

**ROAD TO A CHAMPIONSHIP?**

Belmont's GI Metropolitan H. is one of the most prized events on the racing calendar, partly because it carries great weight when a horse is retired to stud. But since Criminal Type (Alydar) won the race during his

1990 Horse of the Year campaign, only two winners of the Met Mile have gone on championship honors in the same season--Holy Bull (Great Above) ('94 Horse of the Year); and Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector) ('03 champion sprinter). Trainer Todd Pletcher hopes to add a third name to that list when he sends out **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) in today's renewal. The big bay, currently the top-ranked handicapper in the nation, gave glimpses of his brilliance last year, setting track records with wins in the nine-furlong GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream and 6 1/2-furlong GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga. In his next two, at a mile and a quarter over sloppy tracks, he ran third in the GI Travers S. and second in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, but there was an anticlimactic end to the season after a much-publicized gate scratch in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. With an eye on redemption in 2010, Pletcher sent the Ned Evans homebred to a rousing win in the Gill Hal's Hope S. at Gulfstream Jan. 3, then watched as Quality Road unleashed a 12 3/4-length dismantling of the GI Donn H. there Feb. 6, lowering his own track record in the process. It's been nearly four months since that big win, but Pletcher isn't worried about the layoff. "He's run well fresh before," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "The Amsterdam was exceptional. I think we've got him ready enough, and, hopefully, his brilliance will take care of the rest." **Cont. p2**

**STAY PUT, FLY DOWN BREEZE FOR BELMONT**

A pair of hopefuls worked yesterday in advance of Saturday's GI Belmont S. At Saratoga, trainer Nick Zito sent out GII Dwyer S. winner **Fly Down** (Mineshaft) to a bullet half-mile work over the Oklahoma training track. The colt breezed in :47.50 under exercise rider Maxine Correa, the fastest of 26 moves at the distance. Fly Down worked in company with the maiden Kerouac (Rock Hard Ten) and galloped out in 1:01.15. "He looked pretty good to me this morning, so I was happy about that," said Zito. "The main thing is, he came home good, and he looked good doing it. That's all you can ask for. He looked ready to me, and I hope we get a good week." Zito, who has won the Belmont twice, will also saddle **Ice Box** (Pulpit) in the 1 1/2-mile Classic. Both ship to Zito's Belmont Park barn Wednesday. Meanwhile, at Belmont, trainer Steve Margolis's **Stay Put** (Broken Vow) went an easy half in :50.62 just after the renovation break. "I liked the way he breezed this morning," said exercise rider Loren Diego, who is watching the colt for Margolis, slated to arrive this evening. "The main thing is to keep him happy, keep him fresh. I think he's been handling the track well since he's been here." Two other Belmont hopefuls who were going to work Sunday will instead work today. WinStar's **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) goes over the main track after the renovation break, while trainer Alexis Barba will prep **Make Music for Me** (Bernstein) over the training track.

**No Easy Task...**

Rival trainers aren't about to just hand the Met Mile to Quality Road, however, and a very solid group will oppose the colt. **Warrior's Reward** looks ready made for the one-turn mile. The Ian Wilkes trainee enjoyed a break-out victory in the GI Carter H. on Wood Memorial day Apr. 3, when he rallied from the back of the pack to deny **Musket Man** by a nose. He again put in a valiant rally in the GII Churchill Downs H. in his latest May 1, but came up a half-length short to Atta Boy Roy (Tribunal) over a sloppy Churchill track. He adds a furlong from those seven-furlong tests, and Wilkes thinks his charge belongs here. "I look forward to the challenge," Wilkes told *DRF*. "My horse is doing unbelievably well. I want to see him compete against the best." The aforementioned Musket Man is still looking for his first Grade I, but, in addition to his gutsy runner-up finish in the Carter, was third in last year's GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. He was third again, beaten 3 1/4 lengths, in the Churchill Downs H. last out. **Kensei** should sit a good trip in a race that lacks a lot of speed. The winner of last year's GII Dwyer S. and GII Jim Dandy S. was a lackluster seventh in the Churchill Downs H., but has the excuse of a sloppy track and seems well-suited for the Met Mile's distance.

**Karelian** is enjoying his best season at the tender age of eight. The gelding denied last year's champion older male Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in the 1 1/16-mile Tampa Bay S. in February, then tallied his initial victory at the Grade I level with a 5-2 win in the GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 9. He gets the services of Rafael Bejarano going for his third straight triumph. Since finishing third in his debut last February, Cal-bred **Compari** hasn't found a horse better. He's won his last six, including a half-length victory over Fluke (Brz) (Wild Event) in the GII Arcadia H. at Santa Anita Apr. 3 in his first try in a graded stakes. "This could take him to another level," trainer Marty Jones told *Daily Racing Form*. The big unknown is **Mr Gruff**. A winner of his last four, the lightly raced six-year-old gelding has made all but one of his eight career starts down Santa Anita's hillside course. He's coming off a daylight score in the GIII San Simeon S. there Apr. 17, and is a threat if jockey Joe Talamo can throttle his considerable speed early.

The Terranova-trained bay disappointed in her seasonal debut--and return to the course and distance of her 2009 GI Alcibiades S. triumph--in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3, but was then runner-up in the Apr. 29 Edgewood S. at Churchill Downs in her first turf try. **Check the Label** won the GIII Appalachian S. in Lexington on Apr. 15, which has proven to be a key race; runner-up Bay to Bay (Sligo Bay {Ire}) came back to take the American 1000 Guineas at Arlington last Saturday, sixth-place finisher Red Hot Buddha (Buddha) took the May 7 Inaugural S. at Presque Isle in her subsequent start and seventh-placed runner Go Ask Alex (Afleet Alex) won the Indiana Distaff before settling for place honors behind Bay to Bay in Chicago. **Ultimate Class** is two-for-three on turf and was scratched out of the ungraded Little Silver S. at Monmouth yesterday for this tougher spot.

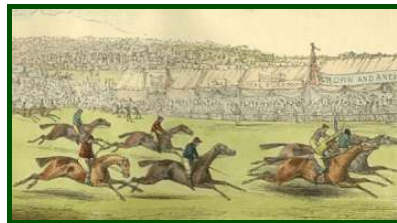

**Snow Fairy Added to Oaks Field...**

Anamoine Ltd's **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) has been supplemented for Friday's G1 Investec Oaks at Epsom, making a total of 17 fillies still engaged. Successful in the Listed Height of Fashion S. over nearly 10 furlongs at Goodwood May 19, the Ed Dunlop trainee joined the acceptors at the six-day stage for the mile-and-a-half Classic. Patrick Cooper, racing manager to owner Cristina Patino, told the *Racing Post*, "Snow Fairy is officially rated 107 after her win in the Height of Fashion S., and so she doesn't have that much to make up on the principals in the Investec Oaks. The mile and a half of the Investec Oaks is a bit of a question. We weren't absolutely sure that she would stay 10 furlongs at Goodwood, but most of the fillies lining up on Friday won't have raced over a mile and a half, so they too are about to find out. There is plenty of stamina going back in her pedigree--the 1999 Derby winner Oath (Ire) is in the background, and so is Elusive Pimpernel. There have been plenty of two-milers in her family, so there is every chance that she will stay the distance." Most of the leading chances remain, including Khalid Abdullah's Henry Cecil-trained pair **Aviate (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and **Timepiece (GB)** (Zamindar), and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Rumoush (Rahy)**. Michael Jarvis has also confirmed that Sheikh Ahmed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's May 20 Sandown maiden scorer **Sajjhaa (GB)** (King's Best) would be allowed a shot at the big prize. "Although Sajjhaa is inexperienced, she is a straightforward filly who has shown plenty of ability, and therefore deserves to take her chance," her conditioner told the *Post*. "I believe both Classics are very open this year, particularly the Oaks. Frankie has an option to ride for the owner and, as he has a couple of other possible mounts, we'll wait on riding plans for now."

Last year's G1 Champion S. winner is on course for the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 16 after coming through his workout with Tranquil Tiger (GB) (Selkirk). "It was a nice piece of work and he quickened away well," Cecil told *PA Sport*. "He seems in good form and the idea was to get the adrenaline going with the Prince of Wales's in mind as he has not raced since Dubai. He could go for the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 3] after Ascot if we are happy with him. There is also the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 17] and the [Oct. 16] Champion S., which he won last year, and he could go back to the Breeders' Cup again. He does like a bit of give in the ground, but those are the races open to him and he could go for some of them."

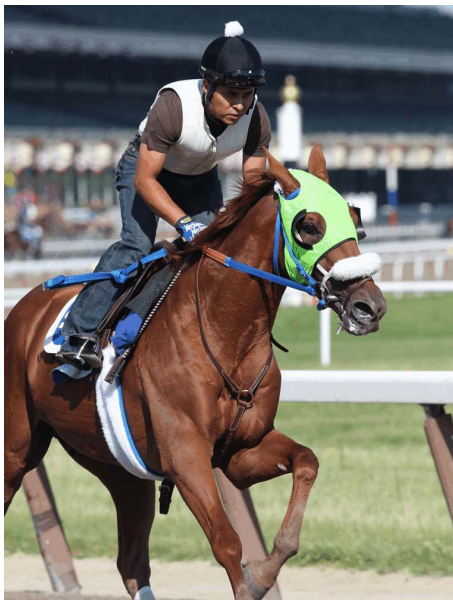


**Atta Boy to Get Time Off After Aristides...**

**Dogwood Top Two Doing Well...**

GIII Dogwood S. winner **Ailalea** (Pulpit) and runner-up **Tap Tap Tapping** (Tapit) both came out of Saturday's race in good order. "She got a little hot after the race and she did the same thing after the [Kentucky] Oaks," Mike McCarthy, assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher, said of Ailalea. "But, she [was] fine after about 30 minutes. We had her out on the grass earlier this morning and she was fine." Tap Tap Tapping, who was 31-1 in the Dogwood, is also doing well and could go next in the GIII Iowa Oaks at Prairie Meadows June 26. "The race usually comes up light and it is \$200,000," said trainer David Vance. "She is really just learning, and I think she has more in her," he added. Vance is also interested in trying the filly on the turf at some point in the future. "I am inclined to keep her on the dirt, but I may work her on the grass to see how she handles it," he said. "She has El Gran Senor in her pedigree and sometimes the Tapits take to the grass."

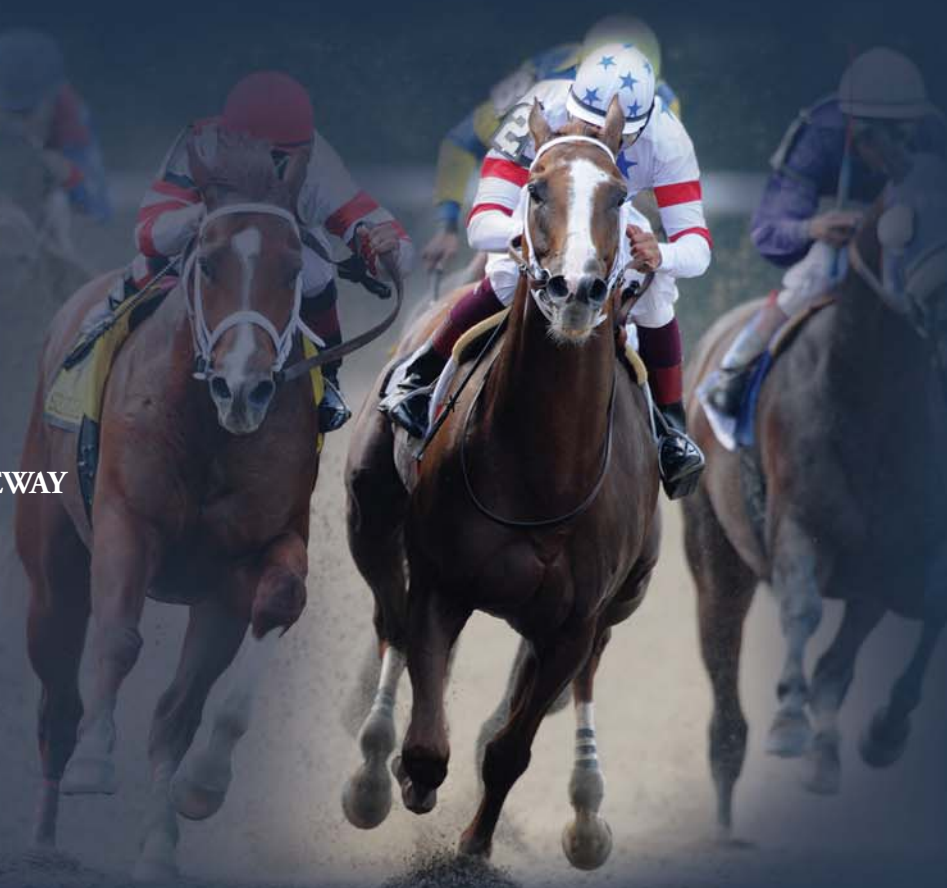
