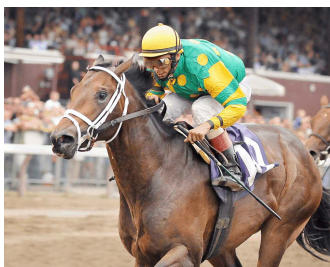
Aikenite Tunes Up; Super Saver to Work Today...

In preparation for Saturday's GI Preakness S., Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) worked five furlongs in 1:01.40 over the main track at Churchill Downs Sunday morning. With exercise rider Kevin Willey aboard, the Todd Pletcher trainee--who was accompanied by four-year-old Megaholtz (Action This Day)--reeled off fractions of

:12.60, :25.20, :37.60, :49.40 and galloped out six panels in 1:15. "He broke a couple of lengths behind Megaholtz and they finished on even terms," said Pletcher. "It was a good work, typical of how he works and he had a solid gallop out." Pletcher expects the colt, who was runner-up behind **Hurricane Ike** (Graeme Hall) in the Apr. 24 GIII Derby Trial S., to return to the track Tuesday. Shortly after Aikenite completed his work, GI Kentucky Derby hero **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) went to the track. Under Willey,

the handsome bay stood in the starting gate before galloping 1 1/8 miles. "He was well behaved at the gate," said Pletcher. "He was calm, cool and collected. He is very professional and has always been that way. It is a huge edge when you have a horse with talent that also has the proper mindset." According to Pletcher, the WinStar representative, slated to ship to Pimlico Wednesday, will work a half-mile after the renovation break this morning. Pletcher also has Preakness possible **Mission Impazible** (Unbridled's Song), ninth in the Derby.

TANDA RIDES THE RAIL IN RAILBIRD

Seeking her fourth victory in five starts this season, **Tanda** (Sweetsouthernstaint) showed her class to hand favorite **Switch** (Quiet American) a 1/2-length defeat in Sunday's seven-furlong GIII Railbird S. at Hollywood Park. A step slow at the start, Tanda quickly moved up to press early leader Southern Fireball through an opening quarter mile in :23.08. Up to take command while scraping the paint, the Florida-bred was a length in front of her rival after a half mile in :45.64 and remained comfortably in front turning for home. Set down for the drive, the bay had enough left in the tank to fend off the 8-5 choice with **All Due Respect** (Value Plus) closing for third. **Cont. p5**

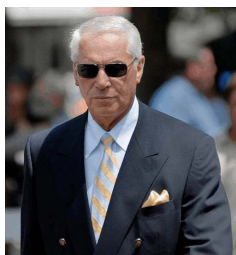

Gomez to Ride Dublin in Preakness...

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas confirmed yesterday that jockey Garrett Gomez will replace Terry Thompson on Robert Baker and William Mack's **Dublin** (Afleet Alex) in Saturday's GI Preakness S. "If Peyton Manning is available, you are not going to leave him in the locker room," said Lukas, explaining the switch on the Grade I-winning colt. Seventh in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1, the son of Classy Mirage (Storm Bird) has been tabbed to work this morning. Lukas has yet to name a rider for his other charge--Westrock Stable's **Northern Giant** (Giant's Causeway)--in the 9 1/2-furlong Classic.

Lookin At Lucky Possible for Preakness...

Looking increasingly likely to make a start in the second jewel in the Triple Crown, **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) galloped a mile and a half at Churchill Downs Sunday. A decision whether the juvenile champion will start Saturday is expected today. "I'd say there is a very good chance, unless I see something [Monday] afternoon that changes my mind," explained trainer Bob Baffert. "I'm going to wait until [Monday], but right now, he's getting stronger every day. I'm leaning toward it, but I'm just not sure." If the bay were to line up Saturday, he will have a new rider. "I talked with Garrett [Gomez] a few days ago," said Baffert. "I told him that we've just been having such bad luck, and I wasn't sure if I was going to run, so I wanted to give him a chance to find another mount. And if I did run, I was maybe going to replace him only just to change our luck."

Game on Dude to Belmont?

Trainer Bob Baffert indicated that Saturday's GIII Lone Star Derby winner **Game on Dude** (Awesome Again) may take a crack at the June 5 GI Belmont S. "We will look seriously at it with him," said Baffert. Campaigned by Lanni Family Trust, Mercedes Stable, Diamond Pride and Bernie Schiappa, the bay will head back to Baffert's base at Santa Anita in Southern California.

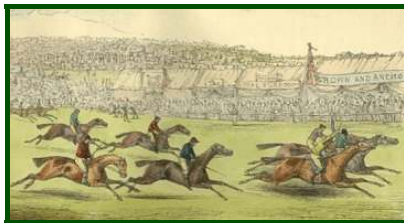
Albertrani Has Three for Summer Sophomore Stakes...

Trainer Tom Albertrani has a trio of promising three-year-olds in his barn that could make an impact in this summer's Grade I events. Padua Stables' **Odysseus** (Malibu Moon), who was forced to miss the Triple Crown after sustaining a knee injury during a last-placed finish in the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 10, should be back in training in about a month. "The injury wasn't as bad as we first thought--he might have done a little damage to the ligament in the front of his knee, but the reports are very, very good," said Albertrani. **Odysseus** emerged as a Kentucky Derby contender with a win in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 13. Albertrani has also assumed training duties for **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate). The GIII LeComte S. winner was guided by Tom Amoss to a 3-0-0 record in his first six starts. "He came in with a quarter crack, so we had to nurse his foot a little," said Albertrani. "We'll see how he does over the next couple of weeks and then think about a schedule for him. I don't think there's any possibility of making the [GI] Belmont S. [June 5]." The New York-based conditioner also has **Cocalero** (A.P. Indy), who showed promise in his debut Saturday at Belmont with a 1-3/4 length last-to-first score. "[Cocalero] is a nice colt and looks like a promising three-year-old," Albertrani. "Towards the end of the summer, we could have some exciting things going on." Also in the barn is **Gozzip Girl** (Dynaformer), who dominated the three-year-old turf filly division for much of last season. The GI American Oaks winner could return in the GII Sheepshead Bay S. May 22 or GII New York Breeders' Cup S. June 19.

BOLGER POINTS GREINE AT THE GUINEAS

Jackie Bolger and Harry Dobson's G1 1000 Guineas third **Gile Na Greine (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will head to the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 23, it was announced yesterday. While Wednesday's G3 Tattersalls Musidora S. had been an option for the homebred, trainer Jim Bolger favors another tilt at Classic glory over a mile. "Gile Na Greine is going to go for the Irish Guineas, I never committed her to York and I think she deserves a proper shot at a Classic," he told *PA Sport*. "The Irish Guineas is the best chance she has to do that and we will take it step by step beyond that."

BLANCO SUFFERS SCARE Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's unbeaten **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) has met with a setback ahead of his proposed tilt at Thursday's G2 Dante S. Trainer Aidan O'Brien was yesterday still expecting the G2 Futurity S. and G3 Tyros S. winner to make the extended 10-furlong contest and he told *PA Sport*, "He caught his heel when cantering this morning, but I hope it is going to be nothing and he is another who will come on for the run." The Ballydoyle conditioner also outlined provisional plans for last year's G1 Criterium International winner **Jan Vermeer (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). "If Jan Vermeer goes to the Derby, he will need a run beforehand and that will have to come in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 22]," he added. "I would like him to have a run beforehand, but if we can't manage that he could go to the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 6] without a run."

Danon Chantilly was coming off his first group victory in the G3 Mainchi Hai in March. Traveling near the back of the pack early, the dark bay colt displayed his exceptional turn of foot, racing widest of all up Tokyo's

final straight and powering to the front with 100 meters remaining en route to a track-record setting performance. "I knew that he had the ability to come from any position and win, but the fast pace with us quite far off the lead had me a little worried," admitted winning rider Katsumi Ando. "The draw being what it was, however, I had

planned on going wide. If there was no interference, I knew he had the kind of finishing power to win." The Kunihide Matsuda trainee will now aim for the May 30 G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) over the same course. Ando admitted the distance of the Tokyo Yushun could be an issue for Danon Chantilly. "It's 2,400 meters next and he is an excitable horse, best suited to the mile, but with today's strong showing, I think we can take on the challenge with confidence," the jockey said. Matsuda saddled King Kamehameha (Jpn) (Kingmambo), also ridden by Ando, to a Mainchi Hai-NHK Mile Cup-Tokyo Yushun treble in 2004. Danon Chantilly was bred at Darley Japan in Hokkaido and is the first JRA Group 1 win for the farm. [JRA race video.](#)

Successful by seven lengths in a seven-furlong Curragh maiden in October, Midas Touch was the choice of Johnny Murtagh over Jan Vermeer (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Criterium International three weeks later at Saint-Cloud, but was only fourth behind his impressive stable companion there. Settled in a detached last of four by Murtagh early as stable companion At First Sight set searching fractions, he swooped as Address Unknown passed the front-runner with a furlong remaining. Gaining the upper hand 100 yards later, he went on to record a time over a second faster than the stable's Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) set 12 months ago, although he was carrying three pounds less and was racing on ground officially a notch faster. "I'm delighted, as it was his first run back and Johnny thought he would come on a good bit," Aidan O'Brien commented. "It was a solidly run race with At First Sight going an even, building pace and you'd have to be very happy with that. I was worried, because the horses had been a bit behind and we had a very bad winter--they've started off slowly over the past few years, but this year has been even slower." Address Unknown, who jinked when headed in the final yards but was beaten fair and square, pleased trainer Dermot Weld. "He would appreciate a little more ease in the ground, but was beaten by a better horse on the day," Weld said. "Pat [Smullen] said it is was as good a Derby trial as will be run, and that the winner is a very good horse." The home-bred made a winning debut for his new yard when landing a conditions event at this track on seasonal return last time Apr. 18 and just gained the verdict over his stable-mate and last term's G1 Deutschland-Preis and G1 Grosser Preis von Baden hero Getaway to claim a career high in this pattern-race bow. Leading early, Eye of the Tiger maintained control throughout and ran on strongly under urging in the straight to win with more in hand than the winning margin would imply. 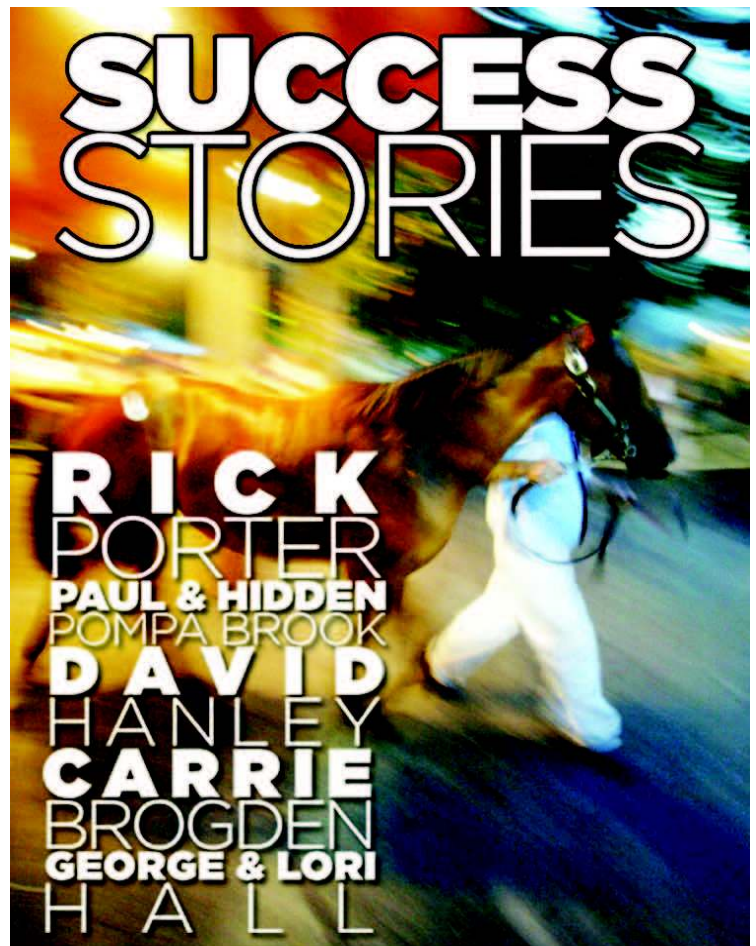

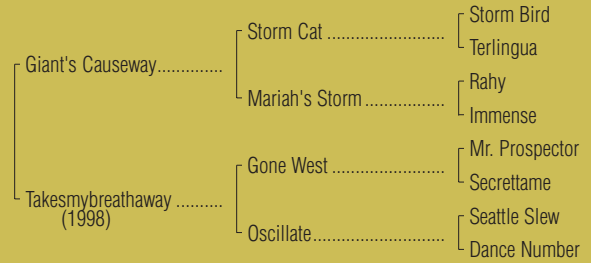

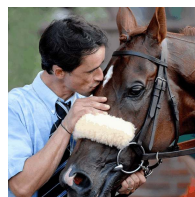
