SWEET 16 DECLARED FOR IRISH OAKS

Tomorrow's G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh will see an assembly of the largest field in living memory with 16 set to contest the €425,000 event, including the first three home in last month's G1 Epsom Oaks. Supplementary entries have been the order of the week, with four such additions made Tuesday, and Newmarket trainer Ed Dunlop will be hoping for a case of history repeating when he saddles **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) to exit from stall nine. That gate has not produced a winner since **Melodist (The Minstrel)** dead-heated in 1988, but the trainer's two previous winners--**Lailani (GB)** (Unfuwain) in 2001 and **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in 2004--were both supplements, as was **Snow Fairy** herself before her June 4 Epsom Oaks score. Oaks runner-up **Meeznah** (Dynaformer) has been allocated stall three, which housed last year's facile winner **Sariska (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}). The David Lanigan trainee will bid to emulate **Moonstone (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), who ran second at Epsom before tasting Curragh glory two years ago. Oaks third **Remember When (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), one of five Ballydoyle representatives, slipped one spot in the G1 **Pretty Polly S.** last time. She has drawn the six box which last gained victory courtesy of **Winona (Ire)** (Alzao) in 1998. The remainder of Aidan O'Brien's quintet have all been handed double-figure draws. His Highness The Aga Khan's **"TDN Rising Star"** **Rosanara (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}), runner-up in the French Oaks last month, attempts to replicate the win of fellow homebred **Shawanda (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}), who took the 2005 contest for trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. She has been handed the widest berth of all in one, from where 2001 victress **Lailani** emerged. Godolphin's supplemented pair of **Hibaayeb (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and **Miss Jean Brodie** (Maria's Mon) are drawn towards the inner, in boxes 12 and 14, respectively. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute holds the post-war record of six wins, and saddles supplementary entry **Eldalil (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) in an attempt to register a magnificent seven.

SWAPS EASY AS CANDY

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ and GI Santa Anita Derby hero **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) will face the starter for the first time since fading to 17th over a sloppy track in the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill May 1 in Saturday's GII Swap S. at Hollywood Park. Earlier in the year, the chestnut captured the GII San Vicente S. and GII San Felipe S. before taking the Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3. "He's back to himself," trainer John Sadler told *Daily Racing Form*. "You'll see him back on his form. He's ready to go." Sadler had entered another ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ by Candy Ride, **Twirling Candy**, but that colt--also a Craig homebred--was an early scratch. He breezed seven furlongs in 1:24 Thursday. With no other speed horses signed on, Life At Ten should have things all her own way on the front end. Conditioner Marty Wolfson was second in this race last year when Icon Project (Empire Maker) was compromised by a glacial early pace. He sends out **Miss Singhsix** this time, who took the local-prep GIII Obeah S. June 12. **Funny Moon**, winner of the 2009 GI Coaching Club American Oaks at this distance, is 3-1-1-1 this year, with a solid win in the GII Shuvee H. over subsequently retired Grade I winner Seattle Smooth (Quiet American), but will need to move forward again to challenge Life At Ten down the lane.

Free Flying Soul missed by a head to Mona de Momma (Speightstown) in the GIII Las Flores H. at Santa Anita Apr. 4, then was 1 1/2 lengths behind that rival in the slop at Churchill in the GI Humana Distaff S. May 1. The dark bay bounced back to take the Desert Stormer H. over this surface June 12, and has three straight bullet works in recent weeks. The fragile **Moon de French**, three-for-six lifetime, was sidelined following a two-turn allowance victory at Oak Tree, and returned to show speed before settling for fourth in the Desert Stormer. John Sadler, who has saddled the last two winners of this contest, is hoping for a three-peat with **Emmy Darling**, who needs to rebound from a fifth in the GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill May 31 in her most recent appearance.

Check the Label broke her maiden at Colonial in her second career start last July before showing solid, but unspectacular, form through the end of that term and into this one. She placed in several stakes during that time, then put it all together in the GIII Appalachian S. at Keeneland Apr. 15. 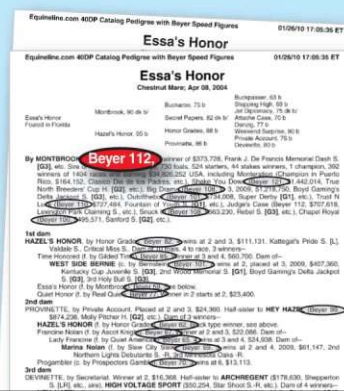

BREEDERS' CUP BOARD OF DIRECTORS RESULTS ANNOUNCED

Edited Press Release

Manfuso (Chanceland Farm); Clem Murphy (Coolmore Stud); Satish Sanan (Padua Stables); Richard Santulli (Colts Neck Stables LLC); Oliver Tait (Darley); E. Duncan Taylor (Taylor Made Sales) and David Willmot (Kinghaven Farms LLC).

NYCOTB TO UNVEIL REORGANIZATION PLAN

According to published reports, bankrupt New York City OTB is working on a reorganization plan that could result in a decrease in the share of revenue received by the state's racetracks and horsemen. The company is also considering proposals that would allow separate entities to assume control of some or all of NYCOTB's operations. The New York Racing Association, along with New York harness tracks and several of the state's other OTBs, have expressed an interest in being involved in the restructuring. Larry Schwartz, NYCOTB's new chairman, said, "The only way New York City OTB survives is if somebody takes over or we create a partnership." NYCOTB's plan for the future is expected to be unveiled next month, and several drastic measures have already been taken. According to *Daily Racing Form*, NYCOTB has terminated four top-level executives, including Chief Counsel Ira Block, CFO Robert Garry and Vice President of Marketing Ron Ceisler, and 11 OTB facilities are scheduled to be closed. "We are moving at warp speed," Schwartz said. NYCOTB President Greg Rayburn, who caused a stir when it was revealed he was earning \$125,000 a month to head up the beleaguered company's restructuring, told *DRF* that it is unlikely any faction of New York's racing industry will be satisfied with the plan. "It's pretty hard for me to imagine a process...not involving some level of compromise from each constituent," Rayburn said, adding, "It will probably be one in which everyone is equally unhappy."
