WHAT'S SO FUNNY?

With only five lining up in Saturday's GIII Withers S. at the Big A, it figured to be a laughter for MGSW **D' Funnybone** (D'wildcat). Cash is King Stable's **Afleet Again** (Afleet Alex), who was a late supplement, didn't quite see it that way. The gray rallied from the back of the pack to pull off a 24-1 upset with the 1-2 favorite tiring to finish fourth. "We really hadn't considered this race before Wednesday," winning trainer Robert Reid Jr. revealed. "It was a small field, and I love the one-turn mile for him, and the big, sweeping turns here."

PLETCHER BREEZES FIVE; BIG HORSE WAITS

Trainer Todd Pletcher chose to wait a day or two before GI Wood Memorial S. hero **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) makes his final breeze for the GI Kentucky Derby, but sent out five others for tune-ups beneath the Twin Spires in the sloppy conditions. Glencrest Farm's **Devil May Care** (Malibu Moon), the GII Bonnie Miss S. heroine, remains possible for the Derby after a five-furlong breeze in 1:00.20. "Mr. Greathouse was out to watch

her work today and he was impressed with her just like we were," Pletcher said. "He said he'd be coming back Monday and we'd talk then about whether she might go in the Oaks or the Derby." Pletcher continued, "Actually, I checked with the racing office and we can enter her in both races. We're aware of how that can affect other horses and we don't want to be in the way of keeping horses out of either race, but on the other hand we've got to do right by our horse, too. You might have a case where she might draw the 20 [post position] in the Derby and the six in the Oaks, and that would play into any decision. We'll have to see."

IKE ROCKS DERBY TRIAL LIKE A HURRICANE

Dawn and Ike Thrash's **Hurricane Ike** (Graeme Hall) couldn't catch the speedy **Eightyfiveinafifty** (Forest Camp) in the GIII Bay Shore S. at Aqueduct earlier this month, but it was a different story in Saturday's GIII The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial S. at Churchill Downs. Sent off at 5-1, Hurricane Ike waited in second as 3-2 chalk **Eightyfiveinafifty** splashed his way through fractions of :22.62 and :45.39. With Calvin Borel aboard, Hurricane Ike slipped through along the inside to take over entering the stretch and drew off over the muddy track to score by 2 3/4 lengths over **Aikenite** (Yes It's True). **Eightyfiveinafifty** tired to finish a well-beaten fourth. "We were hoping he'd like the track," winning trainer John Sadler said. "We don't have that much experience with off tracks in California, especially real sloppy tracks. This horse ran a good race in New York." As for what's next Sadler added, "The Preakness is an option or we might take him to the Dwyer in a couple of weeks. We'll probably look at something back [East] in the short term." Derby Trial cont. p5

considered, I thought all the works were spot-on with what we hoped for," Pletcher said. He continued, "They all did well, but Super Saver is really doing well. He's training the best he's been since we've had him. He seems to be getting better and better. And I know he likes this track. I don't know why, but I know he does." Leader of the pack **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway) was out for a two-minute lick Saturday. "He's doing well," Pletcher said. "He went a mile and three-eighths this morning and everything is good. He's scheduled to work [Sunday]. We're hoping for a break in the weather. He's never been on an off track and that was part of the reason we didn't work him today. We could work him [Sunday], or Monday, or Tuesday. He's a big, robust colt and I have some options with him."

Sidney's Candy Fires Bullet...

Santa Anita Derby winner **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) fired a six-furlong bullet beath Joe Talamo in 1:11.60 over the Churchill slop Saturday. "It was a good work," trainer John Sadler revealed. "I was looking for a strong work coming into this race and he got it today. I would have preferred to have worked him over a fast track--that's what we're likely to see here next week--but we didn't have a choice. I'd say the conditions were less

Rachel Pointing for La Troienne...

Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) is targeting Friday's GII La Troienne S. at Churchill Downs Friday, majority owner Jess Jackson announced yesterday. Last term's runaway GI Kentucky Oaks heroine kicked off her four-year-old campaign with a stunning defeat, placing second in the New Orleans Ladies S. at Fair Grounds Mar. 13. "Right now we're pointing there," Jackson confirmed. "We'd like it to be. Her workout Monday will tell us a lot more. It'll be light; it's not going to be a bullet. We want to see that she stays on track and improves every time she goes out and that's what's been happening the last two or three times. She's getting ready."

City Cup Saturday at Singapore's Kranji Racecourse ([video](#)). He remains perfect in nine career appearances in Singapore and is on track for a start in the KrisFlyer International Sprint May 16, a race in which he was nar-

rowly defeated in 2009 by Sacred Kingdom (Aus) (Encosta de Lago). "It's not a monkey off my back--it's a gorilla," said jockey Robbie Fradd, who was roundly criticized for taking Rocket Man out of his element when riding the gelding from off the pace in the Shaheen. "There was a bit of pressure on me after Dubai. There was a bit of a hiccup and it was my fault. I have to thank [trainer] Pat [Shaw] and [owner] Fred [Crabbia] for sticking by me--this horse means the world to me." Should Rocket Man perform well in the KrisFlyer Sprint, he could rematch with Kinsale King in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot in June.

Vision d'Etat on the Shelf..

Eric Libaud's multiple Group 1 hero **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) faces a spell on the sidelines following his latest outing in Meydan's G1 Dubai World Cup. Only 12th in that Mar. 27 contest, the five-year-old is undergoing tests after returning sore. "Vision d'Etat is now back at home having undergone

scintigraphy," Libaud told *Racing Post*. "We needed an in-depth test to find out if there was anything seriously wrong with the horse and there wasn't. We have now decided that he needs a two-month rest before we start a new programme for

him in the second part of the year. We will try to find him a trial before he goes to Newmarket [for the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16]. The horse is in very good shape physically and seems happy with himself. We must just be patient."

Last seen chasing home Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood in August, Paco Boy showed no signs of rustiness with a smooth display here. Successful in this race under a maximum penalty 12 months ago, the bay was unburdened this time despite winning last year's G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot. That was his second victory at the top level following his breakthrough performance in the 2008 G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp, and he has since established himself in the very highest category of Europe's sprinter-milers. Without cover while racing close to the pace here, he was held onto until deep stretch and, when asked, produced his customary deadly turn of acceleration, upstaged Pressing passing the furlong marker and surged clear. "Hughesie said everything went wrong in the race, but that looked probably his most impressive performance," the trainer's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr. said. "He will go for the G1 Lockinge S. [at Newbury May 15] now, and you will struggle to find one to beat him on that running. We've been gasping to run him for six to eight weeks, as his coat looked great in January and he kicked some windows out of his box two weeks ago. The G1 Queen Anne S. [at Royal Ascot June 15] is also on the owners' agenda and he could come back in trip for the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 3]--they are looking at all sorts of races in all countries."

Bassett, Mooney Win Book Award:

James E. "Ted" Bassett and Bill Mooney were awarded the fourth-annual Dr. Tony Ryan Book Award at a ceremony at Castleton Lyons Friday evening. The award carries a prize of \$10,000 and was sponsored by the Ryan family's Castleton Lyons and the *Thoroughbred Times*. Bassett and Mooney were honored for their collaboration "Keeneland's Ted Bassett: My Life," an autobiography of Bassett's experiences in and out of racing. A longtime industry leader, the popular octogenarian has led a colorful life. After graduating Yale University, Bassett served in the Marines and participated in the Pacific theater during World War II. A chapter of the book is dedicated to his time as a director of the Kentucky State Police during the turbulent 1960s, which Mooney called his favorite in the book, simply because he was least familiar with that aspect of Bassett's life. Bassett is best known, however, for his time at Keeneland, which saw him serve as president and general manager, chairman of the board, and trustee during his 40-plus year tenure. The book was published by The University Press of Kentucky.

During his acceptance speech, Bassett said that the writing of the book, which took over three years, was itself an exciting chapter of his life. "It was a combination of fear and exhilaration," he told the crowd. "Fear that you're going to fail and that nobody would ever open the book; exhilaration at the end that we actually finished it and had an amazing response like this." Mooney, a two-time Eclipse Award-winning writer who resides in Lexington, said that he had never before given so much of himself to a project, and told a few humorous anecdotes. He related a story of a book signing at a Borders Books that went awry when he and Bassett arrived, only to find store management had no idea a signing was planned. Worse, the store had only a single copy of the book on hand. So Mooney and Bassett took the names of the 30-strong crowd that had gathered and arranged for them to receive signed copies later.

Bassett and Mooney beat out two other finalists. They were Lynn Reardon, a first-time author who wrote, "Beyond the Homestretch—What I've Learned from Saving Racehorses," (New World Library); and Andrew Plattner's "The Kentucky Derby Vault: A History of the Run for the Roses," (Whitman Publishing LLC). Both Reardon, who lives in Texas, and Atlanta resident Plattner, were on hand. The runners-up each received a check for \$1,000 and a crystal trophy.

In his acceptance speech, Mooney said that the judges could have named him and Bassett the winners by only the slimmest of margins, and that he himself considered it "a three-way dead heat."

The award was established by the late Tony Ryan, who wanted to support the promotion of Thoroughbred racing through literature. His son Shane Ryan, who now heads up Castleton Lyons, has pledged his continued support of the award.


