NO OAKS FOR INJURED SHE BE WILD

Last year's champion juvenile filly **She Be Wild** (Offlee Wild) will not run in the GI Kentucky Oaks after sustain-

ing a leg injury Sunday morning, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The three-year-old was going through a routine gallop at Keeneland and emerged from the exercise with a fractured left pastern. Trainer Wayne Catalano told the publication that the filly wouldn't necessarily be retired. "Dr. Gary Priest inserted a screw in the leg, and everything went well," said Catalano. "The filly's fine now, and that's the main thing. Obviously we're very sad about it, but it's part of the game."

Owned by Nancy Mazzoni, She Be Wild ran third in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3 in her most recent.

ANOTHER SHOT OF 'BOURBON'

Who needs the scotch and beer when the bourbon is so good? Doing George Thorogood proud yesterday



was **Bourbon Bay** (Sligo Bay {Ire}), who completed a rare sweep of Santa Anita's three graded grass marathons in yesterday's 1 3/4-mile GI San Juan Capistrano H. Coming off victories in the GI San Luis Obispo H. Feb. 21 and GI San Luis Rey H. Mar. 20, Bourbon Bay rated kindly well off the runaway leaders, but kicked into gear in the lane and outfinished **Unusual Suspect** (Usual Heat) to win by a half-length. He becomes just the third horse to sweep the series, following Astray ('73) and Kotashaan (Fr) ('93). "He's going to be getting a rest," trainer Neil Drysdale said afterward. "One

mile and three quarters was stretching it a bit. We're probably going to have a tired horse. ZAYAT PLAN INCLUDES ESKENDEREYA SALE

In a Chapter 11 bankruptcy reorganization plan filed last Friday, Ahmed Zayat's Zayat Stables projected it will sell a 100-percent interest in top Kentucky Derby prospect **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) in 2010. The

plan, filed in a New Jersey federal bankruptcy court, did not set a specific date for a sale and did not include a valuation of the colt, who will be the likely favorite in the Derby as he comes off dominating consecutive wins in the GI Fountain of Youth S. and GI Wood Memorial. Zayat Stables is being sued by Fifth Third Bank for allegedly defaulting on payments on loans totaling some \$34

million. Zayat countersued, alleging Fifth Third engaged in deceptive and predatory lending practices. Friday's filing offered detailed projections by Zayat Stables regarding income from both purse winnings and the sale of horses, as well as expected outlays, including the continued purchase of racing prospects. To date, Eskendereya has won four of six races and earned \$725,700.

He capped off the year with a neck score in the Dec. 26 Radio Nikkei Hai Nisai S. The dark bay made it four in a row--all at 2000 meters--in the Mar. 7 G2 Hochi Hai Yayoi Sho, and was looking to continue his streak here. Rated near the back of the pack, he closed ground from the inside on the backstretch. Jockey Yasunari Iwata steered the colt through traffic in the straight, and he accelerated once clear, taking the lead in the final 100 meters and edging clear. Proud Heiress took advantage of a likely fitness edge over the returning odds-on pick Tribal Belle to collect her first graded success. The chestnut, twice placed in graded company in two previous tries over the Toronto oval last season, won her first black-type event in the Wishing Well S. at Turfway Jan. 9. She just missed by a nose when runner-up in that track's Queen S. Mar. 27, and was the second choice over a favorite who was making her first start since November. At the back of the pack under a confident Chantal Sutherland, Proud Heiress came flying down the center of the track and tagged Tribal Belle and Silver Z in a three-horse photo on the line. "She's getting better with age," said trainer Wayne Mogge. "The race set up perfectly." Stepped up to 11 furlongs on his return, the homebred recorded a gutsy win as the highweight in a handicap on Dundalk's Polytrack nine days before this rapid rise in class. Sticking close to the Ballydoyle second-string At First Sight throughout, the bay gained the edge in their private war with two furlongs remaining and dug in to prevail by a short head as that rival rallied gamely in the closing stages. "Even as a two-year-old, all he ever did was get to the front and do what he had to do--he's very laid-back and takes it all in his stride," jockey Kevin Manning said. "That's the type of horse he is, and he stays well and sticks at it. At home, he doesn't show us a great deal, but on the track it's 'never-say-die' with him."

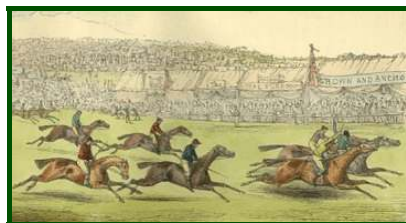

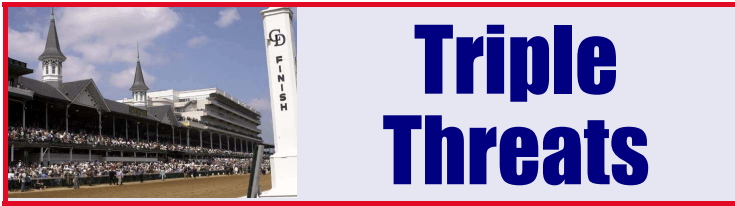

Cliffs Still on Guineas Trail...

Trainer Richard Hannon yesterday confirmed that Saturday's vanquished **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}) will run in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Upset by stable companion **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) in Newbury's G3 Greenham S., last year's impressive G2 Coventry S. winner is set to be taken off the pace in the May 1 Classic. That will mark a departure from the front-running tactics employed as a two-year-old, and in Saturday's race, where he veered to the left, as he had done when third in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August. "It was more an inconvenience than a setback, but we do need to find out why he drifts so alarmingly to his left," Hannon commented. "It cost him the Prix Morny at Deauville, and now it has cost him the Greenham, and it is baffling, as he always goes as straight as an arrow at home. We will ride him differently at Newmarket--Hughesie [jockey Richard Hughes] will bury him in the pack and ride him to get the mile and, having been off since last August, he is bound to improve." Hannon also revealed that Dick Turpin was more likely to wait three weeks after Newmarket for the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh. "Dick Turpin will always prefer a bit of dig in the ground, so The Curragh could be the favoured route, especially as he has already won there. But he is entered at Newmarket and Longchamp, so we will keep our options open for the time being," Hannon said.



Triple Threats

Tiz Chrome Fatally Injured in Churchill Work...

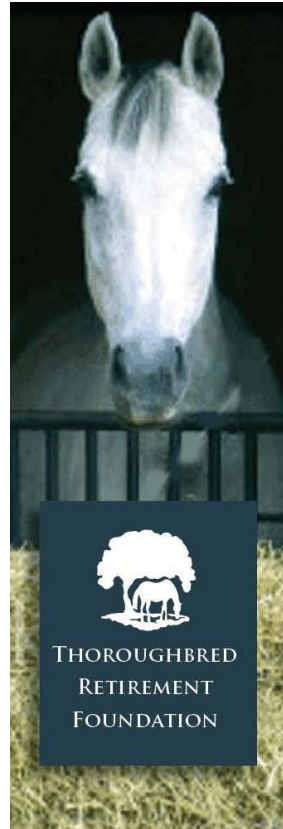
Lanni Family Trust, Bernard Schiappa and Mercedes Stable's **Tiz Chrome** (Tiznow--Woodland Shadow, by Woodman), a promising stakes-winning sophomore, was euthanized at Churchill Downs yesterday morning after fracturing a sesamoid in a workout. The Bob Baffert-trained colt was preparing for Saturday's GIII The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial at Churchill. Working in company with four-year-old stablemate Underground (Indian Charlie), Tiz Chrome was heading toward the far turn when he fractured a sesamoid in his left front. Exercise rider Dana Barnes was thrown to the

track, but was not injured. Tiz Chrome was euthanized minutes later. "He was at the five [furlong pole] and they were going easy, and she said when he switched leads, that's when he did it," Baffert said. "He must have stepped wrong or something, that's all I can think. He was perfect going into the work. You can't really blame it on the track. It was just a bad step." The track was fast when the mishap occurred around 8:50 a.m. EDT, just after the new 15-minute daily training session devoted exclusively to contenders for the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks. Tiz Chrome broke his maiden at first asking for trainer and co-owner Allen Crupper at Churchill sprinting six furlongs last November, then, after being sold privately, won the restricted Stuka S. at Hollywood Dec. 19 in his first start with Baffert. Sent off the even-money choice in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita Feb. 13, the colt failed to see out his first test around two turns, finishing a tired fourth to Caracortado (Cat Dreams). He compiled a record of two wins from three starts and \$67,850 in earnings. Tiz Chrome was a grandson of Grade I winner Fantastic Look (Green Dancer).

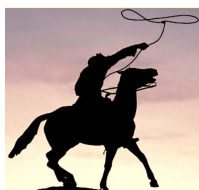

Soaring Empire to Derby Trial...

OI Memorial Stable and C.E. Glasscock's **Soaring Empire** (Empire Maker), eighth after a rough start in the Mar. 20 GI Florida Derby in his most recent, is now likely for Saturday's GIII The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial S. at Churchill Downs Saturday, trainer Cam Gambolati said from his base at Palm Meadows Saturday. The \$190,000 KEESEP yearling, third in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill last November, got up to take a first-level allowance race at Gulfstream in his seasonal debut Feb. 25. In his next, the Florida Derby, he was bumped hard at the start and was in tight later in the race and wound up 14 lengths behind upset winner Ice Box (Pulpit). "He's not really a bad gate horse," Gambolati said. "But I felt he would probably get stirred up with the start right in front of the grandstand and the size of the crowd. It won't be an issue at Churchill. They start back in the chute, where it's quiet and a long way from the grandstand." Regardless, Gambolati said Soaring Empire has received additional gate work in the mornings. "We schooled him a lot here at Palm Meadows since the [Florida] Derby," said Gambolati, who added that Bob Duncan, former head starter for the New York Racing Association, worked with Soaring Empire extensively the past few weeks. "He didn't do a thing wrong for Bob and hasn't done a thing wrong in the mornings," said Gambolati. "I don't anticipate any problems in Kentucky."



RACING Round-Up

Stephen Foster, Jumps in Store for Researcher?

Plans for Saturday night's \$1 million Charles Town Classic hero **Researcher** (Two Smart) are undecided, but the six-year-old gelding could be sent over the jumps in the not-too-distant future. Researcher won last year's inaugural Charles Town Classic, but in his defense of the lucrative event was making his first start for Zohar Ben-Dov's Kinross Corporation--a prominent name in steeplechase circles. Neil Morris, trainer and farm manager for Kinross, confirmed that Researcher had been purchased with steeplechasing in mind. "He's exactly what a steeplechase outfit like us would be looking for," said Morris. "I think there will be one or two more races on the flat through the spring, with the thought of going over hurdles in the fall. He will go back to the farm." One possibility for Researcher is the GI Stephen Foster H. in June. Researcher finished seventh in last year's Foster, but was beaten only 2 1/2 lengths. "There is some talk of the Foster," Morris added. "We will see." Meanwhile, the second Charles Town Classic proved to be a successful night financially for the West Virginia track, with both total handle and single-race handle records set. Fans wagered \$2,584,876 on the 11-race card, setting a new high and topping last year's Classic day handle. Similarly, a new single race wagering mark was established, as \$648,005 was bet through the windows for the Classic.

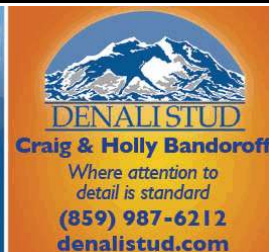

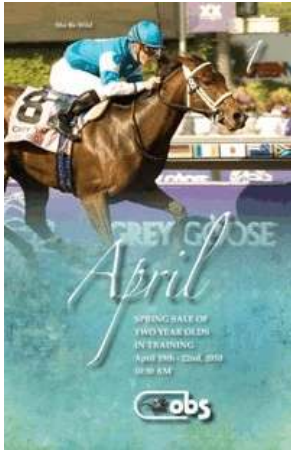

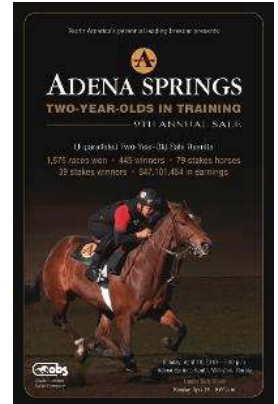

AWESOME AGAIN FILLY TOPS ADENA SALE A filly by leading sire Awesome Again brought the highest bid at last evening's Adena Springs Two-Year-Old in Training Sale in Williston, Florida. Silververton Hills LLC acquired hip [26](#) for \$115,000. A late May 8 foal, the gray, named Bahia Beach, is a daughter of the winning Alphabet Soup mare Pop Princess, herself a daughter of Grade II winner Relaxing Rhythm (Easy Goer) and sister to Grade II winner Spring Waltz (Silver Charm). It was the filly's second trip through the sales ring; she RNA'd for \$65,000 last year at Keeneland September.
