

FRANNY FREUD GETS HER GRADE I

Trainer John Terranova opted to skip the one-mile June 5 GI Acorn S. for **Franny Freud** (Freud) and instead targeted yesterday's six-furlong GI Prioress S. at Belmont. To that end, he chose an atypical prep--the grassy, seven-furlong New York Stallion S. facing males May 26. Franny Freud won easily that day, and in the Prioress, made her trainer look smart, rallying from off the pace to beat **Champagne d'Oro** (Medaglia d'Oro) and **Bonnie Blue Flag** (Mineshaft) by a comfortable 1 3/4-length margin.

Runner-up in both the English and French 2000 Guineas and in the G1 St James's Palace S., John Manley's **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) enjoyed his own day in the sun in yesterday's G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly. Sent off at a generous 7-1 as all the focus was centred around the dual Classic hero **Lope de Vega (Ire)** (Shamardal), the bay kept that rival in his sights in third early. While the favorite was sending out distress signals as soon as he had taken command in the straight, Richard Hughes steered Dick Turpin by with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and his mount settled the result in a matter of strides. At the line, it was **Siyouni (Fr)** (Pivotal {GB}) who came through for second at a respectful four lengths distance. **Cont. p3**

A three-time black-type winner as a juvenile, Franny Freud was just 3/4 lengths adrift of Amen Hallelujah (Montbrook) when shipped across the country to contest the GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita Jan. 16. She aired by nearly five lengths in the Beaumont at Keeneland Apr. 7, then returned to Belmont for her last two. She won the restricted, 6 1/2-furlong New York Stallion Park Avenue S. on the main track May 2, then switched to the green to beat the boys in her latest. She was looking for her fourth straight win in the Prioress.

Hammered down to 3-5 favoritism despite the presence of GI Acorn S. upsetter Champagne d'Oro, Franny Freud was settled in fourth under Garrett Gomez as Stormandaprayer (Songandaprayer) roared through :21.85 and :44.97 splits. Tipped widest of all heading into the lane, Franny Freud forged to the front soon after and was kept to task to prevail by three lengths. Champagne d'Oro edged out Bonnie Blue Flag for place honors. "Of course, there was a lot of speed in the race, but she's fast and Garrett just kind of let her settle into her spot," said Terranova. "We didn't know how fast the early fractions were going to be. It looked like she was just waiting to pounce." Added Gomez, "She's just all horse. She's a little bitty thing, but she gives 120 percent. As far as how far she'll go, she just keeps answering questions for everybody, including her fans. She's a New York-bred doing good things." Richard Baltas, assistant to Eric Guillot, trainer of runner-up Champagne d'Oro was happy with the filly's effort. "I thought she ran great," said Baltas. "She just didn't have the trip. She got behind horses and got in a little trouble, but it wasn't bad. Take nothing against the winner--she's a good horse. I was a little worried shortening back up to six furlongs, but she was ready and was doing great all week. We're happy." Miguel Mena, aboard Champagne d'Oro, added, "If I'd gotten the lead, it would have been better for my horse, but the No. 5 horse [Stormandaprayer] showed more speed than my horse. She finished pretty good, but she's better on the lead." Dick Turpin entered his sophomore year as an outside prospect for the Guineas, with wins in Goodwood's G2 Richmond S. in July and the Tattersalls Ireland Sales S. at Fairyhouse the following month overshadowed by two off-the-board efforts at the top level in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp and G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October. Thrusting himself into the Classic picture with a defeat of Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in the Apr. 17 G3 Greenham S. at Newbury, the bay was again in front of that barnmate when second to Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the May 1 Newmarket Classic. He came up against another French talent in Lope de Vega in Longchamp's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains May 16 before Canford Cliffs mastered him at Royal Ascot June 15. With some ease in the ground to help here, connections spun the wheel again and Richard Hughes was intent on tracking his Poulains conqueror early, as the Classic winner had **Altair Star (Ire)** (Kris Kin) to set the race up. Despite traveling strongly to the turn in, the 9-10 favorite was soon treading water after the rabbit had completed his task in early stretch. Dick Turpin was going forward in style at that point and quickly had his measure inside the final quarter before extending all the way to the line.

"We went a very fast gallop and I kicked him on at least two furlongs out because I knew I'd stay well and I said after the race that he'll probably get 10 furlongs because they weren't catching me," jockey Richard Hughes told *PA Sport*. "He killed them off very quickly. We said to the owners we'll take it race by race and he'll tell us when he's ready to run again. He's been on the go a while, but he looked so well we said 'Why not go?' The only thing we wouldn't do was run him on firm ground, but the French water well and do a very good job." It would be hard to argue that Signature Red didn't deserve this first graded win after an all-heart battle with the veteran Hero's Reward. The bay, who concluded his 2009 season with a third in the GIII Kennedy Road S. over Woodbine's main track, returned to be second in an optional claimer here Apr. 23, then was third again in a graded stakes, the six-furlong GIII Vigil S. May 9. Making just his second start on the spinach in his latest, Signature Red took a lucrative six-panel allowance race June 12 and was the 2-1 second pick returning to black-type company. On the hip of Hero's Reward from the start, he moved to take command in upper stretch and outslugged that foe to the wire. Last year's GI Kentucky Derby hero Mine That Bird (Birdstone) was sent off the public's 5-2 choice in his seasonal debut, but it was Tizdejavu who took the spoils here. The five-year-old's form had tailed off by the end of 2009, as evidenced by his seventh-place showing in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland in mid-October. But he was back on his game when he wired an optional claimer at Arlington Park May 9, and made it two straight with another gate-to-wire score in the Opening Verse S. at Churchill June 11. The bay once again made every pole a winning one, gunning out to lead through honest :23.20, :45.94 and 1:09.73 splits. He kicked away to lead by nearly three lengths in upper stretch and kept on well late. Mine That Bird, unraced since finishing ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 7, was dead last early in the strung-out field and came home eighth. "He was struggling so much," jockey Calvin Borel said of Mine That Bird, making his turf debut. "He kept moving back and forth, switching leads. We will see a different horse after this, a totally different horse. He came back real good, jogging good. I'm telling you get him on the dirt, and you'll see a different horse." A jump past the line, however, he took an awkward step and was quickly pulled up by Brice Blanc. TVG reported the seven-year-old had suffered a career-ending dislocated right front ankle and was being evaluated. After Discreetly Mine's lackluster 13th-place showing in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1, connections opted to focus on sprints. The Robsham homebred set a torrid early pace in the June 5 GII Woody Stephens at Belmont and held on well for second behind D' Funnybone (D'wildcat). New rider John Velazquez decided to employ different tactics today, and guided the GII Risen Star S. hero to the rail early to stalk the pace in the garden spot. Out of Respect led the pack through fractions of :22 flat and :44 4/5 and repelled the bid of second-choice Safe Trip, but could not hold off Discreetly Mine, who bounded home on the outside to win going away. "He kind of got squeezed coming out of there in the first four or five jumps, and I had to encourage him a little bit to make sure he wasn't too far back," said Velazquez. "I thought maybe I was two works short of having him at his very best, but he proved me wrong." Attfield explained the extended absence. "He grabbed a heel really, really badly in Florida, and it took a long time to grow in," said the conditioner. "But he's in fine shape now and, hopefully, we'll have a great year from here on in." Added Smith, "He felt great the whole time. Roger told me not to hit the front too soon. He was going to be a little bit fresh, just cover him up and make that one run. 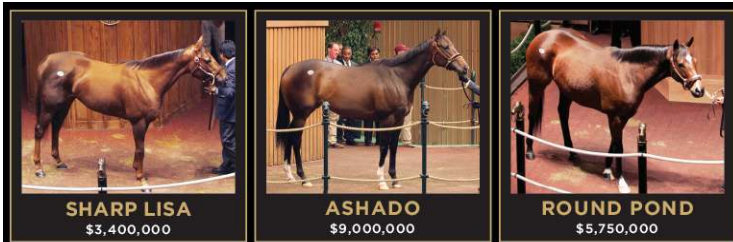

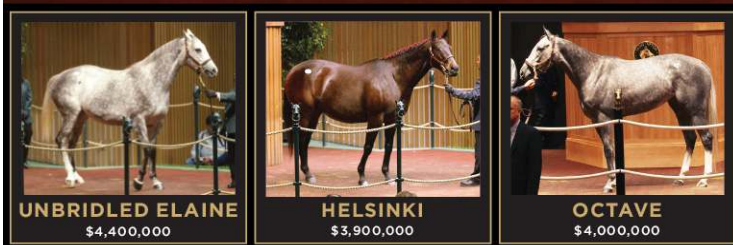

The three horses that comprised the trifecta in Saturday's GII Suburban H. at Belmont Park seem to have exited the nine-furlong race no worse for the wear. Turtle Bird Stable's **Haynesfield** (Speightstown), who led home **Convocation** (Pulpit) and **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even), "came out of the race well," according to Toby Sheets, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen. Sheets said that connections haven't discussed the four-year-old's next start. "We'll wait until he comes back and breezes, and then begin talking about it," he said. Jimmy Jerkens, who conditions Convocation for Centennial Farms, was happy with his charge's effort after a lunging start left the colt toward the back of the pack early. "He ran well, although I don't know why he breaks like that," said Jerkens. "I think he could have been closer to the pace. I'm not sure if he's ready for the GI Whitney [at Saratoga Aug. 7]. I might try him on the grass--he's got the breeding for it." Convocation was produced by Shade Dance (Nureyev), an unraced half-sister to 2001 juvenile filly champion **Tempera** (A.P. Indy). IEAH Stable's **I Want Revenge**, who was making his first start since his GI Wood Memorial win some 15 months ago, also appeared okay. "He's doing well," said Michelle Nevin, assistant to trainer Rick Dutrow.

'Richard' Returns; 'Trip' Assigned 123 for Gold Cup...

Jay Em Ess Stable's **Rail Trip** (Jump Start) will tote 123 pounds when he tries to become the third multiple winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup next Saturday. The reigning champ would join **Lava Man** and **Native Diver** if he's able to defend his title. Both of those California-bred geldings won the race three times; **Native Diver** in 1965-67, **Lava Man** in 2005-07. Going for the minor upset will the returning **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid), unraced since finishing seventh in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 27. "I think it's a good spot for him to start back," said trainer Baffert. "He needs to be going long and it should set him up good for Del Mar. [But] I think **Rail Trip** will be awful tough to beat."

Pure Clan Back Training...

Lewis Lakin's **Pure Clan** (Pure Prize), who was given some time off after refusing to train the morning of May 6, is back at trainer Bob Holthus's barn at Churchill Downs and is set to resume training. The five-year-old multiple Grade I winner was bucking and playing after jogging yesterday under the Twin Spires, prompting a big smile from her conditioner. "She looks a lot happier out there than she was all last year," Holthus said. "She will start galloping again [today]." **Pure Clan** had battled a bruised left front foot this spring, then was sent to Lakin's farm in Versailles and spent time on an aqua-tread. "She has been on the treadmill for 45 days, so it won't be that long until she works," Holthus said of **Pure Clan**, who returned to the barn Thursday. "So far, I like what I see from her." **Pure Clan** concluded her 2009 campaign with a runner-up finish to **Midday** (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Santa Anita, and once again has that race as a target. The Breeders' Cup will be held this year at Churchill Nov. 5-6. "We are going to try to make the GI Flower Bowl [at Belmont in October]," Holthus said. "That would give us the best chance to make the Breeders' Cup." **Pure Clan** won last year's Flower Bowl.

In the summer they would hang in the shed in the heat of the day, but as the sun went down and the heat abated, they would gallop out of the shed, racing each other across the field. After making a few turns, they would settle down for a night of grazing. I looked forward to watching this scene play out; it is one of my fondest memories of horses just being horses. The geldings were not top racehorses, some had never even raced, a few were retired lead ponies, but they all possessed that unbridled spirit horses, particularly Thoroughbreds, have. Wherever **Wake at Noon** is now, I hope he can gallop across the field tonight, free of pain and human expectation. What a shame that a champion such as he has to die to experience peace. *Sue Vitro, NY*
