### MET MILE A QUALITY AFFAIR

Quality Road (Elusive Quality) delivered a tour de force performance to take yesterday's GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park, turning back the late challenge of **Musket Man** (Yonaguska) and completing the mile in a sparkling 1:33.11. Sent off the 1-4 favorite, the Ned Evans homebred attended the pace of longshot **Le Grand Cru**

(Dynaformer), and dispatched that rival after a half-mile in :45.19. He opened a clear lead after three-quarters in 1:08.57 and looked home free before Musket Man came running late, but the classy Quality Road found more and

kicked clear again to win by 1 1/2 lengths. The performance drew high praise from trainer Todd Pletcher. "It was very impressive, and watching him come back and seeing how he hardly took a deep breath, it's unbelievable how talented he is, especially when you consider he was spotting the runner-up seven pounds and coming off a four-month layoff," Pletcher said. "He's such a versatile horse. He set a track record at Saratoga at 6 1/2 furlongs and two track records at Gulfstream at 1 1/8 miles, and he showed today he's a brilliant miler. He took the race to everyone and kept on. Just brilliant." **Cont. p2**

### INTERACTIF JOINS BELMONT FIELD

Trainer Todd Pletcher, who had been pointing Wertheimer et Frere's **Interactif** (Broken Vow) for Friday's GIII Hill Prince S. on the turf, revealed yesterday he would instead send the colt to Saturday's GI Belmont S. "We decided to call an audible and send him to the Belmont," said Pletcher. "Two works ago, we had it in our minds and, after surveying the field, we decided to go." Interactif broke his maiden on the main track at Monmouth Park last July, but was switched to the turf after running eighth in the GII Sanford S. at the end of the month. The winner of the GIII With Anticipation S. and GIII Bourbon S. and third in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf S., the bay opened 2010 with a second in the Feb. 7 Hallandale Beach S. on the Gulfstream grass. He was second in the Mar. 13 GII San Felipe S., beaten just a half-length by Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in his synthetic-track bow. **Cont. p2**

Interactif was last seen running fourth in the Apr. 10 GI Blue Grass S. "His second to Sidney's Candy in the San Felipe was very good, although we were a little disappointed with his performance in the Blue Grass," said Pletcher. "We had the Derby in mind after [the Blue Grass], but thought the three weeks might be a little fast back." Interactif worked five panels in 1:00.41 at Belmont Saturday. Javier Castellano will have the mount in the third leg of the Triple Crown.

**Drosselmeyer Drills Belmont Bullet...**

GII Dwyer S. runner-up **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) had his final Belmont prep yesterday morning, going a bullet five furlongs in :59.65 on the main track at Big Sandy. Exercise rider Juan Quintero was in the irons. The chestnut broke off behind his workmate, but was on even terms in the lane and drew clear late. "The fact that it was that fast, I'm not disappointed," said trainer Bill Mott. "He's supposed to be a good horse, and I was looking for a decent work. I put some company with him, and I thought he would work a bit faster, which he did. He finished up well, and galloped out well, seven furlongs in 1:26 and change. When you get in that range, you're talking about racehorse times." Fourth in the GII Risen Star S. and third in the GII Louisiana Derby, Drosselmeyer will be bidding for his first black-type score in the Belmont.

Also working yesterday, GI Blue Grass winner **Stately Victor** (Ghostzapper) went a half in :49.93 on the Belmont main track, and **Make Music For Me** (Bernstein) covered five-eighths in 1:01.21 over the Belmont training track. Stately Victor was eighth in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby, and Make Music For Me ran fourth. "On the main track, he's been off the bridle," said Make Music For Me's trainer Alexis Barba. "When I galloped him [Sunday] on the training track, he was a little more into it. And he was again today. He was a little sharper. He's been on the main track since he arrived here. [Today's workout] was just a little change up. Sometimes horses do better with that."

Out of the West Coast, trainer Bob Baffert sent GIII Lone Star Derby hero **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) for a six-furlong move at Santa Anita. The gelding went the distance in 1:12.40 out of the gate. "When we first purchased him, he had gate problems," explained Baffert. "I can't stand it when they don't break running. Today he was good in the gate, tracked the other horse, and wasn't too tired when he got back. He's coming into the race very well. I liked what I saw today; if I didn't I wouldn't bring him."

**Quality Road Sparkles in Met Mile** *(cont. from p 1)*

Quality Road has not put a hoof wrong since his infamous implosion behind the gate at last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The four-year-old, who set track records while winning last year's GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream and GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga, returned to the races with a front-running 2 3/4-length victory in the Jan. 3 GIII Hal's Hope S. He was making his first start since a 12 3/4-length demolition job in the Feb. 6 GI Donn H., where he lowered his own track record for nine furlongs in 1:47.49.

Quality Road's time tied for the second-fastest ever Met Mile behind Honour and Glory, who set the stakes record of 1:32.81 in 1996. In 1997, Langfuhr won in 1:33.11. Conquistador Cielo's 1982 victory, before timing in hundreths, was in 1:33 flat. John Velazquez was always confident yesterday. "The first quarter was easy enough for him, I thought 'Let them come and get him,'" the rider said. "After that, we picked it up, and I felt that we picked it up pretty quick, but he just kept going. I encouraged him going to the quarter pole, just to kind of get his mind on running. He was game today." As for what is next, Pletcher said, "We'll see how he comes out of this. There might be a race between now and the [Aug. 7 GI] Whitney, or not. We could take a look at the [July 3 GII] Suburban, but you want to make sure he's still peaking in November, too, so you want to be careful how many times you take him over there. Victor's Cry, who closed powerfully to get up for a half-length tally down the hill turf course at Santa Anita in a Feb. 3 allowance, was fourth in an off-the-turf affair Mar. 7. His late rally came up 2 1/4 lengths short of Mr Gruff when he was second in the down-the-hill GIII San Simeon H. last time out Apr. 17. Lightly regarded in this effort, the dark bay settled off the pace as Mr Gruff cut out fractions of :23.08, :46.05, and 1:09.20. As the pacesetter began to tire, a host of challengers appeared and it was Victor's Cry who was closing best late to just get his head in front of favored Karelian on the line. "Turning for home, I felt all I needed was a spot to run," said winning rider Corey Nakatani. "Right on that turn, they kind of squirted away and I cut the corner and was able to swing out. I waited a little bit to make sure that when I did call on him, he was there. He made a strong move from the three-eighths pole to get position and, to be able to win the race, I had to try to time it as best I could." Trainer Eoin Harty admitted he was surprised by the result. "I was happy because I thought we were going to run third," Harty said. "Then I saw them stopping and I thought he was going to run second. Then I saw they were really stopping and I just couldn't believe it. I entered to win. I thought on paper it might set up well for his style of running. But it is a Grade I and these things are hard to win, so I would have been happy for a piece of it. I am also happy to win it." It's safe to say that Evening Jewel's connections would like--just once--a victory by open lengths. The always-game miss, who hasn't finished worse than second since her unveiling at Del Mar last term, has been involved in some of the most thrilling races of the year. She was nosed out by Blind Luck in the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita in February, came out a neck on top of It's Tea Time in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3, and lost a heartbreaker when a whis-ker short of Blind Luck in the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30. Trainer James Cassidy decided to make the move to the sod for this one, and while she ultimately earned the decision, it was another nail-biter. Put on the lead under Victor Espinoza, she coasted through soft :24 4/5, :50 1/5 and 1:14 2/5 fractions. The field began to bunch up behind her in upper stretch, but she dug in gamely and sprinted hard to the wire, just accounting for the rapidly closing Cozi Rosie. "She was doing it easy and wasn't rank at all," said Espinoza of the winner. "After the first half mile, she was strong so I wanted to wait as long as I could and not use her." Added Cassidy, "She's worked over the turf fabulously, but you never know. The GI American Oaks [July 3 at Hollywood] and the GI Del Mar Oaks are next, and that takes her to the end of the summer." Wasted Tears was in the early stages of what is now a six-race win streak when she set a course record to take last year's Ouija Board as an 11-1 outsider. Coming off front-running wins in the Feb. 20 GIII Honey Fox S. at Gulfstream and in the Apr. 10 Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland, she was no secret yesterday and was sent off the heavy 1-5 favorite. The dark bay mare was pressed by Bubbler through fractions of :22.86, :46.33 and 1:09.71, inched clear at midstretch and was all out to hold off the last-to-second rally of Fortunia. "She didn't break quite as fast as I thought she might, but she broke well, and she was very comfortable in getting to the early lead," said winning jockey Cliff Berry. The 2009 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf winner Maram and jockey Jose Lezcano had the advantage as they came down the lane and she dug in late, but Gypsy's Warning closed the gap with every stride, and the two hit the wire as a team. "She was already proven in South Africa, but you still never know what to expect first time in the U.S.," said Valdivia. "I was very pleased that she went by Maram, because she's a very nice filly. She's got a big turn of foot. I expect big things in the future for her." It was the second graded win in less than 10 minutes for Motion, who watched the race on TV at Belmont Park just minutes after cheering Check the Label (Stormin Fever) to victory in the GII Sands Point S. The runner-up had not been out since finishing sixth in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, the second of an abbreviated two-start campaign in 2009. 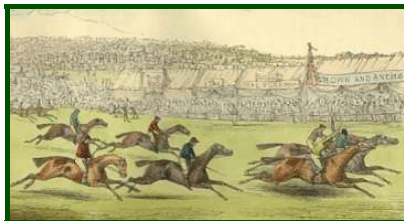

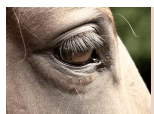

This could be a very big week for King's Best, winner of the millennium 2000 Guineas. The Haras du Logis resident already has the Japanese Derby in the bag, thanks to Eishin Flash's narrow victory in the Tokyo Yushun two days ago, and he has serious candidates for the English and French Derbys next weekend, thanks to Workforce and Simon de Montfort. For good measure, his once-raced daughter Sajjhaa is now one of the leading fancies for the Oaks, following her wide-margin debut victory at Sandown.

This clutch of Classic contenders is another example of success breeding further success five years down the line. King's Best's first three-year-olds raced with distinction in 2005, with Proclamation winning the G1 Sussex S., Dubai Surprise the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio and Oiseau Rare the G2 Prix de Royallieu. Another stakes winner, Runaway, was good enough to earn a Timeform rating of 118 that year, and Notability, another member of this first crop, was to become a Group 1 performer in 2006. King's Best consequently attracted a strong book of mares in 2006, which produced his current crop of three-year-olds (some 20 of which won at two last year).

It hasn't all been plain sailing with King's Best's stallion career, though. Although he commanded the substantial fee of €35,000 for most of his first six years at Kildangan Stud, his fee fell to €25,000 in 2007 and then to €15,000 in 2008, after none of his progeny had scored at higher than Group 3 level in 2007. Towards the end of 2008, Darley took the decision to switch him to France, a country where King's Best had been very ably represented by such as Creachadoir (a close second in the 2007 French 2000 Guineas), Best Name (runner-up in the 2006 Prix du Jockey-Club) and Oiseau Rare.

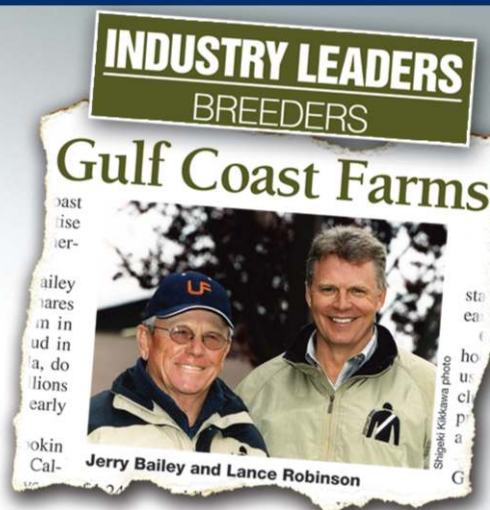

King's Best had completed his first French season by the time his son King's Apostle became his first Group 1 winner in France, in the 2009 Prix Maurice de Gheest.

Perhaps some seeds of doubt had also been sown by King's Best's record in Australia, where he stood the 2001, 2003 and 2004 seasons. He failed to come up with a single group winner there from nearly 250 foals. It is therefore going to be interesting to see how he fares with his first Argentine crop, conceived in 2007 at Haras Vacacion. Some of the yearlings from this crop are on offer at the Copa Bullrich sale early next week.

Part of the problem with King's Best has been his widespread reputation for siring plenty of offspring which inherit his highly strung temperament. This was probably evident at the 2009 yearling sales, when youngsters from his penultimate Irish crop achieved a median of less than 16,000gns, off a fee of €25,000, with his fillies again proving a much harder sell than his colts. Of course, a difficult temperament needn't be a barrier to high-class ability, even if it can make a trainer's job much more challenging.

On the other hand, it mustn't be forgotten that King's Best was a good Classic winner--good enough to defeat Giant's Causeway at Newmarket--or that his pedigree could hardly be more "live." His sire Kingmambo has proved himself one of the era's most prolific sources of European Classic winners, while his dam Allegretta will forever be remembered for producing Urban Sea, the Arc-winning mare who gave us those magnificent colts Galileo and Sea the Stars.

Breeders and trainers may be forced to reassess their prejudices if King's Best's Classic contenders continue to shine this week. Perhaps--rather like Kingmambo's American son Lemon Drop Kid--he is destined to gain new-found respect as a stallion after having his ability questioned.

Sons of Kingmambo were responsible for both the colts that fought out the Japanese Derby, as the runner-up, Rose Kingdom, is by King Kamehameha. This winner of the 2004 Japanese Derby (also sire of this year's Japanese 1000 Guineas and Oaks winner Apapane) is based at Shadai Farm, the organisation credited with breeding Eishin Flash. However, as with the Kentucky Derby hero Super Saver, the people credited with breeding the Classic winner are not the people who arranged the mating that resulted in the Derby heroes. Shadai acquired Eishin Flash's dam Moonlady for 300,000gns at Tattersalls' 2006 December Sales, when the German-bred mare was in foal to King's Best.

If Moonlady's name sounds familiar, it is because she spent several years in America. She arrived in America to challenge for the GII Long Island H., having already won three group races in Germany, including the G2 German St Leger over 13/4 miles. Her connections allowed her to take her chance, even though the Long Island was forced off the turf by heavy rain. Moonlady justified this bold decision by carrying Gary Tanaka's colors to victory, but she was unable to win again in nine further American starts.

When I reviewed Moonlady's pedigree after her Long Island victory, I commented, "With these bloodlines, Moonlady is virtually guaranteed a very successful future as a broodmare." Her second dam Majoritat had possessed enough speed to win the German 1000 Guineas over a mile, plus enough stamina to take the German Oaks over 1 3/8 miles. Majoritat now has numerous stakes-winning descendants, including Macleya, who failed by only a short neck to land the G1 Prix Royal-Oak in 2007, and Mystic Lips, winner of the G1 German Oaks in 2007. Two of Majoritat's sons, Malinas and Masterplayer, were good enough to be placed in the German Derby.

One of Moonlady's greatest attractions as a broodmare was that her pedigree is free of many of the most ubiquitous stallions, and contains very little Northern Dancer blood.

I suspect that King's Best may have been chosen for her on the basis that he is out of a German-bred mare. This produced two lines in the fifth generation of Eishin Flash's pedigree to the three-time champion sire Birkhahn.

Another interesting aspect of Moonlady's pedigree was that she is inbred 4x5 to the outstanding French stayer Reliance II. This winner of the Prix du Jockey-Club and Grand Prix de Paris was a son of the outstanding Dupr, broodmare Relance. Relance's two sons by Tantieme were Reliance II and his equally talented older brother Match III, winner as a four-year-old of the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, King George and Queen Elizabeth S. and Washington D.C. International. Relance did equally well when mated to Tantieme's son Tanerko, producing Relko, winner of the 2000 Guineas in France and the Derby in England.

This was clearly a very potent combination, so the addition of an extra line to Tantieme, via King's Best's dam, must surely have appealed to Moonlady's owners. Although Eishin Flash is by a miler, there is enough stamina in his pedigree to suggest that he will stay well enough to challenge for the Japanese St Leger and the spring version of the Tenno Sho.

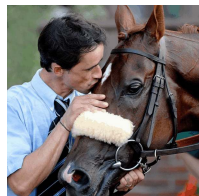
