**IF AT FIRST YOU DON'T SUCCEED...**

It's been over a half-century since Tim Tam parlayed a win in the Derby Trial into victory in the Run for the Roses a week further down the road. In 2005, Don't Get Mad (Stephen Got Even) came with a furious finish

to take the Trial before acquitting himself very well on seven days' rest, finishing 3 1/2 lengths behind the victorious Giacomo (Holy Bull) in the Run for the Roses. The connections of at least two of today's participants are definitely in it to win it, with the goal of cementing a

spot in the Kentucky Derby gate if they want it.

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Eightyfiveinaffifty** (Forest Camp) stretches back out to Churchill's one-turn mile off a handy success in the GIII Bay Shore S. on the Wood Memorial undercard Apr. 3, and hopes to handle this route of ground better than his first try. That came in the Whirlaway S. in New York Feb. 6, when he blew the turn and dumped Jorge Chavez and jumped the outside rail. **Pleasant Prince** (Indy King) was fourth to Derby favorite Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 20, but came back four weeks later to miss by a nose in the GI Florida Derby. With an eye on some extra graded-stakes earnings, he came back in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 10, but was no better than seventh. He makes his third start in the span of 35 days this afternoon.

**THREE CHEERS FOR MUSKETIER**

Runner-up when a 27-1 chance in last year's GII Fifth Third Elkhorn S. at bucolic Keeneland Race Course, **Musketier (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) sat a midpack trip beneath John Velazquez, came out and around rivals in upper stretch and pulled clear for a 1 3/4-length victory. The win gave trainer Roger Attfield a sweep of the turf marathon events to close the meeting annually in Lexington. Subsequently ninth over an insufficient nine panels in Pimlico's GII Dixie S. May 16, he stretched back out to 12 panels to annex the GIII Singpiel S. at his Woodbine base June 21. Employing pacesetting tactics in the GI Man O'War S. at Belmont July 11, he held dourly for second behind Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat), but faltered to ninth after attending a brisk pace in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga Aug. 15. He made just one additional appearance in 2009, a last-of-six effort in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. Oct. 3. A touch slow into stride, Musketier was guided over to the inside to save some ground from centerfield as Timeless Fashion (Sky Classic) tried to slow things down up front. He advanced into sixth position on the turn and responded when asked to win handily. **Brass Hat** (Prized) rallied from the tail of the field to gain the place, while longshot **Blushing Bear** (Rahy) was a good third. **Expansion** (Maria's Mon) was perhaps the unluckiest participant in yesterday's event, as he was blocked for a run at a crucial stage and ran on late into fourth. **Chart p4**

Winner of over \$1.4 million in a 35-race career, the seven-year-old defeated **Monterey Jazz** and **Sir Al** in a Tapeta prep for this event Apr. 2.

**Paco Boy** registered his first score at this trip when garnering last year's renewal, and the dual Group 1 winner makes his seasonal return coming back off a second to Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in July's G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood. However, trainer Richard Hannon is at pains to point out that the G1 Queen Anne S. winner will not be risked on unsuitably fast going, and may be scratched. "The intention is to run as the race is set-up for Paco Boy and will put him spot on for the [May 15 G1] Lockinge S. at Newbury next month," Hannon said. "Last year we had to carry a six-pound penalty for our [G1] Prix de la Foret success the previous autumn, but this time he gets in with no penalty, so it is very tempting. I am told that they have watered the course twice this week, but they are talking about temperatures reaching 20 degrees [Celsius] on Saturday, so it will dry out quickly, and there is no way that I will mess up our season before we have started." Chief among his intended rivals is Juddmonte Farms' **Confront**, who backed up a pair of listed successes with victory in October's G3 Joel S. at Newmarket. He finished a close-up sixth in December's G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin next time, and returns to European action coming off a troubled effort in last month's G1 Dubai Duty Free at Meydan.

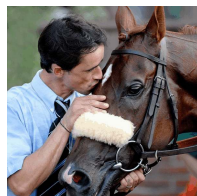

Snapped up by Godolphin following his closing second in the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. at The Curragh in September, Chabal took this Derby trial to bury the memory of a subsequently disappointing unplaced effort in Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. when last seen in October. Keen throughout the opening exchanges, the bay was eventually settled in last by Frankie Dettori before being wound up for his challenge in early stretch. Swooping wide to lead with a quarter mile remaining, he saw off Azmeel in the final 100 yards en route to a decisive score. "We were really keen that he relaxed and enjoyed his day out today, as in the Dewhurst he was a little bit keen," racing manager Simon Crisford said. "He's been very good throughout the winter and it's all worked out very well--he did particularly well to finish up like that with the lack of early pace. He's always moved well, so we didn't think the fast ground was going to be an issue, and he is a definite candidate for the [June 5] G1 Epsom Derby. He will hopefully go for the [May 13] G2 Dante S. at York first and we'll take it from there, but I think the extra two furlongs of the Derby won't be a problem. Whether the cambers of Epsom will be so good for him, as he's a big horse, is open to question and more importantly, it's a case of whether he is settled and relaxed." ### RECORDS FALL AT SOUTH AFRICAN SALE

Friday night saw records smashed at the Emperor's Palace National Yearling Sale. **Potala Palace (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) sold for R3.6 million (US\$485,000), to establish himself as the highest-priced yearling ever sold at public auction in South Africa. The previous record was the R3.3 million paid for Wonder Lawn (SAf) (Fort Wood) in 2005. Consigned by Highlands Farm, Potala Palace ([lot 10](#)) was knocked down to leading

trainer Mike Azzie. The son of Singspiel is out of the Group 3-placed mare Alignment (Ire) (Alzao). He hails from the wonderful Edinburgh (GB) family, responsible for such high-class international performers as Golan (Ire) (Spectrum), Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum) and G1 Epsom Derby winner North Light (Ire) (Danehill). Alignment herself was purchased at the 2006 Tattersalls December Mare Sale for 27,000gns. Then in foal to the multiple Group 1 winner Whipper, Alignment was subsequently sent to the Southern Hemisphere. The Whipper filly she produced is currently in training with top Cape trainer, Joey Ramsden. Connections are very happy with her progress, and she will be raced by Graham Beck.

A son of Fort Wood ([lot 93](#)) was the day's second highest lot, selling for R1.7 million (US\$229,265) to Form Bloodstock. Out of Copper Horizon (SAf) (Al Mufti), the yearling is a half-brother Copper Parade (SAf) (Lecture), the top juvenile of the current season. Consigned by Ascot Stud, the colt, named **Fort Benton**, is also a half-brother to group-placed Copper Jet (SAf) (Lecture).

The top-priced filly of the first session was a daughter of Jet Master (SAf). A flashy chestnut ([lot 63](#)), she was purchased by Cape trainer Glen Kotzen for R500,000 (\$67,000). The yearling is out of stakes winner Capture the Wind (SAf) (Al Mufti), a half-sister to group winners Enchanted Garden (SAf) (Roland Gardens {Ire}), Captive Prince (SAf) (Prince Sao {Fr}) and Captain Ekels (SAf) (Jan Ekels {GB}).

The first local crop of yearlings by Black Minnaloushe proved popular with buyers. The son of Storm Cat was responsible for Nine Tail Cat (SAf), a striking bay colt consigned by Klawervlei Stud. Sold as [lot 67](#), he was purchased by South African-born, Dubai-based trainer Herman Brown for R500,000 (US\$67,000). Brown has purchased eight lots at the sale so far. "There are plenty of nice, correct individuals on offer at this year's sale," Brown said. "There is a lot of depth to the sale, and I am very happy at the overall quality of the sale, which remains as high as ever."

Another sire with his first crop at the National Sale was G1 Vodacom July winner Greys Inn (Zabeel {NZ}). His colt ([lot 83](#)), consigned by Avontuur Farm, was purchased for R550,000 (\$74,000) by Form Bloodstock.

For the session, 72 horses sold for R23,276,592. The average rose 5.5 percent to R323,286 over last year's corresponding session. The sale continues on Sunday and Monday. Just under 100 yearlings went into the ring on Friday, and more than 400 other yearlings will do so on the final two days of the sale.

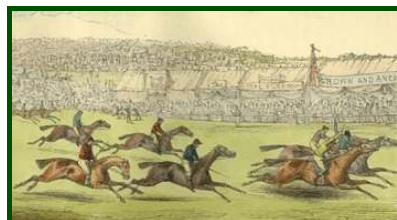

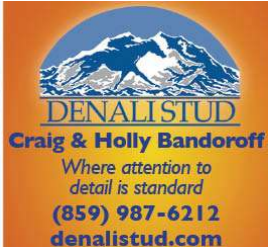

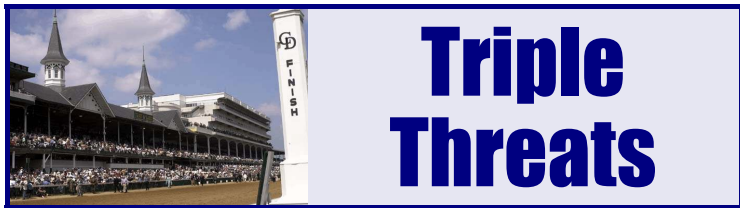

## Work of the Day--Paddy O'Prado...

By all accounts, the most impressive worker of the morning was **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}), the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. runner-up who went five-eighths of a mile over a sloppy Churchill strip in :58.40,

the best of 21 moves at the distance. The gray colt got his opening furlong in :12.20 and the quarter in :23.60. His three-eighths was accomplished in :35 flat and he galloped out six panels in an impressive 1:11.40, seven furlongs in 1:25.60 and the mile in 1:41.40. "He went

perfect--I couldn't be more pleased with how he went," trainer Dale Romans said. "He went fast, but he was well in hand, finished strong and galloped out good. He couldn't be coming into the race any better. This is a race in which you need to be peaking--and it looks like he's peaking."

## Maker Duo Go a Day Early...

With rain in the forecast for Saturday, trainer Mike Maker called an audible and sent out his two Derby hopefuls, GI Toyota Blue Grass S. hero **Stately Victor** (Ghostzapper) and GII Lane's End S. winner **Dean's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), for their final pre-race works yesterday morning at the Trackside Training Center. Breezing in company with stablemate Kera's Kitten (Kitten's Joy), Stately Victor went five furlongs in 1:00.60, in fractions of :11, :22.40, :34.60 and :47.20 before galloping out six panels in 1:16.60. "I was looking for what we got," Maker said. "He did it well within himself and galloped out strong as usual. So it's status quo. He hasn't lost an ounce of weight and to me looks to me as beautiful as he was going into the Blue Grass, so hopefully his synthetic track [form] will transfer over the to the dirt." Dean's Kitten worked in the company of three-year-old stakes-winning filly Age of Humor (Distorted Humor) and covered the same five furlongs in 1:01.20. Working as a team through splits of :11.20, :22.60, :35.60 and :47.80, Age of Humor edged to the fore in upper stretch before getting caught by Dean's Kitten at the wire. "It was a similar-type work and the results were about the same as last week," Maker said. "Dean's Kitten is not an impressive work horse, so he's status quo as well."

## Ice Box Gets Half-Mile Bullet...

Trainer Nick Zito wouldn't mind an off track on Derby day for Florida Derby winner **Ice Box** (Pulpit), who worked a half-mile in a sizzling :46.40, fastest of 27 works at the trip. "The work was really good and his gallop out was even more impressive," said Zito, who won the 1991 Derby with Strike the Gold and sent out Go for Gin in 1994. Did Ice Box gallop out all the way to the kitchen near the half-mile pole? "Yes. Yes he did, just like Strike the Gold," Zito said, beaming as he recalled that colt's final work before his Kentucky Derby victory.

## Borislow Buys in to Homeboykris...

Owner Daniel Borislow, who campaigned MGISW Toccet (Awesome Again) in the early 2000s, has purchased a minority interest in **Homeboykris** (Roman Ruler) ahead of his intended run in next Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby. The Midlantic-based owner joins a group that includes Los Angeles Dodgers manager Joe Torre, Louis Lazzinaro and Jack Mandato, among others. Homeboykris, winner of last year's GI Champagne S., is trained by Rick Dutrow Jr. and has not raced since finishing second in a Feb. 27 Gulfstream allowance over a one-turn mile. Borislow is the inventor of a device called magicJack, which allows one to plug their home phone into a computer to make and receive calls for an annual fee. "I've always done real well with Rick, a number of the guys are investors in my company magicJack, they asked me to come in and so I did," Borislow said. Dutrow conditioned Wild Desert (Wild Rush) to victory in the 2005 Queen's Plate for Borislow.

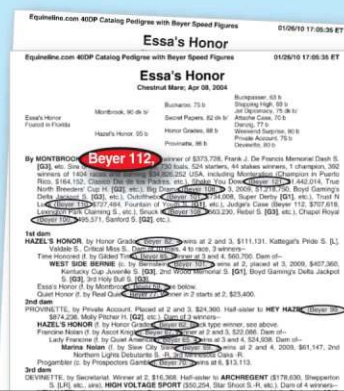

### NYCOTB Fires 35 Employees:

In a move that will save the organization a reported \$2 million a year, the New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation fired 35 non-union employees Thursday and Friday, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The publication reports that Sandy Frucher, who was named chairman of NYCOTB last year, said that the dismissals were the "first of many steps" the company will take in its effort to reorganize under Chapter 9 bankruptcy protection. The 1,300 employees of NYCOTB were informed several weeks ago that all of the company's betting parlors and its account-wagering operation would be shut down unless the state legislature intervened, but they changed their position last week and announced that it would remain in existence for at least the next year. According to *DRF*, Frucher has said that half of NYCOTB employees would be fired and that two-thirds of the betting parlors would be closed as part of its reorganization. Since the majority of NYCOTB employees are unionized, the company is pursuing legislation that would enable it to offer early retirement packages as a concession to the union, *DRF* reports.

"It was pleasing to see so many foreign buyers taking an active interest, in particular a number of different buyers from Korea, who took away 10 horses from the sale."
