## FAVORITES BOOKEND DERBY FIELD

Churchill Downs oddsmaker Mike Battaglia made California-based **"TDN Rising Stars"** **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) the 3-1 morning-line favorite and fellow Golden Stater **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) the 5-1 second choice for Saturday's 136th running of

the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs. Owned by Mike Pegram--whose Real Quiet (Quiet American) took the 1998 Run for the Roses--Karl Watson and Paul Weitman, Lookin at Lucky drew the inside post, which has not produced a winner of the race since Ferdinand in 1986. Under the two-tiered draw process of the last several years, the one hole was routinely among the final to be selected, and Pegram will try to make the most of it Saturday afternoon. "When you get lemons you make lemonade, right?"

he said following the draw. "There is no use in crying about it. All we've got to do is think positive. Real Quiet was buried down on the rail (No. 3) and he came through. It's all about position and I've got the best jockey. We'll just see what happens."

Lookin at Lucky will be ridden by jockey Garrett Gomez, who rode the Bob Baffert-trained Pioneerof the Nile (Empire Maker) to a runner-up effort as the 6-1 third choice last year. Pegram has full confidence in the two-time champion jockey. "I feel very comfortable with Garrett," he commented. "Garrett has been around there. He knows how to do it and we'll get there. That's the good thing about Lookin at Lucky. Coming in, I wasn't apprehensive because he's talented enough that he'll be able to run his race from anywhere."

Lookin at Lucky will look to join Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}) as the only two-year-old champions to wear the blanket of roses, and could use some good fortune, which has been in short supply in his last three runs. Unlucky not to take the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile from the outside post, he overcame trouble at the half-mile pole to win the GII Rebel S. Mar. 20 and was closed off on the fence in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3 before rallying into third. "It's better to have a good trip than a good post position," Pegram offered. "It's ironic that he drew the total outside in the Breeders' Cup and then he comes and draws the rail in the Derby. If we get a good trip, there is no reason why this horse should not run his race. We'll find out if he's good enough to win."

**Candy From the Outside...**

Sidney's Candy was the immediate beneficiary of the trouble Lookin at Lucky found in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but that is not to suggest the Craig homebred was going to be caught that afternoon. The chestnut colt has not been headed in his three victories this season, but that should all change with speedballs such as GI Arkansas Derby winner **Line of David** (Lion Heart) and GIII Southwest S. hero **Conveyance** (Indian Charlie) signed on. No matter the shape of the race, trainer John Sadler couldn't help but be disappointed by the outcome of Wednesday's pill pull. "Not the best of draws. What can I say?" he admitted. "At least you're outside and can see what's going on. It just shows you how tough it is to win any race, and especially this race. But what are you going to do? That's how it works. You've just got to deal with what you've got and do the best you can with it." In 2008, Big Brown (Boundary) proved that horses can overcome the 20 hole to win the Derby.

**Endorsement Injured...**

WinStar Farm, whose **Rule** (Roman Ruler) was declared from the Derby earlier this week, suffered heart-break yesterday when GIII Sunland Derby winner

**Endorsement** (Distorted Humor) sustained a condylar fracture of his right front ankle in what was to be his final pre-Derby workout. Breezing over a drying-out track labeled "good," Endorsement went a half-mile in a bullet (1/17) :47 2/5, but Shannon Ritter, who trains the colt and rides him in his trackwork, knew something was amiss. "I noticed it when we were walking home," Ritter told *Daily Racing Form*. "Obviously it's very disappointing. It's hard to get to the Derby." The fracture was reported to be non-displaced, and Endorse-

ment could undergo surgery as soon as today. WinStar will still be represented in Saturday's race by **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon), winner of the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs last November and American Lion (Tiznow).

**Make Music for Me, Backtalk In...**

The injury to Endorsement and the decision by trainer Todd Pletcher to forgo the Derby with GII San Felipe S. runner-up **Interactif** (Broken Vow) means that **Make Music for Me** (Bernstein) and **Backtalk** (Smarty Jones) were able to draw into the Derby field. Trained by Alexis Barba, Make Music for Me graduated in the grassy Pasadena S. at Santa Anita Mar. 6, but was no better than sixth to **Stately Victor** (Ghostzapper) in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 10. "It's very exciting, but you feel bad for the other person," said Barba, who had entered her charge in Friday's GIII American Turf S., but will now scratch. "You're glad you're in, but you're sad for the other person, that's just the way it is." Joel Rosario was originally booked to ride **Dean's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), with a contingency to ride Make Music for Me if he drew in. Robby Albarado, who was to pilot Endorsement, picks up the ride on Dean's Kitten. Backtalk looked a longshot to make the starting gate, but now gets his chance. "We're fortunate that we're one of the last horses to get in," said Tom Amoss, who trains Backtalk for Gold Mark Farm. "Even though we didn't find out until Wednesday that we were going to get in the race, all along we've been planning as if we were going to run so it hasn't affected his preparation." Backtalk, winner of the GIII Bashford Manor S. beneath the Twin Spires and the GII Sanford S. at Saratoga last season, enters the Derby off a distant third to **American Lion** (Tiznow) in the GIII Illinois Derby Apr. 3.

**Homeboykris Gets in His Work...**

Homeboykris (Roman Ruler) finally got in his final prep for Saturday's race, going a half-mile in :48.40 beneath exercise rider Joe Deegan. "I couldn't be happier. He went really good. Jockey Joe was really happy with him," said trainer Richard Dutrow Jr., who called the shots with Big Brown. "He said he got over [the track] the right way--a very good breeze for him. It's all good." Homeboykris went in fractions of :11.80, :23.80 and :35.60 before galloping out five-eighths of a mile in 1:02.20. Winner of the GI Champagne S. last October, the gelding has not faced the starter since finishing runner-up in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 27.

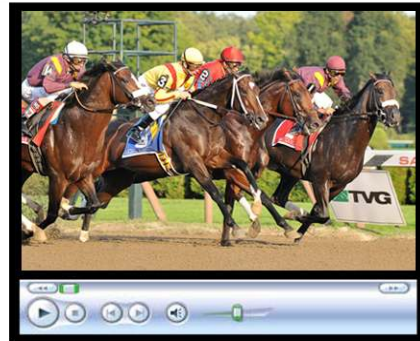

**MAY PRIMARY ELECTIONS TO WATCH**

Ten states will hold senate primary elections in May and those in Indiana (May 4) and Kentucky (May 18) could be particularly contentious.

Sen. Evan Bayh (D-IN) surprised many when he announced in February that he would not seek a third term. Having also served as governor for two terms, Bayh was popular among Indiana voters. The consensus choice among Indiana Democrat leaders to fill the seat is two-term Indiana U.S. Rep. [Brad Ellsworth](#) (D-8th).

The leading contenders for the Republican nomination and to face Ellsworth include former Indiana Sen. [Dan Coats](#), who was Bayh's predecessor in this seat, and former Republican Rep. [John Hostettler](#), who was easily defeated by Ellsworth in their 2006 House race.

In Kentucky, Sen. Jim Bunning (R) announced last July that he would not seek a third term. Secretary of State [Trey Grayson](#) and eye surgeon [Rand Paul](#) are competing to earn the Republican nominee for Sen. Bunning's open seat. Paul is the son of Rep. Ron Paul (R-TX).

Leading Democrats in the Kentucky primary are Lieutenant Governor [Daniel Mongiardo](#) and state Attorney General [Jack Conway](#).

"He's still a good horse and we've got plans for him this year." Trainer William Knight added, "Ian pestered me to try him over two miles, so I'm delighted he won. We thought we'd try this distance because, if he stayed, it would open up options for him. We've really got to stay at this trip now and he's in the [May 14 G2] Yorkshire Cup, so we might have a bang at that."

The seven-time Group 1 victress will begin her campaign, as she did last season, in the May 23 G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp before tackling the straight mile of the G1 Queen Anne S. June 15. "Goldikova has had a very good winter at her owners' stud farm," Head said. "She came back a month and a half ago and she's really well. We want to go to the Queen Anne at Royal Ascot with her and I think we need a run before that, so the Prix d'Ispahan is a good race for her to come back in. We'll forget about last year [in the Prix d'Ispahan] as the going was terrible that day and she didn't like it. If the going is as bad then we won't run, but at the moment the plan is to run in the race. I think it's a great thing to run her at Royal Ascot and I think it is a race she will like as she'll love the straight course."

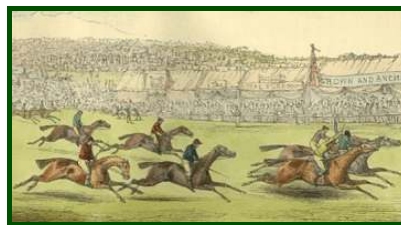
### Jackson-Affiliated Stables to Support Komen...

### Rain Expected at Newmarket

As the countdown to the weekend's Guineas meeting continued yesterday, Newmarket was still basking in above-average temperatures, and the official going remains good to firm, good in places, on the Rowley Mile track. However, atmospheric conditions are due to change and rain is forecast as temperatures drop to nearer the seasonal norm. "We are looking at two to three millimetres of rain on both Friday and Saturday," clerk of the course Michael Prosser told *Racing Post*. "I would imagine if we got six millimetres, which is what is predicted and is in line with other meteorological reports, we will end up going back slightly towards good ground and it may end up being spot-on good ground on Saturday. The wind is going to be more from the north and temperatures are going to be cooler. It was 21 [Celsius] Wednesday, but we will be going back down on Saturday and Sunday to 14 [Celsius], which is the seasonal average."

### Hills Confident of a Bold Show from Awzaan

Jockey Richard Hills, who rode Haafhd (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}) to success in the 2004 renewal of the G1 2000 Guineas, is confident of a bold show from his mount in this year's contest. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's retained rider will be aboard another son of Alhaarth for Saturday's one-mile Classic, the unbeaten G1 Middle Park S. hero **Awzaan (GB)**. "The last time I sat on him was [in a racecourse workout] at the Craven [meeting]," explained Hills. "It was a normal piece of work and he gave me a good feel. It was a good exercise gallop two weeks before the race. He's unbeaten and finished last season by winning a Group 1. He looks great and I can't see him being out of the first four. [The one-mile trip] has been brought up in the press, but [trainer] Mark [Johnston] and I are adamant he'll stay a mile. Whether he stays further or not, I don't know, but I'm very confident he'll get a mile. You've got to look at the race on the day, but they normally go a good gallop in Classics, especially at Newmarket. He's as straightforward a ride as you can get."

### Godolphin's Al Zir on Song, Poet's Voice Doubtful

Godolphin's G1 Racing Post Trophy third **Al Zir** (Medaglia d'Oro) has satisfied trainer Saeed bin Suroor in the build-up to Britain's first Classic of the year on Saturday. "Al Zir is improving all the time and we've been very happy with his preparation," bin Suroor told *Racing Post*. "He pleased Frankie [Dettori] in a main piece of work last week, and again Monday. He will be fine over a mile, but he does stay well and later in the season he may be even better over further." The trainer also served notice that fellow Guineas entry and G2 Champagne S. winner **Poet's Voice (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) is not a certain starter, and may instead point to the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 16, adding, "There is every chance Poet's Voice will be going to France, but a decision will be delayed for a day or two."

### Pasquier on Hearts of Fire

Stephane Pasquier has been booked to ride Pat Eddery Racing's G1 Gran Criterium winner **Hearts of Fire (GB)** (Firebreak {GB}) in Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. "Hearts of Fire seems fine, everything has gone well, so we are keeping our fingers crossed," said Eddery. "The ground won't be a problem, he has worked really well and is very healthy. He gets the trip well and has a real turn of foot, so he has a good chance."

### Fallon to Renew Ballydoyle Link

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has booked former stable jockey Kieren Fallon to ride G2 Champagne S. runner-up **Viscount Nelson** (Giant's Causeway) in Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas. O'Brien also confirmed jockey details for his other runners in the race, with Johnny Murtagh set to partner current favorite **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), and Colm O'Donoghue aboard **Fencing Master (GB)** (Oratorio {Ire}). "At the moment we hope to run all three of our horses in the 2000 Guineas on Saturday in Newmarket," said O'Brien. "All three horses have come through their preparations well."

### Buick booked for Lady Darshaan

Trainer Stan Moore has secured the services of jockey William Buick to partner G1 Ascot Fillies' Mile runner-up **Lady Darshaan (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) in Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. "Lady Darshaan had her final blow out [Wednesday] ahead of the weekend, all was well and I'm very pleased with her," commented Moore. "I just hope all stays good now until Sunday and William Buick has now been booked to ride her in the Guineas. It would be nice if a little bit of rain came, but I am sure Newmarket will make sure it is good, safe ground."

### Mullins Gets 30-Day Suspension:

Trainer Jeff Mullins has been handed a 30-day suspension effective May 9 by the California Horse Racing Board and fined \$2,500 for a TC02 violation that occurred in 2008. The incident violates the terms of his probation from another case in 2006 and could result in an additional 70-day suspension. The Mullins-trained Pathbreaking, third in a race at Del Mar Aug. 3, 2008, was found to have an amount of TC02 that exceeded regulatory thresholds. A hearing was held at Del Mar last summer, and the hearing officer's decision, proposed during an executive session of the CHRB Apr. 15, was accepted. Mullins was on probation for a separate mepivacaine violation and had served 20 days of a 90-day suspension. The remaining days were stayed subject to the conditions of his probation, which required that Mullins be charged with no further violations. Pathbreaking was disqualified from third, and all purse money was redistributed.

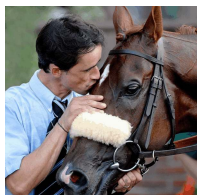
**FOR SALE SIGNS DOT HUNTER VALLEY** The 'for sale' sign is up on an unprecedented number of Thoroughbred properties in the Upper Hunter at present, with Patinack Farm's Aberdeen property, Baerami, Byerley, Kulani Park and Goanna Downs all on the market. MacCallum Inglis rural property sales manager Michael Burke said never before in Hunter Valley history had so many Thoroughbred nurseries been offered simultaneously. Although the Scone-based agency achieved a good result selling Liverpool Farm and the property previously known as Riverslea on the Segenhoe Road at Aberdeen, MacCallum Inglis is not expecting overnight results with the market for such pristine properties currently a little wobbly.

"The market is not strong, but in saying that we achieved successful results with Liverpool Farm and the part of Patinack formerly known as Riverslea--there is certainly still an interest in the stud property market but it is not outstanding interest, and that is as a result of a number of factors," Burke said. "The yearling market has steadied and stallion fees have come off the mark a bit over the course of the last couple of years and these things combine with GST to lessen demand. However, the Thoroughbred market in Australia has held up very well and the buoyancy of our market creates a strong attraction to buy into Australia at the moment."

Patinack's opulent Aberdeen farm is on the market as the Nathan Tinkler-owned Thoroughbred breeding and racing operation shifts its focus to its more expansive Sandy Hollow base. The property previously changed hands for about \$7 million.

"We are looking to international interests to compete on the property," Burke said. "This autumn represents an outstanding time to look to purchase Thoroughbred studs. We haven't had this level of properties available for prospective purchasers, we have genuine and motivated vendors and it's a great opportunity," he said. "These properties are not all on the market due to any one circumstances--it is the dissolution of a partnership in the case of two of the sales and Patinack is consolidating its operations on an aggregation of country at Sandy Hollow. They have outgrown what they have got at Aberdeen," he said. "There is also no correlation between these properties being on the market and the issue of coal mining in the region. The parties selling are staying in the industry and in the actual Hunter," he added.

The 207-acre Baerami property near Jerry's Plains will be auctioned on May 12. It features a six-bedroom homestead built in 2004. Patinack Aberdeen is at the confluence of the Pages and Hunter Rivers in the renowned Segenhoe Valley, close to Vinery, Arrowfield and Darley and features 55 hectares of fertile river flats. “Acre for acre, it is one of the better studs in the Hunter Valley,” Burke said.

Martin Hawcroft is selling Byerley Stud after 19 years in order to concentrate on other interests. “The property is in a unique position because of its ability to obtain income streams from all facets of horse husbandry, including standing stallions through to raising excellent yearlings, growing tonnes of Lucerne and raising good cattle,” Hawcroft said. The property is listed with John Flood Estate Agents. Expressions of interest close May 28.
