DEJA VU

Rolling back the clock to when his sire created such a stir at Royal Ascot in 2003, **Starspangledbanner (Aus)** (Choisir {Aus}) blasted his rivals into submission under Johnny Murtagh to emulate that Australian revolutionary in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. yesterday. Only fifth on his first start for Ballydoyle in the May 12 G2 Duke of York S., the powerful chestnut made all the running against the stand's side rail to justify 13-2 joint-favoritism. Successful for the Leon Corstens stable in the Oct. 10 G1 Caulfield Guineas and Feb. 20 G1 Oakleigh Plate, he made it a trio of Group 1 wins with 1 3/4 lengths to spare over **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) at the line. The story horse **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) was a head behind in third. "His half-speeding before York was unbelievable, and in his last piece of work before this, his second-last furlong was just under 9 1/2 seconds and we've never seen that before," an overawed Aidan O'Brien commented. "I couldn't believe he won over a mile in Australia with fractions like that, and he's no doubt the fastest horse we've had." **Cont. p2**

Donegal Racing's **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}), a very good third in the G1 Kentucky Derby, returned to grass with a dominant three-length victory over **Workin for Hops** (City Zip) in Saturday's GII Colonial Turf Cup. "He found another gear and kept striding for the wire with a lot of energy," jockey Kent Desormeaux revealed of the winner, who entered off a sixth-place finish in the G1 Preakness S. "I became a fan just like you guys watching on the Jumbotron." According to trainer Dale Romans, Paddy O'Prado will remain on the lawn and be pointed toward Colonial's GII Virginia Derby July 17 and the G1 Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 21. **Cont. p4**

PEGASUS EXPRESS

Gainesway Farm's and Martin Cherry's **Afleet Express** (Afleet Alex) stamped himself as a major player in the three-year-old division with a determined 1 3/4-length success over **Afleet Again** (Afleet Alex) in Monmouth's GIII Pegasus S. "We have to hugely consider the [GI] Haskell [Invitational S. Aug. 1]," trainer Jimmy Jerkens said. "He handled everything well today, but there's a lot to figure out. Nothing is etched in stone." Favored **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil) tired to be fifth. **Cont. p5**

When Starspangledbanner took apart the field assembled for the Caulfield Guineas in October, his then-trainer Leon Corstens started crafting him into the top-flight sprinter he has now become. Just over a length behind Nicconi (Aus) (Bianconi) when fourth in the five-furlong G1 Lightning S. at Flemington Jan. 30, he stepped up a panel to best the dead-heating duo of Arinos (Aus) (Akhadan {Aus}) and Here de Angels (Aus) (Dehere) in the Oakleigh Plate back at Caulfield before finishing third in the G1 Newmarket H. at Flemington Mar. 6. Sent to Ballydoyle thereafter, he showed plentiful speed in the Duke of York before finishing just two lengths behind, and O'Brien had gone to work with his stopwatch buzzing in the interim. Sharper and more durable here, he had pressure applied all the way up the straight and, after seeing off G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen hero Kinsale King, was out of reach by the time the three-year-old Society Rock found top gear. "Aidan was very confident coming into this race and told me to jump and let him use his stride," winning jockey Johnny Murtagh said. "He said to wait til you get to a furlong and a half out and he'll respond, and everything went perfect. He went right to the line and I couldn't pull him up after--he's very similar to his sire, in that he's big and strong and was in a different zone to York today." O'Brien is looking at the G1 Darley July Cup now July 9. He added, "He was a very good horse before we got him and was just ready to run at York, but we just felt we had to get him out and let him have a feel of racing in this part of the world. He ran very well there, but just got a little bit tired, and Colm O'Donoghue, who rides him in his work, has done a great job with him. The boys will have to make the decision as to whether they keep him in this part of the world and the quarantine issues if they do, but it would be great to have him for the July Cup, and he's something to look forward to."

Society Rock excelled among the sophomore crop, and his trainer James Fanshawe told *PA Sport*, "He has a great turn of foot. He is entered in the July Cup and, as Newmarket is local to the owner, he would love to go there." Carl O'Callaghan was equally delighted with the effort of Kinsale King. "July here we come," he told *PA Sport*. "I think the run will tighten him up--he hasn't run for eight weeks, and has come to try a straight six furlongs on grass in a different country. We will take it one step at a time. I don't like running them back too close, but he can stay in Newmarket with Jane Chapple-Hyam, and we'll see about the July Cup. We're happy--third is a win for us, and he ran a great race against a good horse." On the far side, Fleeting Spirit (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) led the way, but was not able to bridge the gap. Her conditioner Jeremy Nosedo was another looking ahead to Newmarket. "She ran a great race and she'll improve for the run," he said. "I think that will put her absolutely spot-on for the July Cup." Harbinger had a reputation that preceded him last year and, after a smooth win in Goodwood's G3 Gordon S. in July, shocked York by beating no rivals when sent off the 13-8 favorite for the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at the Ebor meeting in August. Third in Newbury's G3 St Simon S. on his next start in October, he returned to that venue to best subsequent G2 Yorkshire Cup winner Manifest (GB) (Rainbow Quest) in the Apr. 17 G3 John Porter S. before getting the better of Age of Aquarius (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 7. As this meeting's only odds-on favorite, the pressure was on, but Sir Michael Stoute's project made light work of his task here.

Settled in fourth early by Ryan Moore, the bay was angled wide on the final turn and soon had the measure of the long-time leader Barshiba when set alight approaching the final quarter. Powering clear of the chasing Duncan from there, he provided the Freemason Lodge stable with a quandary ahead of a possible showdown with Workforce (GB) (King's Best) in the showpiece event back here in a month. "Sir Michael has got the Derby winner going for the [July 24] G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S., so that means Harbinger could go somewhere else, but if he wants to send him for it, we won't put him off," Highclere's Managing Director Harry Herbert said. "He's such an exciting horse, and to have a horse like him is very special--looking at him in the parade ring today, you can see how well he is progressing. Last year, it all looked very good after the Gordon and, although Sir Michael kept saying he needs time and he's next year's horse, we were obviously still expecting him to win the Voltigeur. Something very odd happened that day, and we think the most likely explanation is his palate flipped and stopped his airway, so he had a very minor op over the winter. He has come out a different horse this year, and the chat has been good for some time now." Stoute, who was recording a sixth renewal, added, "He was very professional today and traveled so well. We were thrilled with him at Newbury, and he was more workmanlike at Chester, but that is a very tight track and he's a big, galloping horse." Moore gave a third commendation when saying, "I had a few bumps early on, so it didn't go as smoothly as I would have liked, and then they slowed the pace up and I had to get rolling sooner than planned. He quickened up very well and enjoyed beating up on inferior horses."

Trainer Clive Brittain, who saddled Bold Arrangement (GB) (Persian Bold {Ire}) to be second in the 1986 GI Kentucky Derby, is eyeing a return to Churchill Downs next year after Zaidan captured this prize. Sent off at 7-1, the dark bay, who was off the mark over five furlongs at Doncaster May 1, was settled in rear early by Seb Sanders and, after easily cutting through rivals, dominated the final quarter mile. "I always said that the next time I go back to the Kentucky Derby, I'd go with a horse with a chance, and this could be it," his trainer said. "Always the dreamer, but we've seen a different horse today than the one who ran at Doncaster, and the one he is at home when he's so switched off and laid-back. He got himself a little bit excited, but there is plenty of time to settle him down, and we'll probably go for a group race next and miss the Breeders' Cup." Sanders added, "He was very edgy when I got on him, and took about four or five furlongs cantering down to the start to get where I wanted. Then he took off strong, so the plan was to drop him in straightaway. I always had plenty of horse to get out at any stage, and he scythed through them as he had at Doncaster, where it took him two furlongs for the penny to drop. He was traveling too well, so took me there too soon, but when the gaps appear you have to take them. Paddy O'Prado posted his first career victory in Gulfstream's GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 6, then punched his GI Kentucky Derby ticket with a runner-up effort in Keeneland's GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 10. The gray relished the sloppy conditions on the First Saturday in May, rallying from 11th to finish within 2 3/4 lengths of Super Saver (Maria's Mon), but only beat half of them home in the second jewel of the Triple Crown, 10 1/2 lengths adrift Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike). Rating kindly along the inside in fourth beneath Kent Desormeaux, Paddy O'Prado was angled out three wide as he began to roll on the turn for home, gained command as he drifted in slightly in the stretch and kept finding to win as the rider pleased. Lady Shakespeare won her second straight graded event in a race whose complexion changed completely when Gozzip Girl (Dynaformer) dumped jockey Ramon Dominguez at the break. Fortunately, horse and rider were uninjured. Lady Shakespeare was one of two runners in the race for Roger Attfield, placed fourth in the GI QE II Cup at Keeneland in October. The Fipke homebred endured a pair of tough beats over the winter at Gulfstream, missing by a head in the Jan. 16 Marshua's River S. and again by that narrow margin in the GIII Orchid S. Mar. 28. She earned a richly deserved first graded success in her latest, stalking a pedestrian pace before quickening home best in Keeneland's GIII Bewitch S. Apr. 22. Daveron (Ger) (Black Sam Bellamy {Ire}) took up the running after the incident at the gate here, and established an easy pace with Lady Shakespeare allowed to trail the quartet. Cut loose on the grandstand side in the stretch, she came with a powerful turn of speed leaving the eighth pole and pulled away to score comfortably. "At the quarter pole, I hit her left handed and put her in the clear--it was like an instant reaction, she went right to them," commented winning rider John Velazquez. 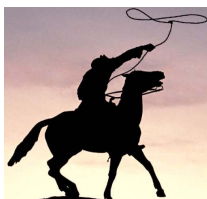

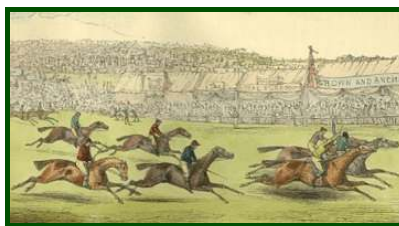

Highclere Duo Newmarket Bound...

Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's Royal Ascot-winning duo **Approve (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and **Memory (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) are set to run at Newmarket's July Festival, connections announced yesterday. The William Haggas-trained Approve registered a 1 1/4-length success in Thursday's G2 Norfolk S. over five furlongs, while Memory captured Friday's G3 Albany S. over six for the Richard Hannon stable. "Ultimately, Approve is a six-furlong horse in the making and needs to race--he's not a horse to sit back on and protect, as he thrives on racing and is very tough--so I think we'll probably look at the [July 8] G2 July S. where he will carry a penalty," the syndicate's Managing Director Harry Herbert commented. "I'd like to think we might hatch a plan for the G2 Prix Robert Papin over 5 1/2 furlongs [at Maisons-Laffitte July 25], which is a race that would suit him perfectly. With Memory, I would think we would look at the [July 7] G2 Cherry Hinton S. and, longer-term, the G1 Moyglare Stud S. [at The Curragh Aug. 29] really does have her name on it, as [jockey] Richard Hughes said yesterday that she will stay further."

Sara Louise On Comeback Trail...

Godolphin's **Sara Louise** (Malibu Moon), last seen annexing Aqueduct's GII Top Flight H. CAMPO CLEARED OF ANTI-SLAUGHTER VIOLATION *Daily Racing Form* reports that the New York Racing Association has concluded their investigation of an incident that almost led to the sale of five-year-old Ultimate Journey (Hennessy) for slaughter, and have cleared trainer John Campo Jr. and owner Fred Robinson of any violation of their recently enacted anti-slaughter policy. The policy, which was put in place in December, states that "any owner or trainer stabled at a New York Racing Association, Inc. (NYRA) track found to have directly or indirectly sold a horse for slaughter will have his or her stalls permanently revoked from all NYRA tracks." NYRA's investigation revealed that Campo and Robinson never sold the horse, but instead allowed a third party to give him away to the Amish in Pennsylvania after it was determined that an ankle injury sustained in a \$7,500 claiming race at Aqueduct Dec. 30 would preclude the animal from racing again. The subsequent events that led to Ultimate Journey's placement in the May 19 Camelot horse auction in Cranbury, New Jersey, are unknown, but a member of New Jersey Horse Angels Rescue purchased him at the auction for \$300, saving him from potential death. Ultimate Journey is currently located on a farm in Howell, New Jersey, awaiting relocation by the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation.

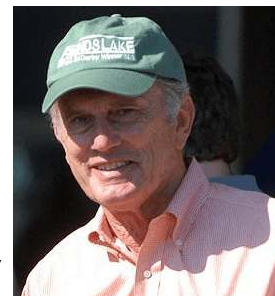

In total, her progeny realized \$1,388,000 in the sales ring.

Gatap has also been successful as a broodmare, foaling SW Jennifer's Prospector (Banker's Gold), SP Daring Derek (Naevus) and GSP Midway Holiday (Harlan's Holiday). Gatap accounted for \$1.2 million in sales receipts for her owners.

And the bloodlines are heating up once again. Just after Trickmeister's impressive allowance score at Delaware, Midway Holiday, now running for Larry Richardson, ran her record to three-for-five in an allowance at Churchill Downs--winning by the identical 4 3/4-length margin.

Trickmeister himself was earmarked for the sales ring, but failed to find a buyer at Keeneland September 2008.

"We had him in the sale, but he had an X-ray that had a little shadow on the stifle," Jones explained. "They get pretty picky at the sales, as you know, and they certainly have a right to. But we have been racing a whole lot more the last few years, because most of the shadows, or the little chips, don't really have any impact [on their racing careers]."

"We loved this horse--he is a great physical specimen --and we decided we wouldn't sell him for less than \$100,000."

Bidding stalled at \$95,000, and Jones and Thornton had a new addition to their racing string. A few minor problems delayed his debut--"If I'm not mistaken, he had a couple of gravels that worked their way up through his hoof," Jones recalled. But the decision to hang on to Trickmeister proved wise.

"Without any bad luck, [Trickmeister] will be a graded-stakes horse, no question," Jones affirmed. "He won eased up today, and he could have gone a great deal swifter, I believe."

And while the bay has been eye-catching in his two six-furlong starts, his connections feel there is more to him than mere velocity.

"I'd be quite surprised if he's not a two-turn horse," Jones said. "The Proud Citizens have shown a great deal of speed, but Proud Spell carried her speed to win the [GI] Alabama S. [at 1 1/4 miles], and that won her the [2008] three-year-old filly championship. She was from his first crop, and she proved you can get a nice two-turn horse from Proud Citizen."

Trickmeister will have the chance to prove his route ability in his next outing.

"I talked to [trainer Cindy Jones] after the race, and she anticipates running him back in the Barbaro S. [July 10, 1 1/16 miles at Delaware]," Jones offered. "That was her suggestion--we leave all of those decisions to Cindy and Larry [Jones]."

"This plan was hatched in December 2008, but she got a bad injury in the spring of 2009 and had to have the year off so the plan got delayed another year," trainer Jeremy Nosedá commented. "Ladbrokes' Mike Dillon first put the plan in my mind, and it's been a long plan over a long period of time. She's been extremely tough to train, so to get her here on the day has been a huge team effort. I was confident because she had the talent and we just had to get her here. I think it's within her compass to win a stakes race and go from there, so I'll sit down and talk to the owners." Murtagh added, "The race went very smoothly for me--she dropped in and relaxed and I was told she had one good kick.
