'FLY' DOWNS DROSSELMAYER IN DWYER

Richard Pell's **Fly Down** (Mineshaft) kicked away to a decisive victory yesterday in the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont, with odds-on **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) a distant second. Pell, a New York-based money manager who got into the racing game in 2008, was pleased with the result.

"[Trainer] Nick [Zito] has always been high on this horse," the owner offered. "Nick has told me from the very beginning, 'He's a Belmont horse,' and he didn't just mean Belmont Park, he meant the Belmont S. The horse has always handled himself like

a pro. I thought he would run well today and that this track would suit him, but he really was impressive." Zito added later, "We'll see what happens in the next 30 days--he puts a lot into his races. If he has a good month, if he rebounds from this, if he's OK, we'll look at the Belmont." **Cont. p2**

WinStar's **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) cruised nine panels under the Twin Spires a week after his GI Kentucky Derby triumph. "He galloped really, really well," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "His energy level is very good and he has rebounded quickly. You always hope for that coming back in two weeks." Immediately after the Derby, Pletcher wasn't sure whether the colt would breeze prior to continuing his Triple Crown aspirations at Pimlico, but is favoring getting the clockers involved Monday. "Right now, I am leaning toward working him," Pletcher said. "I want to see how he gallops [Sunday], but most likely it will be an easy half-mile." The Eclipse Award-winning conditioner also plans to saddle Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) in the Preakness.

A troubled third in his career bow at Belmont Oct. 25 ([video](#)), Fly Down came four wide to rally past First Dude (Stephen Got Even) in a maiden on Churchill's "Stars of Tomorrow II" card Nov. 28 ([video](#)). The chestnut made his next appearance in a nine-furlong test at Gulfstream Feb. 21 ([video](#)), and it was deja vu all over again as he put in another overland rally to just nip First Dude at the wire. Sent to New Orleans for the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 27, where he was the 6-1 third choice, Fly Down was well back in the early stages, then was forced to steady approaching the stretch run, and wound up ninth by 6 3/4 lengths.

The second choice here, he came away alertly before settling at the back of the pack through a :47.70 opening half, with Turf Melody (Maria's Mon) at the head of affairs. Drosselmeyer was just one spot in front of him after an awkward beginning, and Fly Down flew past him with a four-wide move on the sweeping turn. He surged to the front and, despite switching

leads several times in the stretch, proved much the best on the afternoon.

Drosselmeyer, who found trouble when fourth in the Feb. 20 GII Risen Star S. and third in the Louisiana Derby, had been talked about as a candidate for the GI Belmont S. June 5 prior to the Dwyer. "He slipped behind when they first broke, but he finished up and galloped out well," trainer Bill Mott reported. "I wouldn't think [this would affect our Belmont plans], but I still have to talk to the rest of the team."

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Rail Trip rattled off five straight wins to start his career, but incurred his first loss when runner-up in last year's renewal of this race. Second by 3/4 of a length in the GII Californian S. in June, he drew off to a three-length score in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in July, and followed that with a third-place finish, beaten a length, in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Sept. 6. That wound up being his seasonal finale, however. "He was just worn out and foot-sore," winning trainer Ron Ellis explained. "He had a long year. I gave him 60 days off, but he never left the barn." Odds-on for his return, the robust gelding settled into a perfect spot in second as Tres Borrachos (Ecton Park) led through six furlongs in 1:12.66. Jockey Rafael Bejarano gave him his cue on the far turn and Rail Trip responded, drawing off authoritatively. "He surprised me a lot," Bejarano enthused. "I knew I had a lot of horse at the end. I thought I was going to win easy, but not this easy. I think this horse is going to be the best horse around." The gelding showed some speed in the Gill Derby Trial S. at Churchill Apr. 24, but retreated to finish fifth by 19 1/2 lengths over that sloppy track. Equipped with blinkers this time and facing a soft field, the favorite raced in third while second-choice Henshin Hero set the pace in his first route attempt. There have been some close calls since Bonconte di Montefeltro (Ity) (Charlottesville {GB}) completed the Premio Parioli--Derby Italiano double 41 years ago, but the ever-distant beacon of those successes was revisited as Worthadd at last emulated the class of 1969 with the cheekiest of victories in this year's renewal of the Derby. Improving off a debut third at Milan Oct. 24, Worthadd shed his maiden status at second asking back there on sophomore bow Mar. 17, and raked in his first black-type score in the Apr. 5 Listed Premio Gardone at the San Siro. He was impressive when justifying odds-on favoritism in the Apr. 18 G3 Premio Parioli at this track last time Apr. 18, and toyed with his rivals here to land a famous Classic double.

Worthadd raced under an exaggerated grip near the front end as Godolphin's Ameer (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) set modest fractions just ahead of him. He remained on the bridle as his 15 rivals made vain bids for glory in the straight, and he required minimal stirring inside the the final 150 meters to hold on as Ansiei and Saratoga Black made a late fist of matters.

Ice Blue was defeated by Handsome Devil in an Oct. 18 newcomers' event at Longchamp, but exacted revenge on that rival in a conditions contest back at the Bois de Boulogne track Apr. 13 on his seasonal return last time. He raced under cover in fourth facing that rival once again from the outset of this black-type debut. Readied for his bid in traffic passing the quarter-mile marker, he was angled outside soon after and accelerated smartly under whipless encouragement in the closing stages to gain another verdict over his old foe, winning with plenty in hand. "This was a true test today, and I think he came through with flying colors," said trainer Pascal Bary. "I was a little concerned when he was still boxed in due to his inside draw, but [jockey] Stephane [Pasquier] got him to the outside smoothly. When he got into the clear, he quickened really well and was going away at the end. All being well, he will now run in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [at Chantilly June 6]." The Classic route is not an option for the runner-up. "Handsome Devil ran really well and has no excuses, being beaten by the same horse which defeated him last time," trainer Elie Lellouche explained. "We'll wait to see what our options are, but he will not run in the Jockey Club, where I will be represented by [G2 Prix Noailles winner] Planteur [Ire] [Danehill Dancer {Ire}]." Successful in a one-mile maiden at Yarmouth in October, Bullet Train returned to be runner-up to the subsequent Listed Cheshire Oaks

fourth Myplacelater (GB) (Where or When {Ire}) in a 10-furlong conditions event at Newbury last time Apr. 16.

Taking a step forward to win this Epsom prep, the homebred was in front after the first yards and traveled smoothly down the hill to the home bend before quickening smartly under Tom Queally. In no danger thereafter, the bay

was in his comfort zone as Dubawi Phantom and Hot Prospect chased in vain. "It was a good performance--they went an even gallop all the way and I was impressed with the way he stretched and quickened," Queally said. "He's improving, and we have a nice horse on our hands." Trainer Henry Cecil was not committing the winner to a tilt at the June 5 Classic, for which he was recently supplemented. "He's improving the whole time, but he still has a long way to go and won't necessarily run in the Derby," Cecil said. "He might be more of a Royal Ascot horse and is in the [June 18] G2 King Edward VII S., so I'll have to speak to the Prince and Teddy [Grimthorpe]. I'm not counting out Epsom, and we'll just see how he comes out of this." There was a sad postscript when Ballydoyle's Captain James Cook (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) took a bad step on uneven ground, broke down and had to be euthanized.

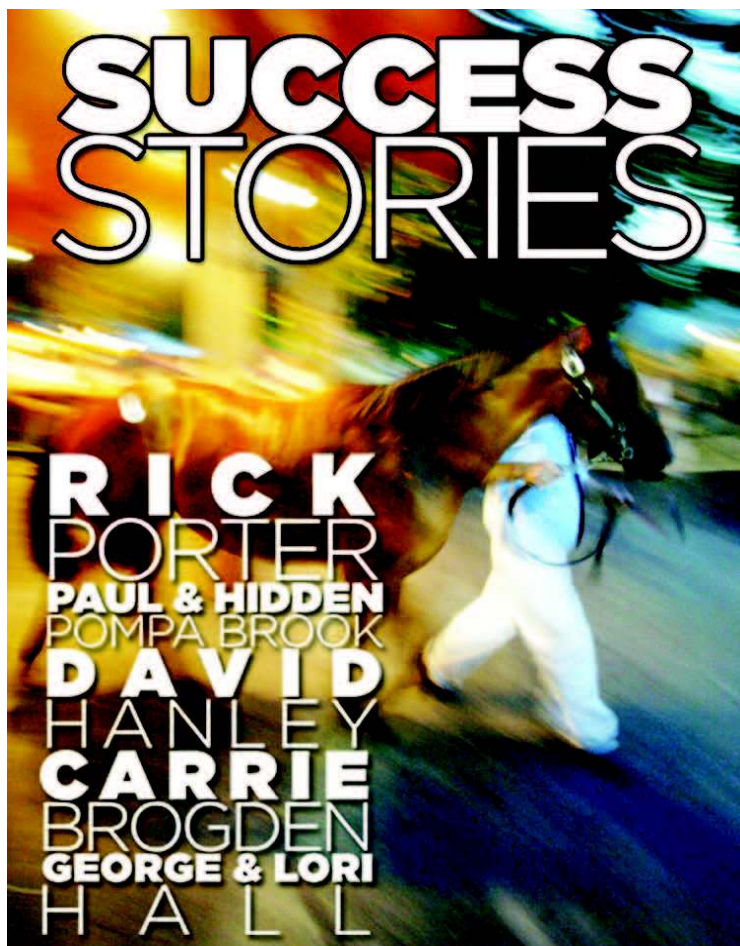

Caracortado Clawing His Way to Preakness...

Caracortado (Cat Dreams) punched his ticket to next Saturday's GI Preakness S. with a seven-furlong drill at Santa Anita yesterday morning, stopping the clock in 1:24.60. It was the faster of two works at that distance. "He looked great," said breeder/trainer Mike Machowsky. "He got a good blow out of it and it tightened him up. He looked good back at the barn." Machowsky has not been to the Maryland oval since capturing the GI Pimlico Special H. with Southern Image (Halo's Image) in 2004. "I'm pretty confident in the way he's going," Machowsky added. "I think he's going to bring his A-plus game to the race the way he's training right now. I'm excited about the opportunity." A Cal-bred campaigned by Blahut Racing LLC, Caracortado--Scarface in Spanish--opened his career with five straight wins, including the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita Feb. 13, before finishing behind Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in his next two appearances at the Arcadia oval. He was third in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 13 prior to running fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3. Journeyman Paul Atkinson, who has piloted the chestnut in each of his seven starts, will be in the irons at Old Hilltop. "He's never ridden this horse poorly and the horse has always run well for him," said Machowsky. "A good horse will make any trainer, owner or jockey look good, and Paul's never had the opportunity to ride a horse like him. There's so many trainers who don't get the opportunity to get a horse like this. I always say its 80 percent the horse and 10 percent the jock and 10 percent the trainer."

Looking to Get Lucky...

Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike), sixth after a brutal trip in the Kentucky Derby, remains possible for the Preakness after galloping 12 furlongs at Churchill Downs Saturday. "I'll know by Monday, but he's 52 percent [to go] today," trainer Bob Baffert quipped. The bay colt has run into significant trouble in his last two starts under regular rider Garrett Gomez, fueling speculation that Baffert may give jockey Martin Garcia a leg up on the champion juvenile instead. "I am still not sure if I am going to run and, if I don't run, I don't need to make a switch," Baffert said. "There are a lot of rumors out there. What happened is I told Martin Garcia's agent [Jim Pegram] not to do anything for Preakness Day because I might have other horses running there that day." Garcia, who regularly rides for Baffert in California, was aboard the Hall of Famer's other trainee, Conveyance (Indian Charlie), in the Kentucky Derby; that colt faded to 15th after setting a fast early pace. Baffert may send **Quiet Invader** (Songandaprayer) to the GIII Chick Lang S. and **Ventana** (Toccet) to the GIII Maryland Sprint H. on the Preakness undercard.



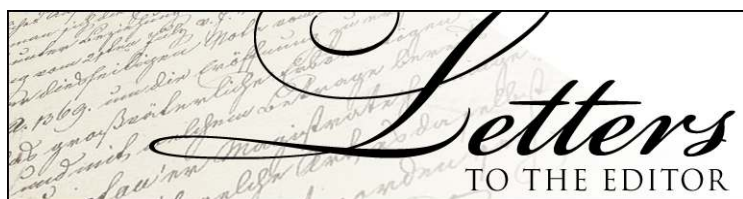

Preakness candidate **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) went five-eighths in 1:00.60 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. Donald Disney's homebred, coming off a third in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 10, put up splits of 11.60, :23.40, :35.20 and :47.60 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:14.80. "I was very pleased with the work--it's on to the Preakness," said trainer Dale Romans, who will also send GI Kentucky Derby third-place finisher **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}) to Baltimore.

I think that Monmouth Park is about to shoot itself in the foot before even one race has been drawn for the new meeting that proposes to distribute \$1 million per day in purses because it has decided to give preference to horses whose Jockey Club registration certificates are posted in the racing office prior to the start of the meet.

Op/Ed feedback

Mr. Whiteley, in his Op/Ed, covered many important topics for us to consider. With regard to marketing, I have three ideas to mention that I think should be implemented at every track.

1) When I was in Japan, the target demographic for marketing was young women. The Japan Racing Association marketed the horses that were currently racing as a short term marketing tool, and the jockeys were marketed as a long-term objective. The jockeys have a much longer time in the public eye, and are as well known in Japan as any sports athlete here. Marketing to women actually hits two markets, because where women are, men usually follow.

2) Make it easy for the neophyte to get involved in our sport. Before I became a trainer, I was at Northlands Park in the early '80s, and my first job there was as an "Ask Me Girl." It was just as it sounds. My job was to go around and be accessible to the public so they could ask me questions as mundane as "where is the bathroom" to "what is the difference between a quinella and an exacta," etc.

3) Portable betting: Now that they have wireless wagering, why not have tellers walking in the bleachers? 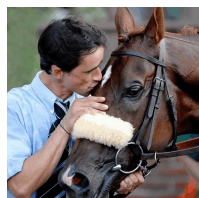
