IT'S OFFICIAL: BC 2011 TO CHURCHILL

Breeders' Cup Ltd. and Churchill Downs made it official Friday morning: Churchill will host the Breeders' Cup in 2011. The announcement was made at a press conference at the Louisville track, which will be the site of event in 2010 as well. The Breeders' Cup has been held at Churchill six times previously--1988, 1991, 1994, 1998, 2000 and 2006. "The return of the Breeders' Cup for a second consecutive year in 2011 is good news for Kentucky and Churchill Downs, as it underscores the importance of the event and our track to life and the economic vitality in our state and region," said Robert Evans, president and CEO of Churchill Downs Inc.

LAMINITIS CLAIMS KIP DEVILLE

Kip Deville (Kipling--Klondike Kaytie, by Encino), who had been at Rood and Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington since last fall, had to be euthanized Friday. The seven-year-old was originally sent to the clinic after suffering two bouts of colic, and underwent surgery twice. He then contracted laminitis in both front feet and, as the condition worsened, the tendons of his front legs were cut to try and alleviate the pressure on his feet. Things appeared to have taken a turn for the better in March, but the gelding's condition deteriorated last week, and the decision was made yesterday to put him down. Bred in Oklahoma by Center Hills Farm, Kip Deville started his career in the southwest, but was purchased privately by IEAH Stables, Pegasus Holdings Group and Resolute Group Stables after his win in the Grand Prairie Turf Challenge S. at Lone Star in April of 2006. The grey won eight races for his new connections, including the GI Breeders' Cup Mile and GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. in 2007, the GI Maker's Mark Mile S. in 2008 (he won the event as a Grade II in 2007), and the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. in 2009. Overall, he compiled a record of 29-12-4-2, and earned \$3,325,489.

ARLINGTON CUTS STAKES PURSES Citing a significant drop in out-of-state handle, Arlington Park officials announced Friday that they will cut \$725,000 from stakes purses. Exempt from the decreases are the

three races that comprise the Aug. 21 International Festival of Racing--the GI Arlington Million, GI Beverly D. S. and GI Secretariat S. "In order to maintain support for current overnight purses, it became necessary to make these

adjustments to the stakes program," said Arlington Park President Roy Arnold. "While lowering purses is never easy, we want to do our best to provide as healthy an overnight purse structure as possible for the horsemen who stable on our grounds and support our program on a daily basis. These adjustments will allow us to retain current purse levels." The track received the approval of its plan from the Board of Directors of the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association. "We are hopeful that we have seen the worst in the way of handle at Arlington Park for the season and we hope that things will improve as the season progresses," said ITHA President Mike Campbell. "It is incumbent on the horsemen stabled at Arlington to race here in order to help field size, which will improve the handle, and hopefully make further cuts unnecessary." The Illinois Racing Board will review the changes at a meeting later this month. Twelve stakes will be affected by the cuts. The \$100,000 Sea O'Erin S. has been canceled; the new purses for the 11 other events are:

Just last fall, Overbrook Farm sold off more than 200 horses in a dispersal that grossed over \$38 million. But Overbrook did not shut down its operation entirely. With Chris Young, the grandson of the late William T. Young, in charge, Overbrook held on to a small string that now numbers 17. Chief among them is the regally bred **Battle Plan**. The five-year-old, a son of Overbrook champion Flanders (Seeking the Gold), suffered a condylar fracture of the right front cannon bone before his first start, and didn't make it to the races until November of 2008. He had only a maiden win to his credit when his stablemates headed to the sales ring last year, and he was recovering from a condylar fracture of the left foreleg. The decision to keep Battle Plan bore fruit when he opened 2010 with a 3 1/4-length allowance win at Gulfstream Park Jan. 8. The bay came back to take an optional claimer by five Feb. 18, then he stepped up his game and made it a perfect three-for-three on the year in the Mar. 27 GII New Orleans H. He looks to make it five in a row after the 2 1/2-month freshening. **Blame** has put together a three-race winning streak, taking the Oct. 31 GII Fayette S. at Keeneland and the Nov. 27 GII Clark H. at Churchill to end 2009, then opening 2010 with a victory in the May 15 GIII W.D. Schaefer S. at Pimlico. **Arson Squad** made only three starts last term, finishing off the board every time, but has shown renewed interest this season. The seven-year-old gelding took the GIII Skip Away S. at Gulfstream Apr. 3 in his third start of the campaign, and most recently annexed the GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill Apr. 30.

Unrivaled Belle looks to give Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott another Grade I weekend. The four-year-old, who boasts five wins and two seconds from her eight career starts, comes off a head victory over reigning Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Apr. 30 GII La Troienne S. at Churchill Downs. The grey is also perfect in two starts over the Belmont main track. "I

think the race she ran last time was as competitive as a Grade I, taking on last year's champion," Mott. "And, having beaten Rachel Alexandra, I would say she definitely belongs here." **Funny Moon** has also shown an affinity for the strip at Big Sandy, with four wins from five trips over the oval. The winner of the GI CCA Oaks last summer, she captured the May 15 GII Shuvee H. at Belmont in her second start after nearly eight months on the shelf. **Life At Ten** steps up in quest of a fifth straight victory. The five-year-old capped off 2009 with a win in Aqueduct's Snit S. Dec. 12, then came back to take the Rare Treat S. Feb. 20. She shipped to Hawthorne for the Apr. 17 GIII Sixty Sails H., winning by a length. "We've always thought she was a good filly," said Jonathan Thomas, assistant to Todd Pletcher.

Trainer Marty Wolfson echoed the feelings of the majority of the connections of the Fleur de Lis runners when he told *Daily Racing Form*, "I hate to have to run against **Rachel Alexandra**." But Wolfson's candidate to beat the Horse of the Year, **Jessica Is Back**, is the lone distaffer in the field whose morning-line odds are less than double digits. The speedy six-year-old romped by nine lengths in the Mar. 13 Ocala S. for Florida-breds at Gulfstream. In front early in the Apr. 17 GIII Sixty Sails H. at Hawthorne last time out, she weakened late to be second. Wolfson, who indicated his charge would run at Churchill, and not in Delaware's GIII Obeah S., added, "You never know what's gonna happen." Still, it will be a shock if the champ doesn't find herself in the winner's circle this afternoon. "I think we'll see the real Rachel Saturday," jockey Calvin Borel told *DRF*.

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Rail Trip** will be tough to beat with anything close to his best effort. The five-year-old kicked off his career in 2008 with a streak of success that spilled over into 2009. The win-train was derailed with back-to-back seconds in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. last May and in the '09 renewal of this race, but Rail Trip redeemed himself with a three-length tour-de-force in the July 11 GI Hollywood Gold Cup over an accomplished field of 12 that included four Grade I winners. He finished up the season with a close-up third in the GI Pacific Classic, and returned this term in the Mervyn Leroy with a 3 1/4-length score over many of these foes. A nice win could set up for an exciting showdown down the road with the likes of Quality Road (Elusive Quality) and Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), perhaps with Horse of the Year honors on the line.

Wertheimer and Frere's **Colizeo** had little difficulty leading a field of allowance foes, which included late-running contender **Prince Will I Am** and next-out winner Down With Dixie (Purge), gate-to-wire at this track and distance May 9. The Pletcher trainee was favored three back when he was the victim of pace pressure from GI Preakness S. runner-up and GI Belmont S. show horse First Dude (Stephen Got Even) in a February Gulfstream allowance and faded to fourth of five. That race set up for Fly Down (Mineshaft), who went on to win the GII Dwyer S. before finishing second in the Belmont. A repeat of the first scenario is more likely in today's test. **Max Silverhammer** debuted under the Twin Spires in November versus \$15,000 maiden claimers in an abbreviated sprint and finished well after some early trouble to be third at 40-1. The modest \$5,000 KEESEP yearling followed his unveiling with a stretch-out win at Turfway in a maiden special weight Jan. 9. Racing with mixed results in four subsequent outings, he returned to Churchill for a starter allowance May 7. The gelding made a sweeping inside-to-out move to draw off by eight lengths that afternoon, but must now pass the class test.

Only nine go to post for tomorrow's G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks), which is the smallest field since East of the Moon (Private Account) beat eight rivals in 1994, so the draw will have far less of an impact this time.

His Highness The Aga Khan set out his intentions earlier this week when he decided to send both the Alain de Royer-Dupre-trained **"TDN Rising Stars"**

Rosanara and **Sarafina** to post for this Classic and it may be that potential rivals have taken the hint. His sole representative **Deluxe** (Storm Cat) is a daughter of the great Hasili (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) and she becomes the first of her progeny to try for this esteemed prize. Last year, Jean-Claude Rouget enjoyed a red-letter day when saddling a one-two for his first renewal led home by Martin Schwartz's Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}), and that owner will be cheering on **Zagora** this time, who was drawn against the fence yesterday. Francois Rohaut, who relies on Lady O'Reilly's **Sandbar** and Robert Collet, responsible for Richard Strauss's **Heaven's Vault**, are two of France's leading trainers still looking for a first Diane and despite being drawn widest of all, the latter will occupy the nine stall from which the 2005 and 2007 scorers Divine Proportions (Kingmambo) and West Wind (GB) (Machiavellian) emerged.

Racehorse owner and professional gambler Harry Findlay was yesterday handed a six-month ban by the British Horseracing Authority as a result of an investigation into the laying of one of his horses on betfair. The part-owner of the classy flat runner Inler (Ire) (Red Ransom) and top jumps performer Denman (Ire) (Presenting {GB}) is set to appeal against the penalty, and has seven days to do so. Findlay yesterday claimed that the bets in question on his runner Gullible Gordon (Ire) (Anshan {GB}) on two separate occasions were in the first instance an error and in the second to lay off a win bet. "I'm not going to go out and shout and scream at anybody, I'm a heartbroken man," he said in an interview on *At The Races* yesterday. "With the first race in question, I made a technical error and pressed the wrong button and, in the second one, as a professional gambler, I had a bet before and then a little bit more on before laying back in running. I'm a gambler and all I have is my word and my reputation. Whether I win the appeal or not, I honestly don't think I will be owning horses again in Britain. You cannot have people ultimately deciding whether people are charged or not with gambling-related offences if they know nothing about gambling. It cannot be right and fair."
