STATE OF SHOCK

Though the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland was regarded as a wide-open affair--**Interactif** (Broken Vow) was the 3-1 favorite--few could have predicted the 40-1 upset sprung by **Stately Victor** (Ghostzapper). Owned by F. Thomas Conway and his son, Kentucky Attorney General Jack Conway, the bay colt was coming off five straight unplaced efforts, but put those memories behind him by dashing past **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}) in the final sixteenth. "My dad and I would go to the Kentucky Derby and walk out on the third floor at Churchill Downs, and we'd want to be there about 45 minutes early when the horses would be making that walk," Jack Conway recalled. "Dad would always say, 'One day we're going to make that walk.' So we'd sit up there and get teary and sing 'My Old Kentucky Home.' And the thought that this year we're going to make that walk..." Line of David didn't do much when unveiled in a sprint on Hollywood's Cushion Track, finishing ninth in a Nov. 29 heat, but, stretched out to a mile at Santa Anita Dec. 30, improved to be third behind ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ Take Control (A.P. Indy). However, he regressed to be seventh next out on the Pro-Ride Feb. 5, and trainer John Sadler opted to switch it up for his next start eight days later. With blinkers on for his turf bow, the chestnut colt was sent to the lead and never looked back, and he added an allowance tally over the Santa Anita spinach Mar. 11, completing a 4 1/2-length wire job.

"When we switched him we did three things different," Sadler explained. "We added the blinkers, we changed his running style and we changed surface, so we were hoping when we came here it was things one and two, and not three. It was very good." He added, "We wanted to be in front because at Santa Anita he was going in front, and it just seemed to build confidence."

When the gates flew open, favored Noble's Promise (Cuvee) hopped up, and Line of David broke like a shot from the eight hole and quickly cleared the field. He strode along smoothly through splits of :22.65 and :46.26, with Super Saver (Maria's Mon) about three lengths behind, but looked to be getting a bit leg weary turning for home. Though Super Saver and Dublin (Afleet Alex) collared him in the lane and looked to have the race between them, Line of David was all heart on the rail and denied their challenges all the way to the wire.

He will now join his high-profile stablemates, ☆ "TDN Rising Stars" ☆ and Grade I winners Sidney's Candy and Crisp (El Corredor)--a GI Kentucky Oaks candidate--in Louisville. "The horse ran great," Sadler confirmed. "We're setting up camp on Monday and Tuesday at Churchill. We have Sidney's Candy and Crisp and a few others, so we'll add this one to the list."

Super Saver and Dublin will also both head north to Kentucky. "He's only had one race this year, and the thing you hope for is to move forward in a race like this," said Elliot Walden, racing manager for Super Saver's owner, WinStar Farm. "He did that, and we just hope he puts it all together in the Kentucky Derby." Dublin's trainer D. Wayne Lukas offered, "He had dead aim and he might have gotten a nose in front at some point, but you've got to be impressed with how the speed held pretty good. I've got no complaints. We will look at this as a prep and see where we are. We're disappointed not to win, but I was pleased with the effort."

Noble's Promise wound up fifth, his first unplaced finish in eight outings. "He put himself in a bad position when he hopped at the start," surmised trainer Ken McPeck. "We will look at him and see how he's doing. We didn't get beat by much, but we never really had a chance because of the start."

Stately Victor had a promising start to his career at Saratoga, finishing second to subsequent **TDN Rising Star** Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song) in an off-the-turf event Aug. 22 ([video](#)) before dashing clear by 4 1/2 lengths on the Spa spinach Sept. 5. Sent off at 5-1 in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity over this surface Oct. 10, the bay was seven wide before finishing sixth to Noble's Promise, and he signed off on his juvenile campaign with a seventh-place finish as the 2-5 chalk in an allowance on the Churchill main track. He kicked off 2010 with a fifth behind Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) in a Jan. 31 allowance at Gulfstream, and trainer Mike Maker opted to take off the blinkers and move his charge back to turf. Eighth in an entry-level allowance on the Gulfstream grass Feb. 17, he improved to be fifth, beaten just 1 3/4 lengths, in a similar affair Mar. 7, but Maker never lost faith in his charge. "I've always been high on this horse," he said. "After awhile, when a horse underachieves, you kinda forget about them. But I never quit believing in this horse. Gulfstream Park wasn't to his liking--the turf course and so forth, bad trips. He was one of those horses you made excuses for every time." As for the decision to take this class hike, Maker recalled, "I bought Tom [Conway] a bottle of vodka, ordered a couple of glasses and told him something crazy. He went along with me. I had to twist Tom's arm for about 15 seconds to get him to run."

Alan Garcia settled Stately Victor near the rear as Odysseus (Malibu Moon) showed the way from Paddy O'Prado through splits of :23.89 and :47.96, but the chestnut never looked that comfortable over the Polytrack. He began to give way on the far turn, and Paddy O'Prado entered the stretch under a full head of steam. Garcia and Stately Victor saved ground entering the second turn, but began to angle out for the homestretch. The colt cruised past Aikenite (Yes It's True), set his sights on Paddy O'Prado and strode by him with authority.

Stately Victor, named for a friend of Jack Conway's who was killed in a car accident in 1992, is the first black-type winner for 2004 Horse of the Year Ghostzapper. He is out of Collect the Cash, who captured the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup in 2000 for Frank Stronach. Collect the Cash has a two-year-old Smart Strike filly, and foaled a Lemon Drop Kid colt in February. Wasted Tears plays the catch-me-if-you-can game with verve, and did so once more here in the biggest test of her career. Sidelined following a win in Lone Star's GIII Ouija Board H. on Memorial Day, the dark bay resurfaced to wire a Gulfstream optional claimer Jan. 28, and led flagfall-to-finish once more in the GIII Honey Fox S. over the same course Feb. 20. The firm Keeneland sod could only help her cause, and the six-year-old assumed her usual spot on the front end while tugging at rider Rajiv Maragh. She came back to Maragh on the backstretch and settled into an even tempo. Defending titleist Forever Together skimmed the rail before tackling Wasted Tears from the outside in the lane, but the frontrunner dug in gamely and fended off the champ all the way to the wire.

"[Owner/ breeder/trainer Bart Evans] told me to just get along with her," Maragh reflected. "She's very talented and [Evans said] as long as I get along with her and make her feel like she is doing it on her own, she would give me a good kick, and she sure did." Together Indy, a grandson of MGISW I Ain't Bluffing, hit the board in his first two career starts at Gulfstream in 2009 before thumping New Jersey-bred maidens by eight lengths at Monmouth in May. After a half-length score in a state-bred allowance at the Oceanport oval July 12, the dark bay came up two lengths short over yielding ground in the Tap Admiral S. at Saratoga Aug. 3, and found himself on the sidelines. He faltered to a last-of-eight finish in his return, the GIII Appleton H. at Gulfstream Mar. 20, and was trying the all-weather for the first time here. Ravalo (Mutakddim) and Imperial Council vied for the lead through fractions of :23.18 and :46.12, with Together Indy sitting just off them inside in fourth. Congressional Page got first run on the leaders, but the Garden State native shifted off the rail, ranged up three wide and finished strongly for his first black-type trophy. "The most important part was in the paddock when [trainer] Mr. Weaver told me he had tried to put some speed in this horse in the mornings and wanted me to use it this afternoon," jockey Kent Desormeaux explained. "I think the first 50 yards won the race because of his training." Weaver had been wanting to get his charge on the all-weather. "I saw this horse train a long time ago back in Ocala over a synthetic surface, and he trained very well," he said. "We needed the race at Gulfstream, and this race was coming up to my liking." Silver Timber has proven to be one of the sharpest \$25,000 claims in recent memory. Haltered from trainer Linda Rice for that amount last April out of a Gulfstream dash, the grey secured a New York-bred optional tagger at Belmont in May, then triumphed in the GIII Jaipur H. over that course in July. He was second by a neck to Royal Ascot runner Cannonball (Catenus) in Saratoga's Commentator S. Sept. 6, and shipped to Santa Anita off a score over this course and distance in the GIII Woodford S. Oct. 10. Silver Timber encountered traffic down the hill in the Nov. 7 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint last time out, and wound up sixth. The crowd's choice skimmed the rail here as Moralist led from Grand Adventure through a :44.30 half. Forced to angle out in the lane, Silver Timber responded to jockey Julien Leparoux's handling and came charging on the outside. "I was worried he would be a little rusty," said winning trainer Chad Brown. "I had not run him after that long a layoff before, but he has been training very good and we had a top jock on him, so I felt pretty confident that he would be right there." Jan. 9, Touching Beauty got back on track with a narrow decision in a seven-panel Gulfstream allowance Mar. 14, and was the second choice in her return to New York. She raced alongside the favorite just off the duelling Anchorage (Tapit) and Volare Cantare (Roman Ruler), and took to the outside turning for home. Meanwhile, the favorite opted to come up the fence, but the tiring Anchorage drifted over and nearly took her out. Touching Beauty continued on her clear path and made it to the wire safely in front of the late-charging Speightful Affair. "If there ever was a time she was going to win going a mile, this was it," said winning trainer Jimmy Jerkens. "She's probably improving with more racing. When, where and with whom did you have your first winner?

As a rider, I won the first race I ever rode at Arlington Park with a horse called Scary Mary in 1976, I think. I was working for a guy

called Don Gibbons. I was getting big fast and he told me I'd better ride fast. Somehow or other we won. It was a great experience to see the other side of a fence. A couple of years after that I got my trainer's license and I won my first race with a filly named Inside Job at Sportsman's Park in 1980.

How has the business changed since you got involved? It's gotten much more competitive. It's tough to compete with the supertrainers. Managing a smaller group of horses, it's not as tough as if you're managing 300 horses. As far as the employees and the riders, you don't have the people that are there for their lives anymore. It isn't a life for as many people as it used to be, it's more like a 9 to 5. The tracks are geared towards gambling and not towards horse racing. It's the love of the horse that holds the industry together and we need that. When we went to Hot Springs, it was really neat. It's all about horses there. You go to Saratoga, it's all about the horses, Keeneland the same.

Do you have an idol in the business? Allen Jerkens. When I was going out on my own, he was always helpful with information. I could go to his barn tomorrow morning and say, 'This horse has got this problem, what should I do?' He's the kind of guy that would come to your barn. He's a great horseman.

How did you celebrate your win at Oaklawn? We went to [co-owner] the Lieblongs' house, they live in Conway, AR. We stopped there for two hours. They have a little barn there, so we put Duke in the barn and then had a wonderful brunch.

What do you do to occupy yourself when not training horses?

Fishing. I'm just a nut for it. Mostly offshore, deep sea fishing. I try to do a dark day in the barn. I've got great assistants and I take the day off. My assistant at Gulfstream, Don Stetler, he's phenomenal.

What is your favorite vacation destination? Anywhere there's water. But we made a road trip last week. I've got a gooseneck horse trailer. We loaded up Duke and drove the 19 hours to Arkansas.

If you could talk with any horse, who would it be and why? Ruffian.

There was just something about her. But I don't know if we'll see a better horse than Zenyatta. Ruffian was a little before my time, but Zenyatta, she's unbelievable.

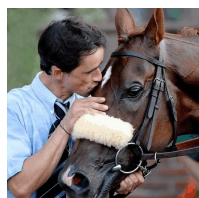

McManus-owned and Jonjo O'Neill-trained 10-year-old, who was heavily backed into 10-1 joint-favoritism in a momentous gamble. Never far from the lead, he took over from **Black Apalachi (Ire)** (Old Vic {GB}) at the last fence and powered away from that rival to score by

five lengths. "It means everything to me to win the Grand National--I've won lots of big races and I'm supposed to be a good jockey, but not winning the Grand National would have been a negative on the CV," McCoy said. "My trainer put me on the right one, if the truth be known. I asked him to toss a coin, and I think he tossed it a few times until he got Don't Push It. I couldn't have picked it, but Jonjo was very adamant and I didn't argue with him. If you get enough goes at something and you keep going, you've always got a chance. I'm delighted for J. P. [McManus], as he's the best supporter this game has ever had and ever will have." McManus added, "I want to thank Frank Berry, as he found the horse in Listowel--without him, I don't think we would have had the horse. Full marks to Jonjo and the team at Jackdaws Castle, as he's been a difficult horse down the years to keep right. He can get hot, and it's been difficult to keep his mind right." O'Neill, such a stellar jockey himself in his prior career, remarked, "I thought it would never happen to me.
