## SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

Still buzzing off Super Saver (Maria's Mon)'s runaway victory in last weekend's GI Kentucky Derby, Bill Casner and Kenny Troutt's WinStar Farm remains in the spotlight with

**Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) in today's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park. According to trainer Bill Mott, the GII Risen Star S. fourth-place finisher and GII Louisiana Derby third-place finisher can punch his ticket to

the GI Belmont S. with a big effort today. "The plan is, going into it, if he runs well to run in the Belmont," Mott said. "He displayed in his other races that his running style will suit the Belmont, and he seems to have good stamina." **Soaring Empire** (Empire Maker), a Gulfstream allowance winner Feb. 25, looks to get back on track following a disappointing eighth in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 20. "It was a maturity thing," trainer Cam Gambolati said of his effort in the Florida Derby. "He's a talented colt, and we were behind the eight ball, trying to make the Kentucky Derby, and he just wasn't ready. But the Dwyer is a great spot for him. The Belmont, of course, is a possibility, but we'll let him tell us where he'll go next. Right now, he's trained very well and I expect him to run well." The lightly raced **Remand** (Successful Appeal) enters off a good third behind Eightyfiveinafifty (Forest Camp) and Hurricane Ike (Graeme Hall) in the GIII Bay Shore S. Apr. 3. Trainer John Terranova swept Sunday's New York Stallion series with Franny Freud (Freud) and General Maximus (Freud).

## ESKENDEREYA RETIRED

Zayat Stables' GI Wood Memorial S. winner **Eskendereya** (Giant's Causeway--Aldebaran Light, by Seattle Slew) has been retired due to a career-ending soft tissue injury of his left front leg, it was announced late Friday evening. Jess Jackson has purchased an undisclosed interest; Zayat will retain a "significant ownership stake." Stud plans have yet to be announced. "It is heart-wrenching that Eskendereya did not have a chance to achieve his full potential and show what he was made of at the Triple Crown," Zayat said. "He is a once in a lifetime horse. [Trainer] Todd [Pletcher] and I discussed every other possibility before concluding that retirement was the only option and the right decision to protect Eskendereya's health. Mr. Jackson is the perfect partner for such a beloved horse, and I look forward to working with him as he has proven to be a true sportsman and a credit to our industry." Jackson added, "I am extremely pleased to partner with Zayat Stables in ownership of this magnificent Thoroughbred. Eskendereya is best of class and his progeny will only add to his legacy and that of American racing." The early favorite for the GI Kentucky Derby, he had to be withdrawn six days before the race, and subsequently underwent diagnostic testing in Lexington. Eskendereya was purchased by Zayat for \$250,000 as a KEESEP yearling. The chestnut broke his maiden with a 7 1/4-length romp in the off-the-turf Pilgrim S. at Belmont Park last October. *Cont. p2*

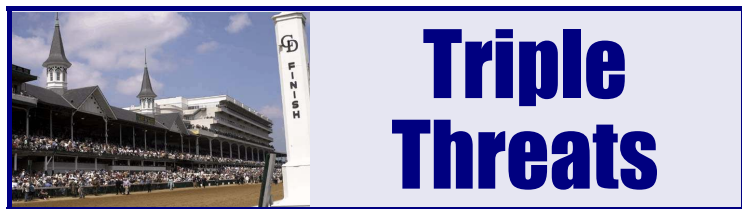

Ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he came back to take a Jan. 7 allowance at Gulfstream Park ([video](#)), and added an 8 1/2-length triumph in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. ([video](#)) before his 9 3/4-length Wood Memorial tally ([video](#)). "Eskendereya is as good a horse as I've ever brought to the Triple Crown races," Pletcher said. "We look forward to this next stage of his career as a sire and creating the next generation of racing stars." The three-year-old retires with a record of 6-4-1-0 and earnings of \$725,700.



**Aikenite Confirmed for Preakness...**

Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True), second in the GIII Derby Trial S. Apr. 24, will head to the GI Preakness S., it was announced Friday. The GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. third-place finisher will be ridden for the first time by Javier Castellano, who won the 2006 Preakness aboard Bernardini (A.P. Indy). He is trained by Todd Pletcher. "Aikenite has been training smartly at Churchill Downs since his second-place finish in the Derby Trial, and Todd Pletcher plans to work him on Sunday," Dogwood Stable President

Cot Campbell commented. "He will ship to Pimlico with his stablemate, and Derby winner, Super Saver, on Wednesday, May 12."

**Noble's Promise to Royal Ascot...**

Trainer Ken McPeek revealed yesterday that Chasing Dreams Racing's **Noble's Promise** (Cuvee), a valiant fifth in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby, will skip the GI Preakness S. and instead ship to Royal Ascot for the G1 St. James's Palace S. June 15. McPeek, who broke the news via a text message to Triple Crown Insider, had been considering the overseas venture for the colt prior to the Derby. After the race, however, he announced that connections had decided the trip would prove too expensive, and that the purse of the one-mile event, £250,000 (approximately \$370,500), did

not compare favorably to the \$1 million on offer for the Preakness. While McPeek admitted that the added three-sixteenths of a mile of the Preakness was a factor in the final decision, he added, "We questioned the distance, but he just needs more time."

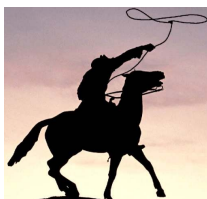

## Careless Jewel & Seattle Smooth Shuvee Bound...

Donver Stable's **Careless Jewel** (Tapit) will now set her sights on the GII Shuvee H. at Belmont May 15 after missing an intended start in Churchill's GII La Troienne S. Apr. 30. The GI Alabama S. heroine has been off since tiring to eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. "We are currently pointing for the [Shuvee]," trainer Josie Carroll said. "She's going to work on Sunday [at Woodbine], probably five furlongs, and we will then make a final decision." Regarding the audible to start in the Shuvee, Carroll added, "We had to fix something on her foot, nothing major. Other than that, she has been doing really well." Also pointing to the Shuvee is Mercedes Stables's **Seattle Smooth** (Quiet American), who has been off since annexing the GI Ogden Phipps H. last June. "We're looking forward to it," said trainer Tony Dutrow. "We'll think she'll run well. She's all ready to go."

with a seventh-place finish in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 20, then was a well-beaten fifth while making his first attempt for Bob Baffert in the Gill Derby Trial S. Apr. 24. Baffert, who shipped Mythical Power (Congaree) to Lone Star for a victory in the Gill Texas Mile Apr. 24, adds blinkers for this. Morning-line favorite **Henshin Hero** (Dance Master) makes his first attempt

beyond six furlongs. He had a two-race winning streak snapped when second in a turf sprint at Keeneland Apr. 16. The Lone Star Derby marks Henshin Hero's first try versus stakes company. Trainer Bret Calhoun said, "We wanted to stretch him out sooner, it just didn't work out, and we thought this was a good spot to try him at two-turns." **Crider** (Closing Argument) reported home fifth in Oaklawn's Gill Southwest S. Feb. 20, but was moved up to fourth via disqualification. He completed the exacta as the 1-2 chalk in a \$50,000 optional claimer at Oaklawn Mar. 27.

Godolphin collected 12 months ago courtesy of Mastery (GB) (Sulamani {Ire}) and ship in **Ameer** this time. Third in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud on his final juvenile start in October, he was denied by a head by Coordinated Cut (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the £250000 Tattersalls Timeform 3YO Trophy at Newmarket on his return Apr. 14. This Epsom prep has lost some of its significance since the days that Teenoso, Slip Anchor (GB) and Kahyasi (Ire) used it as a stepping stone to Blue Riband glory in the 80s, but High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}) did complete the double in 1998. Successful on debut over 10 furlongs at Newmarket's Craven meeting Apr. 14, he is on a sharp learning curve from here. "He has a Derby entry, but his Newmarket win leaves him a long way off being a Derby horse at this stage," owner Saeed Suhail's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told PA Sport. "I haven't seen him doing anything spectacular on the gallops, but Sir Michael would not have put him in these races if he didn't think he was a decent horse. We are confident he will get a mile and half--we actually think he needs a mile and a half."

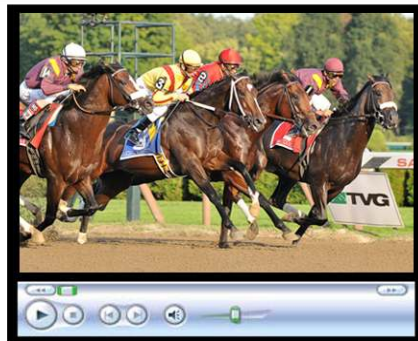

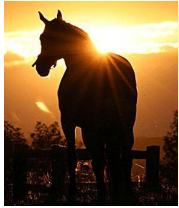

# SOPHOMORE SPOTLIGHT

## FULL TANK OF 'FUEL' FOR SECOND HALF

While Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) and Evening Jewel (Northern Afleet) put on one for the ages in the GI Kentucky Oaks last weekend, Canadian co-champion

**Biofuel** (Stormin Fever) remained north of the border at Reade Baker's Woodbine base.

The Brereton C. Jones homebred, a very unlucky fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last November ([video](#)), made a splashy sophomore debut in Woodbine's six-furlong Star Shoot S. Apr. 10

([video](#)). Jones was particularly impressed by the GIII Mazarine S. heroine's victory, considering what his charge had overcome this winter.

"In late December, she had abdominal surgery," the former Kentucky Governor revealed. "We were fearful that she had a twisted intestine, but it turned out that she had swallowed something that she couldn't digest at least a year and a half or maybe two years earlier. It had lain there picking up other residue of food particles over the years, and it was as big as your fist and as hard as a baseball. I didn't anticipate her getting back to the races until May or June, quite frankly."

In the Star Shoot, Biofuel stayed close to the leaders while last of five, was guided six wide by regular rider Eurico Da Silva into the stretch and kicked impressively down the center of the lane to win going away by two lengths. The bay lines up next in the 1 1/16-miles La Lorgnette S. at her home track May 23.

"As Reade said, after this race on the 23rd, if she runs as well as she's been training, then we go hunting for bear," Jones offered. "I would anticipate probably the same basic course we had Proud Spell on a couple of years ago when we focused on the Alabama."

Fellow Jones homebred Proud Spell (Proud Citizen), who captured the 2008 Kentucky Oaks, added wins in the GII Delaware Oaks and GI Alabama S. during her championship three-year-old season.

Biofuel has never raced on dirt in six career starts, making five attempts on all-weather surfaces and one on grass, but has trained smartly on it in the morning, Jones reports. The Kentucky-bred posted three workouts at Palm Meadows in March, including a three-furlong bullet.

"She's trained as well on dirt as she has on synthetics," the Airdrie Stud head confirmed. "She trained strictly on dirt when we had her as a two-year-old before she went to Reade. My original question was would she handle the synthetic...not, would she handle the dirt."

Biofuel proved she belonged on the big stage at Oak Tree last fall, finishing only 1 1/2 lengths behind champion She Be Wild (Offlee Wild)

following a nightmare run in the stretch. Settled in 12th for most of the way, she began to pick it up on the turn for home while racing very wide. Looking like a major player as she came flying down the Santa Anita stretch, Biofuel was knocked off stride after getting veered into sharply by Negligee (Northern Afleet), but miraculously re-rallied to complete the superfecta at odds of 20-1. She came within 3/4 of a length of third-place finisher and current division leader Blind Luck.

"She was so game," Jones said of Biofuel's effort in the Breeders' Cup. "First of all, I couldn't understand what Negligee was doing. She did a right turn, and we were on the extreme outside. Most horses would've stopped after that. It would've taken the wind out of them. It's like it made her mad. Had that not happened, I think it's quite conceivable that she could've won, or at the very worst, finished second."

Biofuel is the first foal out of Jones's unraced Indian Charlie mare Ms. Cornstalk. The six-year-old broodmare is a half-sister to 1989 GII Arkansas Derby hero and GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. fourth-place finisher Dansil (Silver Hawk), who was also bred by Jones.

"Ms. Cornstalk had numerable x-ray issues--it's tough enough to sell fillies who have clean ones sometimes," Jones said. "If you take a filly, particularly one not out of a mare that's had a lot of good horses and doesn't pass the vet, the chances of getting her sold are pretty nil...I decided not to even break her, so we never even knew if she could run or not. I bred her as a two-year-old; most people don't do that, but she was strong enough and big enough that I felt it was appropriate."

Jones continued, "I really love the family. I also owned Ms. Cornstalk's dam, Upper Dancer. It's a very good female family. The further back you go, the better it gets."

Ms. Cornstalk has also produced a two-year-old filly by Harlan's Holiday, a yearling filly by Johar, and a weanling filly by Flashy Bull. She was bred back to Claiborne resident Pulpit.

## Racing Round-Up

### PENN NATIONAL ACQUIRES SHARE IN MD TRACKS

Penn National Gaming Inc. has acquired a 50-percent share in Laurel Park and Pimlico Racecourse, and will operate the two Maryland tracks jointly with co-owner MI Developments, it was announced yesterday. According to *Daily Racing Form*, MID Vice Chairman Dennis Mills revealed that Penn National Gaming paid \$50 million for its stake, and will oversee the development of casino-style gaming at the two tracks. Mills said in a press release, "This transaction is consistent with our plan to enhance the returns of our racing and real estate assets and pursue other opportunities, including the potential for gaming, to benefit the value of the Maryland Jockey Club. Penn National is a strong partner with complementary pari-mutuel, real estate and gaming industry expertise, as well as a strong financial position. We look forward to working with Penn National, the racing industry and local regulators to develop business models that will ensure the ongoing success of these high quality assets." Penn National already holds a casino license in Cecil County, Maryland, and a law prohibiting a company from attaining more than one such license in the state will need to be amended in order for the tracks to offer expanded gaming in the future.

### Stronach Stepping Down at Magna...

In related news, *The Globe and Mail* in Toronto reported Thursday that Frank Stronach has agreed to give up his majority holding in his auto parts empire, Magna International. Under the terms of the deal, Stronach, who founded the company more than 50 years ago, will receive an \$863-million buyout, and will be left with a 7.44-percent share in Magna. Regarding the decision to sell, Stronach told *The Globe and Mail*, "It took a lot of reflection, a lot of soul searching." Stronach, 77, will continue in the position of chairman of Magna for four years, and will be in charge of Magna E-car systems, a division that will develop electric cars. The plan to step down had been in the works for some time and, while Stronach intends to be at the forefront of the electric car venture, he told *The Globe and Mail*, "I realize I can't manage the company from the grave."

### I Want Revenge Back on Work Tab...

**I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even), out of action since being scratched as the favorite on the morning of the 2009 GI Kentucky Derby, had his first breeze in more than a year at Aqueduct yesterday morning. The four-year-old went three furlongs in a leisurely :38.25, with a final quarter in :25, but the work was not without incident, *Daily Racing Form* reported. As I Want Revenge was nearing the pole, stablemate Break Water Edison (Lemon Drop Kid) fell just after completing a workout. Exercise rider Gustavo Rodriguez had to guide I Want Revenge off the rail in the stretch to avoid the stricken horse. "When I heard the siren [warning of a problem on the track], I was looking for a loose horse," Rodriguez told *DRF*. "When I didn't see it, I said, 'let me go ahead and breeze.' When I came into the lane, I said, 'this isn't going to be any good.'" Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said I Want Revenge came back from the work in good order, and could be ready to run in six weeks. Dutrow is confident the colt will return to the form he displayed in winning the Gill Gotham S. and GI Wood Memorial S. last year. "If the injury doesn't re-occur, I don't know why not," Dutrow told *DRF*. "He's young enough where he can still be a force." Break Water Edison suffered a broken shoulder and had to be euthanized. The four-year-old captured the Gill Nashua S. and ran second in the Gill Saratoga Special S. at two. Sidelined after being eased in the Gill Fountain of Youth S. last February, he joined the Dutrow barn in the interim. The bay won an Apr. 18 optional claimer at Aqueduct in his third start off the layoff, but finished last in an optional test five days later. A son of August Storm (Storm Creek), he had earned \$172,120.

## ★ NEW YORK ★

### Bruno Sentenced to Two Years:

Ex-Senator Joseph Bruno, convicted on two counts of "theft of honest services" by a federal jury last December, has been sentenced to two years in prison and ordered to pay \$280,000 in restitution. The former New York Senate majority leader's conviction stemmed from payments Bruno received for consulting work that it was determined he did not perform, and that were paid out by companies owned by a businessman who had lobbied for grants and other assistance from the state legislature. The 81-year-old also failed to disclose that he took part in a racehorse partnership with that businessman. Bruno could escape the jail sentence, however, as a case currently before the U.S. Supreme Court could determine the constitutionality of the "theft of honest services" law.

**PICA SLEW (Pico Central {Brz})**

You rarely see horses debut in stakes races. It's tough enough to win against other maidens, with all the new experiences for a young horse in his or her first afternoon trip to the track. But Pica Slew's owner/breeders, Sal and Colleen Simeone of Sienna Farms LLC, thought their young filly could handle the daunting task. She certainly didn't disgrace herself; the bay finished a troubled-trip sixth in the five-furlong My Dear S. at Woodbine June 28 of last year for then-trainer Gregory de Gannes.

"From what I gathered from the owners, they were so impressed with her in the morning that they thought she could win a race like that," explained new conditioner Joseph Calascibetta. "Who knows? With a better trip, she might have."

Perhaps the Simeones would have looked for a less ambitious spot for Pica Slew's first run had they known how productive a race the My Dear would prove to be. Her 10 1/4-length romp yesterday in a 5 1/2-furlong maiden race at Calder made her the fifth My Dear runner to win next out. Winner Midst (Closing Argument) returned to the races recently to take an optional claimer at Keeneland by 5 1/4; runner-up Franny Freud (Freud) has won four stakes since then, including the GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland Apr. 7; ninth-place finisher Singandprayfurrhen (Songandaprayer) won an allowance at Presque Isle in September; and last-place finisher Letter of the Law (Stormy Atlantic) returned victorious in the Turf Starlet S. at Penn National.

Pica Slew was sidelined for 10 months after her debut. She joined the Calascibetta barn about six weeks ago.

"I never really asked and [the owners] never really offered," said Calascibetta as to what prompted the time off. "She's a big, big horse and, with her talent, I think they might have just wanted to give her time to mature."

Calascibetta, who conditioned future four-time Grade II winner D'Funnybone (D'wildcat) in his first two starts last year, fully expected his speedy new addition to validate her owners' high hopes.

"She has done everything right in the morning," he said. "She has a great mind for racing. She never even turned a hair in the paddock [yesterday] or anything. She's very professional."

From the first crop of Brazilian champion--and a multiple Grade I winner in this country--Pico Central (Spend a Buck), Pica Slew is out of the unraced Seattle Slew mare Maggie O'Slew. Her second dam is Grade II-placed Miss Maggie (Afleet), whose dam, Dancitus (Far North), is a half to 1987 champion sprinter Groovy (Norcliffe), as well as the dam of 1996 champion two-year-old Boston Harbor (Capote). Pica Slew will be pointed to the six-furlong Leave Me Alone S. for sophomore fillies at Calder June 12. --BD

**EVA OUTBREAK DERAILS ACTIVITY** An outbreak of EVA forced officials at Palermo Racetrack in Buenos Aires to cancel Friday's racing program, while racing at La Plata has also been called off Sunday and Tuesday. The National Service of Animal Health (SENASA) has decided to restrict the movements of horses for the next 15 days in the area of the province of Buenos Aires. SENASA has collected some 300 blood samples from horses in Palermo, San Isidro and La Plata, but it will be 72 hours before results of those tests will be available. The Copa Bullrich Sales have also been postponed, and officials with the auction house will look to reschedule the event for June. The virus is believed to have entered Argentina through frozen semen from Holland that was acquired by a local breeder.
