**FALLON TO RIDE KINSALE KING**

Kieren Fallon will ride **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) in the June 19 G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, trainer Carl O'Callaghan announced yesterday. Fallon will fly into New York to work the five-year-old next Wednesday morning. "I think Kieren will fit the horse fine," O'Callaghan said. "This has been the hardest choice I've had to make in the business. I've had so many calls from so many riders. But I thought it was important to get someone who is used to the straight track, and Kieren is riding at the top of his game right now. I feel this is the right thing to do for the horse and for the owner." Kinsale King was last seen winning the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in March with Garrett Gomez aboard. He is expected to ship to New York from his Southern California base Tuesday.

**A Perfect Evening...**

The runner-up in the Nov. 28 GI Matriach S. at a mile in her 2009 finale, Tuscan Evening dropped back to 6 1/2 furlongs for the GIII Monrovia H. Jan. 3 and came from just off the pace to win by a length. She added the one-mile GII Buena Vista H. Feb. 15, then stretching her speed over nine panels for the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 21. The bay demonstrated her stamina with a front-running tally in the 10-furlong GII Santa Barbara H., and she evidenced her versatility as she dropped back an eighth for this. Martin Garcia gunned Cat By The Tale out of the gate, but an unperturbed Rafael Bejarano sat chilly aboard Tuscan Evening, rating her in second. California's latest distaff darling went after the pacesetter when they hit the lane, and the two duked it out for a few strides before Tuscan Evening did what she does, holding Forever Together at bay to get her picture taken one more time. "We thought we would be on the lead, but I talked to Rafael about it and we agreed that, if someone did something different, we would adjust, and he adjusted perfectly," Jerry Hollendorfer remarked. Worse than second just once in her career, Hour Glass took it to the next level with her first graded success. The bay captured an optional claimer on the Aqueduct inner track to open the season Jan. 24, then stepped up for the GII Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel Feb. 15. Sent off the 2-1 chalk, she bid five-wide at the top of the lane, but came up a half-length short while finishing a far-from-disgraced fourth. The Mill House runner rebounded to take the restricted Wheel Turns S. at the Big A Mar. 21, and was looking to turn the tables after finishing second to Tar Heel Mom in the GII Distaff H. in Ozone Park Apr. 17. Hour Glass was taken in hand to rate off splits of :21.85 and :44.50 in the tightly bunched field. Behind a wall of horses as they raced around the bend, she dove through an opening at the top of the lane, angled to the rail and was all out to get by longshot Rightly So in the final furlong. Ailalea looked like she might be any kind at the end of her juvenile campaign. The bay bested subsequent GIII Delta Princess S. and GII Fair Grounds Oaks heroine Quiet Temper (Quiet American) by four lengths in a Belmont maiden test Oct. 4 and came right back to take the GIII Tempted S. at Aqueduct Nov. 7. She was unable to hold that form at the start of 2010, however, finishing off the board in the Jan. 31 GII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream, the Mar. 26 Fair Grounds Oaks and the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks. Looking for a confidence builder, her connections dropped the filly back to a mile and down to Grade III company, and the move cured whatever was ailing her. Ailalea pressed the pace from the outside as the even-money chalk. She went to the front as they hit the lane and was not really threatened as Tap Tap Tapping closed late to be second. "I thought she was much the best," jockey Calvin Borel remarked. "I was very confident. Just two years ago, owner Jim Tafel and trainer Greg Geier sent out Cordial Cat (Forest Wildcat) to take this event at odds of 11-1. The two were at it again yesterday, this time scoring the 21-1 upset with Country Flavor. The bay had won three of his six starts between August and January, taking a maiden test over this track and trip Aug. 30, an optional claimer at Hawthorne two tries later Oct. 7, and a similar test in the slop at Fair Grounds Jan. 15. Main Aim collected last year's renewal of this race en route to a fourth-place finish behind high-class miler Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot in June. Stepping back to six furlongs the following month, he placed second in the G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket. The versatile bay posted two off-the-board finishes in the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood and the G1 Sprint Cup here before finishing fourth in the seven-furlong G2 Victor Chandler S. at Newmarket in October. A pipe-opener in the six-furlong G2 Duke of York S. at York May 12 put him cherry-ripe for this, and he landed the spoils for the second straight year. Sent off as the joint favorite, Main Aim tracked market rival Lord Shanakill (Speightstown) during the early exchanges before hitting the front two furlongs out. As his rivals queued up to challenge in the final furlong, the homebred battled on to seize the victory in game fashion. "He looked magnificent today and he's definitely come on from York," said winning rider Ryan Moore. 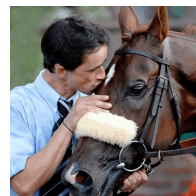

**O'Brien Issues St Nick Warning...**

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has posted a note of caution for next week's G1 Epsom Derby, warning would-be punters that plans for Ballydoyle's hopefuls in the Blue Riband event have yet to be finalized. He issued a statement Friday that ante-post favorite **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) had failed to inspire jockey Johnny Murtagh in a routine gallop, and elaborated further yesterday. "St Nicholas Abbey worked with **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) on Friday and worked as well as him, but that was the unusual thing because he usually works head and shoulders above everything," O'Brien explained. "He did a piece of work on Tuesday and Johnny was over the moon with him, but he was a

bit disappointed on Friday morning, so we decided to let everybody know. The problem with training horses is that they're all different, there is no rule. [Jockey] Colm [O'Donoghue] rode Midas Touch, and he thought he had improved a lot from Leopardstown, so that's also there, but St Nicholas Abbey is usually head and shoulders above everything; he's the most incredible worker you've ever seen. I suppose it might have just taken Johnny back a bit that he just worked as well as Midas Touch. He wasn't disappointing, just not as scintillating as he usually is. I think we'll make a final decision in the middle of the week."

Regarding the G1 Prix du Jockey Club, O'Brien added, "Obviously we have to decide which horses will go to France. **Viscount Nelson** (Giant's Causeway) will definitely go there, and whether something goes with him will be decided in the middle of the week. They'll work again Tuesday or Wednesday, and we'll have the main work done by then. The two intended for Epsom were **St Nicholas Abbey** and **Midas Touch**, along with **At First Sight (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). **Jan Vermeer (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) had the possibility of going to France, too, so if there was any doubt about St Nicholas Abbey, there is a big chance Jan Vermeer might go to Epsom as well. It's all up in the air, and I would say to everybody to just wait and see because we wouldn't want to run him unless we were very happy with him."

Contredanse booked her flight with an impressive six-length success in a 10-furlong handicap at Salisbury May 13. Last year's G3 Prix d'Aumale winner Middle Club was third in the G3 Prix Penelope at Saint-Cloud Apr. 22. "She seems to love travelling and and has already earned her corn in France," the latter's trainer Richard Hannon said. "They have had a bit of rain and that won't worry Middle Club, who should also relish the step up in distance." Saldennahe took this track's Listed Premio Baggio May 9, and hails from a high-class family with strong staying influences. Of the home team, **Super Motiva** showed enough speed to land the Listed Premio Torricola over a mile in Rome Apr. 4. Last year's G3 Premio Dormello scorer **Blessed Luck** enjoyed a smooth warm-up in a nine-furlong conditions event on that same card.

# TDN Q & A

## VENTA Copa Bullrich June 6, 7, 8, 10, 15

A total of 341 yearlings have been catalogued for this year's Copa Bullrich Sales. Originally scheduled for its traditional May dates, it was postponed due to an EVA outbreak in the area, and now will take place at San Isidro June 6-8, 10 and 15. The *TDN* spoke with Antonio Bullrich, the company's director general, ahead of the upcoming auction.

### When was the sale established?

The Copa Bullrich Sales were established in 2006. The idea came about after a suggestion from Elaine "Legs" Lawlor. The Copa Bullrich follows the basis of the Goffs Millions Sale.

May was the month we set aside for the Copa Bullrich, and all of the yearlings sold automatically qualify for the Copa Bullrich race series. We have three qualifying races, split between fillies and colts, and the first four in each go through to the final in

April. The Copa Bullrich race series offers the richest two-year-old race in South America.

### Who are some of the better horses to have sold at this sale in the past?

We have been lucky enough to sell some great horses over the last four years. The Group 1 winners listed below are just some of the graduates of the Copa Bullrich:

- Anaerobio (Arg) (Catcher in the Rye {Ire})
- City Thunder (Arg) (Thunder Gulch)
- Evocado (Arg) (Southern Halo)
- Interaction (Arg) (Easing Along)
- Ishitaki (Arg) (Interprete {Arg})
- Kryisia (Arg) (Matty G)
- Lingote de Oro (Arg) (Orpen)
- Peristaltica (Arg) (Interprete {Arg})
- Phone Time (Arg) (Gilded Time)
- Sembra Fe (Arg) (Manipulator)

### How has the sale changed/grown since it was started?

It has grown at a remarkable rate. We sold 126 yearlings the first year. This figure had doubled by 2007, and last year we had over 600 catalogued, forcing us to create separate Copa Bullrich sales within the year. We have also had to add extra days to the Copa Bullrich May sale, which runs over five days in order to accommodate all of the yearlings. There is a definite increase in the number of international buyers, from all parts of the world.

### How many yearling sales are there in Argentina?

We have five yearling sales, the main one being the Copa Bullrich. The five also include two specific sales for Haras Vacacion (held May 6 this year) and Haras La Quebrada (set for Sept. 7).

### South Africa and Dubai have had a lot of success with Argentine horses. Has there been a concerted marketing effort to attract buyers from those regions?

I think this year we have made a more concerted effort to grab the attention of buyers worldwide, not specifically from one country or one type of buyer. The new markets such as India and Turkey have come to the fore, and we will always retain interest in Dubai and South Africa, as the Argentine horses have been successful there.



### Do you run the sale in conjunction with any other international auction companies, such as Tattersalls, Keeneland or Fasig-Tipton?

We don't run anything in conjunction with any other international auction companies. This year, however, we did have Tom Thornbury, director of Keeneland Sales, as the selector for the Copa Bullrich. Tom is a respected man who holds a wealth of knowledge and experience. It was fantastic to have him here in Argentina.

### How is the Argentine economy progressing in comparison to the international community, and what sort of impact do you think it will have on this year's sale?

In this current downfall, buyers are looking to enter new markets, and I do think that there has been a notable increase in interest this year.

Argentina is still operating an affordable market. We have top stallions standing here at a reduced stud fee, therefore enabling buyers to enter the top of the market far easier than many countries. Argentina also has one of the most rewarding training costs to prize-money ratios.



**Bullrich Q & A cont.**

The U.S. breeding industry has a huge commercial component. The perception here of the Argentine industry is that is centered on breeding to race, rather than selling young stock. Is that accurate?

I think that's just a perception--we sell the young stock. The top breeders here may retain some of their young stock to keep a particular family's line, but most of the top stock will be sold at auction.

**What is the average foal crop in Argentina, and what percentage is offered at public auction?**

The foal crop has increased almost twofold in the last eight or nine years. In 2008, there were 8,154 foals born, with around 25 percent going to the sales.

The growth is due to the introduction of the slots in 2001, brought in by Palermo Racetrack. Palermo has supported this industry so much over the last eight years. There has been a significant increase in prizemoney, which has led to yearlings selling for more.

**What sort of sales preparation do the yearlings go through?**

The yearling preparations will start from February for the May Sale. Breeders here usually allow around 12 weeks to prepare the horse. They are brought in from the fields, and by March they are walking in hand and being groomed.

Ponying then starts in April up until the time of sale. The stud managers and the breeders make a huge effort and take great pride in ensuring their yearlings are ready for the sale and look in peak condition.

**What are your expectations for this year's sale?**

We, like every sales company, expect to progress each year with a better quality of horse, increased international interest and a more competitive market.



To add to that, interest in Argentine horses has been phenomenal over the last few years and continues to rise. The commerciality of the stallions standing here gives reason for this. Within our sale this year we have yearlings by some great stallions:

Distorted Humor, Tiznow, Southern Halo, Malibu Moon, Successful Appeal, Orpen, Bluegrass Cat, King's Best, Mutakddim, Not For Sale (Arg) and Pure Prize, amongst many others.

The only thing that we can safely say at the moment is that we have never had so many horses of the quality found in the two selected days of this year's Copa Bullrich. That will open the doors to the future.

**Q & A WITH THE BREEDERS' CUP CANDIDATES**



On May 24, Breeders' Cup announced the 28 candidates who will stand for election to the Breeders' Cup Board of Members and Trustees. There are 13 openings on the Board. Voting begins June 8 and closes June 22 at 5 p.m. The bios of the 28 candidates are available in documents circulated to the voters--Breeders' Cup foal and stallion nominators--and the *TDN* once again will provide additional information on the candidates' viewpoints. To that end, we posed the following question to each of the candidates, and have given them 400 words or fewer in which to respond. What do you think is the biggest issue facing the Breeders' Cup today and, if voted to the Breeders' Cup board, how would you propose this issue be solved?

**Satish Sanan:**

Issue: Too much business dependence and reliance on nominations revenue. We must find a way to diversify and grow our revenue and the popularity of our sport.

When the late visionary leader John Gaines conceived the idea of the Breeders Cup Day "Crowning of Champions," his objectives were:

- Support the Thoroughbred Industry as whole;
- Make racing more exciting to owners, horse players and fans;
- Support a strong racing circuit to attract more new owners;
- Sell more horses, help drive bloodstock values to keep breeders in business
