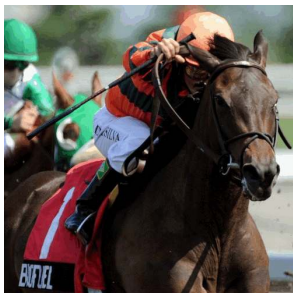

LIVE FIVE IN MOTHER GOOSE

Just as in 2009, five fillies were entered for the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont this afternoon, but the similarities stop there. The unstoppable Rachel

Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) wound up thrashing two over-matched rivals a year ago, but today's renewal features a very competitive group. Brereton Jones' homebred **Biofuel** (Stormin Fever), who shared Sovereign Award honors for top juvenile filly last season following her exploits in Canada, as well as a troubled fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, tries conventional dirt for the first time. The dark bay swept past her foes in both of her starts north of the border this year, the Apr. 10 Star Shoot S. ([video](#)) and May 23 La Lorgnette S. ([video](#)), and trainer Reade Baker knows his filly is in with a big chance. "We had looked at the Mother Goose for her all along, if we were good enough coming out of the La Lorgnette," Baker told *Daily Racing Form*. "Everything's going great. I couldn't have one going into a race any better." **Cont. p4**

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM?

Lingote de Oro (Arg) (Orpen) will make his third appearance in the Carreras de las Estrellas, Argentina's

version of the Breeders' Cup, this afternoon at the Palermo racecourse in Buenos Aires. Carrying the colors of Keyser Soze, the bay ran second in the 2008 G1 Estrellas Juvenile when the championship event was contested at this dirt track. He could only manage eighth in last year's G1 Estrellas Classic,

which was run on the San Isidro turf. This time, the Classic is back at Palermo, a surface over which Lingote de Oro has been nearly unbeatable. He rebounded from his 2009 defeat with three runaway victories on the local dirt, only to have a hiccup when seventh in the G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini on the grass at San Isidro. But Palermo is another story. The four-year-old son of Laika (Old Trieste) cruised to victory in a local contest Feb. 12, and has added a pair of Group 1 wins over this track and trip, the Gran Premio de Honor Apr. 10 and Gran Premio Republica Argentina May 1. Ernesto Romero trains the colt, who is a graduate of the 2007 Copa Bullrich yearling sale. **Cont. p5-6**

MURTAGH OPTS OFF JAN VERMEER

Jockey Johnny Murtagh will partner Derrick Smith's **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in tomorrow's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh, forsaking his G1 Epsom Derby mount **Jan Vermeer (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). While both were disappointing in their latest outings, with Cape Blanco off the board in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club June 6 and Jan Vermeer failing to make an impact in the blue riband a day earlier, Ballydoyle's retained rider has opted for the G2 Dante S.-winning Cape Blanco. Murtagh yesterday revealed why he had made the choice. "It was a tough decision, but Cape Blanco never got into his stride in France," he commented. "He won very well in the Dante, and I think we have him back to his best, so we'll see what happens." Trainer Aidan O'Brien remarked, "We are not sure why he ran a little disappointing in France last time out, but he seems well and we are hoping for a good run from him." He added, "Jan Vermeer has been working nicely since finishing fourth at Epsom; Seamus [Heffernan] won his maiden on him as a two-year-old at Gowran, and rides him again on Sunday." As for his other Irish Derby runners, O'Brien said, "**Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) seems to be well also, and Colm [O'Donoghue] rides him again. **At First Sight (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Bright Horizon (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) both ran at Ascot, and both seem to have come out of their races well." **Cont. p2-3**

Strong Suit to Phoenix...

Julie Wood's G2 Coventry S. winner **Strong Suit** (Rahy) is set to tackle the G1 Keeneland Phoenix S. at The Curragh, trainer Richard Hannon announced yesterday. He recorded a nose defeat of Elzaam (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) in last Tuesday's Royal Ascot contest, and the Aug. 8 highlight is on his agenda now. "We had considered the July S. at Newmarket, but he would have a three-pound penalty there and, having won his Group 2, it makes sense to step up to the top table," Hannon explained. "It was an incredible performance at Ascot and, every time I watch the video, I still can't believe how he managed to get out of jail and win, but he has come back fine and we are looking forward to Ireland. We have always believed that Strong Suit was a serious horse, and while they tell me that Aidan O'Brien has won the Phoenix 10 times in the last 12 years, we have faith in our fellow."

No Eclipse for Sariska...

Lady Bamford's **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) will side-step Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown, trainer Michael Bell announced yesterday. Last year's G1 English and Irish Oaks heroine is being geared towards a tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 3. "We had a team talk with the owners and Jamie Spencer on Friday morning and decided we didn't fancy going 10 furlongs on fast ground around Sandown with Sariska," Bell told the *Racing Post*. "We had originally hatched a plan which revolved around the Arc, and we will now revert to that."

After collecting the GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream Mar. 20, the bay with the distinctive face took plenty of money as a 10-1 chance in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1, but, after looming at the top of the stretch, wound up splitting the field in 10th. "For a moment I thought she was going to be right there, but she kind of flattened out in the final eighth," said Pletcher, who wound up winning the race anyway with Super Saver (Maria's Mon).

"She probably didn't have as much foundation as we would have liked. We kicked [the thought of going to the GI Belmont S.] around, but we just felt after the Derby that we should give her plenty of time." The Glencrest Farm colorbearer captured the GI Frizette S. at this track in October before disappointing when 11th in the Breeders' Cup. She faces stablemates **Ailalea** (Pulpit), coming off a win in Churchill's GIII Dogwood S. May 29; and **Katy Now** (Tiznow), who is stepping up after a local allowance success May 28.

Ballydoyle struck here with Peeping Fawn (Danehill) three years ago following her placed effort in the G1 Epsom Oaks and bid to repeat the tale with **Remember When**. Still a maiden, the three-parts sister to Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill) has raced exclusively in black-type company so far this term, and followed a come-back third behind **Chinese White** in the Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S. at Gowran Park May 2 with a close fourth in this venue's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas three weeks later. Stepped up to a mile and a half for the Oaks, she looked likely to take the honors before fading late on to be third in that June 4 Classic, and Aidan O'Brien is hoping she can continue to draw comparisons with the 2007 winner. "She is in very good form and ran very well in the Oaks--she got a little bit tired after coming there looking like she was going to run a big race, and ran a little bit like Peeping Fawn," he said. "She is still a maiden, but there are comparisons with Peeping Fawn, and we'll take our time on her and hope she runs a nice race." Jockey Johnny Murtagh added, "It was a very good run and she maybe didn't stay the trip that day, so this will be ideal for her. She's a filly I like a lot, and she has improved through the year."

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Chinese White has been a credit to connections throughout her career, and is in for a final hurrah here in foal to Cape Cross (Ire). Her latest third in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup over 1 5/16 miles May 23 came on similar fast ground, and that is the main concern again. Godolphin's '09 G2 Ribblesdale S. winner **Flying Cloud** was third behind Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and Middyay (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) on her return in York's G3 Middleton S. May 13. Saeed bin Sueroor said of her, "I was happy with Flying Cloud on her first start of the season, and she came up against two very good fillies at York. It will be a tough race to win, but she has the class to run well in a Group 1, and she will enjoy racing over 10 furlongs." Jim Bolger saddles **Akdarena**, who followed a seven-length success in the G3 Blue Wind S. at Naas May 12 with a sixth in the Oaks. Bolger said, "She came out of the Oaks a little bit on the light side, and it's taken time to get her weight back on."

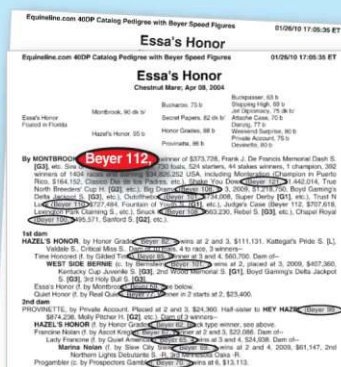

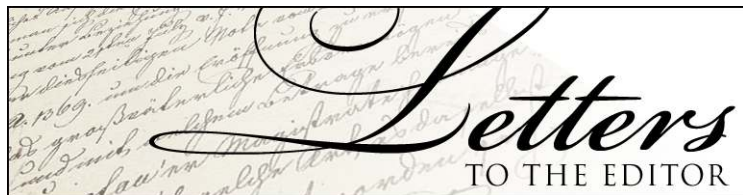

#2- Giving each paying attendee a quick, Pick 6 ticket that comes with the price of admission. This simple act would inspire all who received one to watch and be interested in at least the first race. No one is going to turn down what could be a huge paying lottery ticket, and if there was a big winner, it's great publicity for the track and racing! A similar and maybe better suggestion has also been made to give each paying entrant a \$2 betting voucher that could be used at either the tellers or the automatic betting machines, ensuring that the vast majority of the young crowd would bet on at least one race. This would give a person unfamiliar with the process of betting a kick-start push to find out how easy it is to deal with the tellers and staff.

#3- Hold a hip (not fuddy duddy) and cool hand-capping "for dummies" how-to session right in the vicinity of the party crowd. Have a tent set up near the paddock, well-run with young, fun people and good signage helping newbies bet. There could be automatic teller stations in the air-conditioned tent, along with a paddock sign-up sheet. For those interested in going to the paddock with a "chaperone" racetrack representative, they could put down their information (name, email, cell phone, etc) and receive a text message if they were chosen to head to the paddock area before a race. Not only could young people get up-close and personal with the horses, they could possibly meet some of the owners and jockeys. Let us all not forget, we have the biggest weapon in all of sports: human's awe of the beauty, the athleticism and love of the horse. Since the vast majority of the racing on Friday nights is not stakes caliber, the paddock should be an easy-going and relaxed environment for new fans to really see more of what racing is about. The fact that the paddock goes signed up to visit the paddock would be key to their future interest in racing. They could receive follow-up promotions via email to come to other days of racing and fun.

Our industry is in trouble. We need to involve and inspire new fans. This is a captured crowd coming to Churchill Downs for fun--let's make the most of it and them and introduce those who want to learn to what makes us so passionate about this industry. It is time for us to embrace the younger set that we have so long ignored.

Now that the younger set has walked through the turnstiles, we need to look at converting these partygoers into future fans of the sport. As easy as it may seem to an experienced bettor, placing a bet and reading a (*Daily Racing*) *Form* is a daunting and intimidating task to a young person who has never attended a racetrack.

I had a wonderful time last Friday night helping introduce a client's smart and savvy 20-year-old daughter to the sport. Through that experience, I realized that it was hard not to overload her with a ton of data, and I had to focus my information into something that was easily understood and fun.

For example, the name, age and color of the horse, along with the jockey, trainer and owner and morning-line odds. 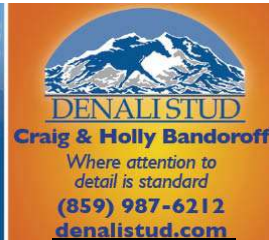

UNCOUPLED ENTRIES APPROVED IN NY According to the *Daily Racing Form*, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board ruled Wednesday that, effective July 14, entries that have the same trainer, but different owners, can race uncoupled in the state. The New York Racing Association has been lobbying for the change since 2006 and, according to *DRF*, NYRA officials have calculated that more than \$556 million in total handle was lost in the interim, the equivalent of \$20.7 million in revenue for NYRA and \$18.7 million in purses. The loss was attributed to the fact that, under state rules, New York tracks are not allowed to offer superfectas on races that include coupled entries, which necessitated 1,246 scratches between 2006 and

2009. It has not yet been announced when NYRA will adopt the uncoupled entries policy, but it is expected to be in place when the Saratoga meeting opens July 23.

KENTUCKY MINIMUM THRESHOLDS TO BE RELEASED The Kentucky Racing Commission will be required to release previously unpublished medication thresholds and minimum detection levels in the wake of a ruling issued by the Fayette County Court Thursday. Veterinarian Frank Piehowicz sued the commission for the information under Kentucky's Open Records Act after he was issued a citation for a medication overage, but was told that the threshold for that medication was confidential. While publishing some thresholds, the Commission had previously withheld a one-page table of therapeutic medications and minimum concentration levels, below which the Commission would not issue a positive finding on raceday. They argued that the document was properly withheld under the Kentucky Open Records Act, and that the release of the information could be used by those wishing to affect a horse's performance without incurring a positive finding. According to Piehowicz's attorney, Frank Becker, the case represents the first time any racing authority has been required to reveal the minimum thresholds. Said Becker, "We are pleased that the judge ruled that there was no exception to Kentucky's Open Records Act with regard to the table of thresholds. We think this will assist veterinarians in their compliance with Kentucky law."

MARQUETRY RETIRED TO OLD FRIENDS Marquetry (Conquistador Cielo--Regent's Walk, by Vice Regent), who was pensioned this spring due to fertility problems, has been retired to Old Friends in Georgetown, Kentucky. The 23-year-old stallion was standing at Stone-

wall Farm Ocala LLC for a fee of \$3,000 when he was pensioned. From 14 crops to race, he has sired 34 stakes winners, including champion sprinters Artax and Squirtle Squirt and graded winners Stella Grande (Aus), American Freedom and Uanme. His progeny have earned more than \$36 million. Marquetry, a Grade I winner on turf and dirt, captured the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, GI Meadowlands Cup and GI Eddie Read H., and earned \$2,856,811. A \$110,000 KEEJUL yearling bred by Edward A. Cox Jr., he started his career for Juddmonte Farms, who sold an interest to Dr. Moreley Engelson in 1992. He was trained by Bobby Frankel. The chestnut started his stud career at Vinery in 1994 before moving to Stonewall.

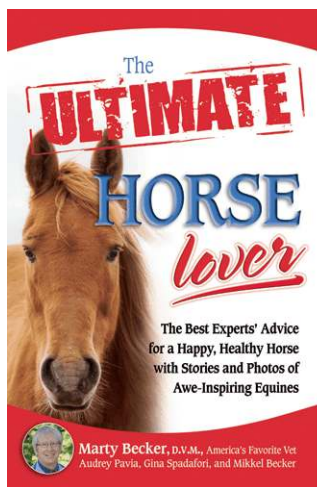
