PLAYING THE BLAME GAME

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Blame** (Arch) confirmed his status as one of the nation's top handicappers, coming with a relentless rally inside the final 100 yards to pin back long time leader **Battle Plan** (Empire Maker) and win the GI Stephen Foster H. at

Churchill Downs. It was the first Grade I badge for the colt, who was quietly one of the leaders of his division in 2009. Blame took a one-mile allowance over this track in his second sophomore appearance, then progressed to defeat subsequent GSW **Gone Astray** (Dixie Union)

in the restricted **Curlin S.** at Saratoga Aug. 2. The bay faced a near-helpless task in the GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 19, with **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor) the lone speed, and while that one scored easily, it was Blame's stinging late run into second that caught the attention of many. Armed with realistic aspirations, connections skipped the Breeders' Cup and instead sent the colt out to defeat his elders in the GIII Fayette S. at Keeneland Oct. 31, and he backed up that performance with yet another score versus older foes in this track's GII Clark H. Nov. 27.

It was by trainer Al Stall Jr. design that Blame got the winter off, and he made the ideal return to action, charging home from between horses to land the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. on the Preakness undercard May 15. It would prove the perfect steppingstone.

Battle Plan, the last-out winner of the GII New Orleans H., jumped well and took them along through moderate fractions early on. While the Overbrook runner was able to take full advantage of his draw in two, Blame was handicapped by his outside stall, was unable to get in on the track and traveled four wide in sixth to the backstretch. General Quarters, exiting a win in the GI Turf

Classic May 1, laid closest to the front runner and came to try to make a race of it at the quarter pole. Blame was still trapped four deep as the field reached the quarter pole and looked to have his work cut out, but he went after the pacesetter inside the final furlong and roared past for the victory.

“My main concern was trying to come home off that pace,” admitted winning rider Garrett Gomez. “That’s what you’re always scared of and I think the farther the better with this horse. He does everything good. He’s coming around; he’s gotten a little more seasoning. He’s a true professional and a pleasure to be around. I’ll let him answer how good he can be.”

Stall said the winner would likely for Grade I races such as the Whitney H., the Woodward S. and the Jockey Club Gold Cup en route to the GI Breeders’ Cup Classic back at Churchill in November.

His Highness The Aga Khan is not usually accustomed to running more than one of his luminaries in the same race, but it may be significant that the last time he did so in a Classic, Alamshar (Ire) (Key of Luck) led home Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) for a memorable one-two in the 2003 G1 Irish Derby. Sarafina, who is bidding to emulate recent winners of the G1 Prix Saint-Alary Zainta (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) by adding this to her impressive success in that Longchamp contest May 23, is the choice of rider Christophe-Patrice Lemaire. Rosanara has suffered three reversals since playing her part in a day of days for her owner/breeder when taking Longchamp's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on Arc day.

All horses in the *TDN* are bred in North America, unless otherwise indicated

Third behind Jan Vermeer (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November, the grey returned to that track to finish third in the Apr. 25 G3 Prix de la Grotte and fifth--before being promoted to fourth--in the May 16 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches. On the latter occasion, she was one of the worst victims of the interference that ultimately changed the result, and trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre is hoping for a reversal of fortune. "Rosanara had a very bad race in the Pouliches, where she could have won were she not stuck in the middle of the straight," de Royer-Dupre explained. "She looks very well at this time and the distance should be okay for her, so I have decided to run the two fillies. Our pacemaker **Valasyra (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}) will ensure a good pace."

Deluxe Item...

Andre Fabre was the craftsman responsible for Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill) and Intercontinental (GB) (Danehill), and is busy at work on another Juddmonte project in **Deluxe** (Storm Cat), who shares her illustrious dam Hasili (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) with that formidable duo. Following two straightforward successes over a mile at this venue in September and at Longchamp Apr. 15, she dealt with the substantial hike in class with aplomb when a half-length second to Sarafina in the Saint-Alary. While there was no disguising the authority of the winner that day, connections have a still-unexposed type on their hands who is from a family that progress markedly with time. She bids to emulate Bright Sky (Ire) (Wolfhound), who went one better here after suffering defeat in that prize eight years ago. "Deluxe was running on at the end of the Saint-Alary, and she is still learning," Teddy Grimthorpe, the owner/breeder's racing manager, told *Racing Post*. "Obviously, she will have to improve again to win this race, but the filly is in good form, and she should stay this slightly longer distance."

Raising the Bar...

Lady O'Reilly's **Sandbar (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) is a quietly progressive type, having followed a hard-fought win in the Listed Prix Rose de Mai at Saint-Cloud Mar. 20 with a fluent score in that venue's G3 Prix Cleopatre last time May 8, where **Heaven's Vault (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) was 1 1/4 lengths back in third. She was supplemented this week, and connections are hopeful that the homebred can end a long drought for that trial; Pawneese (Ire) was the last to complete the Cleopatre-Diane double back in 1976. "She's a very tough filly, and Lady O'Reilly made a very brave move to supplement her," James Kelly, the owner/breeder's racing manager, told *PA Sport*. "It's very difficult to figure out the French form. Neither Lady O'Reilly or [trainer] Francois Rohaut can make head or tail of it. All the fillies seem to be beating each other. Numerically it's a small field, but it certainly looks a very competitive one." Jean-Claude Rouget relies on Martin Schwartz's **Zagora (Fr)** (Green Tune), who followed a head second to the subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches first-past-the-post Liliside (Fr) (American Post {GB}) in the Listed Prix la Camargo over a mile at Saint-Cloud Apr. 1 with an impressive win in the May 2 G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp. Lattice (Ire) (Inchinar {GB}) and the aforementioned Zainta have used that prep as a springboard to glory here in recent times.

The progressive Life At Ten was pressed along through a very demanding opening six furlongs, but scooted away in upper stretch and went on to her first Grade I score and fifth consecutive win. A well-beaten seventh in a nine-furlong allowance over a yielding Belmont turf course Sept. 30, the chestnut shortened up to six furlongs and got up for a half-length victory in the Aqueduct slop Nov. 15. Stretched back to a distance of ground for her next, she tacked on a 1 3/4-length tally in the Dec. 12 Snit S. over the inner track Dec. 12 before getting a little breather. She showed no signs of rust in her return to action in the Feb. 20 Rare Treat S. in Ozone Park, leading every step of the way for a dominating 5 1/4-length win and, in her latest effort, shipped into Chicago for the GIII Sixty Sails H. Apr. 17 and departed with her first graded-stakes trophy. The second wagering choice behind Unrivaled Belle, Life At Ten stumbled just a touch at the break, but recovered nicely and set demanding fractions of :23.22 for the opening quarter mile and :45.55 to the half, pressed all the while by the odds-on selection. Asked to go for home after six furlongs in a testing 1:08.40, Life At Ten disposed of the Unrivaled Belle challenge and was not seriously threatened the remainder. Funny Moon was well poised to rally into the strong pace, but she hung a bit late and allowed Unrivaled Belle to outfinish her for second.

There were no mistakes this time around, as reigning Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra sprinted away from four overmatched rivals leaving the eighth pole for her first victory as a four-year-old, and silencing at least some of her critics. The bay filly was a perfect eight from eight during her championship season, with five Grade I successes, including her historic 20 1/4-length score in the Kentucky Oaks. Three of those five tallies at the highest level came at the expense of males, first the GI Preakness S. followed two starts later by a six-length defeat of Summer Bird (Birdstone) in the GI Haskell Invitational S. Aug. 2. Her season ended--abruptly for some--with a head win from Macho Again (Macho Uno) in the GI Woodward S., and she would not be seen for six months. A date with Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Apple Blossom S. seemed a mere formality when Rachel went to post as the 1-20 favorite in the New Orleans Ladies' S. Mar. 13, but Zardana (Brz) (Crimson Tide {Ire}) had other ideas and beat the champ on the square. With the Arkansas trip now called off, she took her place in the gate for the GII La Troienne S. on the Oaks undercard Apr. 30, and though she ran with credit when runner-up to Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song), many wondered just what she had left in the tank. She left nothing to chance yesterday. Steered off the heels of Jessica Is Back under the wire the first time, Rachel Alexandra was a stalking second through an easy half in :47.25. Calvin Borel asked her to go after the pacesetter on the turn, and while Distinctive Dixie looked a momentary threat, Rachel strode away under hand encouragement and scored as much the best. It doesn't get a whole lot easier than this. Rail Trip jumped alertly from the seven hole, tracked longshot pacesetter One Track Mind (Mach One) from second and strode home a confident winner of The Californian, a race in which he was defeated into second in 2009. Off that effort 12 months ago, the 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 was dismissed at nearly 10-1 for the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 11 and made those who doubted him pay dearly with a three-length victory. Sent off the 5-2 favorite for the GI Pacific Classic in what would become his final four-year-old appearance Sept. 6, the bay was never far from the front and made a nice stretch run, but was outfinished by longshot upstart Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) and Einstein (Brz) (Spend a Buck). Forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Classic with an injury, connections were in no hurry to get him back to the races, but when he did so, it was business as usual, as he romped by 3 1/4 lengths in the GII Mervyn Leroy H. May 8, a race which produced another runner-up effort last year. Confidently handled by Rafael Bejarano, Rail Trip tracked smoothly for second, eased by One Track Mind at the head of the lane, went clear and was taken in hand for the final 50 yards. "I had so much horse at the end," Bejarano commented. "It was nice to be able to save something for next time. He's been training so good and he was really fit today. I felt a little pressure at the half-mile, but he kept on running. He's getting better and better and you can do anything you want with him."

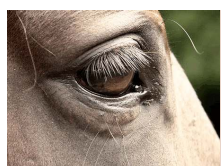

In three subsequent starts back at Kenilworth in the summer, the dark bay was runner-up to Pocket Power in the Dec. 5 Pinnacle Plate and third behind that rival in the Jan. 9 G1 Queen's Plate, but only ninth in the feature Jan. 30 G1 J & B Met. On the latter occasion, he may have had excuses from a poor draw having too much ground to make up in the straight, and went on holiday as connections eyed a July repeat. Following a respectable display when fifth on his return in the seven-furlong G2 Drill Hall S. at Greyville last time May 7, he put himself firmly in pole position with this battling performance under Piere Strydom. He was left alone in second early as the runaway stable companion of Pocket Power Blue Tiger (SAf) (Counter Action {SAf}) set furious fractions, was the only horse capable of chasing the pacemaker down, and had his measure in the final 100 yards. South Africa's number one draw Pocket Power stayed on into third without troubling the front pair at 2-5. Big City Life's trainer Glen Kotzen told *sahorseracing.com*, "Everyone wrote him off on one bad run in the Met, but I thought it was a great run. Finger Lakes Forced to Cut Overnight Purses:

Officials at Finger Lakes Racetrack in upstate New York have announced that the track's overnight purse structure will be cut and that four stakes will be eliminated owing to a debt of \$3.6 million owed the track by the bankrupt New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation. In a release, track President and General Manager Chris Riegler said, "The unconscionable act of NYCOTB to refuse to pay its bankruptcy post-petition legislated payments has left a huge hole in our purse account going forward. Given the current uncooperative attitude of NYCOTB, and with no apparent resolution on the horizon, we have no choice but to make drastic adjustments to the purse structure that in the end will negatively impact the industry, and the tens of thousands of New York residents that depend on it for their livelihood." Overnight purses are set to fall by 12 percent. Eliminated from the stakes schedule are the Wadsworth Memorial H. July 4, the Proud Puppy H. Oct. 2 and the Finger Lakes Juvenile and Juvenile Fillies Oct. 16 and 30, respectively. All were worth \$50,000.
