## CAPED CRUSADER

The Curragh was the scene of a historical training achievement yesterday as Aidan O'Brien became the first to win five consecutive renewals of the G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby courtesy of Derrick Smith's **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). For good measure, the 7-2 second favorite led home stable companions **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Jan Vermeer (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) at half-length and 1 1/2-length intervals as he put an unplaced effort in the June 6 G1 Prix du Jockey Club firmly behind him. Settled in fourth early off the fast pace set by the stable rabbits, the chestnut put it up to Midas Touch at the top of the stretch and after gaining the edge before the furlong marker toughed it out to prove Johnny Murtagh right in his choice. "All the horses ran great

## SUPER SAVER HASKELL BOUND

WinStar Farm's **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon), winner of the G1 Kentucky Derby, will make his next start in Monmouth Park's G1 IZOD Haskell Invitational, trainer Todd Pletcher confirmed yesterday morning. "He's training great, and we're on schedule to be at Monmouth on Aug. 1." Pletcher has already taken the Jersey shore's marquee event when winning back-to-back runnings of the \$1-million contest with WinStar runners Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) in 2006 and in 2007 with Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor). Super Saver, a 2 1/2-length winner in the run for the roses May 1, faded late to finish eighth in the G1 Preakness S. May 15. Since the Preakness, the bay has recorded a trio of works at Belmont Park, including a five-furlong move this morning in 1:01 4/5.

Cape Blanco was always at the forefront of the Ballydoyle juvenile ranks in 2009 and went unbeaten in three starts with varying degrees of style. After a workmanlike debut success over seven furlongs at Fairyhouse in June, he went to Leopardstown for the

G3 Tyros S. the following month and displayed panache under positive tactics. A month later, he was back at Fairyhouse for the G2 Futurity S.--diverted from this venue--and had to pull out the stops to satisfy the bridge-jumpers at 1-5, prompting connections to point to the testing ground for that less-than-flattering effort. With bounce back in the surface at York on his belated return, he saw off Workforce (GB) (King's Best) at odds with his equipment in the May 13 G2 Dante S., and it was a case

of divergent fortunes for the first two home thereafter. Just 24 hours after the runner-up had blasted himself into immortality at Epsom, Cape Blanco was delivering a first disappointing performance when out the back in the Chantilly equivalent and he entered this race with a point to prove. "The last day was a blip on this horse's card and we couldn't understand it, but this is great for everybody," commented Aidan O'Brien. O'Brien was welcoming back an eighth Irish Derby winner in total, with seven of those coming since 2001. This was also the second time that Ballydoyle representatives had filled the first three places in this Classic after Soldier of Fortune (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) spearheaded the trifecta just three years ago.

Johnny Murtagh's decision to desert Jan Vermeer in his favor suggested Ballydoyle were expecting a turnaround from the French flop, and it was evident early on here that he was a different proposition to the languid version seen last time. As the stable's Bright Horizon (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) provided the lead-out with the Epsom runner-up At First Sight (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Midas Touch behind, Cape Blanco sat in the clear in fourth. When Colm O'Donoghue committed Midas Touch at the top of the straight, Murtagh opted to cover the move. Despite Seamus Heffernan and Jan Vermeer briefly threatening up the rail, it was Cape Blanco and Midas Touch who had it between them, and the latter was gradually subdued from a furlong out. "Johnny gave him a brilliant ride, and I'm just delighted to be part of it," O'Brien added. "They all ran stormers. It wasn't the horse that we knew in France, and maybe it was the travel and the first day away in the heat like that, but something upset him. Today, he left it all behind him, and we saw all the class and courage that we always thought was there. We always thought if things went well here, we'd look at the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 24]." The supplemented Monterosso (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), sent off the 3-1 favorite, was sending out distress signals before the straight, but stayed on strongly under Frankie Dettori to be fourth. Trainer Mark Johnston said of him, "I have to be honest and say we didn't come to be fourth, but at the same time there were no excuses. Frankie said it was either a bridge too far and we were expecting too much of him--and maybe when I go back and look at the form of his Royal Ascot race I'll say that's his form--or, hopefully, it just came a little bit too soon [after his win in the G2 King Edward VII S.] and there is more to come from him later in the year."

Alain and Gerard Wertheimer have enjoyed their fair share of glory with Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in recent times, but the famed brothers were provided with a handsome bonus here as Plumania held on by the slimmest of margins from Youmzain for a first top-level success. Labeled a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ at two, the homebred was fourth in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp in October 2008

before going through her sophomore campaign winless. Despite that statistic, the bay showed she retained a high level of ability with third placings in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly in June and in Longchamp's G1 Prix Vermeille in September, on the latter occasion being promoted to second on the disqualification of Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}).

Taking time to find her stride this term, she followed a return fourth in a conditions event here Apr. 9 with the same placing in the G3 Prix Allez France back at Chantilly May 3. Back to winning ways last time in the May 24 G2 Prix Corrida over 1 5/16 miles here, she was placed near the front end by Olivier Peslier as Pouvoir Absolu (GB) (Sadler's Wells) set a less-than-demanding pace in front of her. Striking decisively at the top of the stretch, she kept on in game fashion as first the favorite Daryakana closed in and then Youmzain arrived with a wide flourish under Richard Hughes. In the event, the post came in time, and it was her nose down and Youmzain's raised for the photo, with Daryakana sandwiched between in a pulsating finale. **cont. p4**

Andre Fabre was recording a sixth renewal after a subsequent stewards' inquiry into possible interference between the winner and eventual fifth Pouvoir Absolu allowed the result to stand. Pierre-Yves Bureau, Racing Manager for Wertheimer et Frere, told *Jour de Galop*, "That was a great performance. The filly has been to the Stud in the winter like Goldikova and is a very good filly who deserves her win today in a Group One. It was a perfect ride from Olivier Peslier and she goes to the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 12]." Youmzain's connections are looking at the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 24 before a fourth crack at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 3, while Daryakana's jockey Christophe-Patrice Lemaire said of the third home, "We had a doubt about how she would handle the left-handed bends, but she did so very nicely and had every chance after enjoying a good run behind the leaders. At one stage, I thought I might win, but she was beaten by two better horses on the day and I have no excuses." Off the mark at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 28, Never Forget registered a black-type success in Longchamp's Listed Prix de la Seine May 16 before filling third spot behind Lady's Purse in Chantilly's G3 Prix de Royaumont last time June 6. Tracking that rival in this tactical renewal, the bay was forwardly placed by Anthony Crastus as Gerald Mosse set funereal fractions on Lady's Purse. Traveling strongly at the top of the stretch as Christophe-Patrice Lemaire wound up the favorite Shamanova for her effort from behind, Never Forget grabbed the lead at the furlong pole and was beyond recall as that rival closed late to fill the runner's-up berth. "She is very brave, and last time in the Prix de Royaumont, they went a very fast pace and on the uphill finish she found a mile and a half too far," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "Today, on this flat track, she found the distance much more in her range and was very brave again." Owner-breeder Claude Cohen added, "I have bred most of the family, and my dream is to run in the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 12], so hopefully that's where we'll head." This renewal, which has been dominated by Aidan O'Brien in recent times, lost some intrigue when Jim Bolger scratched newcomer Glor Na Mara (Ire) (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). But the crowd was nonetheless treated to a pulsating finale as Formosina denied Samuel Morse in the dying strides to end Ballydoyle's sequence. Third behind the subsequent G2 Coventry S. winner Strong Suit (Rahy) at Newbury May 14, Formosina underlined that form when scoring by seven lengths at Doncaster last time June 13. Settled behind the early leaders by Ryan Moore, the bay was angled wide to tackle the pace-setters Samuel Morse and Clondinnery inside the closing 100 yards and ground down the former late. "I thought he would have been an unlucky loser if he hadn't got the run as he was traveling well behind," trainer Jeremy Nosedá said. "He's improved since his debut at Newbury, but I rang up an owner of mine after that and said 'We've just seen the winner of the Coventry,' and he went on to do that, so I knew it was a good race. He gave me the impression he had moved forward again from Doncaster and I had this in the back of my mind. The only ground he wouldn't want is very soft, and I've no doubt he'll get seven [furlongs]. Grand Adventure, winner of the one-mile GIII Summer S. at two, scored once in four starts last term--a \$62,000 optional claimer at Woodbine in August--and was runner-up in the Bonapaw S. at the Fair Grounds in his seasonal finale in December. Fifth in his seasonal bow going six panels on the dirt at the New Orleans oval in the Gaudin Memorial Jan. 23, the dark bay returned to be a close-up second in the GIII Shakertown S. over the Keeneland turf Apr. 10. The winner of the seven-furlong GIII Connaught Cup May 30, the Sam-Son Farms rep was well backed here. 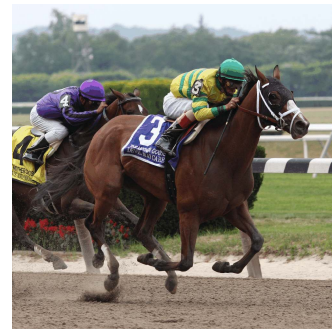

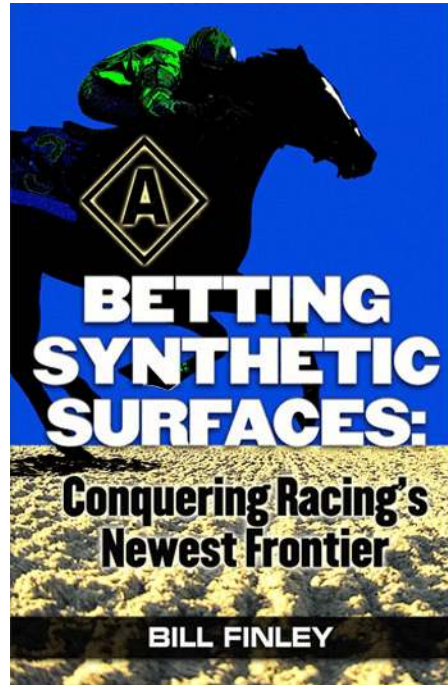

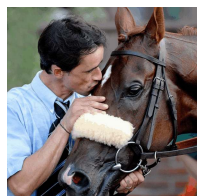
