

DYNAMEAUX FINISH IN WILL ROGERS

Leroy's **Dynameaux** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) forged to the lead in deep stretch and held off favored **Bogie (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) by a neck to win yesterday's GIII Will Rogers S. at Hollywood Park. Leroy's Dynameaux and Bogie raced at the back of the eight-horse field as **Macias** (Purge) took the field through fractions of :22.85, :45.71 and 1:10.12. As the pacesetter began to tire, Leroy's Dynameaux was winding up with a five-wide rally down the lane and he just held the late-closing favorite. "I wasn't that confident during the race because on the first turn he was trying to get out," admitted winning jockey Joel Rosario. "Coming to the five-sixteenths, he just moved and the other horses were slowing down and I took it from there. He's a little horse, but he's a good horse and always tries. I just took my time and he did the rest." Leroy's Dynameaux won on debut down the hill at Santa Anita Mar. 26 and was a close-up second over that course in an Apr. 15 optional claimer. The three-year-old gelding was beaten just three-quarter lengths when third in the May 15 Alcatraz S. at Golden Gate while stretching out to 1 1/16 miles last time out. 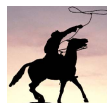

QUALITY ROAD, SUPER SAVER WORK

Quality Road (Elusive Quality), in his first work since winning the GI Metropolitan H., went a half-mile in :50.26 ([video](#)), while stablemate and GI Kentucky Derby winner **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) went the same distance in :50.66 at Belmont Park yesterday. "We weren't looking for much," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "It was a maintenance half for both. We're still a ways away from their next races." Quality Road is expected to make his next start in the Aug. 7 GI Whitney H., while Super Saver's main target is the Aug. 28 GI Travers S. "We'll pick it up a little with Super Saver as we go along, but so far he's doing very well," Pletcher added. "I'm real happy with his overall condition and weight. The way he's moving and everything else indicates to me he's rounding into top form."

Scenic Blast Returns Sunday

Scenic Blast (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}), winner of last year's G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot, will make his U.S. bow in the June 27 Robert Kerlan H. at Hollywood Park. Mike Smith has the call on the six-year-old, who worked five furlongs over the Cushion Track in 1:02.40 yesterday. Now trained by John Shirreffs, Scenic Blast also won last year's G1 Lightning S. in his native Australia. He has been off since running 14th in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint last December.

Bullet Work for Atta Boy Roy

GII Churchill Downs S. winner **Atta Boy Roy** (Tribunal) worked a bullet half-mile in :47.40 at Churchill Downs Sunday. Jockey Calvin Borel was in the irons.

The five-year-old Washington-bred is expected to start next in Friday's Iowa Sprint H. at Prairie Meadows. Atta Boy Roy is coming off a runner-up effort in the GIII Aristides S. That effort, and his Churchill Downs victory, convinced trainer Valorie Lund her charge can be competitive in graded company. "If he would have gotten outrun, I would have

just gone home," said Lund, who races in the fall and winter at Turf Paradise and in the summer at Emerald Downs. "I thought he fit here. If he had been outrun, I guess I would have been wrong. I plan to be here until the Breeders' Cup. I have that much confidence in the horse. I had plenty of invitations to run elsewhere and people saying they would take care of us, but the end goal is the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Sprint] and everything is pointing to that as long as it fits his schedule."

Stablemate **Katy Now** (Tiznow) went a half-mile over the main Belmont track Sunday in :48.48. The Mill House colorbearer has won three in a row, including a 4 1/2-length allowance tally at Belmont May 28. Starlight Partners' **Ailalea** (Pulpit), coming off a win in the May 29 GIII Dogwood S., worked a half-mile over

the training track in :50.07. "Obviously, in a perfect world, we wouldn't be running these three fillies all together," Pletcher explained. "It's not effective stable management from my perspective. But it's what the owners want, it's a Grade I and it's at home. So that's attractive."

There was an element of fortune in the win of Norderney here after the stewards found that the first-past-the-post Illo had caused interference to the third home Scolari and opted to demote him behind that runner. Successful in the Listed Dusseldorfer Stutenpreis in April, Norderney was campaigned ambitiously thereafter and followed a fourth in that track's G2 German 1000 Guineas in June with a third in the G3 Grosser Preis Der Jungheinrich Gabelstapler at Hamburg in July. Off the board in the G3 Prix de Psyche at Deauville in August, the bay was third in Frankfurt's G3 Euro-Cup in September before rounding off her campaign by annexing the G3 Frankfurter Stutenpreis in October. Following a return third in the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne May 9, the homebred raced on the fence behind the leaders and found a seam up there in the straight as Illo drifted across Scolari. 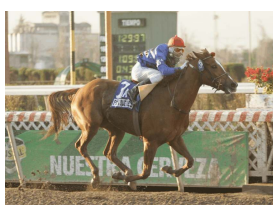
