

**SUPER AT 17 - ZENYATTA DOES IT AGAIN!**

Once again putting herself at the forefront of history, Jerry and Ann Moss's **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) secured the 17th straight win of her unblemished career in Sunday's GI Vanity H. at Hollywood Park. It wasn't without a few white-knuckle moments, however, as the towering filly needed every inch of the stretch to fight past an ultra-game **St Trinians (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}) and win by a half-length. "Oh my lord, she ran her eyeballs out," Smith said of the runner-up. "But we just kept on grinding, and [Zenyatta] hit her best stride 100 yards out, and I knew we had it won at that point." Winning owner Jerry Moss said simply, "She's otherworldly." The victory moved Zenyatta past the likes of Citation, Cigar and Mister Frisky as horses with the longest winning streaks outside of statebred company.

**A REGAL DUO**

Everything went according to the script at Chantilly yesterday. Playing their parts to perfection, **"TDN Rising Stars"** **Sarafina (Fr)** (Refuse To Bend (Ire)) and **Rosanara (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}) were first and second for His Highness The Aga Khan and trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre in the G1 Prix de Diane. Sent off the even-money favorite, the May 23 G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Sarafina was keen early while trapped wide for Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, but soon settled as her stable's pacemaker **Valasyra (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}) cut out the required tempo up front. Sweeping to the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, the bay asserted as Rosanara emerged from the pack. Sarafina was always holding her barnmate to score by 1 1/2 lengths and make her owner-breeder the joint-winningest owner of this Classic, alongside Auguste Lupin. **Cont. p3**

*She's So Vanity...*

☛ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☛ Zenyatta was collecting her 14th straight victory in her historic tally over the boys in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic. She won by 1 1/4 lengths in the GI Santa Margarita H. in her seasonal debut at Santa Anita Mar. 13, then took the GI Apple Blossom by 4 1/4 lengths at Oaklawn Apr. 9. The margin of victory would be much closer in the Vanity. Settled a good 10 lengths off the dueling **Miss Silver Brook** (Cozzene) and **Cherryblossommiss** (Langfuhr) going into the first turn, Zenyatta edged a bit closer as they cruised through a half in :47.54 and three quarters in 1:11.91. She was within two lengths of the leaders wheeling into the stretch widest of all, but the scrappy St Trinians burst away with a quick turn of foot. Put to a drive under Mike Smith, Zenyatta closed with resolute strides and finally surged past in the shadow of the wire. "It's just incredible," enthused Smith. "It was a gallant effort on St Trinians' part--she really ran huge. When we headed for home, I hit a real big gear, and she hit another one right back at me, and I said 'Whoa, she's serious--she's going to make me run.' I was working at it until the last 100 yards and then I knew I'd out-grind her." Smith said he'd considered guiding Zenyatta toward the inside two furlongs out, but decided on the overland route instead. "We're carrying a lot of weight, and I just wanted to get that weight moving forward, so I tried to tip out as we came off the turn and use that momentum to kind of sling-shot me--even though I was a little wide--to get her at least running. I didn't want to take a chance splitting them, because if Martin [Garcia, on St Trinians] saw me do that, he might make it tight on me. If I had to steady just for a jump, to get that weight going again is asking an awful lot. I knew he was probably going to take me out [wide], it was great race riding on his part. But it was just me and him. So as wide as he is, that's as wide as I'm going to be. Nothing matters at that point." While the New Mexican filly Peppers Pride (Desert God) concluded her career unbeaten with 19 wins to her credit--all in statebred company--most race fans would point to Citation's and Cigar's 16-race skeins as the standard by which modern-day win streaks are judged. A crowd of 12,232 lined up to watch Zenyatta

make history, and roared with approval as she streaked under the wire still unbeaten in her 17th start. Owner Jerry Moss was in awe after the race. "I'm going to be watching that [replay] 30 or 40 times," he said. "I had a feeling she was

going to make it somehow, like she always does, ever since she caught Anabaa's Creation in that race at Del Mar [the 2009 GI Clement L. Hirsch, when Zenyatta won by a head]. She won, she got there, she gave away the nine pounds [129-120], and she came about seven wide. She's just awesome. What can I say? The reaction of the crowd was amazing. She's such a fan pleaser. Everybody here loves her." The bettors sent St Trinians off at relatively low 2-1 odds--Zenyatta was at 1-2 odds--and the five-year-old nearly posted the upset of the year. "I don't know what to say," jockey Martin Garcia offered. "I couldn't have asked her for any more. The other mare is just too much horse." Said her trainer Mike Mitchell, "I wanted to be a little farther in front of her turning for home, because I know the kick that Zenyatta's got. My mare has a big kick, too. She just got outrun. I'm happy. We're all big fans of Zenyatta in my family, and I know that [St Trinians] didn't shame herself."

Introduced over a mile at this venue May 3, Sarafina rolled to an authoritative six-length success in that debutantes contest, and it was a measure of the regard in which she was held in the Alain de Royer-Dupre stable that she was pitched straight into the highest level at Longchamp next time. Despite suffering a troubled trip in the May 23 G1 Prix Saint-Alary, she was in a league of her own there, and the half-length margin back to Deluxe (Storm Cat) flattered that rival. She was the overwhelming favorite over Rosanara in this major test. Sarafina raced alongside her stable companion in sixth early and was in an ideal striking position in the clear as Rosanara needed racing room towards the rail in early stretch. Gaining first run when overhauling Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, she was in control when Rosanara found the gap, and there were ultimately no excuses for the runner-up, as Gerald Mosse failed to conjure the required acceleration from the grey. Winning jockey Christophe-Patrice Lemaire said, "We had a very good trip and, although she was a little bit keen early on, luckily the pacemaker went a good pace and she settled very well. She showed a very nice kick in the straight, and is a filly with a lot of talent." Added trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, recording a sixth success in the race, "It is a very satisfying result to have the one-two, and Sarafina has not stopped improving since the Prix Saint-Alary. I knew she would be better today than last time."

As for the future, he remarked, "I am not certain what to do next, as I am not sure she will stay a mile and a half. Maybe she will at Longchamp, which is an easier course, but if the [Oct. 3] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe is to be her target, I would not want to run her over a mile and a half shortly before. I doubt she will run in the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 12], but that is definitely where Rosanara will go next." Jakkalberry ran sixth in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club over course and distance when tried at the highest level for the first time Oct. 18, and gained a confidence-boosting win in a conditions heat at this track on seasonal return Mar. 23. He bagged a personal best in the G3 Premio Ambrosiano back here once more Apr. 24, and ran sixth in the G1 Premio Presidente Della Repubblica at Rome's Capanelle May 16. Jakkalberry was restrained in rear from the break and trailed all of his rivals until turning for home. Making stealthy headway on the bridle to take closer order in the straight, he came under pressure passing the quarter-mile marker and stayed on strongly once hooking up with Getaway at the eighth pole to deny that resolute rival for a career high. Jakkalberry's win completed a notable family double, following up the victory of half-brother Kidnapping (Ire) (Intikhab) in the Listed Gran Premio d'Italia 75 minutes earlier on the card. Two days before his close relative Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) goes for a ninth Group 1 at Royal Ascot, Goldwaki did his own sterling work for the family when leading home a one-two for Andre Fabre, providing his trainer with a 13th renewal of this prize. After conditions wins at Lyon-Parilly Mar. 26 and Apr. 11, the homebred was sent to that course for a third time to register a fluent success in the May 4 Listed Coupe des Trois Ans. He raced last of the six runners early here. Needing a niggle from Olivier Peslier before the final turn, the bay picked up as soon as the whip was applied and, after arriving wide to overhaul stable companion Mashoor with a furlong remaining, asserted for a cozy success. Winning rider Olivier Peslier said, "He is a good, strong and tenacious horse who really stays, and even though he doesn't have a brilliant turn-of-foot, he is capable of winning good races." Wertheimer Racing Manager Pierre-Yves Bureaux added, "He has not stopped improving and goes from strength to strength. Sormiou broke his maiden in his sixth attempt in a mile handicap at Saint-Cloud in October, and followed that confidence boost with wins in conditions events at Angers the following month, and on his sophomore bow at Bordeaux-le-Bouscat Mar. 26. Third behind Blue Panis in the Listed Prix Aymeri de Mauleon at Toulouse Apr. 30, the bay broke through at that level on his next start when annexing Longchamp's Prix du Pont-Neuf over seven furlongs May 20. Settled in rear early by Alexandre Roussel this time, the bay was gifted a charmed run up the rail alongside the early pacesetter Blue Panis as Emerald Commander veered off a true line in the centre of the track. Getting on top in the final 75 yards, he was an ultimately comfortable winner at the line. "We came into this with no pressure at all, but after he won his listed race last time we had to try a group race," trainer and part-owner Cedric-Ghislain Diard explained. Labeled a 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 at two, Fuisse was beaten 1 1/2 lengths by Le Havre (Ire) (Noverre) when runner-up in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at this track last June. He was off the track after that effort until the Listed Prix Jacques Laffitte at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8, where he ran third behind subsequent G2 Prix du Muguet winner and G1 Prix d'Isphahan runner-up Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre). The bay had eventual G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot winner Dalghar (Fr) (Anabaa) three lengths back in second when receiving five pounds from that rival in Longchamp's Listed Prix de Montretout last time May 6. Keen racing close to the early pace without cover, the homebred was ridden inside the final quarter. Slickly Royal looked to have made a race-winning move, but Fuisse's determination carried him past that rival in the final 100 yards as Vertigineux closed in late. "He deserves to win a group race, as he showed talent last year, but we were forced to stop with him after the Jockey-Club," conditioner Criquette Head-Maarek said. "He has come back stronger and needed the race when second to Byword. He has a huge action, and you have to be careful how you ask for his run, as he can become unbalanced very quickly--Christophe Lemaire did a great job. I think he'll run in the G3 Prix Messidor [at Maisons-Laffitte July 17] next, but the race I am targeting is the [Oct. 16] G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, as it is the perfect race for him." Heavily favored Embur's Song may have compromised her own chances with a very rank run into the first turn, and it was longshot Roan Inish who took advantage, springing an 11-1 upset in Canada's premier race for three-year-old fillies.

Roan Inish began her career in Europe last year. Second on debut at The Curragh in June and a well-beaten 11th at Leopardstown, she concluding her stand in Ireland with an eighth in the G3 C.L. Weld Park S. back at The Curragh Sept. 29. The Costigan-bred filly found a lucrative spot to break her maiden, taking the \$250,000 Princess Elizabeth S. facing fellow Ontario-breds in her North American debut Oct. 31. She concluded her season with a second in the Glorious Song S. Nov. 15, then was second again returning in the restricted Fury S. May 1. Here, Roan Inish was rated toward the back of the pack in the early going as a headstrong Embur's Song pulled Garrett Gomez through a quarter in :23.93. Embur's Song settled down, cut out sensible :47.92 and :1:12.26 splits, and looked like she'd be tough to get by in upper stretch, but Roan Inish rallied in tandem with Moment of Majesty and gamely got her head down. "Queen's Plate here we go!" said winning rider Davy Moran of possibility of facing males in the July 4 Classic. "The farther we go, the better." ## ROYAL ASCOT REVISITED

Long since the feature meeting of the British racing calendar, Royal Ascot has taken on a new face in recent years due to the track's redevelopment program, and the annual international presence in the sprints. While Australia has been responsible for three of the last four winners of tomorrow's G1 King's Stand S., and will offer a strong challenge again, there is also a healthy Royal Ascot representation from Hong Kong and the States. Flying the stars and stripes just one year after the G3 Queen Mary S. and Listed Windsor Castle S. victories of Wesley Ward trainees Jealous Again (Trippi) and Strike the Tiger (Tiger Ridge) are the likes of Chasing Dreams Racing's **Noble's Promise** (Cueve), who goes to post in tomorrow's G1 St James's Palace S., and Sheehy LLC's Guinness-gulping G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen hero **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor), who is set to continue the fairytale in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S.

The five-year-old gelding Kinsale King and his country music-singing trainer Carl O'Callaghan, who spent a period homeless on the streets of New York in the nineties, could be in line for the kind of cult status Takeover Target (Aus) (Celtic Swing {GB}) and Joe Janiak enjoyed here if they succeed.

"He loves Guinness and, although it's a myth, he has two pints in the morning and two at night. It is very healthy--it has got a lot of yeast in it and helps a horse," O'Callaghan explained of his charge's favorite indulgence. He added,

"This whole thing with the King has been amazing and it's all about him--all I do is keep him happy and sound. If Kinsale King wins at Ascot, then I will be going home [to Ireland]. We have brought the American flag and the Irish flag with us. Either way, we will celebrate. I'm dying to see The Queen, and this is what life is all about--the dreams."

Tomorrow's action threatens to peak almost too soon as the meeting kicks off with a clash of the titans **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa), **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Paco Boy (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Anne S. Respectively the best older milers from France, Ireland and Britain, the trio boasts 13 Group 1 victories between them, although eight of those belong to the Wertheimers' brilliant Goldikova. She could kickstart a golden afternoon for France, with the G1 2000 Guineas hero **Makfi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) set to fly the tricolore himself in the St James's Palace. Mathieu Offenstadt, Alain Louis-Dreyfus, Sylvain Fargeon and Mikel Delzangles's now-famous Shadwell castoff again faces Newmarket Classic third and subsequent G1 Irish 2000 Guineas scorer **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), owned jointly by the BHA Chairman Paul Roy. **Cont. p9**

Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. looks a wide-open affair at present, with Godolphin's **Cavalryman (GB)** (Halling) potentially poised to provide Ascot stalwart Frankie Dettori with a flying dismount to delight the assembled crowds, while Thursday's G1 Gold Cup also appears anybody's race, as the great Ballydoyle campaigner Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) will be absent for the first time since 2005. Henry Cecil has won five renewals of the prized marathon, including triumphs with the dual heroes Le Moss (Ire) and Ardross (Ire), and may have an heir apparent to Diane Nagle and Susan Magnier's four-time-winning champion in Khalid Abdullah's lightly raced G2 Yorkshire Cup winning four-year-old **Manifest (GB)** (Rainbow Quest).

Friday sees the three-year-old filly milers take centre stage in the G1 Coronation S. For the first time in years, the winners of the English, Irish and French 1000 Guineas are missing, which presents the opportunity for some new blood at the top of the division. Perhaps it will be another Cecil trainee, the disqualified Newmarket Guineas first-past-the-post **Jacqueline Quest (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who can add another chapter to this meeting's remarkable history. Owned by Noel Martin, the quadriplegic victim of a Neo-Nazi attack in 1996, she is named after his late wife, and no doubt will carry a large share of sentiment from the massed crowds as she heads to post.

Saturday's Golden Jubilee caps the week of high intensity and pageantry, and offers the chance for the speed merchants to emulate the Antipodean ground-breaker Choisir (Aus) in completing the King's Stand-Golden Jubilee double.

For the first time this year, the entire jamboree is available to the world, as live pictures will be on TVG and HRTV, Australia's Sky Channel, France's Equidia, the Hong Kong Jockey Club, Singapore Turf Club and Dubai Sports channel. Ascot's Head of Communications Nick Smith said, "It's good to have horses not just from Australia--which we are used to--but also from Hong Kong and America, and especially outside of the sprints. To get a horse like Noble's Promise to run in the St James's Palace is a big step forward, and it's a reputation thing--these races are going to be seen by everyone all over the world and that's what it's all about."

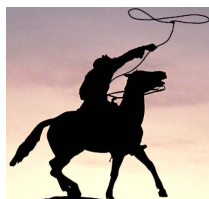

Trainer Todd Pletcher, who was on hand at Churchill Saturday to saddle Battle Plan, said that he was also impressed

with his charge's runner-up try. "I thought he gave a big effort in his first race over the surface,"

## Rachel Alexandra Well after Fleur de Lis Win...

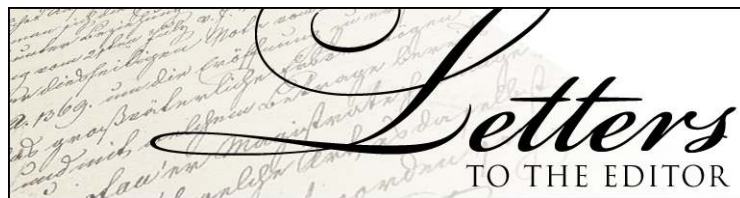

**STATE SHUTDOWN THREATENS NY TRACKS** A looming showdown in the New York State Senate could force the state government to shutdown, and force tracks in the state to temporarily shutter operations. New York, facing a \$9.2 billion deficit, has been operating on weekly budget extenders ever since senate leaders failed to pass a state budget for the fiscal year Apr. 1. In recent days, two senators, Democrats Pedro Espada Jr. and Ruben Diaz Sr., have threatened to vote against the next extender, and the state government could grind to a halt as early as today. It would be the first shutdown in New York history, and would likely affect racetracks in the state, since stewards and officials who oversee drug testing are on the state payroll and would not be allowed to work. The last three extenders have been passed along party lines, with Democrats needing all of its 32 members voting in favor to assure passage. The loss of Espada's and Diaz's votes mean that Gov. David Paterson would need to sway at least two Republicans to vote for the extender bill. The vote for the is slated for today.

**NYRA Launches Investigation Over Rescued Horse:**

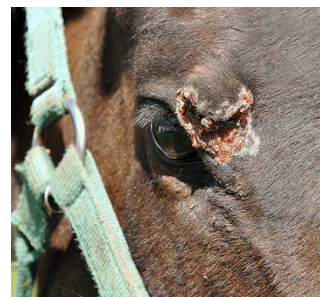
The discovery of Ultimate Journey (h, 5, Hennessy) in a New Jersey auction house that is often the last stop for horses before being sent to slaughter, has sparked an investigation by the New York Racing Association.

According to *Daily Racing Form*, NYRA officials are trying to determine if its anti-slaughter policy has been violated. Last December, NYRA took a tough stance on slaughter, adopting a policy that read: "Any owner or trainer stabled at a NYRA track found to have directly or indirectly sold a

horse for slaughter will have his or her stalls permanently revoked from all NYRA tracks." Just weeks later, Ultimate Journey, a five-time winner who plied his trade primarily in cheap claimers on the East Coast, finished eighth in a \$7,500 claimer for owner Fred Robinson and trainer John Campo Jr. at Aqueduct Dec. 30. The bay, who was bred by Bruce Lunsford, next turned up at the Camelot auction house in central New Jersey in mid-May, where he was purchased by New Jersey Horse Angels Rescue's Sharon Catalano-Crumb for \$300. The horse was underweight and had suffered a laceration above his right eye (*right*). He is now reportedly awaiting placement by the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation. A source familiar with the auction house said that officials at Camelot work with rescue groups to help find new homes for horses. Campo, brother to NYRA Vice President and Director of Racing P.J. Campo, told *DRF* that the horse suffered an ankle injury in his career finale, and that attempts to rehabilitate the ankle proved unsuccessful. Campo said a friend arranged for Ultimate Journey to be given to someone in Amish country.

In September, 2008, he added the G1 Underwood S. to bring his tally to seven wins at the highest level. Weekend Hussler was named Horse of the Year for the 2007-2008 season.
