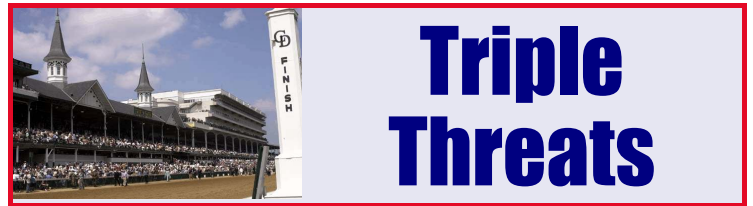

SPLIT DECISION IN BROWN-VERSUS-LAUFFER

A Kentucky court has ruled that owner James Lauffer must pay Jerry Brown, the owner of Thoro-Graph, \$25,000 for his role in advising Lauffer to buy an interest in Rachel Alexandra. However, Brown was seeking a far larger settlement in his civil suit against Lauffer. After the decision was announced Monday by Judge John David Preston, who heard the suit in Johnson Circuit Court in Paintsville, Kentucky, both sides declared victory. Lauffer had admitted that he and Brown talked about Rachel Alexandra prior to his purchasing a share in the filly during her two-year-old campaign, but contended they spoke only briefly and that Brown's advice was not instrumental in his decision to buy a piece of the horse. He also argued that no agreement was ever reached between the two as to what, if anything, Brown would be paid. Brown's argument was that Lauffer used his services and his expertise and would not have bought part of Rachel Alexandra without him advising the owner to do so. When Rachel Alexandra was sold to Jess Jackson after her win in the Kentucky Oaks, the debate between the two intensified because of the amount of money involved. "Mr. Lauffer, all along, offered Jerry Brown a five-percent commission, which he understood was the going rate when a purchase like this is made," said Tom Miller, the lawyer representing Lauffer. "He got \$25,000, which is exactly equal to a five-percent commission and exactly what we had always offered. That's a very reasonable decision under the circumstances." Andre Regard, the lawyer representing Brown, said he was pleased the court ruled that his client had to be compensated for his services. He disputed the claim that Lauffer was willing to pay Brown \$25,000 all along. "They found that Mr. Lauffer could not avoid his responsibilities to pay Mr. Brown," Regard said. "Lauffer said he didn't owe Jerry a cent. This shows that the court determined he was liable and had to pay Jerry and that the recommendation and analysis of Jerry was important and valuable to Lauffer in making his decision." Brown had been seeking a "disgorgement" of the entirety of the profits Lauffer made as an owner and seller of Rachel Alexandra, which totaled about \$4.9 million. His claim was that Lauffer should pay that amount in damages.

Regard said an appeal could be made based on the court dismissing some of his assertions that Brown was entitled to more money. "We're going to review the record and review the opinion with a fine tooth comb," Regard said. "We believe the court should have given more credence of the fee structure of Brown, and that's something we very well could bring up on appeal."



Odysseus Out of Derby...

Padua Stables' GIII Tampa Bay Derby winner **Odysseus** (Malibu Moon), who finished last when making his synthetic-track debut in Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, came out of the race with a chip in his left knee. The colt is being treated by Dr. Robert Hunt at Hagyard Equine Medical Institute in Lexington. "We're still evaluating the extent of the injury, and what our best option will be for him to make a full recovery," said Padua Racing Manager Sasha Sanan. "We're not quite sure yet if he will require surgery, but we are optimistic that he will have a good prognosis for a return to the races." The chestnut earned **"TDN Rising Star"** status after romping by 15 lengths in an optional claimer at Tampa Bay Feb. 17. After pressing the early pace in the Mar. 13 Tampa Bay Derby, Odysseus dropped back at the top of the lane, but came on again late to win it by a nose. Sent right to the front in the Blue Grass, he stopped badly on the turn, finishing some 12 lengths behind 40-1 winner Staley Victor (Ghostzapper). His record stands at 5-3-1-0, with earnings of \$219,920. **Aikenite** (Yes It's True), who finished just a neck in front of Odysseus after pressing the pace in the Blue Grass, has also been taken off the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby trail.

Under regular exercise rider Dominic Terry, the four-year-old filly worked through fractions of :12.80, :25.40, :37.20, :48.40 and 1:00.20. She galloped out seven furlongs in 1:25.20. The work was the fastest of seven at the distance yesterday. "I was very pleased with her work," trainer Steve Asmussen reported. "She looks happy and she cooled out great. It was a very strong move. I'm very anxious to see her attitude off of the work. How she acts, how she rests in her stall and if she's comfortable with everything we're doing. From a work standpoint, it was very impressive and fast, which she is." Rachel Alexandra was second in the Mar. 13 New Orleans Ladies S. in her only 2010 start to date, and her next start remains up in the air.

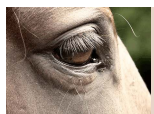

Even though Adena Springs has a formidably impressive history, including five consecutive breeders' Eclipse Awards, last week's happenings at Keeneland must still have been very satisfying for the Stronach organisation. Thursday saw the GI Vinery Madison S. fall to Dr. Zic, who became the first Grade I winner for Milwaukee Brew, who is now based in Canada for the Adena Springs/Gardiner Farms partnership.

Then, two days later, the shock success of Stately Victor in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. provided a landmark first graded victory for 2004 Horse of the Year Ghostzapper. For good measure, it was a former Adena Springs stallion, El Prado, who was responsible for the Blue Grass runner-up, Paddy O'Prado. **Cont. p4**

I am probably guilty of British understatement when I say that Ghostzapper needed this Grade I win. Having started out at \$200,000 in 2006, his fee had fallen to \$125,000 by 2009, when his book declined to 84 mares, and it was then slashed to \$50,000 for this year, after his second-crop yearlings averaged just under \$73,000 (off a \$150,000 fee).

Clearly Ghostzapper hasn't been fast out of the gate as a stallion, but was it fair to expect him to be matching strides in the early stages with some of his more

precocious contemporaries? Even though he was pretty spectacular on his debut at Hollywood Park in November of his juvenile season, he disappointed next time and wasn't asked to race again for another six months. Nor was he asked to tackle stakes company until the end of August. He finally became a stakes winner a

month later, when he trounced the opposition in the GI Vosburgh S. Even that impressive victory wasn't enough to persuade Bobby Frankel to subject him to the white-hot competition of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at that stage of his career.

This patient approach paid off handsomely. Having received an International Classification of 116 for his three-year-old efforts, Ghostzapper topped the following year's World Rankings with a figure of 130, earned with a perfect record of four wins from four starts. Even though we saw him only once at the age of five, his victory in the GI Metropolitan H. was good enough to secure him top weight of 128 among the older horses on the World Rankings.

At this point it is well worth adding that Ghostzapper's sire Awesome Again was another who got better and better as he matured. Assigned 117 on the International Classification as a three-year-old, Awesome Again did so well at four that his rating rose to 130, just one pound below the formidable Skip Away. Awesome Again now has 38 stakes winners to his credit, but only six of them achieved stakes-winner status at two.

Ghostzapper's broodmare sire Relaunch was another who needed a little time, waiting until the Del Mar meet as a three-year-old to score his first stakes successes.

Perhaps, in the circumstances, we shouldn't be too shocked that Ghostzapper has taken until now to come up with an important winner.

And what do we make of Stately Victor after his 40-1 triumph? Although there seemed to be no fluke about his win, can he fare any better at Churchill Downs than the three previous winners of the Blue Grass since its switch to synthetic?

Dominican, who got the better of Street Sense by a nose in 2007, could finish only 11th behind his old rival in the Derby; Monba, the 2008 winner, trailed in last; and General Quarters, the 2009 hero, could do no better than 10th.

Collect the Cash was conceived when Dynaformer's fee was \$17,500, but that didn't stop her earning more than \$430,000. Although she won one of her five starts on dirt, she was much more successful on turf.

Collect the Cash's second dam, the good broodmare Cricket Club, was by Dr. Fager, a horse whose record in some ways resembled Ghostzapper's. Both were fast enough to win the Vosburgh, while possessing enough stamina to win over a mile and a quarter at the top level.

Dynaformer has shown an affinity for mares with Dr. Fager blood, siring five graded winners from them. He sired his first graded winner, Rabiadella, from a Dr. Fager mare, plus the Kentucky Derby third Blumin Affair and the dual Grade I winner Critical Eye from mares by Dr. Fager's son Dr. Blum.

Stately Victor is the fourth Grade I winner so far out of a daughter of Dynaformer. This figure is likely to rise significantly in years to come, as Dynaformer's fee was no higher than \$30,000 prior to 2002. His first daughters sired at fees of \$50,000 or more weren't born until 2003, so the eldest progeny of these mares with deeper pedigrees are only just approaching racing age. They should be well worth keeping an eye on.

As Stately Victor has yet to win on the main track (and disappointed on a previous visit to Churchill), he still has plenty to prove. One thing in his favour is that the extra distance in the Derby is unlikely to worry him. He was staying on in fine style at the end of the Blue Grass and he is out of a Dynaformer mare, Collect the Cash, who gained her finest victory in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup over a mile and an eighth.

ALAN SEEWALD DIES Trainer Alan Seewald, a perennial presence at Monmouth Park since the mid-1980s, died yesterday at his New Jersey home. He was 62. A native of Brooklyn, New York, Seewald obtained his trainer's license in 1984. He conditioned fan favorite Teddy Drone (Drone) to eight stakes victories from 1988 through 1995. This season, Seewald saddled **Uptowncharlybrown** (Limehouse) to victory in Tampa Bay's Pasco S. and a third-place effort in the GIII Sam F. Davis S. The colt is expected to start in Saturday's GII Coolmore Lexington S. at

Keeneland. "Alan's passing is a tremendous loss for the entire Monmouth Park community," said Monmouth Park Vice President and General Manager Bob Kulina. "He was a good friend and horsemen--an all-around great guy. Alan was one of those people that everyone rooted for. He was just such a kind person. 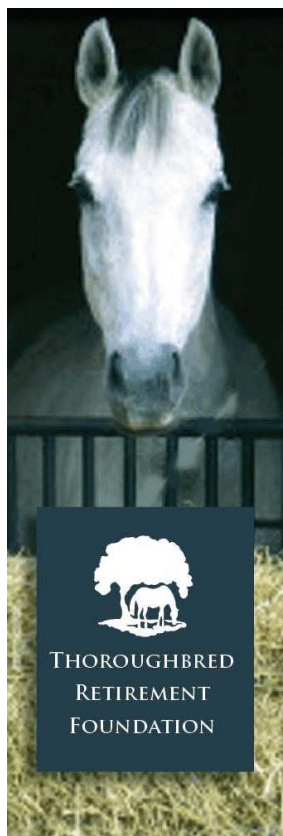
