduating at Turfway last September. He was first home in the John Battaglia Memorial S. Feb. 27, but was demoted to second for causing interference in the stretch. Runner-up to Interactif (Broken Vow) in the GIII Bourbon S. on the grass last Oct. 11, Codoy was 12th in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in his final two-year-old start Nov. 7.

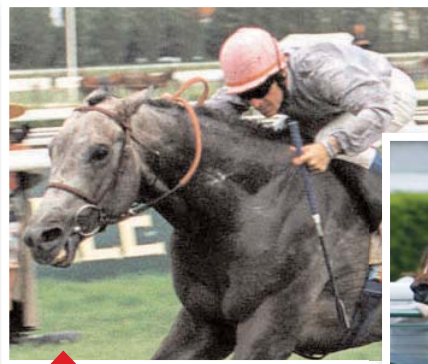

SERIES OF BILLS TO ADDRESS NYC-OTB

WOES The New York State legislature is currently on a holiday break, but a series of bills devised to prevent New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation from closing will be in front of them when they reconvene Wednesday. NYC-OTB has threatened to close the doors on its operations Apr. 11 if it is not afforded legislative relief. All 1,300 NYC-OTB employees were mailed 14-day layoff notices Mar. 26. A bill introduced Friday by Rep. J. Gary Pretlow, chairman of the Committee on Racing and Wagering Committee, would amend the responsibilities of the Non-Profit Racing Association Oversight Board that was originally created to keep watch on the New York Racing Association. If passed, the bill would give the Oversight Board the power to "oversee, monitor and review all significant transactions" of NYC-OTB, as it does NYRA, and would transfer control of its wagering accounts to the Oversight Board. The Oversight Board could then appoint a third party to manage the accounts. According to *Daily Racing Form*, NYRA has petitioned to take over management of the accounts, an action that has so far been rejected by Gov. David Paterson, but that could be approved if the bill is passed. "If all they did was graft the phone and Internet wagering to us, and let the parlors sort themselves out over the next six months, we'd probably be all right," a NYRA official told *DRF*. Legislation referred to the Assembly's Investigations and Government Operations Mar. 31 would allow a private vendor to take over the operation of NYC-OTB, and a bill introduced Mar. 26 would allow NYC-OTB to defer payments to NYRA, as well as the harness tracks and the state's breeding funds, until May 8. *DRF* reported that more than a dozen bills regarding the NYC-OTB situation would be before the legislature Wednesday, including one that would merge the corporation with Nassau OTB, and one that would pave the way for video gambling machines. NYC-OTB claimed a debt of \$95 million when it declared bankruptcy in December, of which \$15 million is owed to financially troubled NYRA.

SPEIGHTSTOWN RECUPERATING WinStar Farm announced yesterday that **Speightstown** (Gone West) underwent successful surgery at Hagyard-Davidson-McGee veterinary clinic for a large colon torsion. The stallion began showing signs of discomfort Thursday evening. Honored as the nation's champion sprinter for 2004, the chestnut is expected to miss the next three to four weeks of the breeding season. He has covered approximately 60 percent of his book this year. "We will do everything within our power to accommodate all those breeders who have supported our program," said Doug Cauthen, the farm's president.

ZAYAT CLEARED TO RACE IN KENTUCKY

Owner Ahmed Zayat has been cleared to race in Kentucky after an investigation into his alleged association with convicted bookmakers, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Lisa Underwood, the executive director of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, said that four weeks of looking into the matter yielded no evidence of wrongdoing which would preclude Zayat, owner of top Kentucky Derby candidate Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway), from running his horses in the Commonwealth. "We take matters of integrity seriously in Kentucky, but we've determined that there's no reason to suspend his license in Kentucky," Underwood told *DRF*. In papers filed in bankruptcy court earlier this year, Zayat listed four outstanding loans he had made to members of the Jelinsky Family totaling \$600,000. Two members of the family, Michael and Jeffrey Jelinsky, pleaded guilty to charges of illegal bookmaking in 2009, *DRF* reports. "I was confident that there was no reason to suspend my license," Zayat told the publication. "We cooperated fully in the investigation and they treated me very well."
