## NO HOLDING HIM BACK ON CANADA DAY

**Hold Me Back** (Giant's Causeway) might not be Canadian born or raised, but he certainly had reason to celebrate after he gained a narrow decision in Woodbine's

GIII Dominion Day H. yesterday. Waving the banner for the hot combination of WinStar Farm and Bill Mott--the team that took down the June 5 GI Belmont S. with Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor)--Hold Me Back had to work considerably harder for the victory than his Classic-winning stablemate did. However, at the end of the 10-furlong contest, the handsome dark bay had enough left to hold off **Pool Play** (Silver Deputy) by a head. Allowed to stalk 41-1 shot **Mast Track** (Mizzen Mast)'s opening splits of :24.42, :48.12 and 1:12.31, the Keeneland graduate narrowed the gap on the tiring leader and poked his head in front at the head of the stretch. With 11-1 chance Pool Play hot on his heels, Hold Me Back had to dig deep to stave off that rival by a head at the wire, collecting his first victory in over a year. Showing some run approaching the final turn, 8-5 choice Southdale (Street Cry {Ire}) evened out late to pick up third. *Cont. p2*

## RACHEL RETURNS TO MONMOUTH JULY 24

**Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro), winner of last summer's GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth, will return to that venue to compete in the July 24 Lady's

Secret S. The Lady's Secret was originally scheduled for Aug. 1 as part of the Haskell Day undercard, however, with Rachel Alexandra running, the race has been moved ahead on the calendar and the purse has been increased to \$400,000. If Rachel Alexandra is unable to compete, the purse will revert to the originally scheduled \$150,000. "We had a great experience at Monmouth Park, and we appreciate the overwhelming show of support the fans there have given us," said

Jess Jackson, who owns the defending Horse of the Year in partnership with Harold McCormick. "It's the perfect place to start what we hope will be another championship run." Rachel Alexandra, winner of last year's GI Preakness S., also defeated older males in the GI Woodward at Saratoga. In her latest start, the four-year-old filly romped in the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill Downs June 12.

**More Speed for Antares World**

Trainer Steve Specht indicated that dual stakes winning **Antares World** (Decarchy) will likely be closer to the pace in Saturday's GI American Oaks than she was in her most recent start in the June 6 GII Hollywood Oaks. Placed off the early pace in fourth in a five-horse field in the 8 1/2-furlong test over Hollywood's Cushion Track, the dark bay offered little of her late kick and had to settle for fourth behind winner Switch (Quiet American) and runner-up Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision). "She's better up close, and I was pretty upset last race when I saw her back there behind those slow fractions," admitted Specht. "If they're crawling, I want to be there." Specht summoned Frank Alvarado, who rode the filly to victories in the California Oaks and the grassy Golden Poppy H. at Golden Gate Fields, to replace Victor Espinoza. "I don't think the surface is an issue," said Specht of the switch from Cushion Track to turf. The filly, who worked six panels in 1:12 flat at Golden Gate June 27, shipped south from the Northern California oval Monday. "She's an easy filly to ride; she has tactical speed," said Specht of the California-bred. "She's not a front-end horse and she's not a deep closer. She keeps grinding away."

The winner of his first two career starts over the Polytrack, Hold Me Back failed to make an impact when fifth in his juvenile finale in Old Fashioned (Unbridled's Song)'s GII Remsen S. A comfortable winner when returned to the synthetic for the GII Lane's End S. at Keeneland in his three-year-old bow, the colt was runner-up in the GI Bluegrass S. before finishing 12th after problematic trip in the GI Kentucky Derby. Off the board while trying the turf for the first time in the Virginia Derby, Hold Me Back was second in a sloppy edition of the GI Travers S. and rounded out his sophomore season with a sixth in the nine-furlong GII Kentucky Cup Classic Sept. 26. In a pair of starts on the dirt earlier this term, the Kentucky-bred rallied to be second as the even-money choice in an \$80,000 optional claimer over a mile at Gulfstream Mar. 3 before failing to recover following a stumble at the start and coming home ninth in the GII New Orleans H. Mar. 27.

Since winning the Betfair TVG GI Acorn S., **Champagne d'Oro** has remained stabled at Belmont under the care of Guillot's assistant, Richard Baltas. Originally considered for last Saturday's GI Mother Goose S., Guillot opted to hold Champagne d'Oro back a week and run her in this shorter spot. "The Mother Goose was too quick back, and I wanted to come off a sprint going into the [GI] Test [S., over seven furlongs, Aug. 7 at Saratoga], not back up from a mile and a sixteenth," Guillot explained. "I think seven-eighths is her best distance, and I haven't gotten to run her at it yet--that's why I'm eyeballing the Test. Running three-quarters at Belmont is more like seven-eighths, in my opinion, because you have those big turns."

"We're trying to get things sorted out with the plane," said Mettee. "He will work five furlongs this weekend [at Belmont Park]. We're trying to get there." Rafael Bejarano will ride the five-year-old for the first time. Winner of the GI Arkansas Derby at three, the dark bay was purchased privately by Godolphin at the beginning of 2009 and captured a Group 3 in Dubai in March before adding a score in the GI Ancient Title S. in October.

**KEENELAND RELEASES FALL STAKES SCHEDULE**

Keeneland officials yesterday released the stakes schedule for its Fall Meet, which will be held Oct. 8-30. The meeting will include 18 stakes races with purses totaling \$4.35 million. There will be 10 stakes races during the track's opening "FallStars Weekend," including six Grade I contests, and nine Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win and You're In" qualifiers during opening week.

Winners of the GI Darley Alcibiades S., GIII Phoenix S., GI Shadwell Turf Mile S., GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity S., GI First Lady S., GII Thoroughbred Club of America S., GI Juddmonte Spinster S., GIII Bourbon S. and J.P. Morgan Chase Jessamine S. will be granted automatic berths into corresponding Breeders' Cup races, to be held at Churchill Downs Nov. 5-6. All Breeders' Cup Challenge races from Keeneland will be televised on the ESPN family of networks.

"Even in these challenging economic times, we have been able to put together a month of the best that racing in North America has to offer," said Keeneland's Director of Racing, Rogers Beasley. "Our opening FallStars weekend, in particular, will offer some of the most compelling racing in America and provide a chance for fans to watch some of the top contenders for the Breeders' Cup in action."

There are also three new stakes sponsors: Abu Dhabi will sponsor the \$400,000 GI First Lady S. Oct. 9, The Emirates Equestrian Foundation will sponsor the \$50,000 President of the United Arab Emirates Cup for Arabians Oct. 9 and the exclusive West Virginia Greenbrier Resort will sponsor the \$150,000 GII Greenbrier Fayette S. Oct. 30.

Despite Keeneland's impressive fall line-up, officials acknowledged that they were forced to cut over \$1 million in purses, with most of the money coming from stakes races. The Perryville S. and Bryan Station S. were eliminated altogether. The track will still average more than \$500,000 in daily purses, however, and indicated it will preserve overnight purse money. There are currently no plans for purse reductions for Keeneland's 2011 race meetings.

"We are making these reductions after a great deal of thought and strategy," explained Beasley. "Our goal is to maintain a commitment to the highest quality racing and purses within the constraints of a very challenging economy. We think this purposeful approach accomplishes that objective."

**BC AND KY LOTTERY PARTNER TO PRODUCE SCRATCH-OFF**

The Breeders' Cup and Kentucky Lottery have announced plans to re-release the popular Breeders' Cup scratch-off ticket that sold almost one million copies in 2006, the last time the Breeders' Cup was held at Churchill Downs, to commemorate this year's championship that will take place in Louisville Nov. 5 and 6. The \$5 ticket will have a grand prize of \$30,000, and will be available in limited quantities beginning July 1. Nine images of past Breeders' Cup winners, including last year's GI Classic winner Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), will adorn the tickets. Players will also have a chance to enter losing tickets into a drawing for one of 10 VIP grand-prize packages that will include tickets and accommodations to attend this year's championships.

Champion **Thunder Puddles** (Speak John--Big Puddles, by Delta Judge) died June 29 at Carl Lizza Jr. and Joseph Bartone's Highcliff Farm in Delanson. The stallion, who had stood at the upstate farm since entering stud in 1985, was 31. Thunder Puddles was buried at Highcliff. In regard to Thunder Puddles' track and stud careers Highcliff Farm's co-manager, Suzie O'Cain summed it up, "He had the perfect trip." Bred and raced by Long Islanders Herbert Schwartz and Dr. Robert Boggiano, the New York-bred finished runner-up in the Pilgrim S. at two and added the GII Rutgers H. and West Point H. the following season. Also at three, the chestnut was second in the GI Rothmans International S., and third in both the GI Washington D.C. International S. and GI Man O'War S. He was fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe three years ago, and was the runner-up in what turned out to be his final race in the June 13 G1 Gran Premio di Milano. Getaway compiled a record of 22-9-6-1, and earned over \$1.2 million. He was due to undergo surgery yesterday.
