## PLAY BALL!

Trainer Todd Pletcher could just about field a baseball team with his Triple Crown candidates for 2010.

Pletcher already has seven of the top 20 three-year-olds

(by graded earnings) in his barn, a line-up headed by ante-post Kentucky Derby chalk Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway). Another son of Giant's Causeway from the Pletcher barn, **Connemara**, could earn his way onto the bench with a strong effort in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at

Keeneland today. Connemara captured his first two starts, breaking his maiden at Turfway in October and adding an Oak Tree allowance tally in November. Second in the Jan. 16 California Derby at Golden Gate, he raised his batting average to .750 with a victory in the Feb. 20 GIII El Camino Real Derby. The Magnier, Tabor and Smith colorbearer was the 17-10 favorite in the Mar. 27 GII Lane's End S., and closed after trailing early to be third. His connections have not committed to a run for the roses for the synthetic specialist, but, if he made it to the gate, Connemara could give the Coolmore conglomerate its only Derby starter this year. ## NYRA APPEALS TO BC BOARD

New York Racing Association officials sent a letter to Breeders' Cup Chairman William S. Farish Jr. Thursday, requesting that Belmont Park host the 2011 championship event. The Breeders' Cup has been held at Belmont four times, most recently in 2005. In the letter, Chairman Steven Duncker and President Charles Hayward stated, "NYRA also firmly believes that the Breeders' Cup event should rotate among three or four racetracks in North America, and that Belmont Park should be included in this rotation. An annual rotation on a regional basis gives Thoroughbred owners, trainers and racing customers in every section of the country the opportunity to participate in the Breeders' Cup without having to incur significant cost and travel time." The Breeders' Cup Board will meet Apr. 22 in Lexington, and future sites are expected to be a major topic, including the possibility of a permanent host site, which is rumored to be Santa Anita. Duncker and Howard added, "Moving the Breeders' Cup to a single location, particularly to southern California and Santa Anita's artificial racing surface, imposes a severe hardship on horsemen and racing customers." They concluded, "Finally, the absence of a Breeders' Cup in rotating locations would clearly marginalize the Belmont Fall stakes program, particularly historic races such as the Jockey Club Gold Cup, that are conducted on one of the safest dirt racing surfaces in the country." The Wertheimer et Frere homebred went gate to wire in the Mar. 27 Rushaway S. at Turfway Park, and could be alone on the lead again today. Two Derby winners in the past 30 years have prepped in the Lexington--Charismatic, who captured the race in 1999, and Swale, who was second in 1984.

Alex Rankin's **Tar Heel Mom**, two-for-three over this track, ships back north after wintering in Florida. The dark bay mare capped of 2009 with a win in the Nov. 11 In Her Glory S. at the Big A, and opened 2010 with a close-up third in the Jan. 9 GIII Sugar Swirl S. at Gulfstream. Second in the Feb. 13 GIII Hurricane Bertie S. and Mar. 14 GII Inside Information S., she looks to earn her first graded victory here. **Justwhistledixie** is in quest of her first trip to the winner's circle in more than a year. The West Point Thoroughbreds and Lakland Farm runner captured the GII Davona Dale S. and GII Bonnie Miss S. in Hallandale last year, but was sidelined after finishing second in the GI Acorn S. in June. Second in her return, the Nov. 27 GII Top Flight H. at Aqueduct, she has been fourth in both 2010 appearances--the Jan. 17 GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita and Feb. 27 GIII Sabin S. at Gulfstream. "She's been a bit of a disappointment, but [trainer Bill Mott] has been happy with the way she has been working lately," said West Point President Terry Finley. "We hope the change in scenery helps."

This is one of the most intriguing renewals of the Greenham in years due to the presence of arch-rivals **Arcano** and **Canford Cliffs**, who reached the top of the tree among 2009's fast juvenile brigade. They clashed in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August and, after the former got the better of subsequent

G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Special Duty (GB) (Hennessy) and a disappointing Canford Cliffs, both were not sighted again. Arcano's rider Richard Hills is expecting there to be major improvement from his mount. "He's going to need the run tomorrow and is being trained for the Guineas, not the Greenham, so the outing will benefit him," he said yesterday. "It's a good trial and we'll learn a lot, but he's a small and compact speed horse, which you need for the Guineas." There has never been any secret of the regard in which Canford Cliffs is held in the Richard Hannon stable, and his impressive six-length defeat of subsequent G2 Vintage S. winner Xtension (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. in June showed what he is capable of to the watching world. Hannon also saddles the G2 Richmond S. winner **Dick Turpin**. "We have said that he is the best we've had and he looked awesome at Royal Ascot last year, but now he has to go and prove that he is as good and maybe even better as a three-year-old," Hannon commented. "The professionals are telling me that he'll prove to be a sprinter, but none of us here are going along with that theory. If we did not have Canford Cliffs, we'd be more than happy to claim Dick Turpin as our number one Guineas contender. He was a big two-year-old and has really blossomed through the winter, filling out in all the right places."

🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 **Lady of the Desert** was a flagbearer for the Brian Meehan stable in 2010, and followed a smooth success in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot in July with an even more impressive display in York's G2 Lowther S. the following month. Third behind Special Duty (GB) (Hennessy) and the re-opposing **Misheer** when the 11-8 favorite for the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October, the daughter of the 2002 winner Queen's Logic (Ire) (Grand Lodge) is partnered for the first time by Kieren Fallon. "I have only ridden her in work over shorter trips at home, and she travels for fun and gives you a great feel," said Fallon. "She feels great and her work has been brilliant, so if she stays the seven furlongs, she will be the one to beat." Misheer was also an accomplished juvenile. After getting closest to the tearaway Jealous Again (Trippi) in Royal Ascot's G2 Queen Mary S. in June, she comprehensively beat **Habaayib** and subsequent G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up Lady Darshaan (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket the next month. The filly failed to get involved in the G2 Flying Childers S. over five furlongs at Doncaster in September, but was back in the zone in the Cheveley Park, and trainer Clive Brittain is excited to unleash her again. "I think she's strengthened up over the winter and everything suggests that she's gone the right way," Brittain told *PA Sport*. "She ran very well in the Cheveley Park and was running on strong enough at the end to suggest this step up to seven furlongs won't be a problem." Ed Dunlop is hoping that G3 Albany S. winner Habaayib can bounce back from an eighth in the Cheveley Park.

The well-travelled **Gone Astray** has raced at a different track in each of his last seven starts, and tries out the Chuck Town surface for the first time today. "He likes to run around out there, and he should like getting a third turn. Of course, you never know for sure until they do it, but I think he should handle it."

**NYC OTB BOARD TO MEET TODAY** The Board of Directors of New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation will hold a public meeting this morning at 11 a.m. to discuss the immediate future of the company. NYC OTB was slated to close at the end of operations last Sunday, Apr. 11, but the Board voted to remain open, giving the state legislature an additional week to come up with a plan that would provide some economic relief. Legislators failed to come to terms before going into recess Wednesday. "The future is up in the air," said NYC OTB spokesman David Vermillion. "There's not much to say right now other than the executives at OTB are working their hardest to determine the best plan going forward." NYC OTB issued a statement yesterday, assuring its customers that funds in wagering accounts and from uncashed winning tickets were secure. "Customer funds are held in a separate bank account, designated as containing 'customer' funds and deposits, that is fully funded and entirely segregated from the Corporation's own corporate funds," said the release. "In the unfortunate event that NYC OTB ceases operations, a limited number of branches will remain open in Queens, Brooklyn and Manhattan for six calendar days after the last day of operations so that customers can cash tickets/vouchers and make account withdrawals. Thereafter, these transactions can be conducted at NYCOTB's customer service center, located at 1501 Broadway in Manhattan, for up to six weeks. The locations that will remain open temporarily are: 107-40 Queens Blvd. (Forest Hills-Queens); 67-19 Bay Parkway (67th Street-Brooklyn); and 515 7th Avenue (37th Street-Manhattan). The hours of operation will be from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on the six calendar days following the last day of operations." My wife, Pam, and I are retiring on the same day, and we're excited about the future." Mooney is from a racing family--his grandfather, J.D., piloted Balck Gold to victory in the 1924 Kentucky Derby and later trained Canadian Horse of the Year Crafty Lace. His father, John, was president of the Ontario Jockey Club tracks, Laurel Race Course and Arlington Park.

FALLON ESCAPES SERIOUS INJURY IN PADDOCK

**INCIDENT** Kieren Fallon faces a spell on the sidelines after being kicked in the leg by his intended partner at Newbury yesterday. Fallon was later taken to the Royal Berkshire Hospital in Reading for precautionary X-rays on his upper right leg, but was given the all-clear after it was confirmed that he had not sustained a fracture. His agent Dave Pollington told *PA Sport*, "He's left hospital, the X-rays have all come back clear and he just has some severe bruising. I don't know whether he will be riding tomorrow or when he will be back, we haven't got that far yet."
