ONE TO GROW ON

Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) signalled Classic intent with a smooth win in the G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp yesterday. The bay was successful in a newcomers' event at Deauville Aug. 7, but slipped one spot in a conditions event at Chantilly Sept. 2. He closed his juvenile campaign with an impressive six-length conditions victory at Saint-Cloud Sept. 24, and was making his black-type bow in his 2010 opener. Positioned second until coaxed to the front at the two pole, Planteur took a clear advantage into the final furlong and was pushed out to easily keep the late-surging **Rewilding (GB)** (Tiger Hill {Ire})--a half-brother to recent G1 Dubai Sheema Classic heroine Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire})--at bay. "Planteur showed a great deal of promise as a two-year-old, and confirmed that in very good style today," enthused trainer Elie Lellouche. "He will now run in the G2 Prix Hocquart [back here May 16], or he might go straight to the [G1] Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 6] without another run. We will see what the horse tells us." The Wildenstein homebred is out of the unraced Plante Rare, a half-sister to group winners Policy Maker (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), Pushkin (Ire) (Caerleon) and Place Rouge (Ire) (Desert King {Ire}), and hails from the family of Arc hero Peintre Celebre (Nureyev). Noble's Promise (Cuvee), fifth as the 8-5 favorite in Saturday's GI Arkansas Derby, came back from the race with lacerations on both front legs, suffered when he was roughed up between horses soon after the start.

"Everything that could have gone wrong went wrong yesterday," said Walter Blum Jr., assistant to trainer Ken McPeck.

"He had problems getting saddled, then it was all over right at the start of the race. He's all cut up and we had to treat him with antibiotics." As for

State of the Union...

Stately Victor (Ghostzapper), upset winner of the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Saturday, exited the race in good order and was back at his home base at Churchill Downs Saturday night. "He came out of the race fine--excellent," trainer Mike Maker said. Maker has already mapped out a plan to get the colt to the May 1 "Run for the Roses." "He will work six or seven days out from the Derby, and that will be it," said the conditioner, who will saddling a Derby runner for the first time. Maker will also send GII Lane's End S. winner **Deans Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) to the first leg of the Triple Crown. The Ken and Sarah Ramsey homebred worked five-eighths in 1:01 4/5 on the Trackside training track Saturday. "He worked well, and he will work every Saturday or Sunday prior to the Derby," Maker said.



CLIFFS TUNES UP FOR RETURN

Last year's G2 Coventry S. winner **Canford Cliffs** (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) came through his latest workout with flying colors yesterday ahead of his comeback in Saturday's G3 Greenham S. Trainer Richard Hannon revealed that his G2 Richmond S.-winning stable companion **Dick Turpin** (Ire) (Arakan) would also line up in the seven-furlong trial. "Canford Cliffs was ridden by Richard Hughes, and he came up with Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) and Soul City (Ire) (Elusive City), so it was a very satisfactory piece of work that will have put him spot-on for Newbury," Hannon said. "We will also run Dick Turpin in the Greenham; he also worked this morning and we were pleased with him, too. In a perfect world, we would keep them apart, but both are Group 2 winners and would incur a penalty for the Craven at Newmarket on Thursday."

'Show' Readied for Nell Gwyn Test...

Jaber Abdullah's **Music Show** (Ire) (Noverre) is on course to run in Wednesday's G3 Leslie Harrison Memorial Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket, trainer Mick Channon announced yesterday. Unveiling the plan for the G2 Rockfel S. winner, the West Ilsley-based conditioner commented, "She has the ability to be a genuine contender [for the 1000 Guineas], but I think we have to run her. It makes far more sense than working her at home and sending her on a racecourse gallop."

Apapane capped her championship campaign in 2009 with a win over this course in the Hanshin Juvenile Fillies S. Dec. 13. The bay filly was second in her seasonal opener, the G3 Tulip Sho on the yielding local ground Mar. 6, but was favored to go one better here. Reined in to race in midfield, Apapane shifted to the outside in the straight and changed gears impressively in the center of the course to secure this Japanese Classic. The Oka Sho--named for the cherry blossoms that are currently in bloom--is now accorded international Group 1 status. Cutlass Bay bagged a win at Argentan in his only juvenile contest, and followed up with victory at Fontainebleau in his three-year-old bow last March. His sophomore campaign was curtailed by injury after victory in the May 12 G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud, but he justified favoritism in this comeback to maintain a perfect record conceding weight all round. Settled in sixth and shaken up at the top of the straight, the bay quickened to the front with 300 meters remaining and possessed enough of a buffer in the closing stages to safely hold the wide late bid of Court Canibal. "I am very pleased and it was a very good performance," trainer Andre Fabre told *Racing Post*. "The [G1 Prix] Ganay [back at this track May 2] is a possible target, but we shall see." In quest of her fourth straight victory, Unzip Me went right to the front and never looked back to get it done in her graded-stakes bow. The chestnut capped off 2009 with an open-company allowance score going six furlongs on the Hollywood weeds, and added an optional-claiming success over this course and trip Jan. 28. She was coming off a first black-type tally in the Mar. 20 Irish O'Brien S. against Cal-breds. Quickly into stride, Unzip Me cut out relaxed splits of :22.56 and :45.24, gave 'em the slip at the top of the lane and held the field at bay in the final sixteenth to win handily. "She's relaxing so much better now," jockey Joe Talamo said. "She had her ears straight up the entire race today." Favored Gotta Have Her, runner-up in the Nov. 7 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint last time out, was near the back early after bobbling at the break and closed late to get up for third. Racing wide in mid-pack throughout the early stages, the grey quickened to stalk that rival as the pace increased three furlongs from home. When the pair drew clear to settle down and fight out the finish, it was the cast-off's perseverance under driving that proved decisive as he out-gunned his former stablemate. Kargali, who registered a second black-type success here following his win in the Listed Heritage S. at Leopardstown 12 months ago, improved on a 14th-placed effort in the Mar. 21 Irish Lincolnshire H. over an extra furlong at The Curragh. "She came back full of mucus, gunk--tried to get sick on me," trainer Richard Mandella said. "She's fine; she's not real sick, but there's a bunch of mucus in her trachea. We're treating her, then we'll bring her home [to California]." The four-year-old was perfect in three starts last year, but was sidelined after taking the May 10 GII Railbird S. She opened 2010 with an allowance tally at Santa Anita Feb. 18, and is now 4-for-5 with earnings of \$162,600.

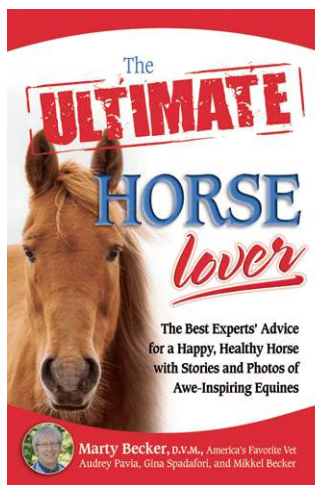
