ALIBIS AND LAUGHS AT PREAKNESS

There was plenty of activity around the stakes barns at Pimlico yesterday after the vast majority of the GI Preakness S. field arrived Wednesday afternoon.

WinStar Farm homebred **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) was sent to the track early. He jogged the wrong way around a Pimlico track that continues to be muddy from on-and-off rains over the last day or two. Super Saver returned to the Preakness barn for a bath, and seemed to be enjoying the attention of the gathered crowd. At

the Alibi Breakfast later in the morning, his trainer, Todd Pletcher, was asked if Super Saver knew he was a rock star yet.

"I think he's picked up on it, yeah," Pletcher said as Sue Casner broke into a grin behind him. "He seems to like the cameras and the action. He's such a cool horse to be around. He's very laid back and takes everything in stride. That's probably part of what makes him as good as he is, is that he doesn't get too upset about anything."

Sue Casner is the wife of WinStar principal Bill Casner, who himself took ample time with reporters yesterday, speaking with several local news outlets back at Pletcher's barn. He also was asked a few questions at the Alibi Breakfast, including his thoughts about the ongoing Triple Crown ride. **Cont. 2**

'BLANCO' AND SARISKA DOMINATE AT YORK

Despite their slow start to the season, Ballydoyle gave further notice that it is firmly on the right track again, as **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) impressively resumed the winning thread in Thursday's G2 Dante S. In putting some serious reputations to the sword and clocking a time just a half-second slower than four-year-old **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) in the G2 Middleton S. 30 minutes earlier, the chestnut enters the G1 Epsom Derby picture dominated for so long by his stable companion St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}).

Already armed with a pair of Classic victories, Lady Bamford's G1 English and G1 Irish Oaks winner Sariska, who crossed the wire 1 3/4 lengths ahead of GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf heroine **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the Middleton, was much the best despite the margin of victory.

"She is a good mover and if you analyse her form, she has got some on quick ground, but is one of those who goes even better with cut, so she's a joy," said winning trainer Michael Bell. "Last year, we went from the Musidora at this track to the Epsom Oaks and we will do the same this year and go for the [June 4, G1] Coronation Cup." **Cont. p7-9**

"It's just very special to be identified with this horse," Casner said. "He's a homebred, and that's one of the things that does make it so special. There are so many people on our team that have been part of this horse's development. From the time their moms give them to us, every day is a challenge for them in terms of going through the process of making it to Derby day. There are very few of them who make the cut, and to have one of these horses and to be able to participate in these races is just very, very special. It's what everybody dreams of."

Casner also reminded fans to enter the "Super Name Sweepstakes," a contest sponsored by WinStar that will give the winner the rights

to name Super Saver's baby brother. Born this spring, the colt is by Medaglia d'Oro and was produced by Supercharger (A.P. Indy). Contestants can log on to www.winstarfarm.com, sign up for the contest and suggest a name. WinStar will select a winner, who receives as a grand prize 50 percent of any winnings resulting from a \$1,000 win wager on Super Saver in the Preakness. The other 50 percent goes to charity. The winner also gets a \$100 gift certificate to the WinStar Farm online store. Entries close just before the Preakness Saturday.

Kentucky Derby favorite and sixth-place finisher **Lookin at Lucky** (Smart Strike) got his first taste of Pimlico's track yesterday. Trainer Bob Baffert watched trackside as 'Lucky' took a spin around the oval and appeared content at what he saw. From this reporter's perspective, Lookin at Lucky's transformation from barn to track was notable. The colt looked a tad flat back at the Preakness barn--not unhealthy, not drab, just a bit flat. But as he followed the wood-chip path that edges the Pimlico property and leads to the track, he picked up considerably. He pricked his ears and arched his neck a bit and, by the time he stepped onto the muddy surface, looked eager to get down to business.

Baffert was also on his game yesterday. Before Lookin at Lucky went out, Baffert watched as Gill Chick Lang S. hopeful **Quiet Invader** (Songandaprayer) jogged. Asked who the horse was, he explained both the horse's name and the intended target.

"What did the race used to be called? The Hirsch Jacobs? Man, I just hope they aren't calling it the Bob Baffert anytime soon," Baffert quipped. The race was indeed previously the Hirsch Jacobs; it was renamed this year after the passing of Lang, longtime general manager of Pimlico and known as "Mr. Preakness." The three-year-old Quiet Invader, incidently, made a favorable impression in the morning. In fact, he looked great walking up to the track.

Lookin at Lucky's visit to the track after the renovation break also produced a few laughs. Baffert and a colleague stood on the track against the outside rail to watch the juvenile champ. Soon, an older gentleman wearing a blue security jacket came over and, having no clue who Baffert was, nor caring, told him to get off the track. Baffert turned to his friend and said, "What's the matter with you Bernie--get off the rail!" The security guard mistakenly thought Baffert was giving him grief, and snapped, "Now if you don't want to, I can just make a call. I got them guys telling me they don't want you on the track, and now you're going to argue with me?" Baffert congenially acted in his own self interest and moved back into the gap without further incident.

The aforementioned Alibi Breakfast was held in the Pimlico clubhouse, where a nice spread--one that included the signature drink of the weekend, the Black-Eyed Susan--was served to the horsemen and media.

Five-time Preakness winner D. Wayne Lukas was prodded when announced to admit that the Lukas-trained Codex did, in fact, bump Genuine Risk in the controversial 1980 running of the race. Lukas responded, "It took two weeks to decide that he didn't bump her. We've won five of them, but we had to win that one three times--once on the track, once in the stewards' room and once at the commission." *Cont. p3*

Lukas drew laughs when asked about the pick-up of Garrett Gomez for **Dublin** (Afleet Alex), following trainer Bob Baffert's decision to take the rider off Lookin at Lucky.

"Bob realized that I was getting up there in years, and wouldn't have too many more opportunities to run in the Preakness, and he felt sorry for me," said Lukas. "He said, 'Look, if you want my rider, just take him. I'll get along with one of the bug boys, and I have a lot of good years left in me, and if Gomez is gonna help you out...go ahead and take him.'"

Lukas was reminded of his quote from last week, when he likened the decision to secure Gomez to making sure Peyton Manning wasn't sitting in the locker room on game day.

Lukas laughed, "Yeah, but Bob had a better [quote]. He said, 'Sure, but he threw five interceptions in his last game.'"

Lukas was also asked about Dublin's outside, post-12 draw in the Preakness. "I didn't like it," he admitted. "I don't think anybody wants the one or the 12 hole in a horse race. But

we're going to live with it. Like there are no ugly brides on wedding night, there are no bad posts if you're in the Preakness."

There are 11 members in Donegal Racing, the group that owns Kentucky Derby third **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}), and almost all of them are or were from Iowa. That includes Jerry Crawford, who was on hand at the Alibi Breakfast, but it was the Boston-based Joe Savage who handled the public speaking duties.

Despite Paddy O'Prado's strong third-place showing in the Derby, Savage thought the colt could have run even better, had hormones not reared their ugly little heads.

"He wound up being in a stall next to a filly, and he's kind of a good-feeling guy," Savage explained. "As [jockey] Kent [Desormeaux] said, 'I didn't know I was riding a five-legged horse.' But if you watch the race, there was some controversy about how [Kent] finished the race. Now, he was going to Bermuda the next day, so maybe there was a filly on his mind, as well."

Godolphin have won this prize with Moonax (Ire), Classic Cliche (Ire), Kayf Tara (GB), Marienbard (Ire) and Mamool (Ire) since 1995 and saddle the likely favorite this time in **Kite Wood** and another interesting contender in **Wajir**. After an unplaced effort in the G1 Epsom Derby last June, Kite Wood's career took a turn for the better, and he followed wins in the G3 Bahrain Trophy at Newmarket in July and G3 Geoffrey Freer S. at Newbury in August with a game second to stable companion Mastery (GB) (Sulamani {Ire}) in Doncaster's G1 St Leger the following month. Last year's G2 Prix Hocquart winner **Wajir** makes his debut in the royal blue and was last seen winning the G3 Prix de Lutece at Longchamp in September. "Kite Wood ran a big race behind Mastery in the St Leger last year and we gave him a break after that run," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He has come back very well and racing over a mile and three quarters will suit him on his first start of the season. I have been happy with his preparation and I am looking forward to seeing how he gets on, although he will improve for the run. Wajir has been working well and he is improving all of the time. He had some good form in France and the distance will be fine, but he will also come on for the run." Henry Cecil saddled the great Ardross (Ire) to win back-to-back renewals in 1981 and 1982, but it is 23 years since Verd-Antique (GB) gave him a third edition. *cont. p5*

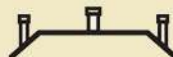

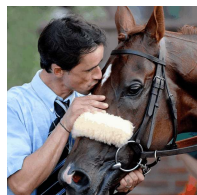

Murtagh continued, "It was a solidly run race and the way he finished today suggests he could stay the Derby trip. He's very genuine and will try--he'll also handle Epsom's challenges, as he has a good mind, the balance and speed." Murtagh may be faced with a dilemma on the first Saturday in June, but he made it clear he remains a fan of St Nicholas Abbey. "It's all systems go now for Epsom and Cape Blanco is a big player and has what it takes, so for me it's a hard job to decide but it's a high-class problem," he added. "Everyone has to question what St Nicholas Abbey did in the Guineas, but if the horse turns up that won the Racing Post last year, the rest will be racing for place-money." Workforce's trainer Sir Michael Stoute reported that the second-favorite's bit had slipped through his mouth and Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "He's a big baby and has now had a good race. Ryan [Moore] wasn't too disappointed and the ground would be as fast as he'd like." Last year's G1 English and Irish Oaks heroine Sariska was in receipt of five pounds from arch-rival Middy and, despite the discrepancy of the conditions of this race, the expectation was that it would be a close call. In the event, the writing was on the wall a long way out after Sariska was taken to the front almost from the outset by Jamie Spencer, and the imposing bay was always comfortable there. In contrast, Middy looked awkward in early stretch and, while she took a long while to hit top stride under Eddie Ahern, Sariska needed only pushing out and a wave of the whip to secure a snug comeback win. "She was very exuberant for the first half of the race and I couldn't go much slower," Spencer commented. "I went a decent gallop, and when she turned in, she picked up well and got tired in the final furlong. I let her coast when I saw the big screen so she would have as less a hard race as possible, so it was a good starting point for her. We were pretty confident with the way she had been working, which had suggested she had stepped up from last year. We'll look forward to a good summer with her, but soft ground in France in October will be tailor-made for her."

NO LOAN FOR NYRA On Wednesday, New York state senators rejected a proposal that would have loaned the New York Racing Association \$17 million. Attorneys informed legislators that the bill was unconstitutional, and it was determined that, according to state law, NYRA would have been eligible for only a fraction of the funds needed. NYRA officials have stated they will be forced to cease operations, possibly as soon as next month, if there is no influx of cash. Unavailable for comment yesterday, they continue to work with the state legislation on a possible solution to NYRA's immediate economic woes. The legislature is in recess until Monday. The latest dead end in NYRA's quest to close the gap in its budget looks likely to result in a lawsuit. It has been claimed that a contract between NYRA and the state guaranteed, if the Aqueduct casino was not opened by Apr. 1, 2009, the state would make payments to NYRA to make up for the revenue lost by the delay. Those payments have never been made. Citing its concerns regarding the future of the Saratoga meeting, a group made up of the Saratoga County Chamber of Commerce, Concerned Citizens for Saratoga Racing and a number of New York breeders last week stated their intention to file a lawsuit against the state today, suing for breach of contract, if a loan to NYRA was not forthcoming. The suit alleges that the state owes NYRA some \$30 million under that contract.

Casino Update...

The bad news regarding the loan to NYRA came just a day after it was announced that the New York State Lottery has now been put in charge of choosing an operator for the Aqueduct Video Lottery Facility, and that the bidding process alone will take until the beginning of August. A plan already approved by Gov. David Paterson has charged the State Lottery with doing something that has proved impossible for the last nine years. The casino received legislative approval back in 2001; it took seven years before Delaware North was announced as the winning bidder, but that deal fell through when the company failed to pay the \$370-million licensing fee it had promised in its proposal. Earlier this year, Gov. Paterson named Aqueduct Entertainment Group to operate the casino, but the process for that selection came under immediate and intense allegations of political favoritism, and the state withdrew its support of AEG. Gov. Paterson then floated alternate plans of reopening the bidding process, or making the selection on his own. On Tuesday, however, the Lottery unveiled a new 43-page Request for Proposals (RFP), and a calendar that will give interested parties until June 29 to submit their bids.

The bidders will be required to pay a refundable \$1-million entry fee, and must agree to pay an up-front licensing fee of a minimum of \$300 million. There will be a mandatory bidders' conference, to be held June 8 at Aqueduct, three weeks before the deadline for bids. Lottery officials will announce the winning bidder Aug. 3. According to the Lottery's RFP, "The Governor intends to accept the Lottery's recommendation of a selected Vendor, and to recommend that the Temporary President of the Senate and the Speaker of the Assembly join in approving the Lottery's recommendation."

The owner/founder of Eddie Woods Training Center in Ocala, Florida, has donated \$1,500 to the Horse Protection Association of Florida (HPAF) to be used to feed the horses of Martin's Martin Stables South and he is urging other members of the National Association of Two-Year-Old Consignors (NATC) follow suit. "Our industry is a tight-knit community, and these horses are our livelihood. I didn't give a second thought to help out, and I can only hope this effort has a successful outcome," added woods.
